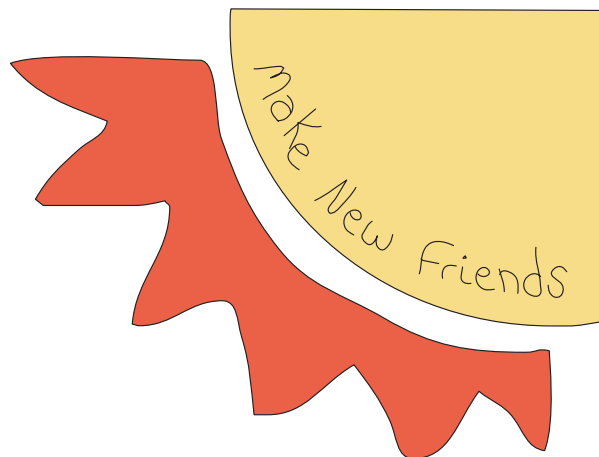

Sun Construction



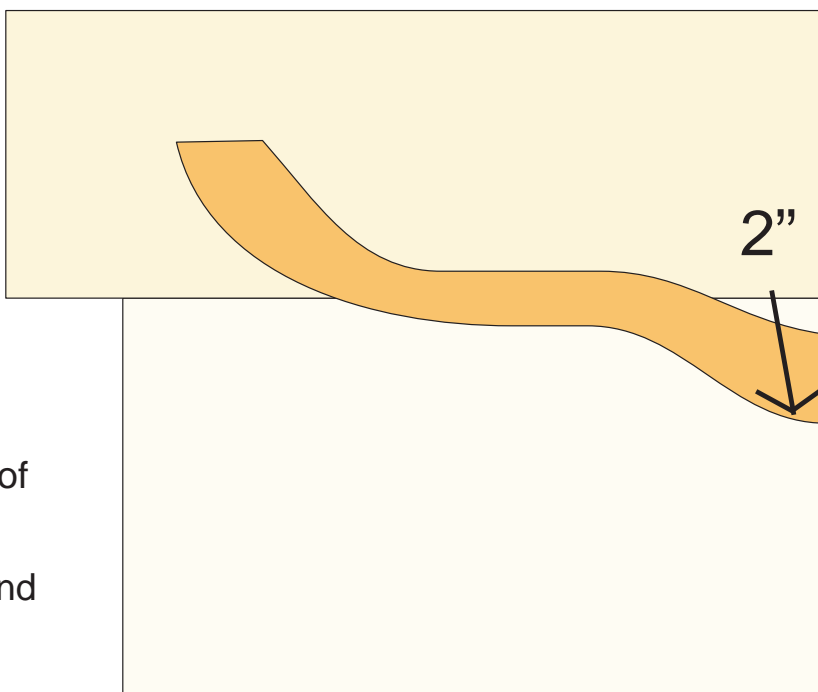
- Trace quote onto the sun before layering
- Tuck the Rays UNDER the yellow sun part.
- Position the BOTTOM RIGHT of the walk way 2" DOWN from the seam, SEE DIAGRAM



Inner Border



- Cut 2 stripe fabrics 1.5" x 28.5"
- Cut 2 stripe Fabrics 1.5" x 34.5"
- Sew the long ones to the sides of the center
- Sew the short ones to the top and bottom of the center

Border Construction

- Dark Blue border fabric
Cut 36 squares 3" x 3" for HST

- Light Blue border
(NOTE - KITS HAVE 2 Fabrics
as one was discontinued
so I mixed it up, so that is
how my quilt is done, a mix
of TWO light blue prints)

- Cut 18 squares 4.5" x 4.5"
(KITS cut 9 from each)

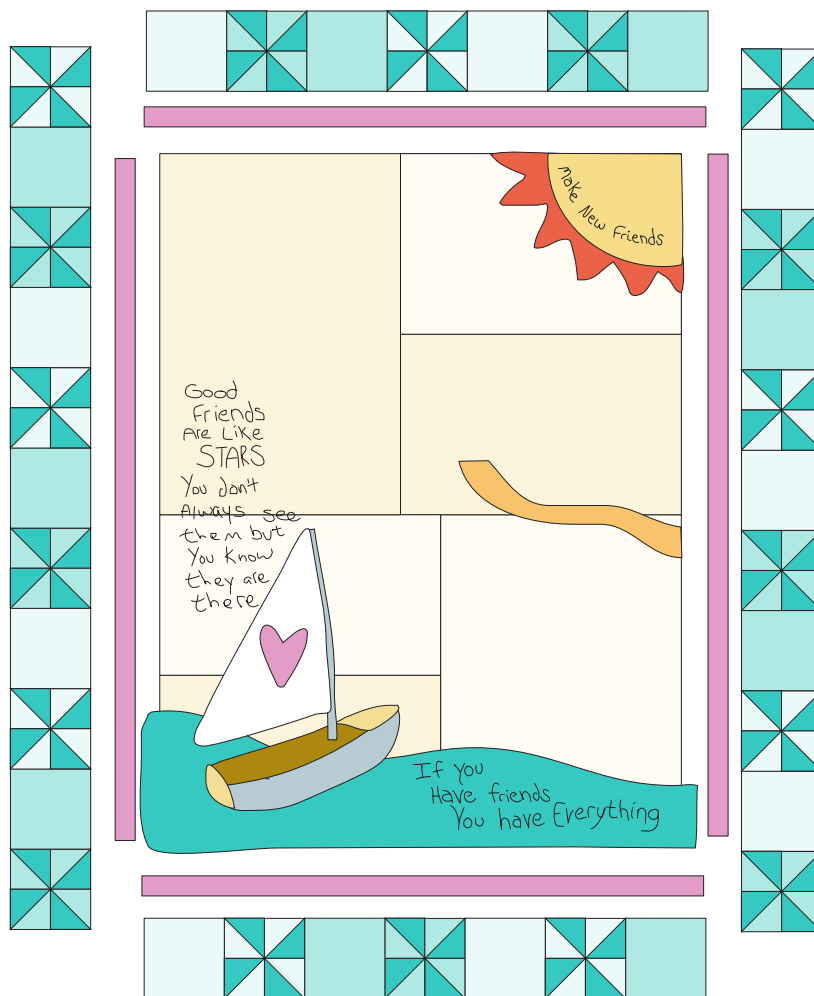
- Cut 36 squares 3" x 3" for HST
(KITS cut 18 from each)

Make 72 HST units that
measure 2.5" x 2.5"
I have Directions on my website
if you need them for using squares to make
HST.

Following the diagram
Make 18 Pinwheel blocks

Following the diagram alternate
pinwheels and squares for 4 borders.

Sew the borders to the center.

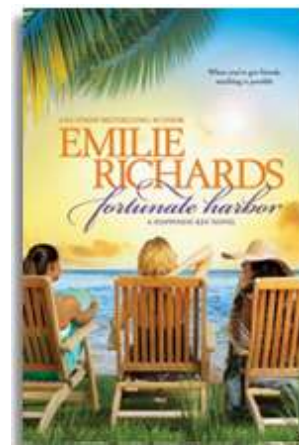
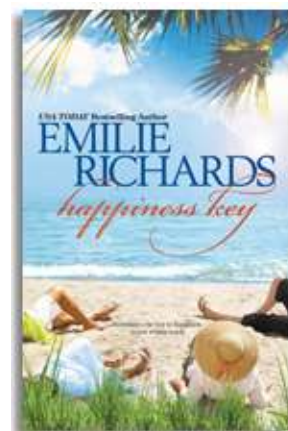
