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Stitching tips

Do a test of your blanket stitch.

Start with the machine default setting .

Then change the stitch width and length.

Write notes on your test fabric.

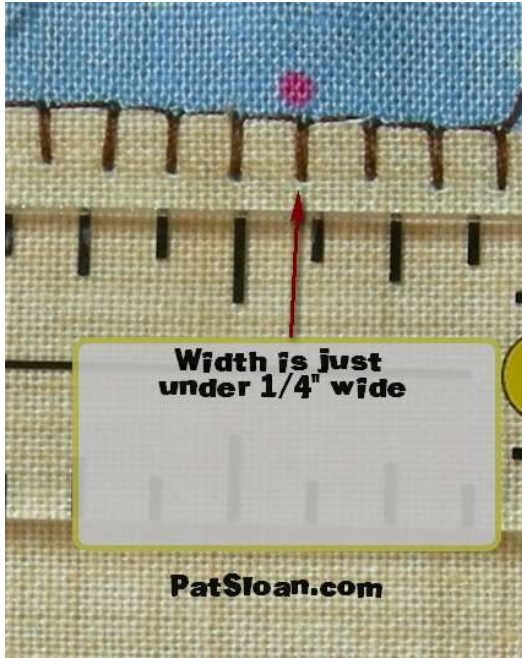
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This is my 'go to' stitch size.

Straight stitch is just a bit less than 1/4".



zig zag is also just under 1/4".

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Handle Corners, points and inside 'v' all the same.

You just turn the fabric more or less to line up where you want the stitch to go.

On a TEST PIECE draw the stitch lines then stitch to practice turning

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
