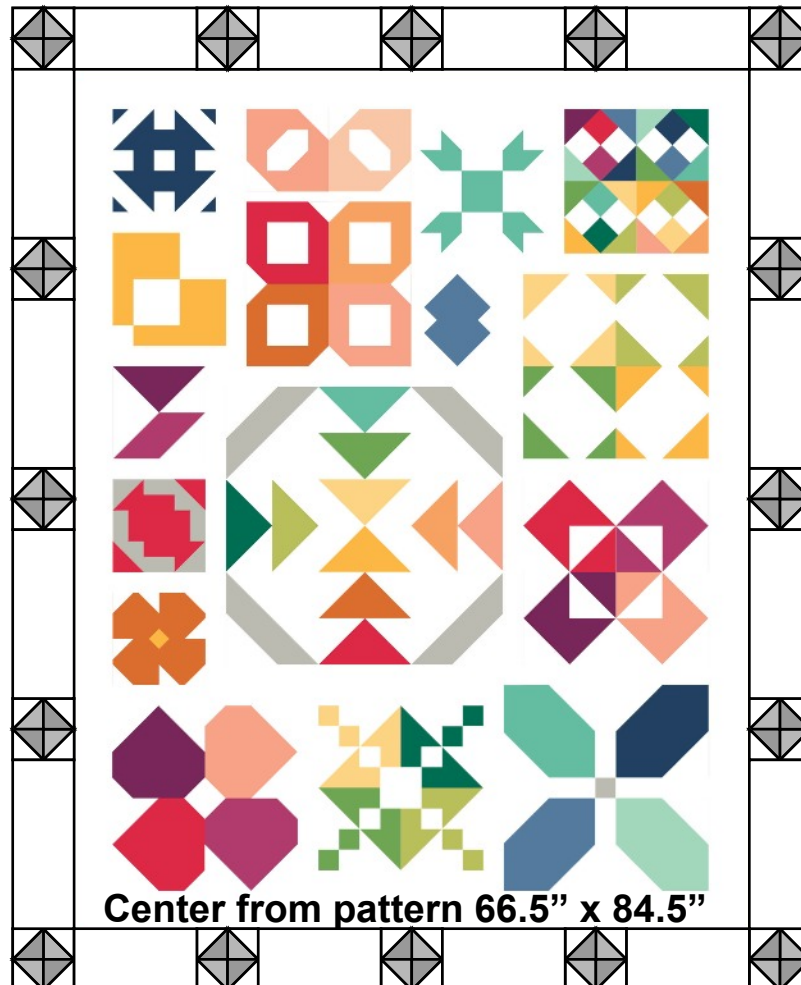

Layout Cutting Directions

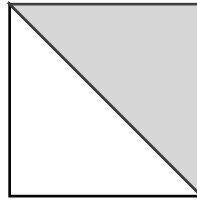
Borders Fabric

- Cut 8 side border rectangles 6.5" x 16.5"
- Cut 8 top/bottom rectangles 6.5" x 12.5"

HST

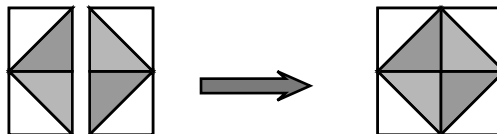
64 - These are created from the Sew and Flip cut always made from the sampler blocks. You will generate a few more than 64, so a few won't be used.

Trim all 64 HST to 3.5" x 3.5"
If you want to make different HST,
Use the directions on the last page



Directions

- 1) Following the diagram, use 4 HST, sew together
Make 16 units
Measures 6.5" x 6.5"

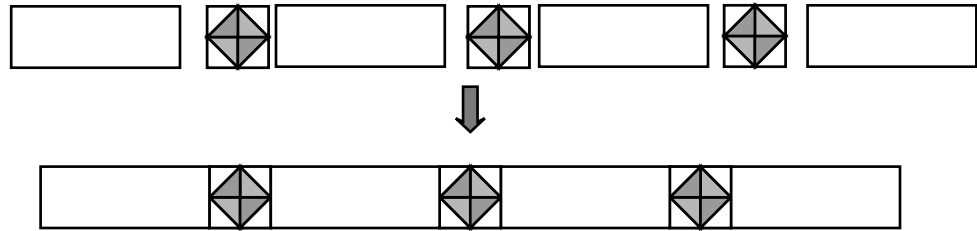

Bonus Border layout

2) Following the diagram, use 4 HST units from Step #1 and 4 rectangles 6.5" x 16.5", sew together

Make 2 side borders

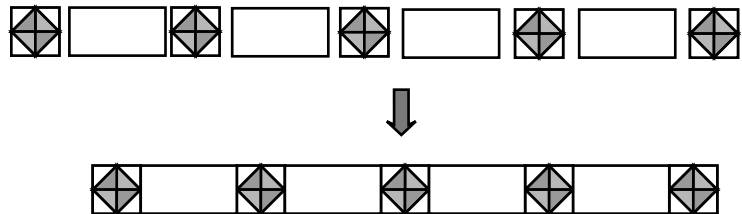
Measures 6.5" x 84.5"



3) Following the diagram, use 5 HST units from Step #1 and 4 rectangles 6.5" x 12.5", sew together

Make 2 for top and bottom borders

Measures 6.5" x 78.5"

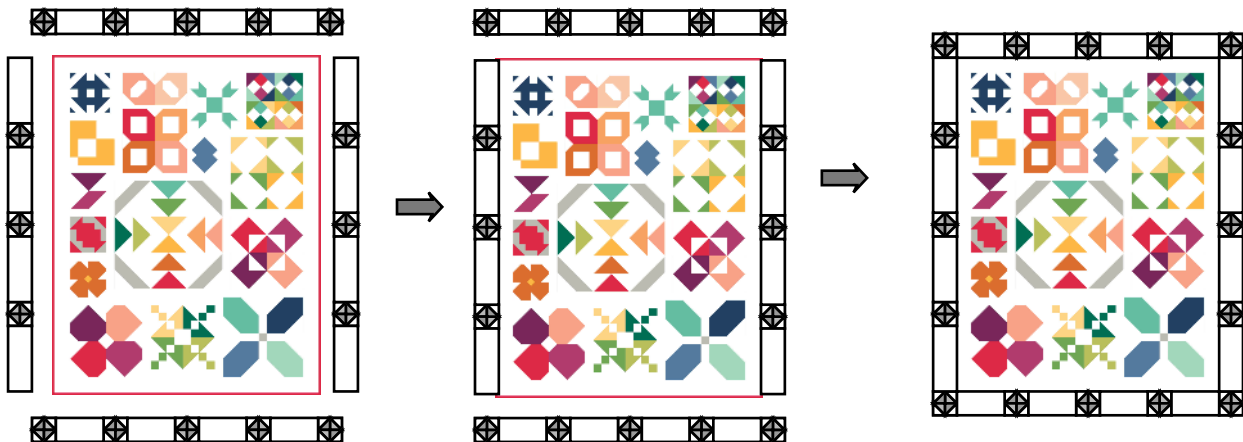


4) The Quilt center is 66.5" x 84.5" before you add the borders.

Following the diagram, Sew the side borders to the center.

Sew the top and bottom to the center

Measures 78.5" x 96.5"



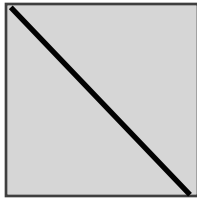

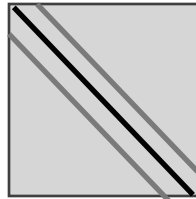
Half Square Triangles Tutorial

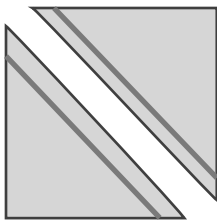
Step 1

- Use 4" squares of light and dark
- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2

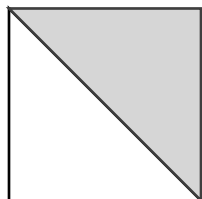
- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a 1/4" seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn
Line for 2 HST

Step 4



-Trim squares to 3.5" x 3.5"
using a square ruler with
a diagonal line placed on the
Seam.
