## Block 11 - Going Dotty Block

Cut 1 toe and 1 cuff  
Cut 6 dots

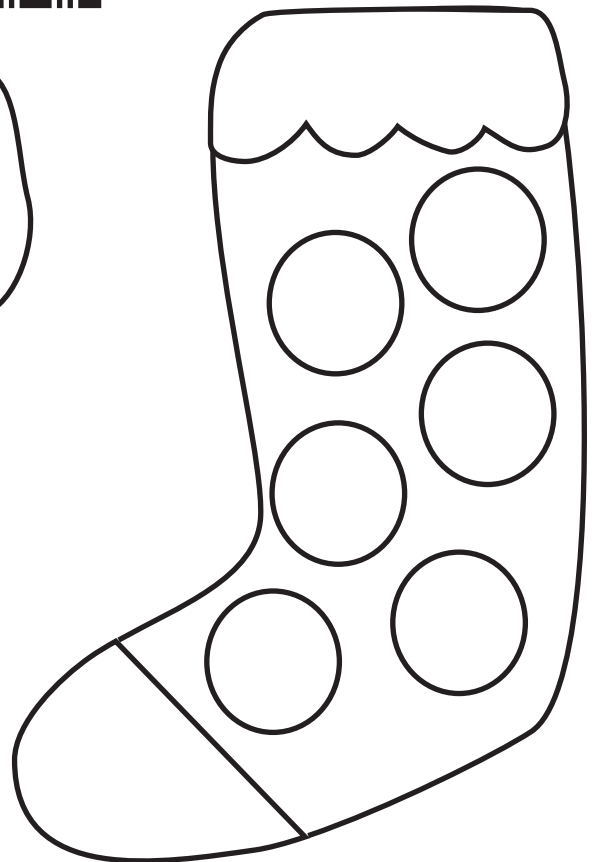
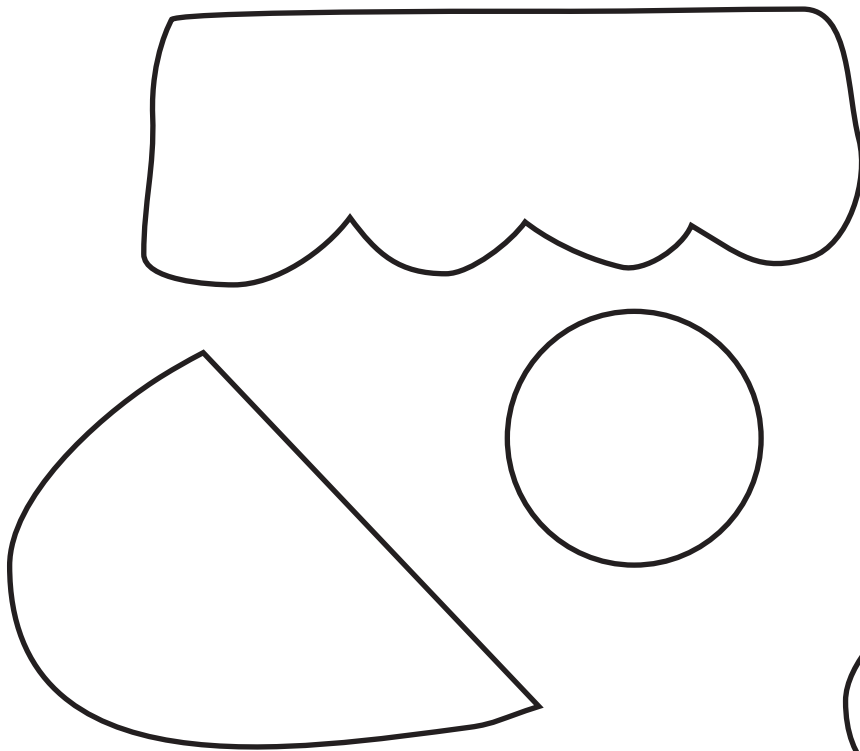
Following the diagram Applique the toe, cuff and dots to the center of the stocking.

If you're doing a 2nd advent block, reverse the colors used in both blocks. Make one stocking red and the other green.
