

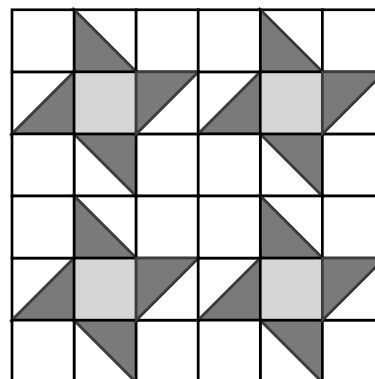

**SQUARE Block to 12.5" x 12.5"**

Finished in the quilt is Size 12"

wonder where I got my Chatty Cathy personality from? Well it wasn't Granny!

She was a very sweet lady, very generous and giving. And she was a working woman.

She worked as a telephone operator then trained new operators. As I went out into the workforce she would share 'office stories' with me and I bet anything 'Oh Snap' would have been one of her favorite sayings.

## Cutting & Sewing

### Light Fabric

- Cut 8 squares 3" x 3" for HST
- Cut 16 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

### Medium Fabric

- Cut 4 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

### Dark Fabrics

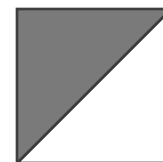
- Cut 8 squares 3" x 3" for HST

### TIP

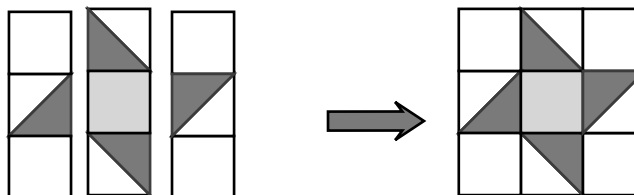
You may want to use multiple fabrics for your block. This is the total needed

### Directions

1) Sew the 3" light and dark squares Using HST method on last page. Make 16 units - trim to 2.5" square



2) Following the Diagram Sew the 2.5" medium square, 4 HST and 4 light 2.5" squares together. NOTE the direction of the HST Make 4 star units - Measures 6.5" x 6.5"



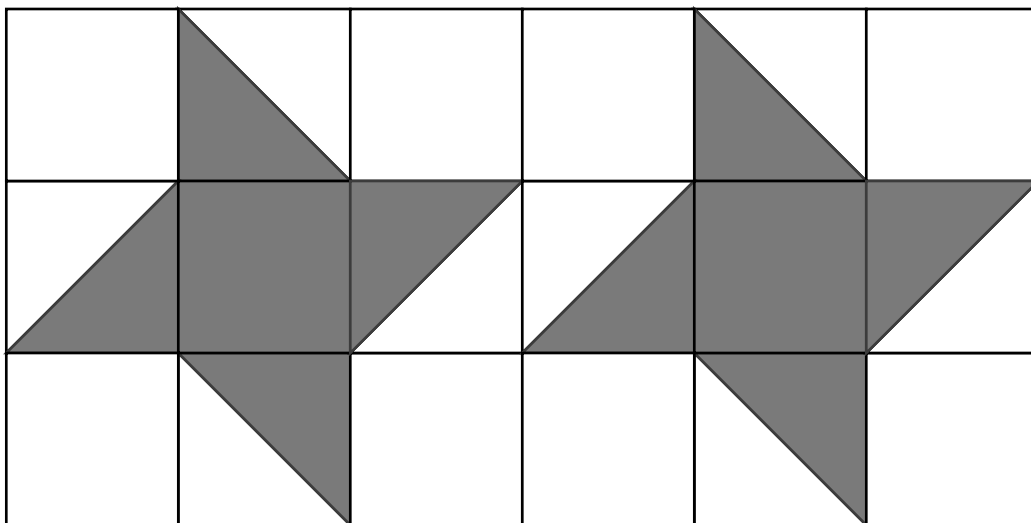
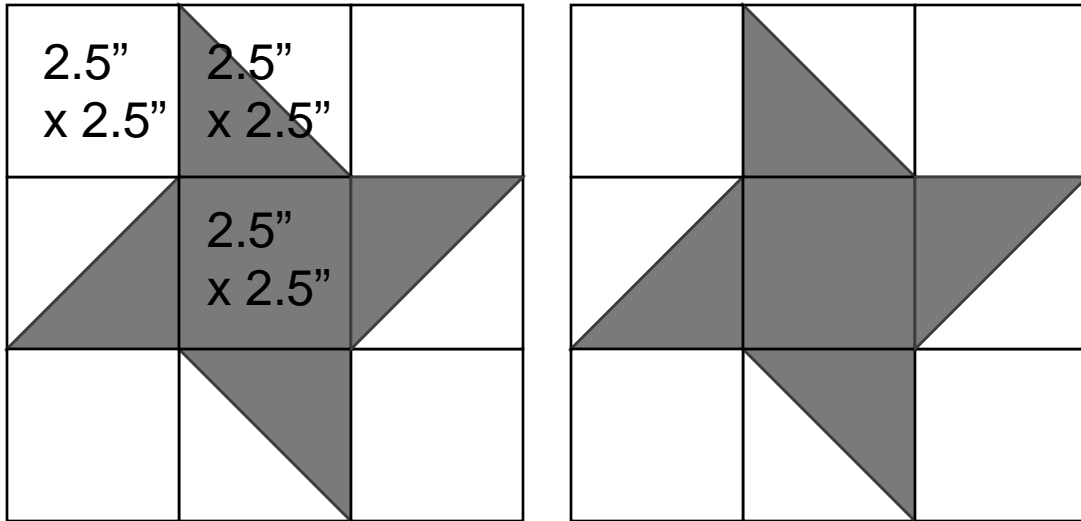
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## Unfinished Sizes

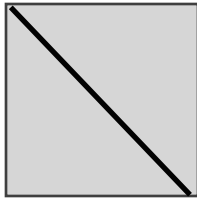


**Square the Block to 12.5" x 12.5"**

IN the Quilt it is finished size 12" x 12"

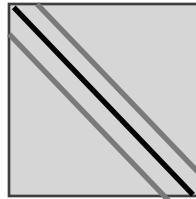
## Half Square Triangles Tutorial

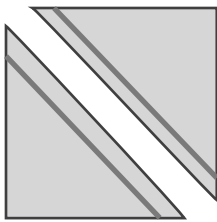
**Step 1**

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



**Step 2**

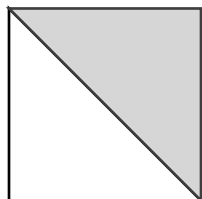
- Layer the 2 squares  
- Sew a 1/4" seam on both Sides of the drawn line



**Step 3**

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

**Step 4**



-Trim squares to 2.5" x 2.5" using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.

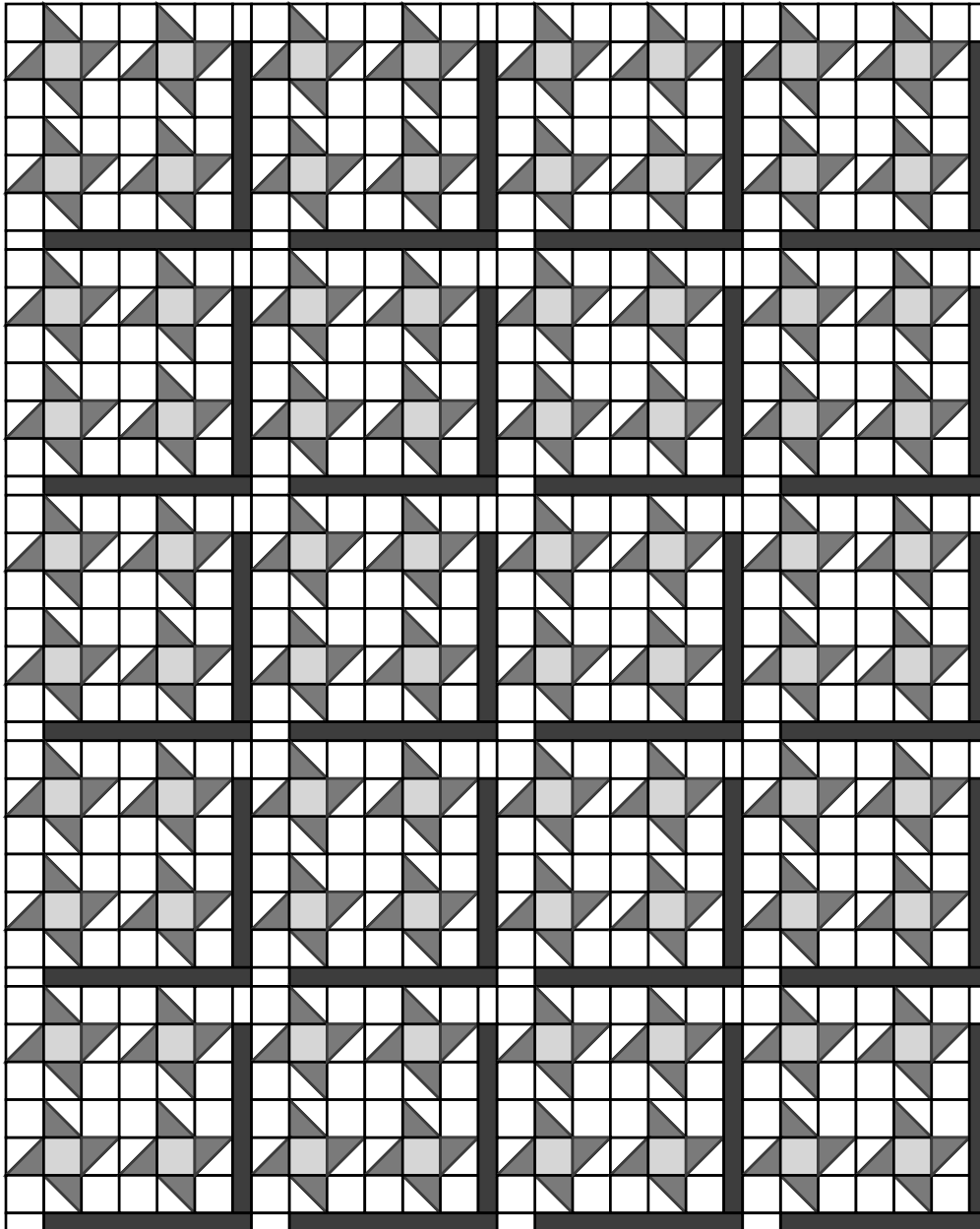

13.5" x 13.5"

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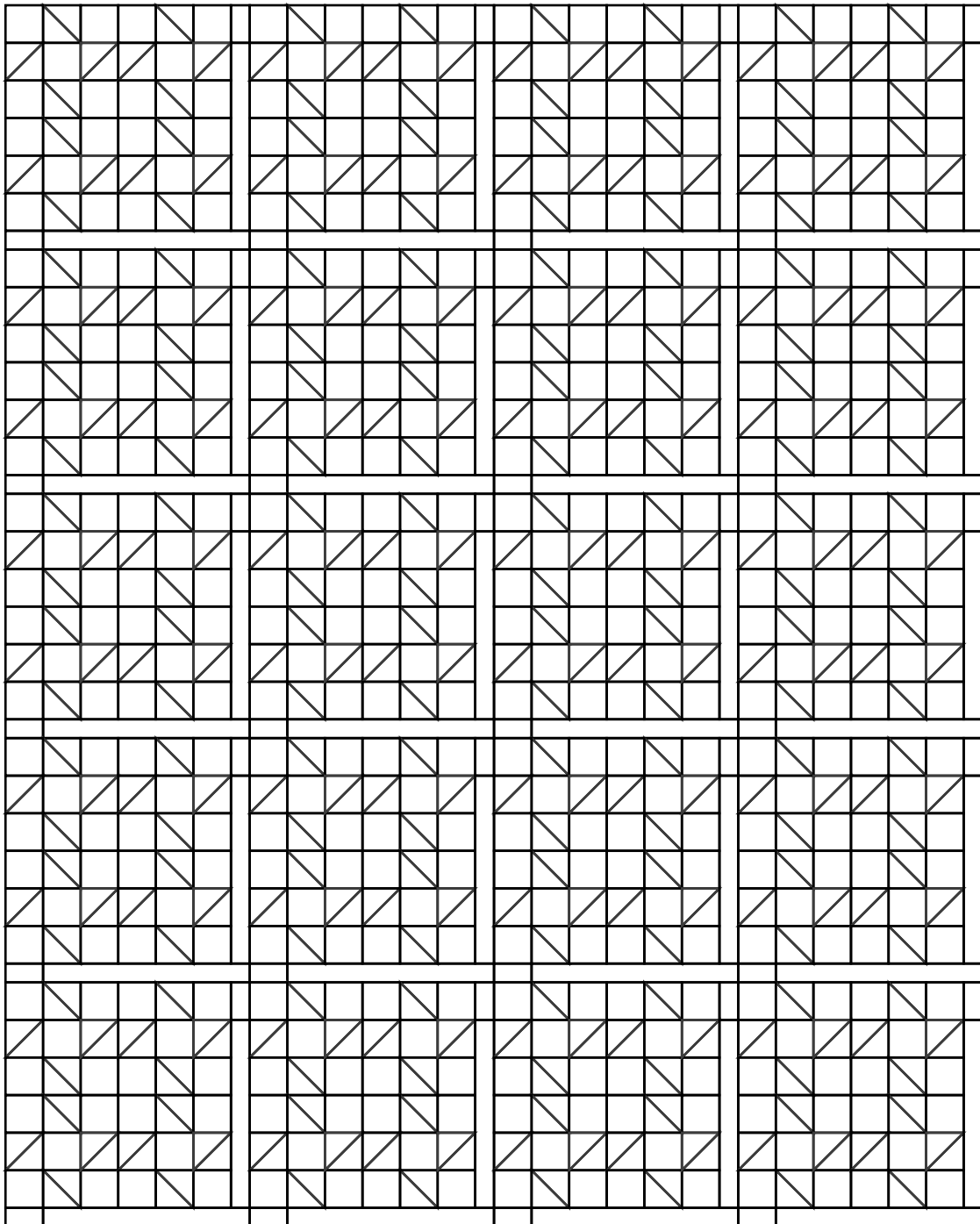
