Take this paper and cut out the stocking leaving a window 'shape' of the stocking. (see my website for photos)

Now place that 'window' over the pieced block to see what looks nice!.

My block is fusible applique for my 12 Days version. I'm collecting lots of fun trims and buttons for each block so they will be unique!

Put your collection of trims in an old canning jar to sit in your studio. That way you will enjoy the trims the whole year and have a place to put new finds!

Cut each stocking
Background 7½" x 9½"

Block 1 - 9 Patch Magic

Cut 5 blocks 3.5" x 3.5" from fabric 1
Cut 4 blocks 3.5" x 3.5" from fabric 2

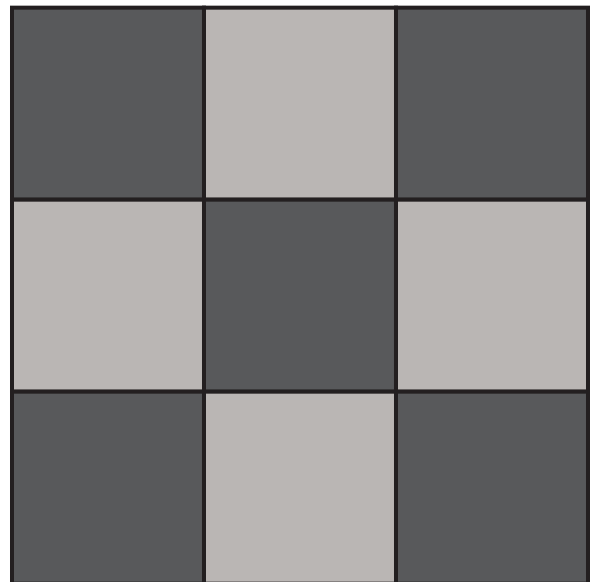
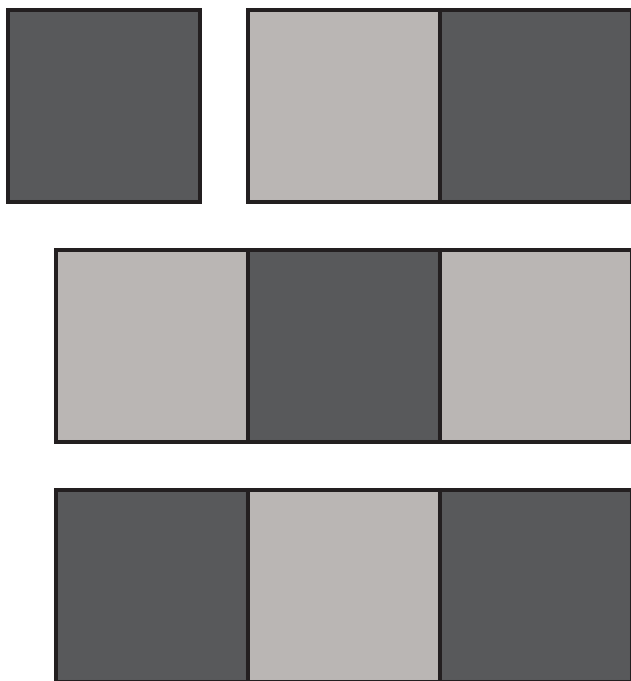
Sew a basic 9-patch block

To cut the stocking, twist it on the block so it is NOT straight. See what looks best to you.

Make a 3-D stocking or applique the shape to the background following the basic directions

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
