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# Pat Sloan Layout for Aurifil's 2019 Designer of the Month Blocks

## Setting Supply List

2 1/8 yds White Background Fabric  
1/4 yd Half Square Triangle fabric (HST)

2/3 yd Star Point Fabric

1/2 yd Star Center Fabric  
1/4 yd Center Sashing & Corner Stones

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## Cutting Directions

### White Background Fabric

- Cut 2 outer borders 1.5" x 60.5"
- Cut 2 outer borders 1.5" x 62.5"
  
- Cut 4 inner border 2.5" x 32.5"
  
- Cut 16 squares 4" x 4" for HST
- Cut 32 squares 4" x 4" for star points
  
- Cut 4 rectangles 2.5" x 3.5"
- Cut 36 squares 3.5" x 3.5"
  
- Cut 1 square 2.5" x 2.5"  
for middle

### Half Square Triangle Fabric

- Cut 16 squares 4" x 4"

### Star Point Fabric

- Cut 32 squares 4" x 4"

### Star Center Fabric

- Cut 8 squares 6.5" x 6.5"

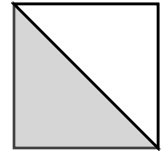
### Center sashing & corner stones

- Cut 4 strips 2.5" x 12.5"
- Cut 4 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

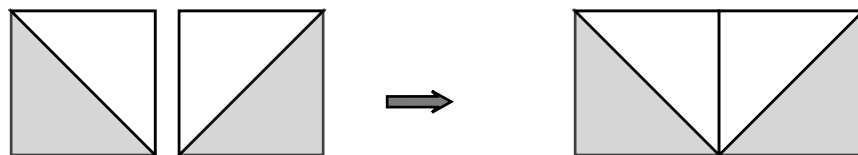
# Pat Sloan Layout for Aurifil's 2019 Designer of the Month Blocks Star Blocks

## Directions

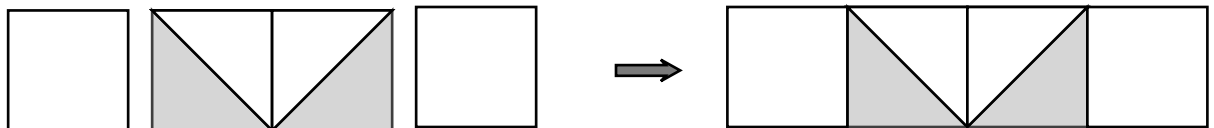
1) Use the 4" star point fabric and 4" background fabric to make the Star points.  
Follow the Half Square Triangle directions on the last page  
Trim to 3.5" x 3.5"  
Make 64 units



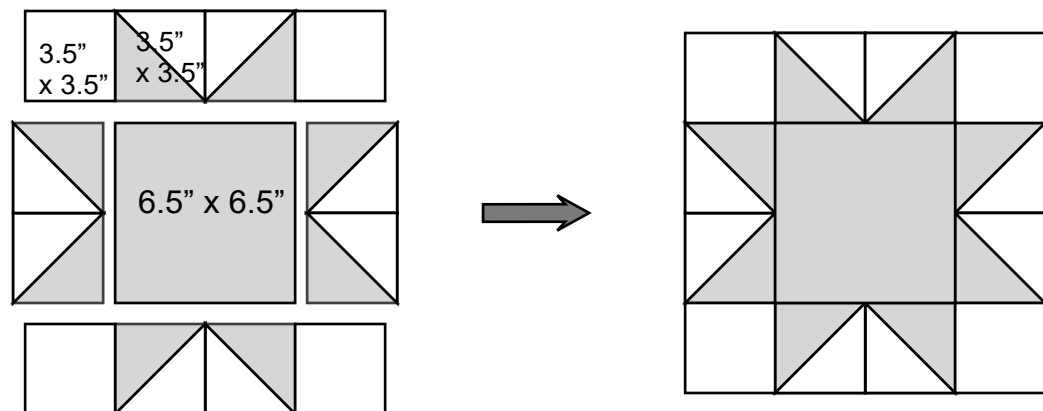
2) Following the diagram, Assemble the Star points units  
Measures 3.5" x 6.5"  
Make 32 units



3) Following the diagram, sew the top and bottom rows using the 3.5" background squares  
Measures 3.5" x 12.5"  
Make 16



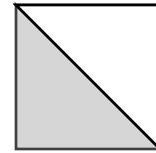
4) Following the diagram, Assemble the block by sewing the units together  
Measures 12.5" x 12.5"  
Make 8



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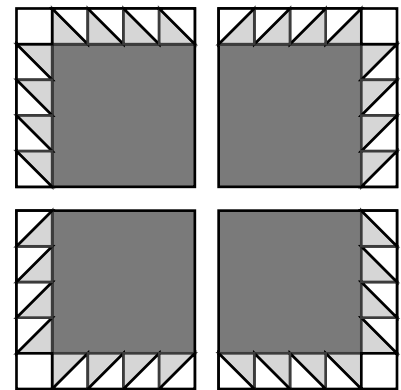
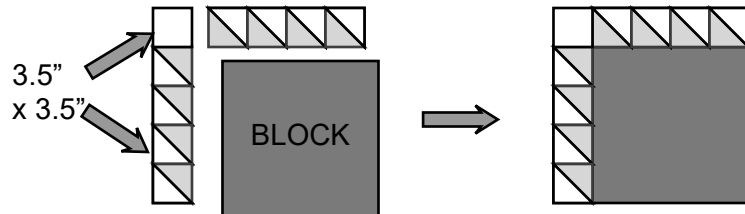
## HST Directions

- 1) Use the 4" HST fabric and 4" background fabric to make the HST units. Follow the Half Square Triangle directions on the last page  
Trim to 3.5" x 3.5"  
Make 32 units

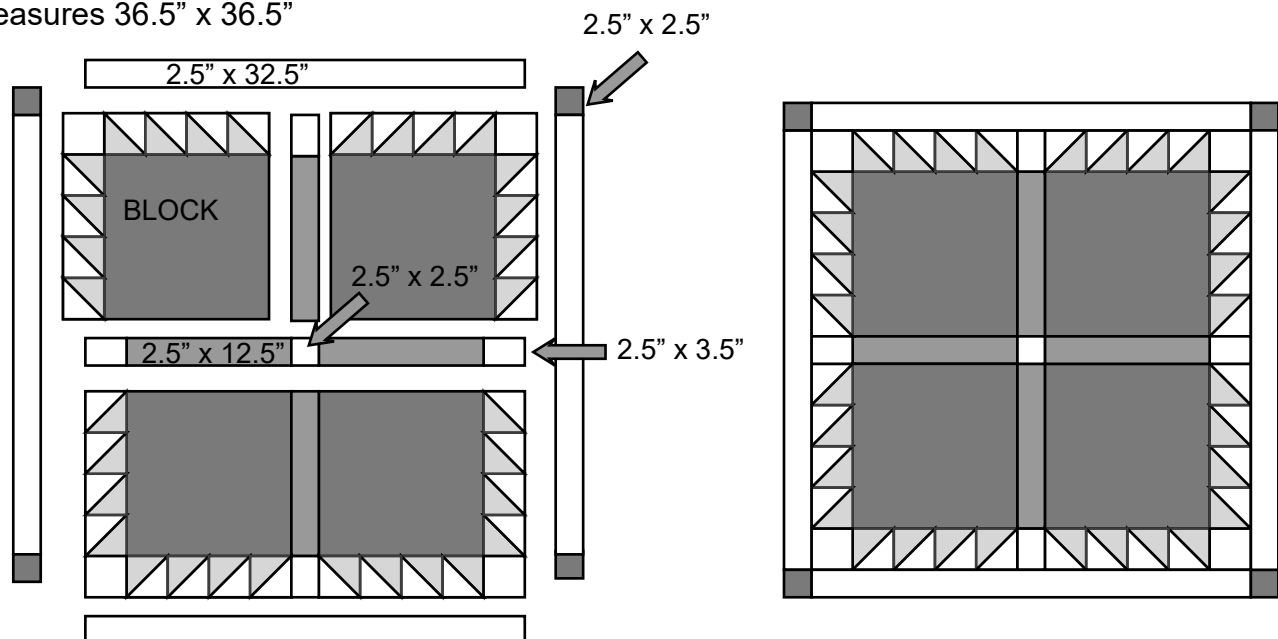


## Assemble the Center

- 1) Following the diagram and noting direction of the HST sew 4 HST to the top of a block  
Sew 4 more HST together and sew a 3.5" background to the end  
Sew to the block  
Make 4 following diagram placement  
Measures 15.5" x 15.5"

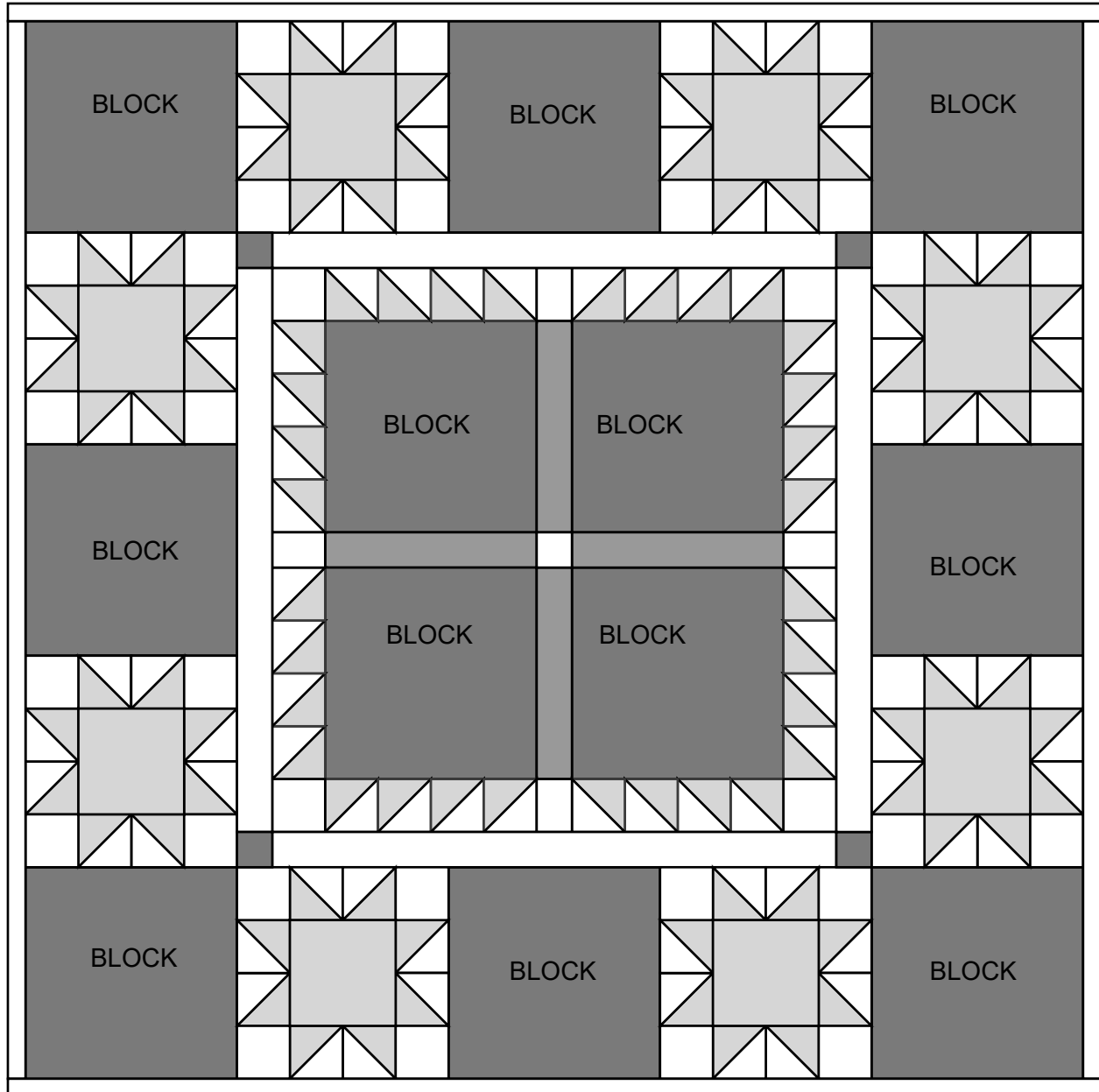


- 2) Following the diagram assemble the middle unit using the 4 units from above, the 2.5" x 3.5" Rectangles, 2.5" x 12.5" sashing, the 32.5" strips, and the 2.5" squares  
Make 1 unit  
Measures 36.5" x 36.5"



- 3) Following the diagram on the next page to alternate Blocks and Stars.  
Sew the 60.5" and 62.5" borders on at the end  
Make 1 unit Measures 62.5" x 62.5"

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Quilt 62.5" x 62.5"

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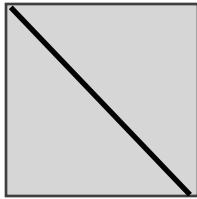
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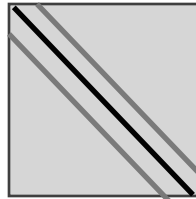
## Half Square Triangles Tutorial

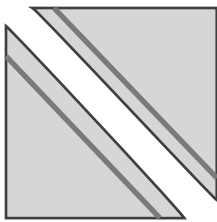
**Step 1**

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



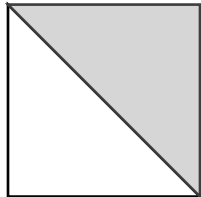
**Step 2**

- Layer the 2 squares  
- Sew a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on both Sides of the drawn line



**Step 3**

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST



**Step 4**

-Trim squares to size in directions using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
