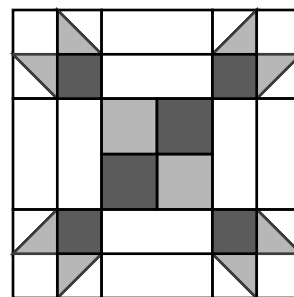


In The Summer Time

Cutting & Sewing

Block Light fabric

- Cut 4 strips 2.5" x 5.5"

Block Medium fabric

- Cut 2 squares 3" x 3"

Block Dark fabric

- Cut 2 squares 3" x 3"
- Cut 4 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

Border Background Fabric

- Cut 4 squares 3" x 3" for HST
- Cut 4 squares 2.5" x 2.5"
- Cut 4 rectangles 2.5" x 5.5"

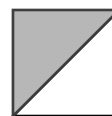
Border Star points Fabric

- Cut 4 squares 3" x 3" for HST

Border Directions

Setting -

Using the 3" background and 3" Star point fabric squares make HSTs using method on last page.
Make 8 units - trim to 2.5" square

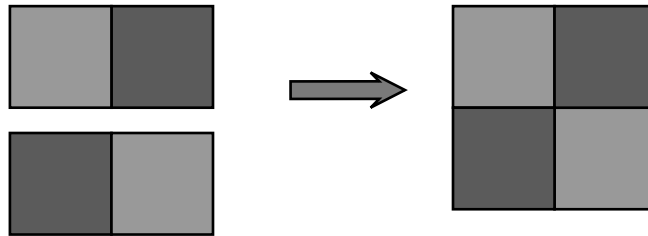

Directions

1) Following the Diagram sew the medium and dark 3" squares into a 4-patch block

Make 1 unit

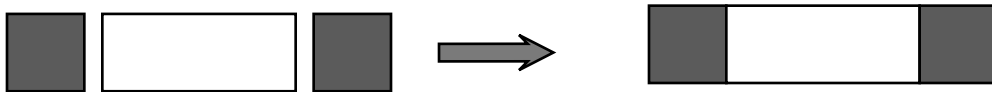
Measures 5.5" x 5.5"



2) Sew a 2.5" dark square to both ends of the light rectangles

Make 2 units

Measures 2.5" x 9.5"

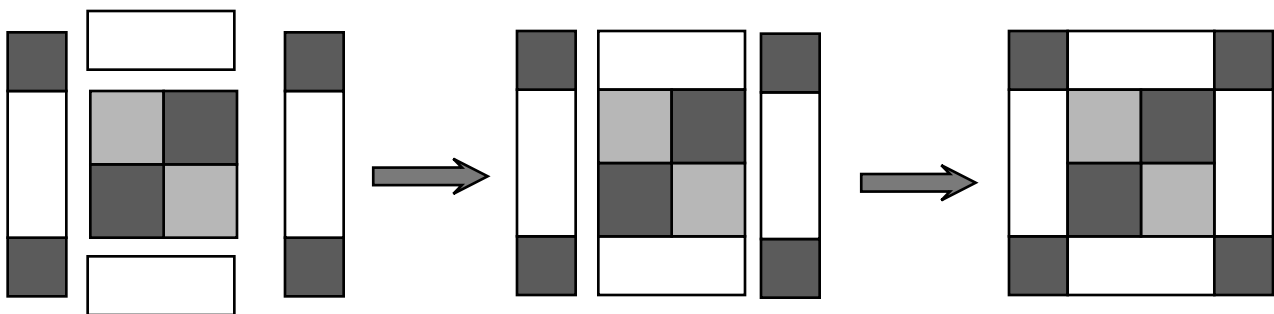


3) Following the Diagram sew a light rectangle unit to the top and bottom of the 4-patch

Sew the 2 units from above to the sides of the 4-patch block

Make 1 unit

Measures 9.5" x 9.5"



Following the diagram on next page
Set the block into the frame

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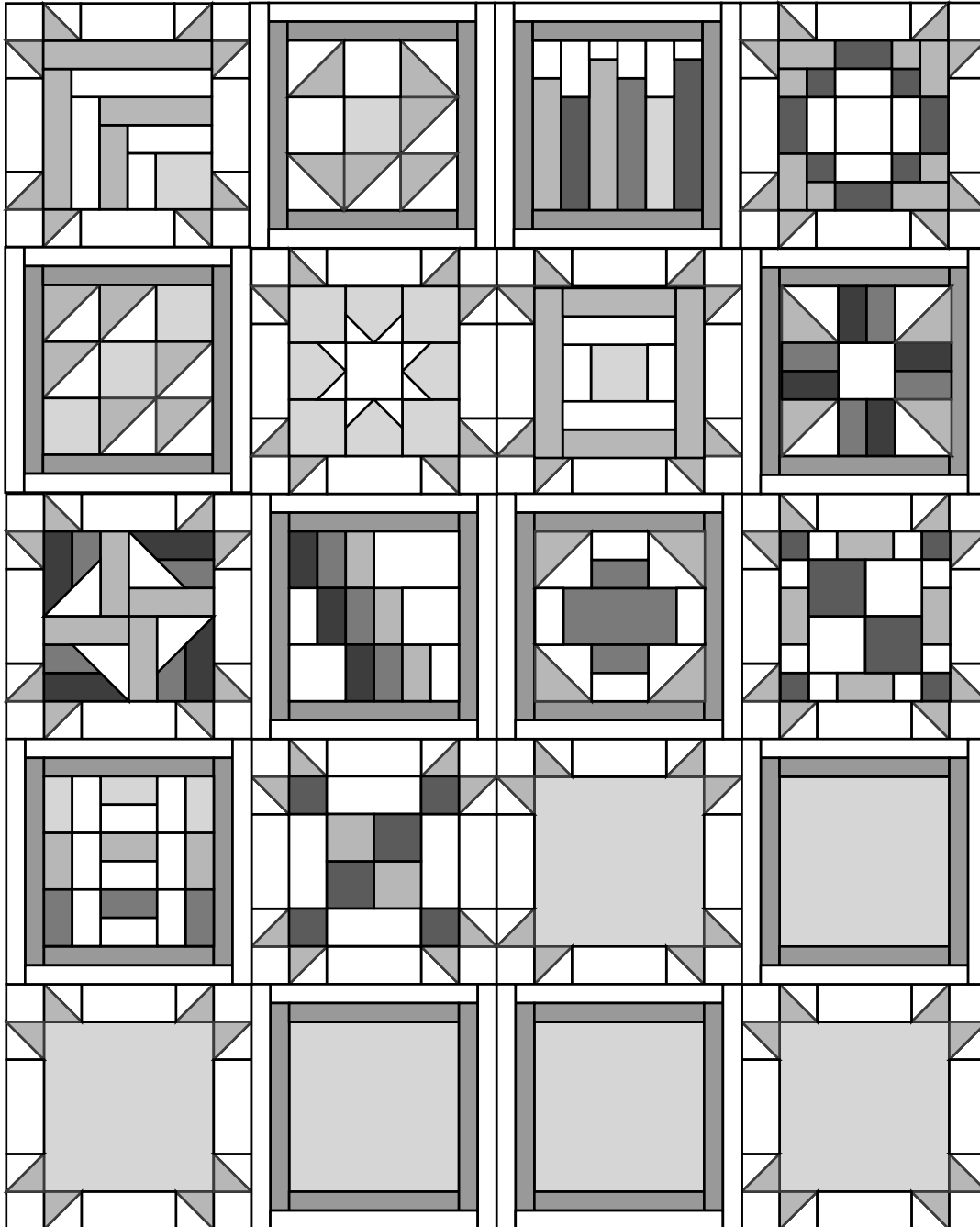

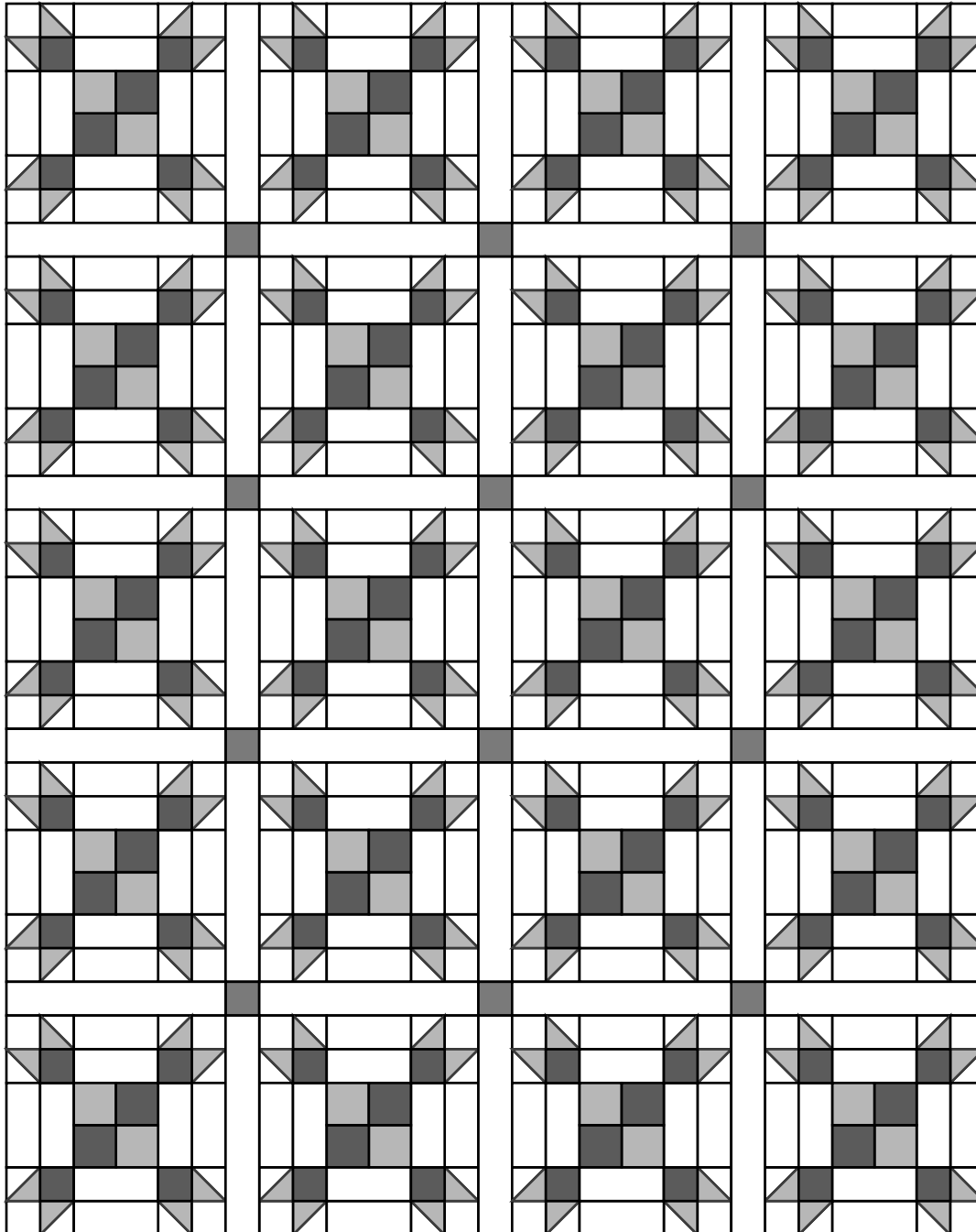

58" x 73" 20 blocks

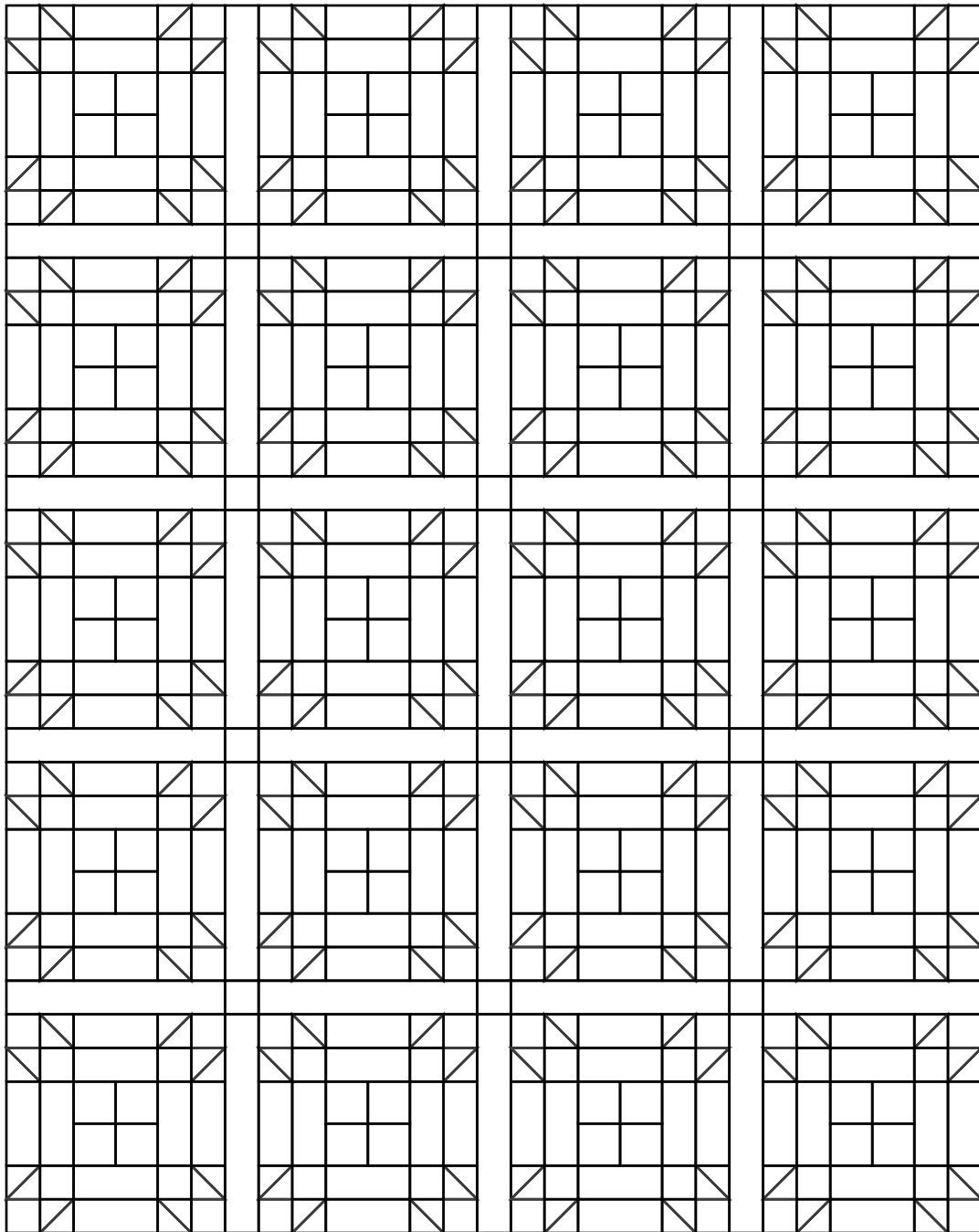
Cut 12 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

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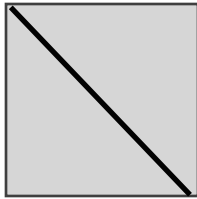
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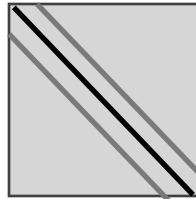
Half Square Triangles Tutorial

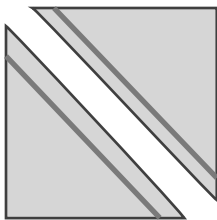
Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2

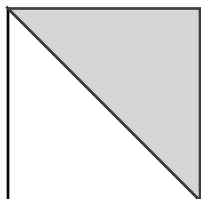
- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

Step 4



-Trim squares to 2.5" x 2.5" using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
