### Border, inner binding, binding and background

- \* Light blue Border print - 28" x wof (Width of Fabric)
- \* Medium to dark Blue border (also used in applique) 23" x wof
- \* Background print 1 - 15" x wof
- \* Background print 2 - 15" x wof
- \* Inner border and binding (stripe) - 18" x wof

### Applique

**NOTE** - if you are using your own fabrics,  
FQ or less will work for the pieces below

- \* Green print 1 - 10" x 16"
- \* Green print 2 - 10" x 16"
- \* Green print 3 - 5" x 14"
  
- \* Brown print - 8" x 15"
- \* White on White - 11" x 12"
- \* Light blue print 1 - 10" x 16"
- \* Orange print - 7" x 15"
  
- \* Yellow print 1 - 6" x 6"
- \* Yellow print 2 - 8" x 18"
- \* Yellow print 3 - 8" x 10"
- \* Yellow print 4 - 8" x 8"
- \* Yellow print 5 - 8" x 8"
  
- \* Pink print 1 - 5" x 20"
- \* Pink print 2 - 6" x 11"
- \* Pink print 3 - 6" x 11"

- \* 1 package of Heat n Bond Lite if doing fusible applique

### Thread for Embroidery

- \* 12 wt Aurifil, or size 8 pearl cotton, or DMC floss. I will be using a deep blue and a cream

## Cutting Directions Center

### Background print 1

- \* Cut 1 rectangle 12.5" x 18.5"
- \* Cut 1 rectangle 9.5" x 14.5"
- \* Cut 1 rectangle 8.5" x 14.5"

### Background print 2

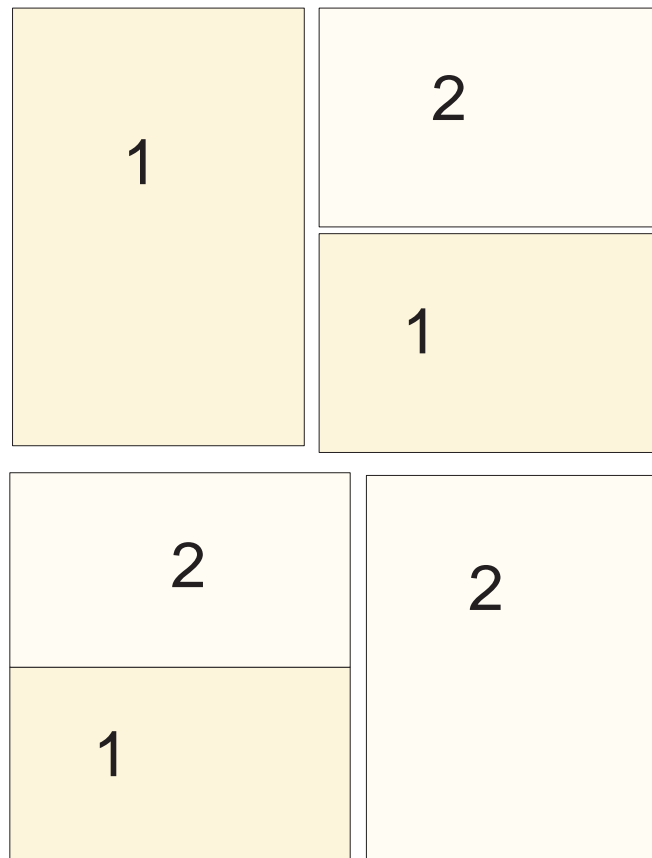
- \* Cut 1 rectangle 9.5" x 14.5"
- \* Cut 1 rectangle 8.5" x 14.5"
- \* Cut 1 rectangle 12.5" x 16.5"

## Sewing Directions

- \* Following the diagram layout the shapes
- \* Sew center top section, then the bottom section
- \* Sew the top and bottom to each other

**At this point you will NOT sew the borders on the quilt**

There is applique that must go on BEFORE borders are added. I always find it easier to do the hand work with a smaller piece

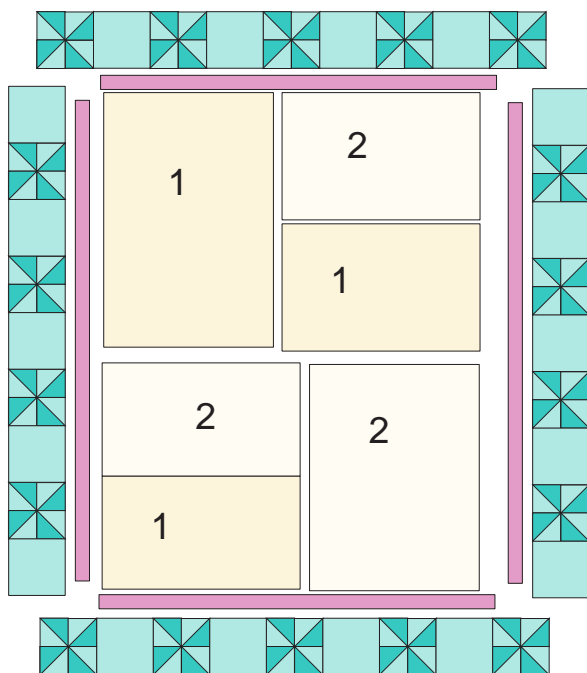

## Applique

You can use the method of Applique you prefer.  
On my website I share fusible applique like I do.  
You can also reference my **“Learn to Applique with Pat Sloan”**  
book for how I do fusible.

We are going to position the water at the bottom of our center.  
It will hang off either end a bit.

\*Applique the TOP of the water.

\*Then BASTE the other 2 sides with the machine or a long  
hand basting stitch.

\*We give it to you FREE!

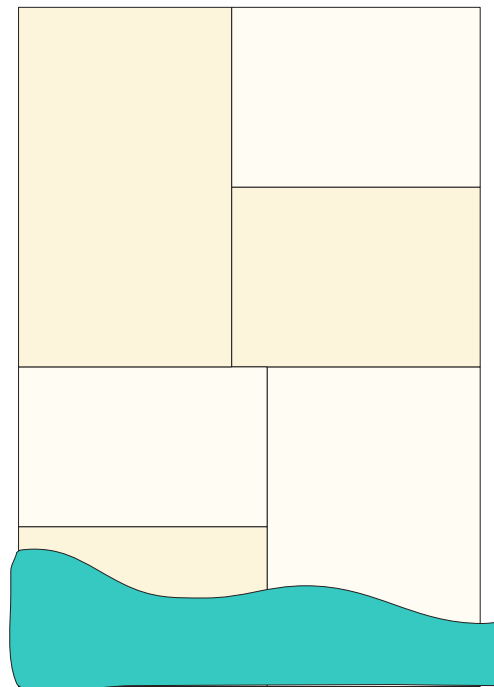
Brilliant I told her.. Brilliant!

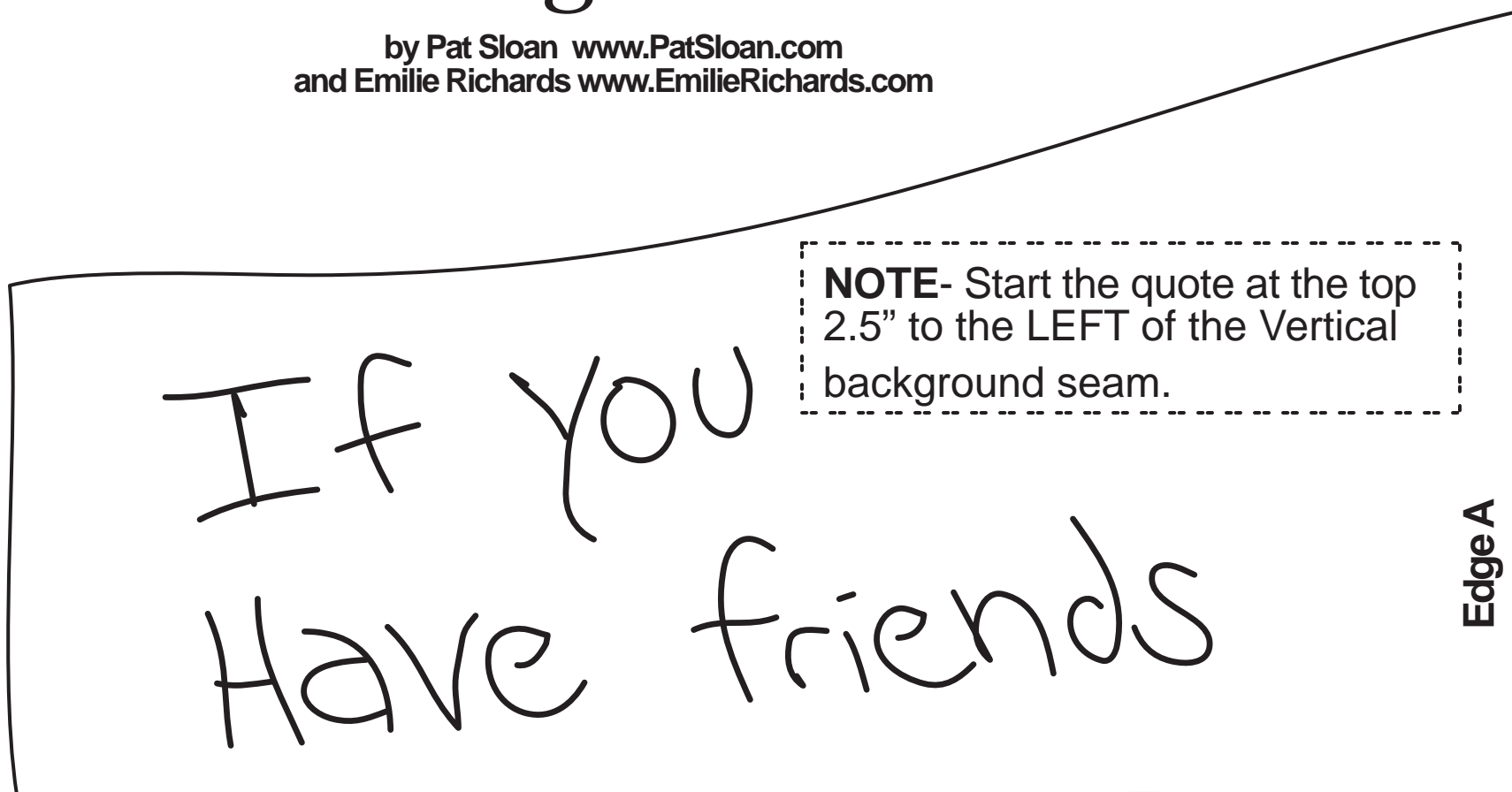

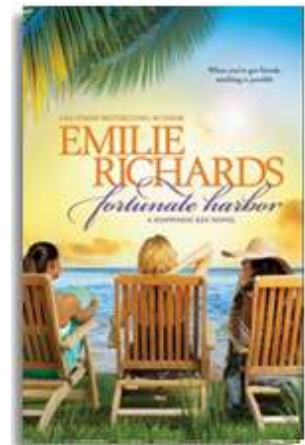
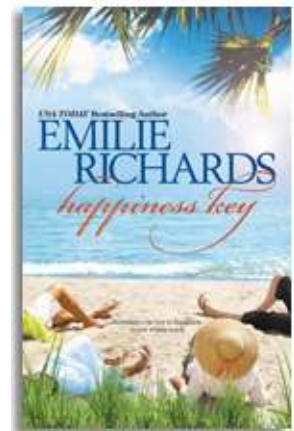
