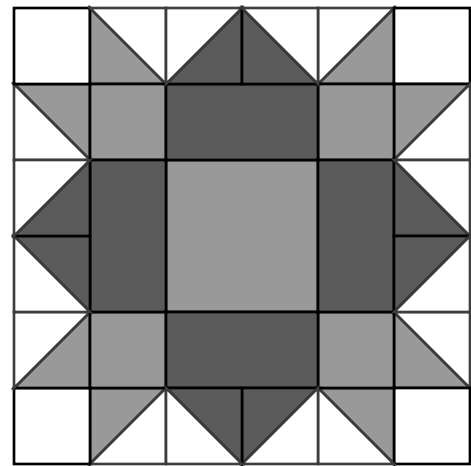
One year when I was teaching in Vermont we went to the Shelburne Museum, which specializes in folk art. It's also the first museum to exhibit quilts as works of art.

The museum's other interesting part is that it's in different buildings. One 'building' is actually a steamboat you go on, it was so neat! One item I can't forget, was the weathervane collection. The display of them as art on bright sunny yellow walls made me so happy, and now I really want a barn & a weather vane!

The Solstice challenge spans 182 days between the winter and summer Solstice this year. We'll be making a quilt with 25 blocks... and Somewhere along this journey I'll give you a setting.

**SQUARE Block to 24.5" x 24.5"**

Finished in the quilt is Size 24"

## Cutting & Sewing

### Light Fabric

- Cut 8 squares 5" x 5" for HST
- Cut 4 squares 4.5" x 4.5"

### Medium Fabric

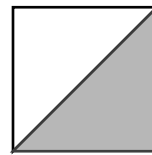
- Cut 1 square 8.5" x 8.5"
- Cut 4 square 5" x 5" for HST
- Cut 4 square 4.5" x 4.5"

### Dark Fabric

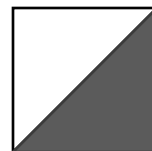
- Cut 4 rectangles 4.5" x 8.5"
- Cut 4 squares 5" x 5" for HST

### Directions

1) Sew the 5" medium and light squares  
Using HST method at the end  
Make 8 units - trim to 4.5" square



2) Sew the 5" dark and light squares  
Using HST method at the end  
Make 8 units - trim to 4.5" square

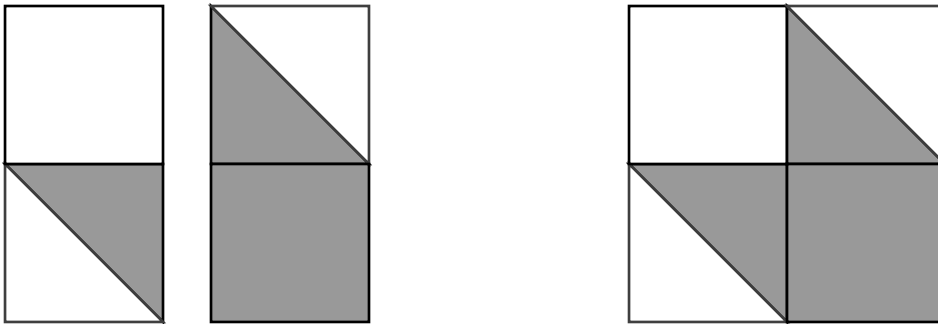

Make 4  
Measures 8.5" x 8.5"

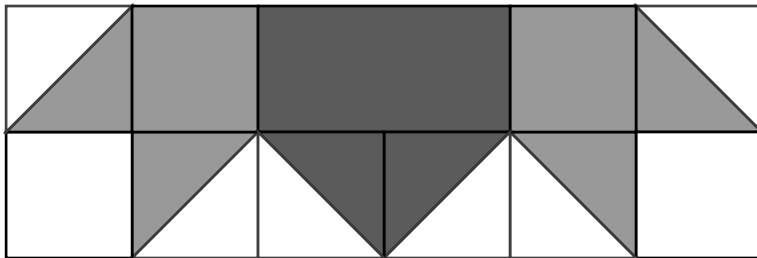
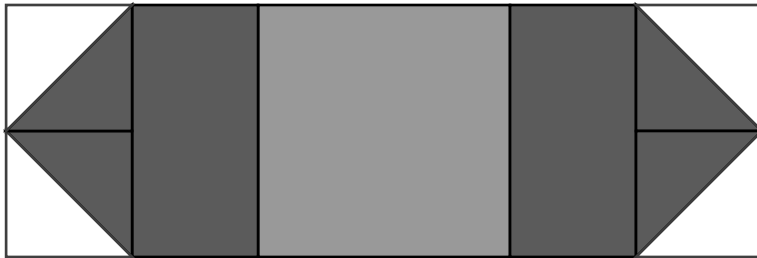
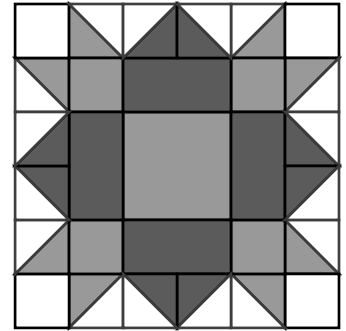
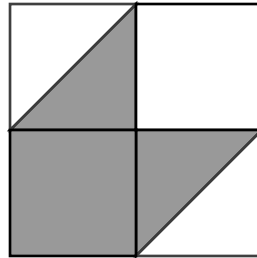
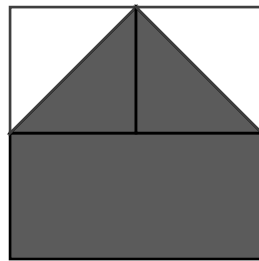
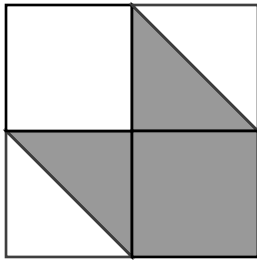

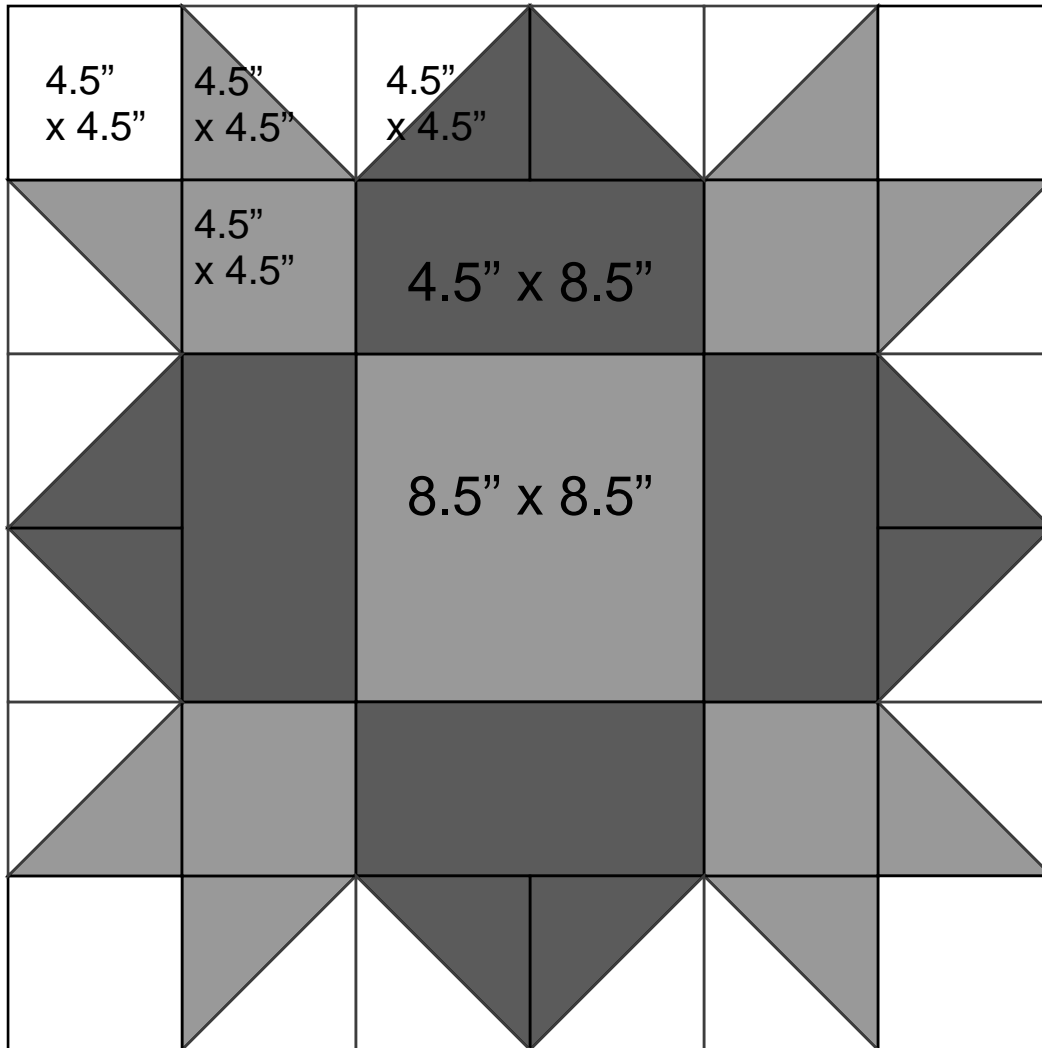
- 5) Following the diagram alternate the units and sew the block together

MAKE HST So they are the SIZE indicated using your favorite method –See page 2



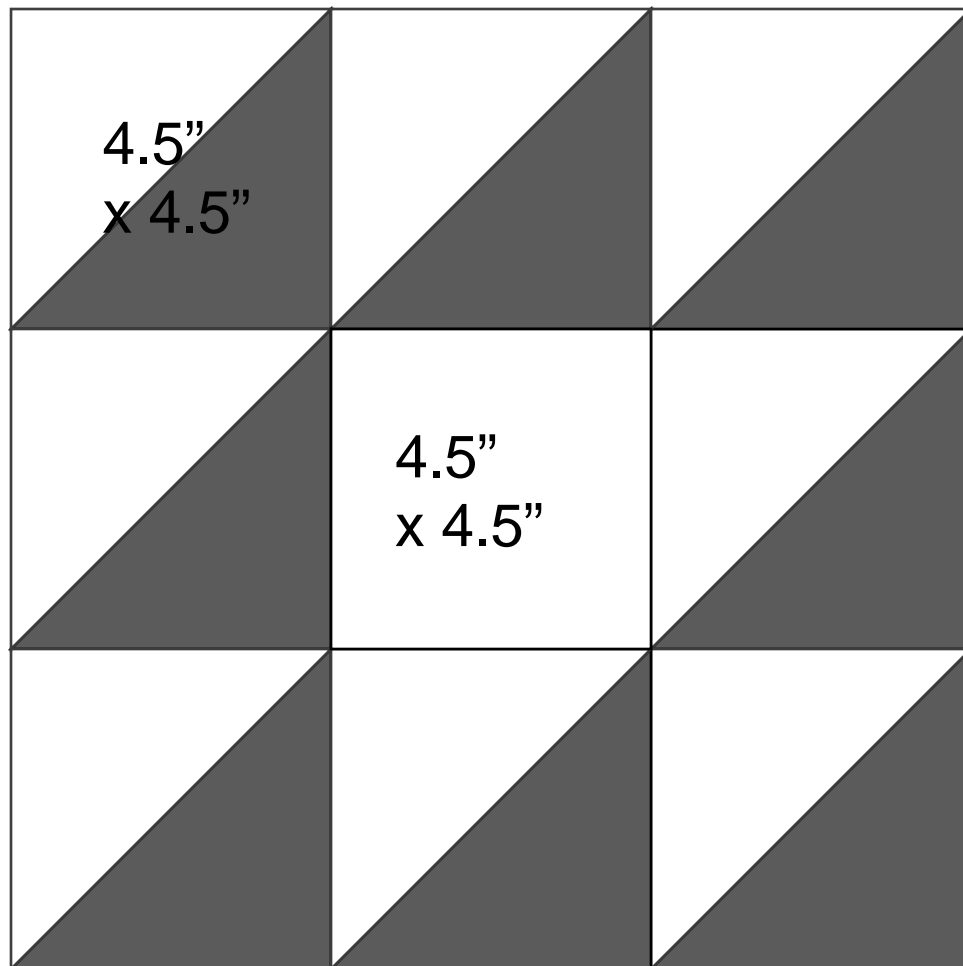
**Square the Block to 24.5" x 24.5"**

MAKE HST So they are the SIZE indicated using your favorite method –See page 2

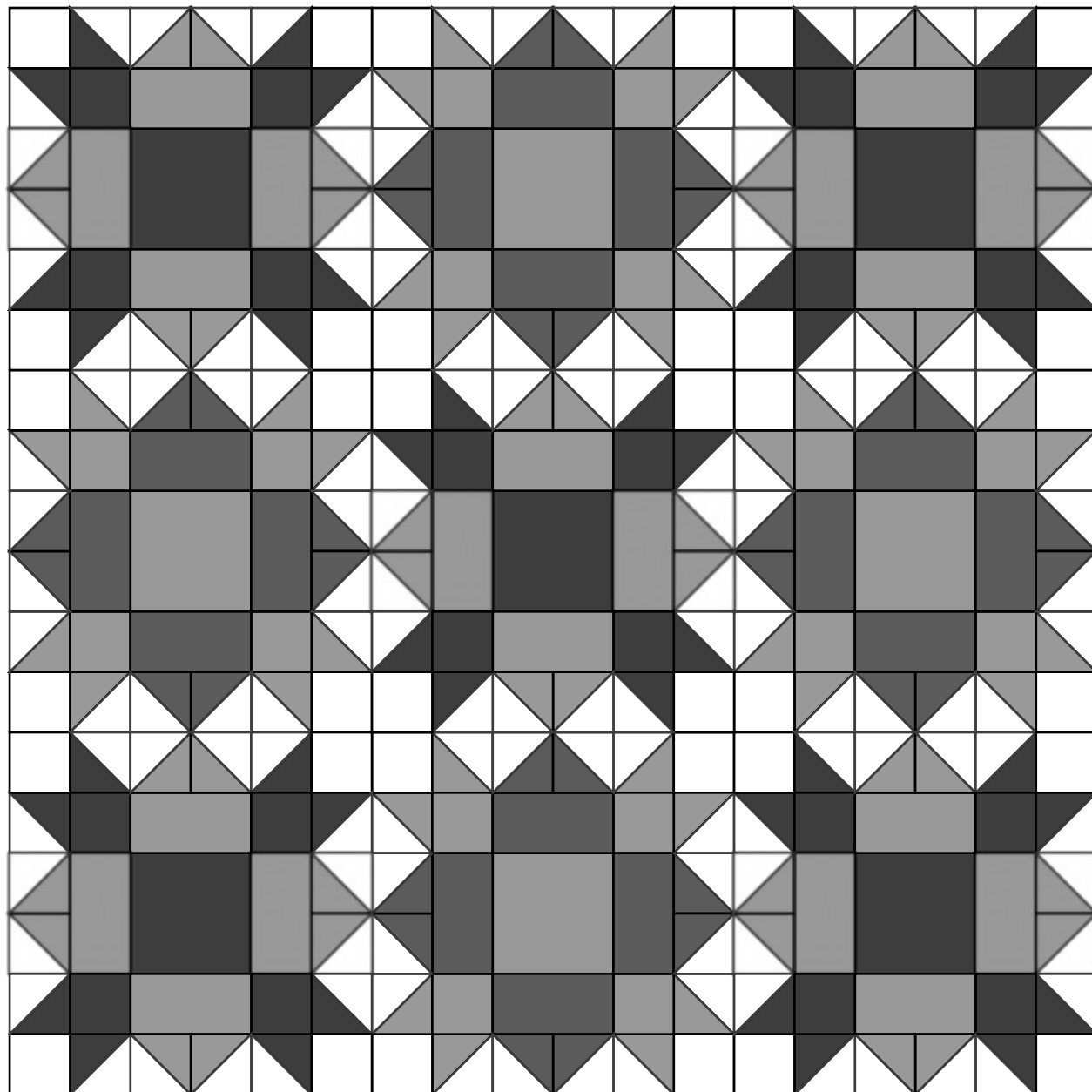


**ALTERNATE 12" block**

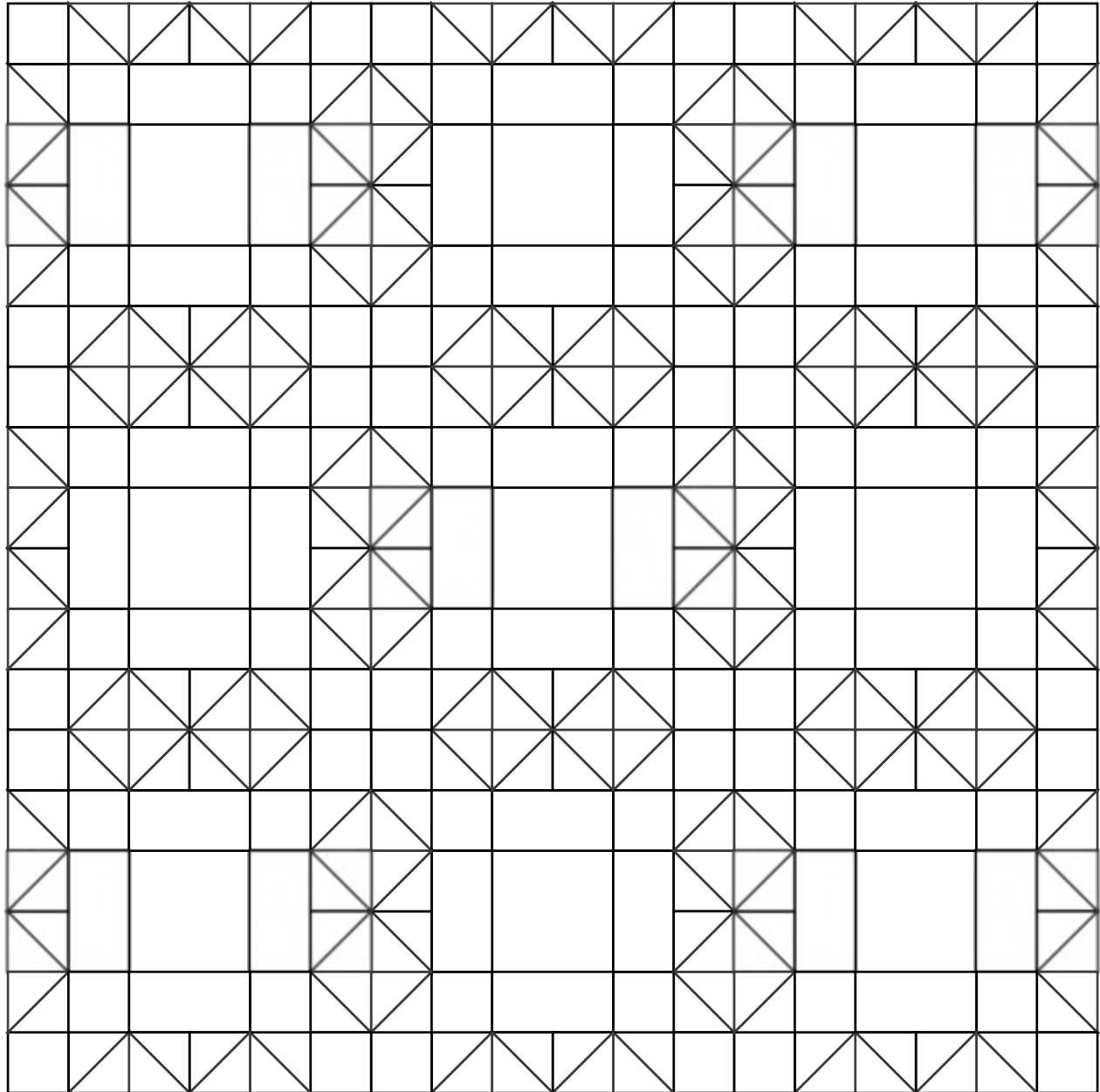
