Grandma's Kitchen Challenge

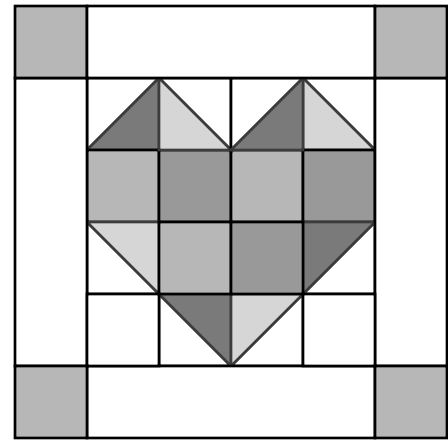

SQUARE Block to 12.5" x 12.5"

Finished in the quilt is Size 12"

Cutting & Sewing

Light Fabric

- Cut 4 squares 3" x 3" for HST
- Cut 2 squares 2.5" x 2.5"
- Cut 4 strips 2.5" x 8.5"

Medium Fabric - total needed

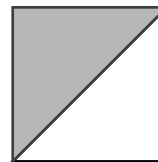
- Cut 2 squares 3" x 3" for HST
- Cut 7 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

Dark Fabric - total needed

- Cut 2 squares 3" x 3" for HST
- Cut 3 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

Directions

- 1) Sew 2 medium and light squares Using HST method on last page. Make 4 units - trim to 2.5" square



TIP

You may want to use multiple fabrics for your block. This is the total needed

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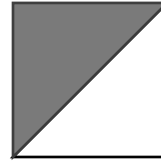
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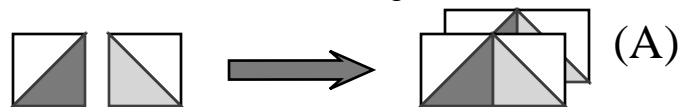

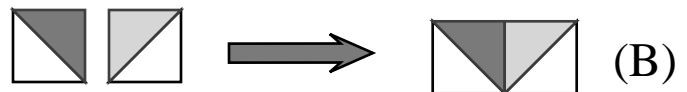
- 2) Sew 2 dark and light squares
Using HST method on last page.
Make 4 units - trim to 2.5" square



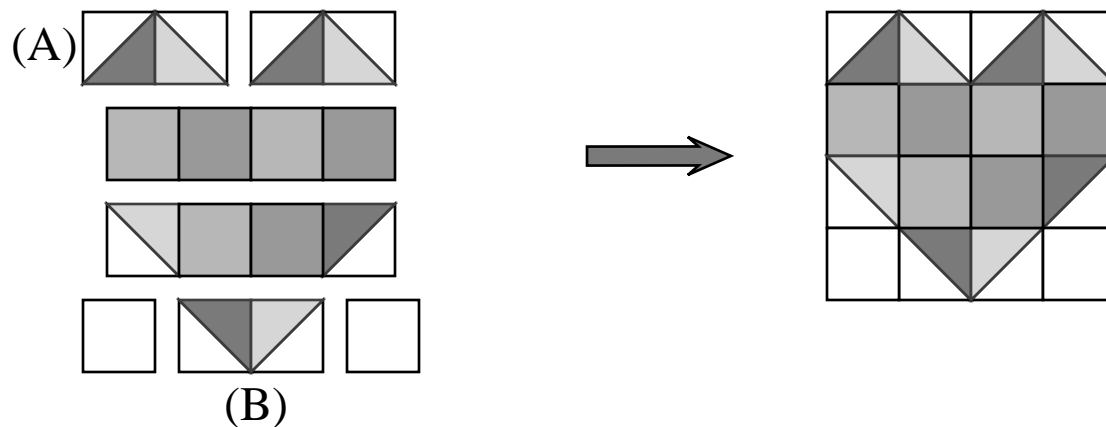
- 3) Following the diagram Sew dark HST and a medium HST together
Make 2 Measures 2.5" x 4.5"



- 4) Following the diagram Sew dark HST and a medium HST together
Make 1 Measures 2.5" x 4.5"

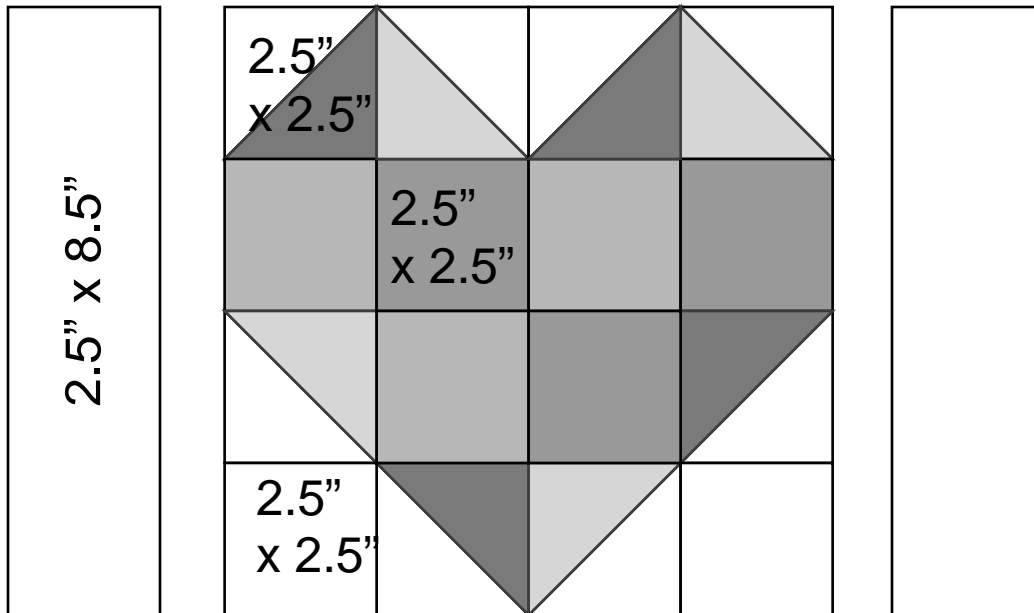
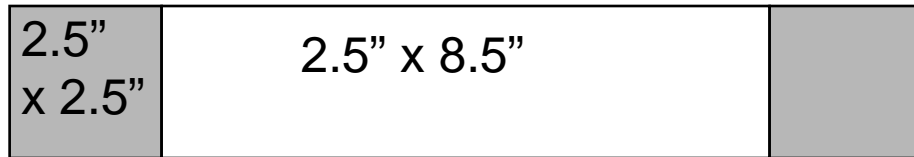


- 5) Following the diagram Sew units A, B, remaining HST and the light, medium, and dark squares into a heart
Make 1 Measures 8.5" x 8.5"



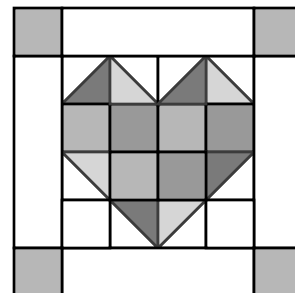
Block Assembly on next page

Square the Block to 12.5" x 12.5"

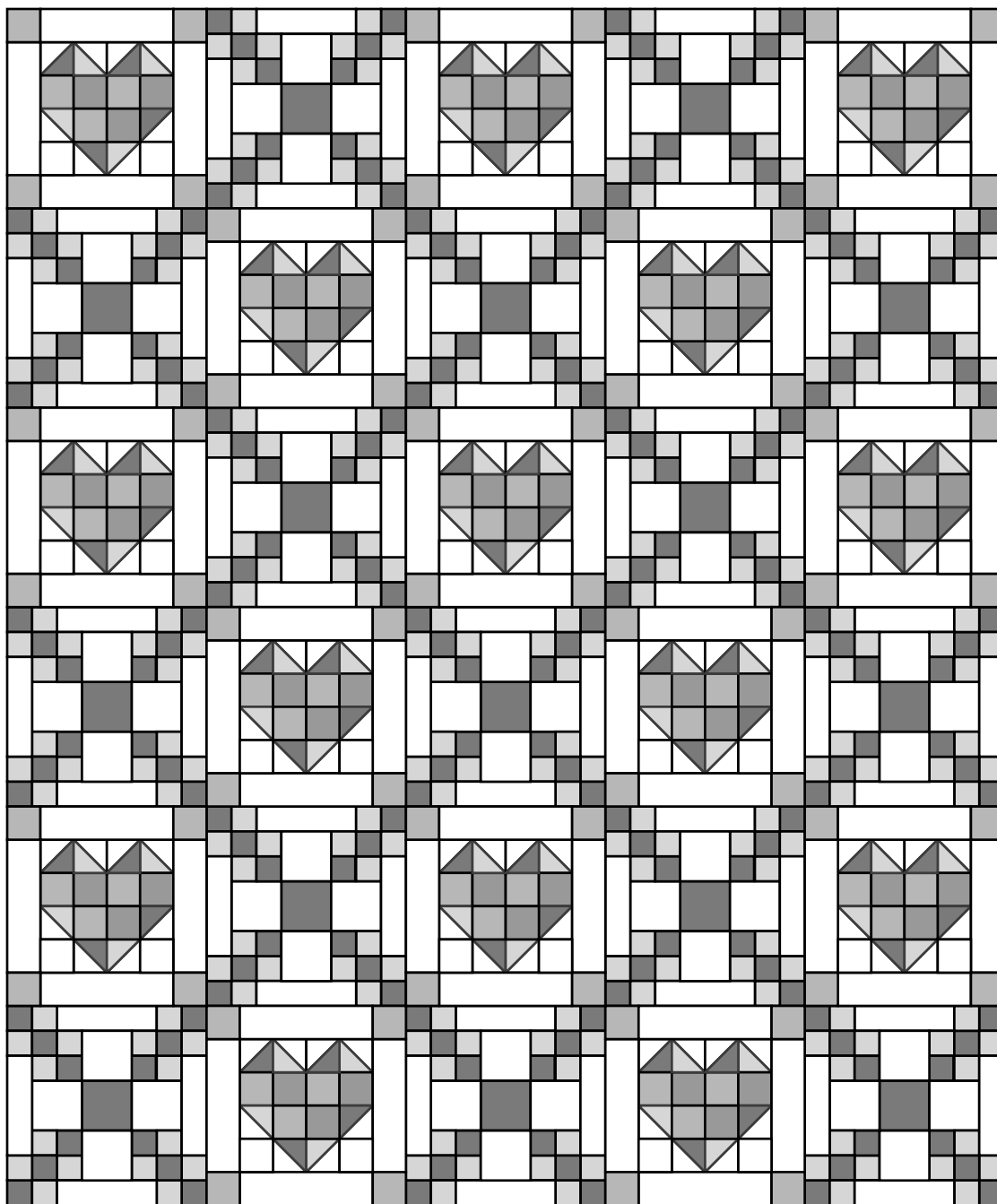
IN the Quilt it is finished size 12" x 12"

15 of Block 13**

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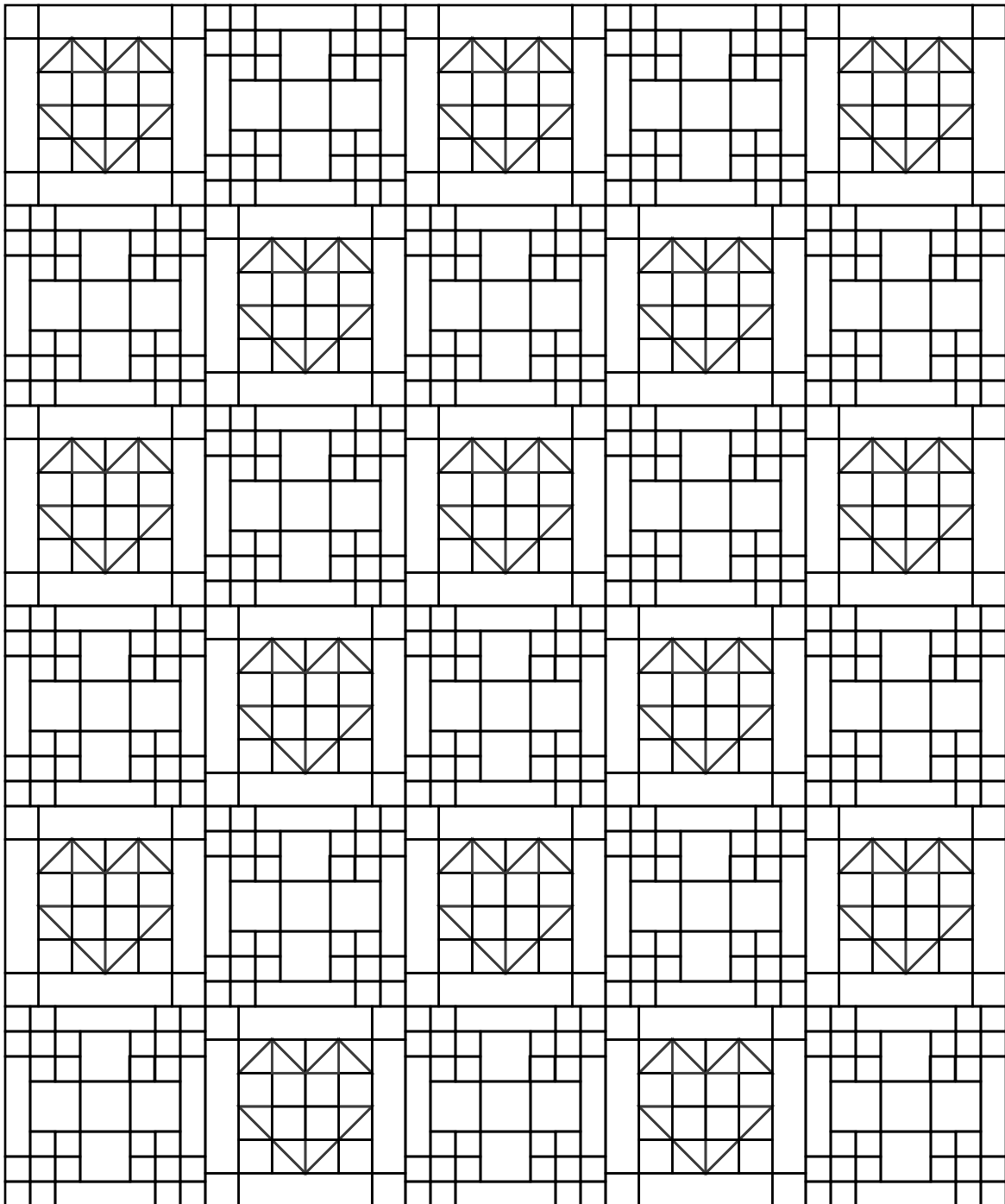

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Half Square Triangles Tutorial

Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2

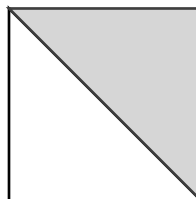
- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a 1/4" seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

Step 4



-Trim squares to 2.5" x 2.5" using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
