

## Yardage

**Backgrounds:** FQ of both 892E and 894E

**Four Patch blocks:** FQ of each of 892G, 891G, 891N, 893N

**Side triangles:**  $\frac{1}{2}$  yd of 892B

**Flowers:** 13" x 18" of each 894D, 895R

**Flower centers:** 6" x 6" of 893Y

**Stems and Leaves:** FQ of 895G

**Inner border:**  $\frac{1}{4}$  yd of 896B

**Outer border and binding:**  
 $1\frac{5}{8}$  yd of 890N

**Backing:** 3 yds of any Brambleberry Farm fabric

## Cutting

Applique patterns are finished size. Quilt was made with fusible applique techniques. For background cut:

(6) **cream squares**  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " from both cream fabrics for a total of (12) squares

(20) **blue squares**  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " from both blue fabrics for a total of (40) squares

(20) **green squares**  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " from both green fabrics for a total of (40) squares

(7) **light blue squares**  $6\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $6\frac{7}{8}$ ". Cut each block in half on the diagonal

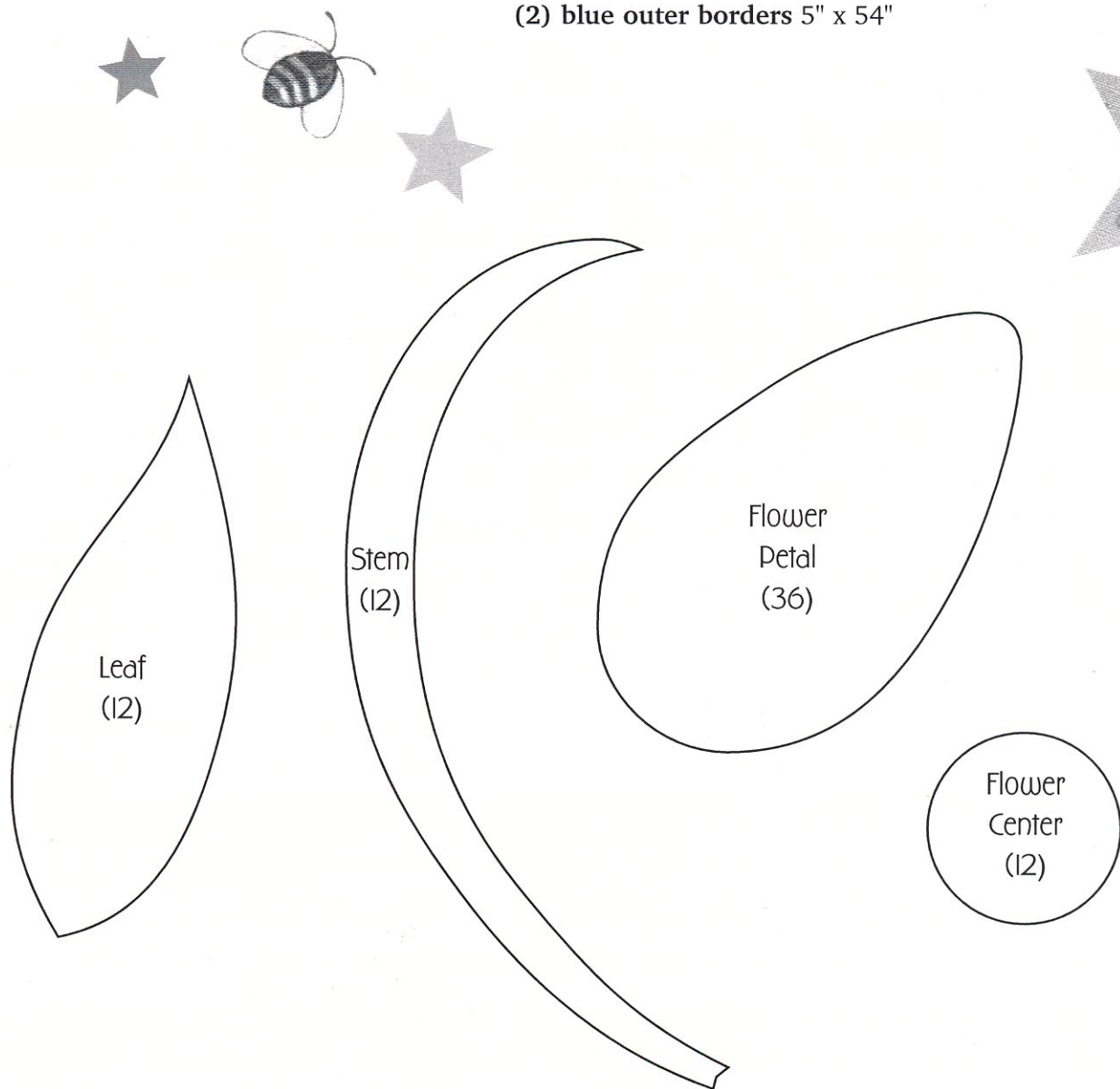
(1) **light blue square**  $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $7\frac{1}{4}$ ". Cut in half on the diagonal twice to make (4) corner triangles.

(2) **blue stripe inner borders**  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $34\frac{1}{2}$ "

(2) **blue stripe inner borders**  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 45"

(2) **blue outer borders** 5" x  $36\frac{1}{2}$ "

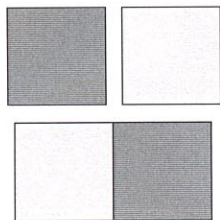
(2) **blue outer borders** 5" x 54"



# Construction

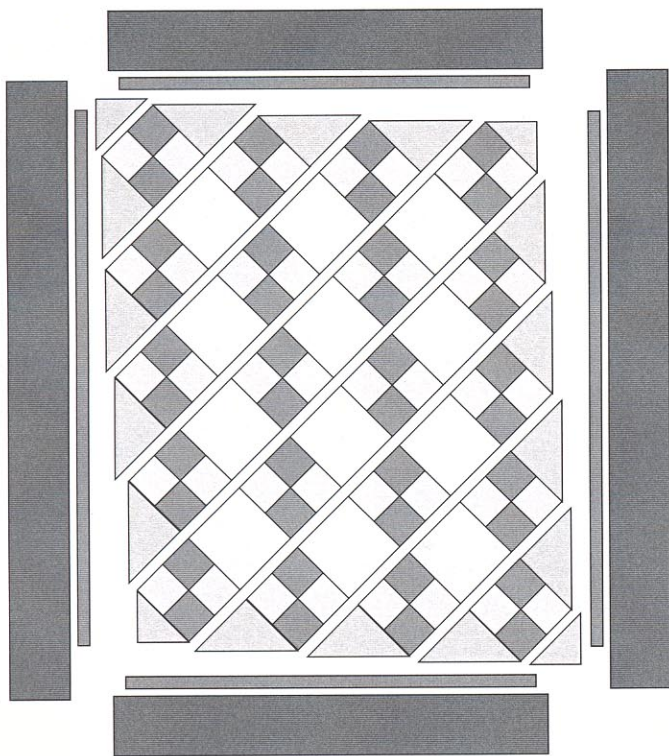
*Note - Refer to the diagrams and photo to assemble the quilt.*

1. Sew (2) blue and (2) green  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares together as shown below.

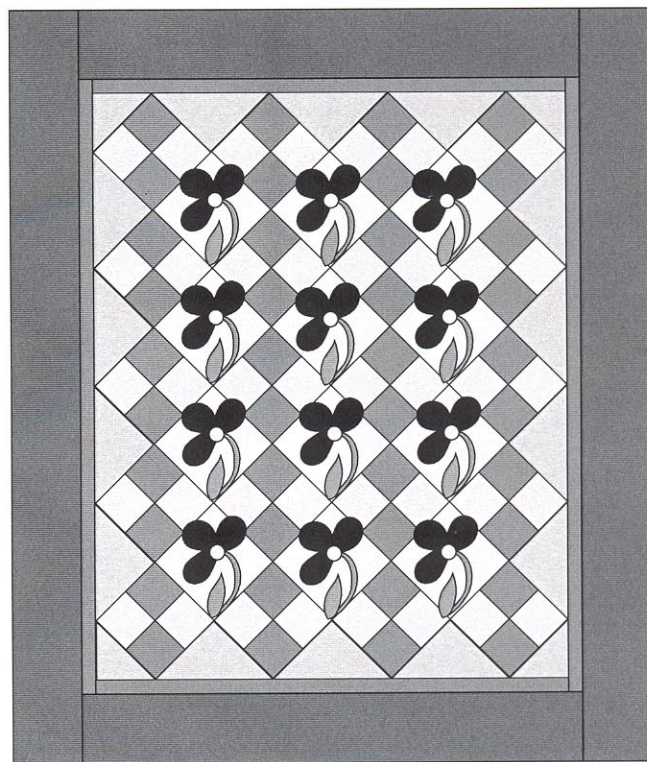


2. Make (20) four patch blocks.

3. Sew the quilt top in diagonal rows.



6. Add inner borders to top and bottom of quilt. Repeat for side borders.
7. Add outer borders to top and bottom of quilt. Repeat for side borders.
8. Layer, baste and quilt. This quilt has freeform stitching in both the background and borders.
9. Prepare binding and sew to the quilt. Fuse a single flower to a 7" x 7" label, applique and add the label to the back of your quilt. *Enjoy!*



4. Follow product instructions to use fusible web to adhere applique pieces to quilt.
5. Finish raw edges of all applique pieces with the machine stitch of your choice. Matching thread was used on this quilt with a blanket stitch.
