Background 7½" x 9½"



--1--

Make a Selvage Edge Stocking

1- select about 11 selvage strips cut 1/2" to 1" wide by 7" wide.
Cut a foundation square 7" x 10"

2- Layer the strips on the foundation. Lay the finished selvage edge on top of the cut edge of the strip under it.

3-Sew VERY close to the edge of the selvage strip.

4-Cut your stocking out of the this and away you go!

If you are making 2 stockings, make one red and one green!
