Recently she told me she would save up her change to buy a Philly cheese steak sandwich 'at the counter'. They were her favorite and a huge treat.

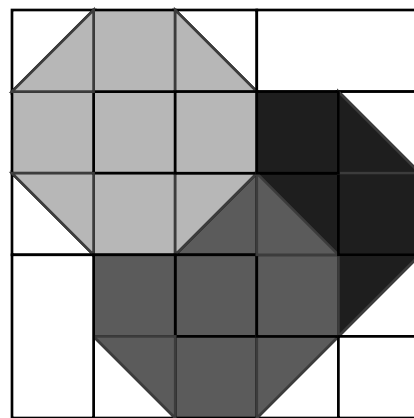
Often I hear it was grandpa that gave out change (mine did too) or another story I heard was grandma having a handkerchief of change wrapped in her purse for the kiddies.

SQUARE Block to 10.5" x 10.5"

Finished in the quilt is Size 10"

Cutting & Sewing

Light Fabric

- Cut 4 squares 3" x 3" for HST
- Cut 2 rectangles 2.5" x 4.5"
- Cut 1 square 2.5" x 2.5"

Medium #1 Fabric

- 3 squares 3" x 3" for HST
- 5 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

Medium #2 Fabric

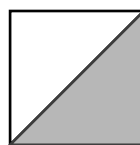
- 3 squares 3" x 3" for HST
- 4 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

Dark Fabric

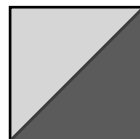
- 2 squares 3" x 3" for HST
- 2 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

Directions

1) Sew the 2 medium #1 - 3" square and 2 light 3" squares Using HST method on last page.
Make 4 units, 1 will not be used. - trim to 2.5" square



2) Sew the 1 medium #1 - 3" square and 1 medium #2 - 3" square
Using HST method on last page.
Make 2 units, 1 will not be used - trim to 2.5" square



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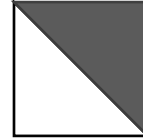
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Directions

3) Sew the 1 light 3" square and 1 medium #2 - 3" square
Using HST method on last page.
Make 2 units - trim to 2.5" square

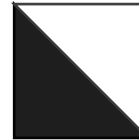


Save the

4) Sew the 1 medium #2 - 3" square and 1 dark # 3" square
Using HST method on last page.
Make 2 units, 1 will not be used - trim to 2.5" square



5) Sew the 1 light 3" square and 1 dark 3" square
Using HST method on last page.
Make 2 units - trim to 2.5" square



6) Following the diagram Sew Units A, B, D & E individually.

Unit A measures 6.5" x 6.5"

Unit B Measures 4.5" x 6.5"

Unit D Measures 6.5" x 4.5"

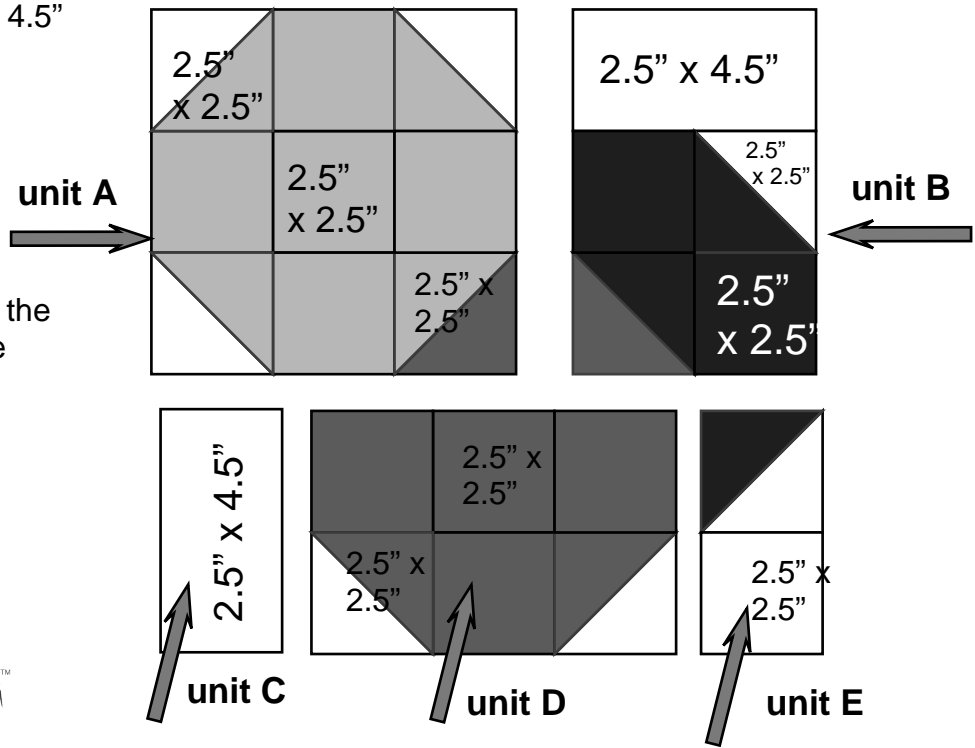
Unit E measures 2.5" x 4.5"

-Sew A to B.
Measures 10.5" x 6.5"

-Sew C to D to E.
Measures 10.5" x 4.5"

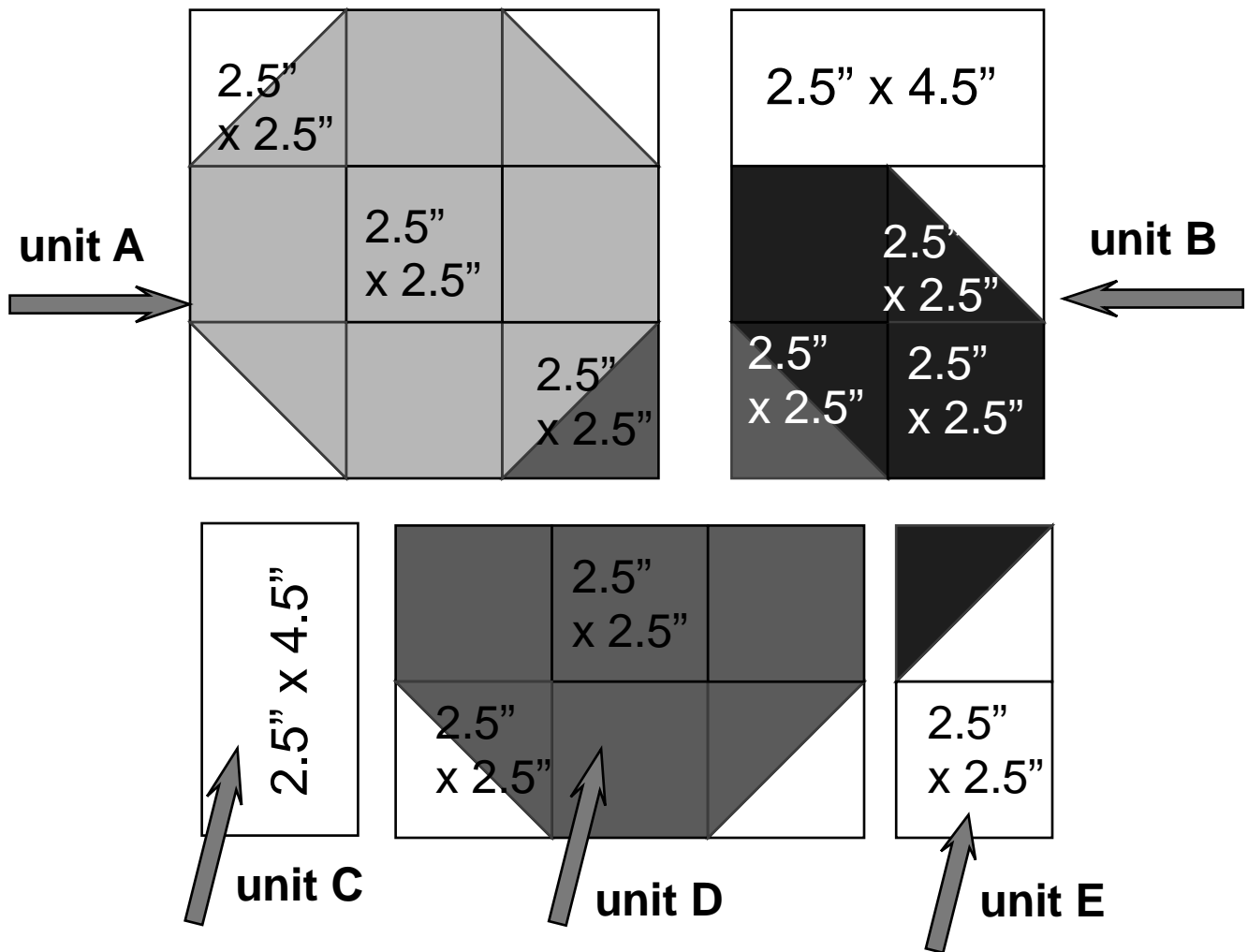
-Sew the top section to the
Bottom section to make
the final block

Make 1 block
10.5" x 10.5"



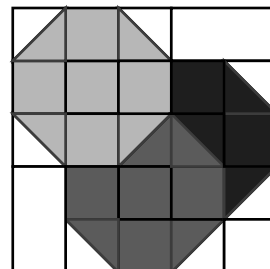
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Cutting & unit Sizes



Square the Block to 10.5" x 10.5"

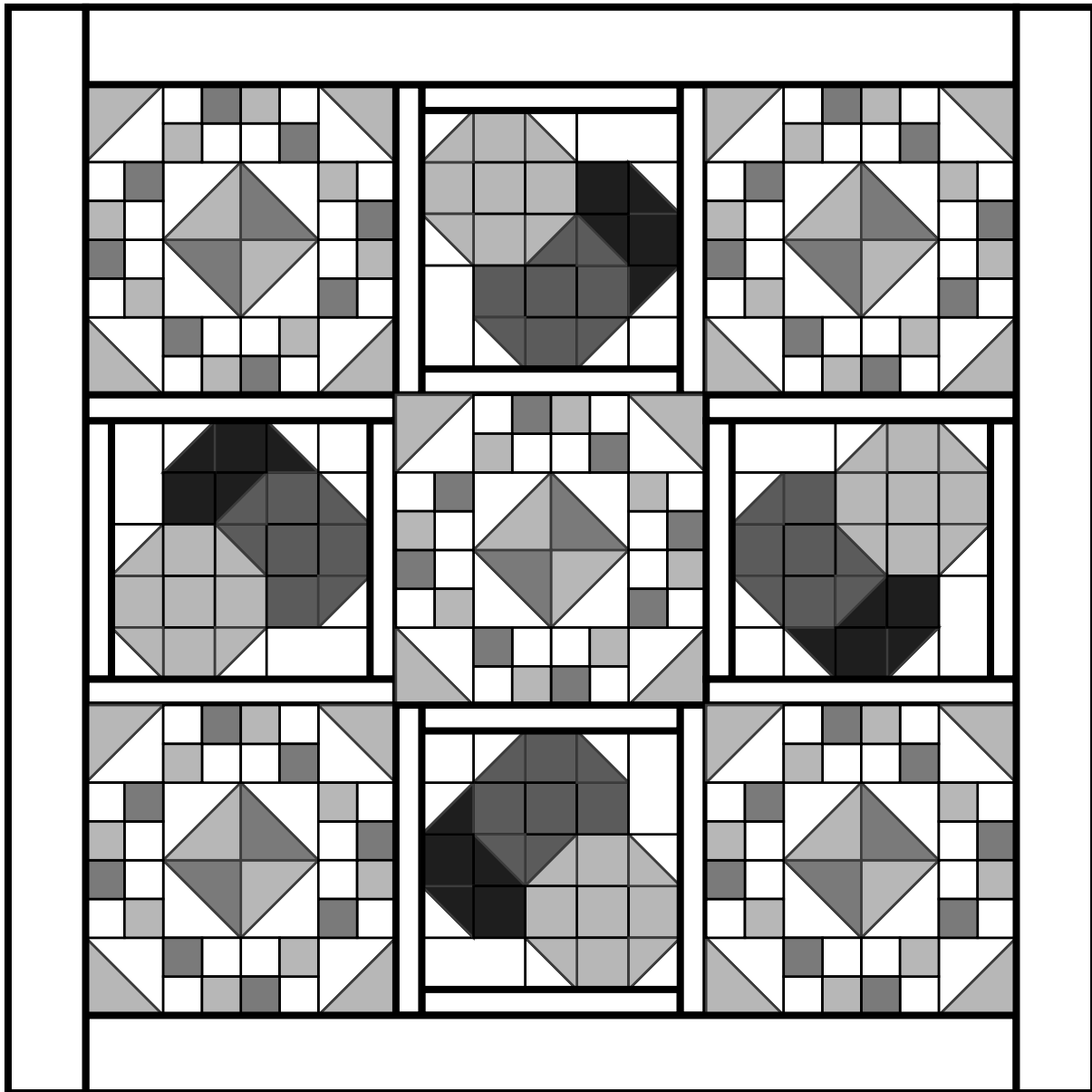
IN the Quilt it is finished size 10" x 10"



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42" x 42" quilt

5 block #3 key holder & 4 Small Change blocks

Cut 8 borders 1.5" x 10.5" sew to top/bottom of Small change

Cut 8 border 1.5" x 12.5" sew to sides.

Borders 2 cut 3.5" x 36.5" & 2 cut 3.5" x 42.5"

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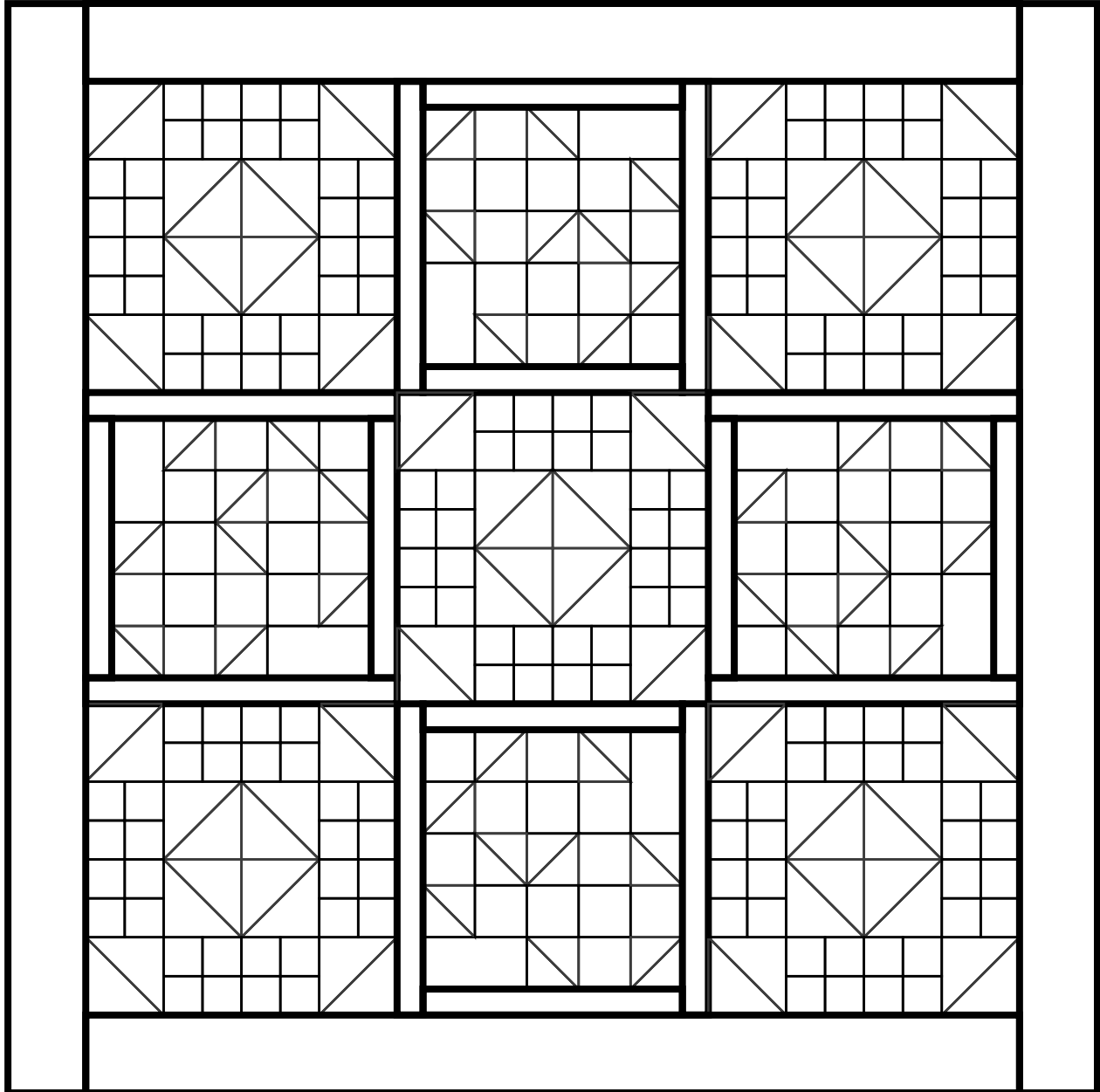

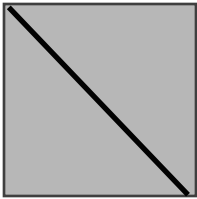
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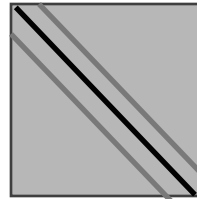
Half Square Triangles Tutorial

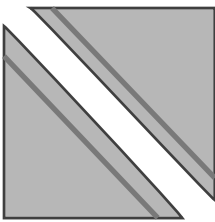
Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2

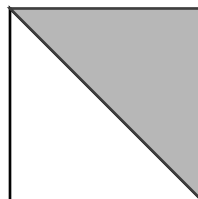
- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

Step 4



-Trim squares to 2.5" x 2.5" using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
