
Block 13/25 Studio Time

One Hundred Eighty-Two Day Solstice Challenge Hosted by Pat Sloan At Ilovetomakequilts.com

This project is a lot about my life during the 182 days between the Winter and Summer Solstice. A documentation of sorts... maybe even a quilt journal.

I've spent about 2 weeks worth of time redoing my Studio which is not really that long. But it is that long.

Moving, Sorting, Rethinking every single little aspect of my creative & business workflow has been going on.



SQUARE Block to 12.5" x 12.5"

Finished in the guilt is Size 12"

After removing every item from my studio, my new Koala Furniture arrived and I'm thrilled! I still have to paint my desk white (or maybe red!) .. Hang new quilts and start really using the new layout.

My 'Studio Time' block is a large 9-patch center with smaller HST.. It's a fun one to do!

The Solstice challenge spans 182 days between the winter and summer Solstice this year. We'll be making a quilt with 25 blocks... and Somewhere along this journey I'll give you a setting.

Cutting & Sewing

Light Fabric

- Cut 4 squares 2.5" x 2.5" for HST
- Cut 5 squares 3.5" x 3.5"
- Cut 4 squares 2" x 2"
- Cut 4 strips 2" x 6.5"

Dark Fabric

- Cut 4 squares 2.5" x 2.5" for HST
- Cut 4 squares 3.5" x 3.5"

Directions

1) Sew the 2.5" light & dark squares Using HST method on next page.

Make 4 units - trim to 2" square





Half Square Triangles Tutorial

NOTE- For other ways to make HST units, see my book "Pat Sloan's Teach Me to Sew Triangles"



Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2

- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a ¼" seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

Step 4



-Trim squares to 2" x 2" using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.






2) Following the diagram Sew the 9-patch block Make 1 Measures 9.5" x 9.5"





3) Following the diagram sew the side units

Make 2 Unit is 2" x 9.5"





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


4) Following the diagram Sew the top & bottom border Make 2
Measures 2" x 12.5"



5) Following the diagram sew the side units to the center Sew the top and bottom to the center

Block is 12.5" x 12.5"








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Cutting Sizes




Square the Block to 12.5" x 12.5"

IN the Quilt it is finished size 12" x 12"



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60" x 72" with 30 blocks

Add border for a bed size!
