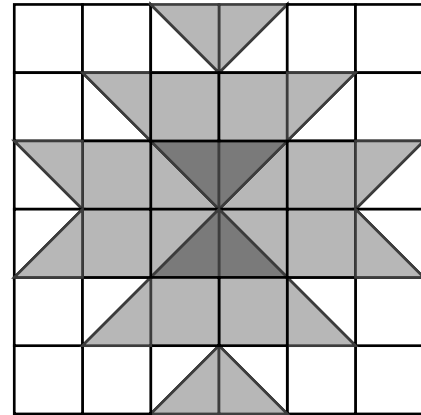
Tile Time

At my online group someone shared a photo of a great tiled floor, and said 'Wouldn't it make a wonderful quilt'.

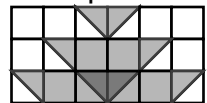
Quilters tend to look at everything and see quilts, which seems totally normal to us!

There are squares and triangles and rectangles in so many places that can easily be converted to a quilt block with just a little math. My Tile Time is inspired by a vacation photos I took long before I quilted, and there it was.. a quilt pattern!



SQUARE Block to 12.5" x 12.5"
Finished in the quilt is Size 12"

Check the last page for a 'half drop' layout of this block, so fun for busting those 2.5" squares and HST you have been making!



The Solstice challenge spans 182 days between the winter and summer Solstice this year. We'll be making a quilt with 25 blocks... and Somewhere along this journey I'll give you a setting.

Cutting & Sewing

Light Fabric

- Cut 6 squares 3" x 3" for HST
- Cut 12 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

Medium Fabric

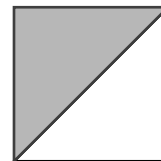
- Cut 8 squares 3" x 3" for HST
- Cut 8 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

Dark Fabric

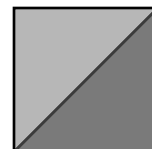
- Cut 2 squares 3" x 3" for HST

Directions

1) Sew the 3" medium and light squares
Using HST method on last page.
Make 12 units - trim to 2.5" square



2) Sew the 3" dark and medium squares
Using HST method on last page.
Make 4 units - trim to 2.5" square



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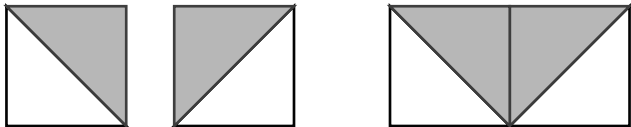

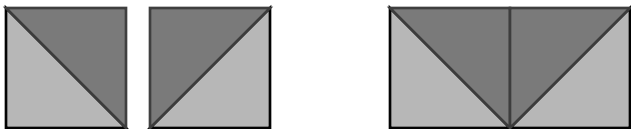

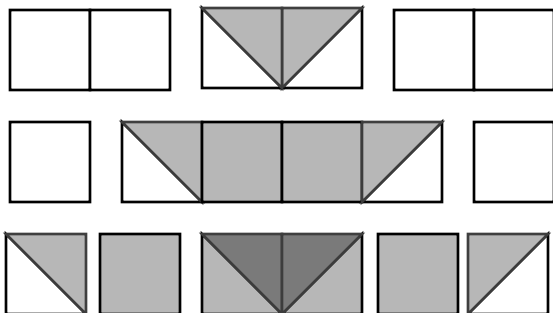
- 3) Following the diagram Sew 2 Medium HST units
Make 2
Measures 2.5" x 4.5"



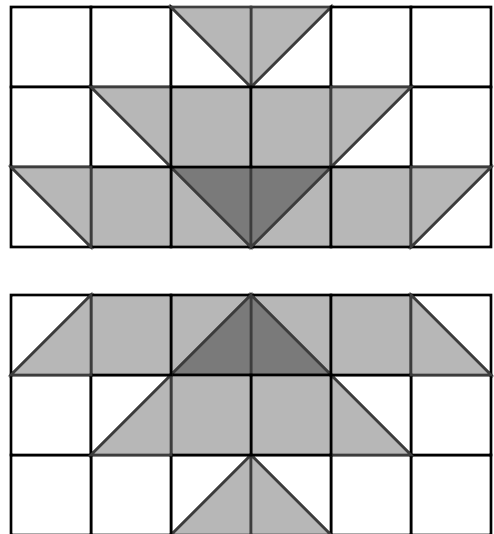
- 4) Following the diagram Sew 2 Med/Dark Fabric units
Make 2
Measures 2.5" x 4.5"



- 5) Following the diagram sew the squares and triangle units together.
Measures 6.5" x 12.5" for 1/2 block unit.
Full Block diagram on the next page
Make 2 units



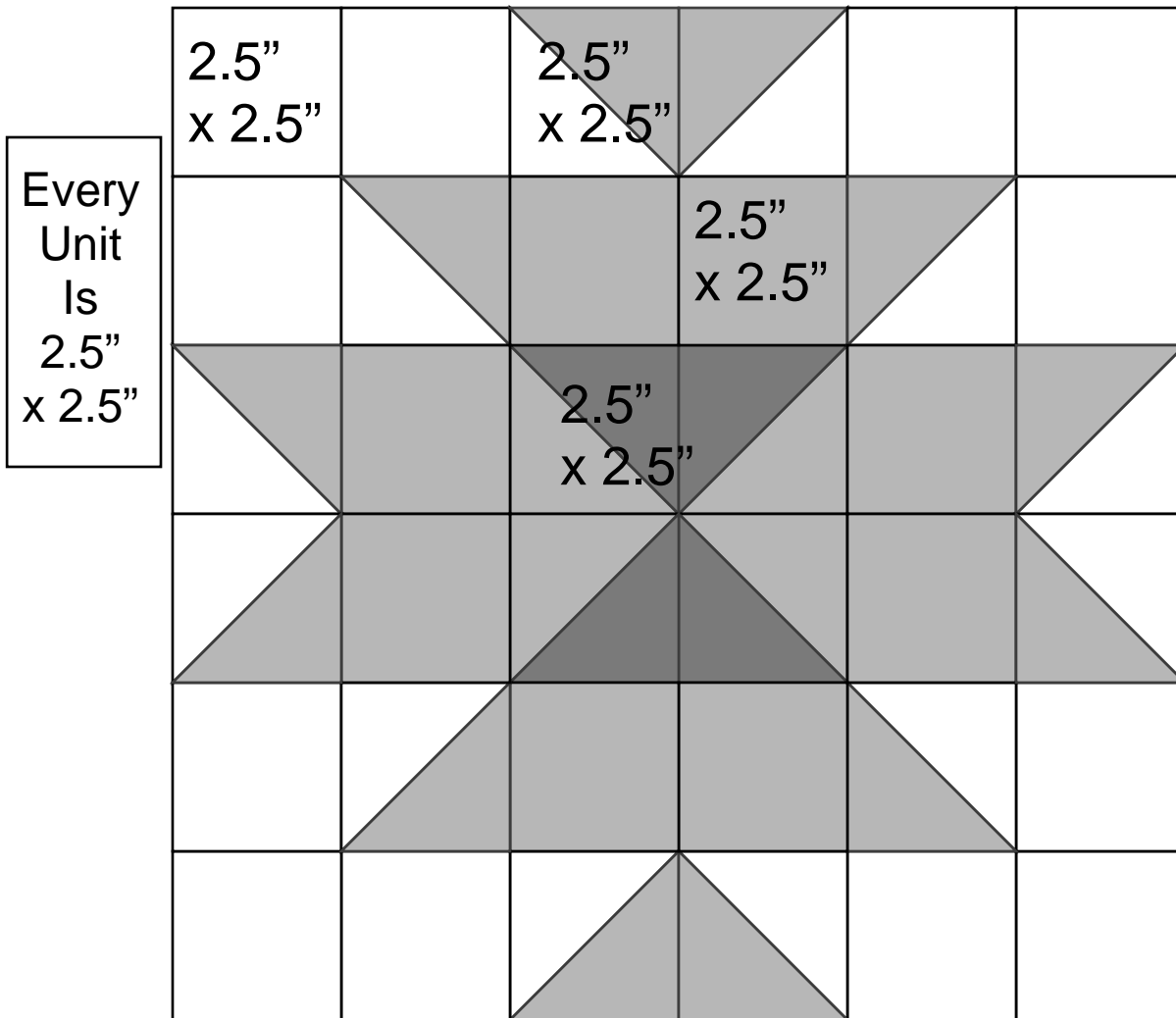
- 6) Sew the 2 sections together



Cutting Sizes

NOTE-

MAKE HST So they are the SIZE indicated using your favorite method



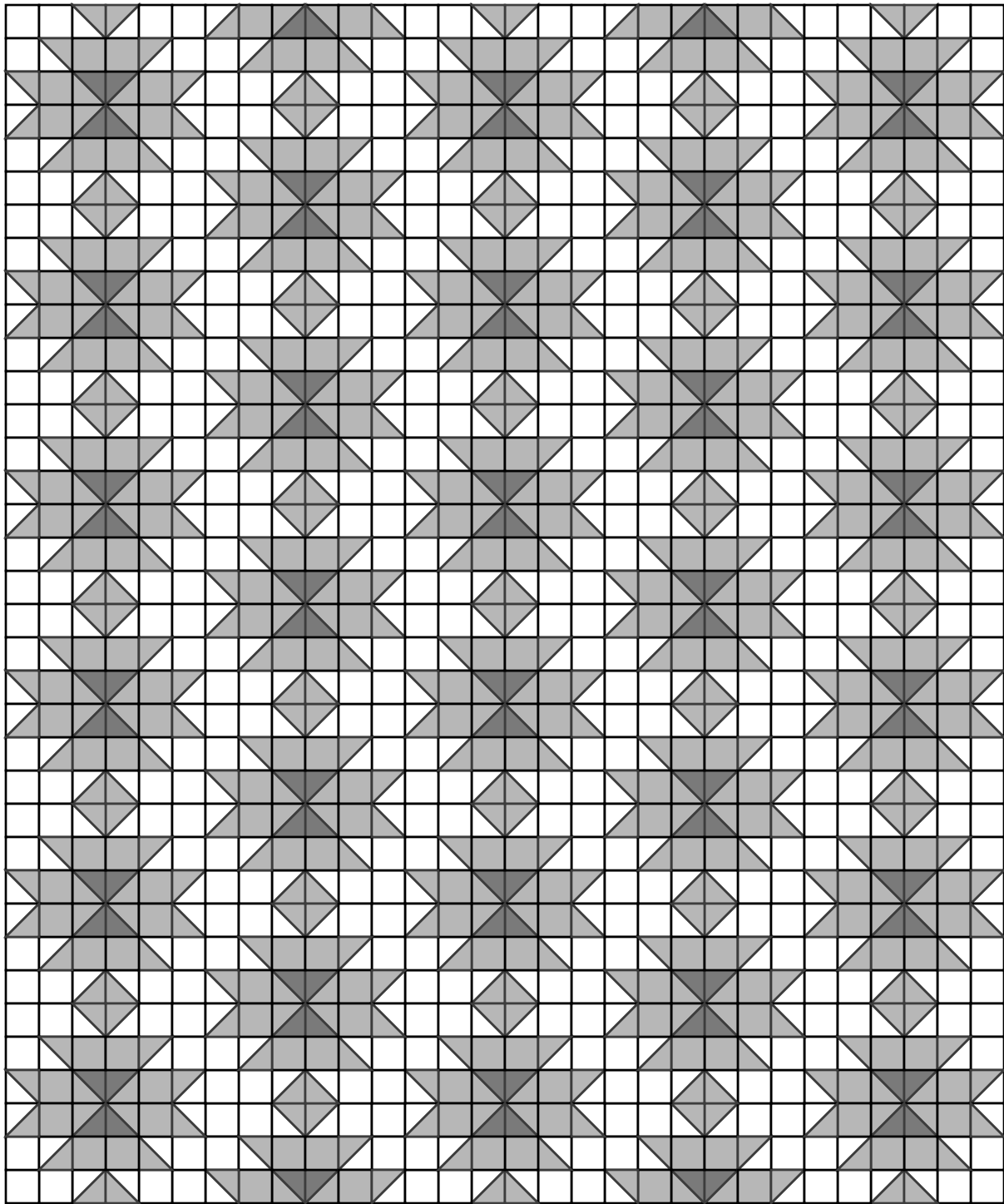
Square the Block to 12.5" x 12.5"

IN the Quilt it is finished size 12" x 12"

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60" x 72"

28 full blocks, 4 half blocks .

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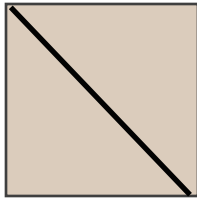
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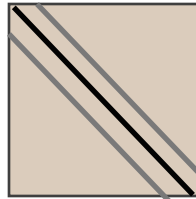

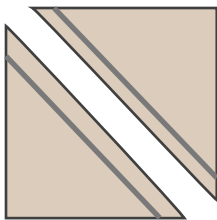
Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2

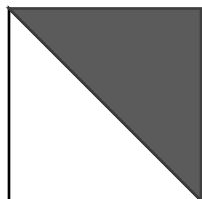
- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

Step 4



-Trim squares to 2.5" x 2.5" using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
