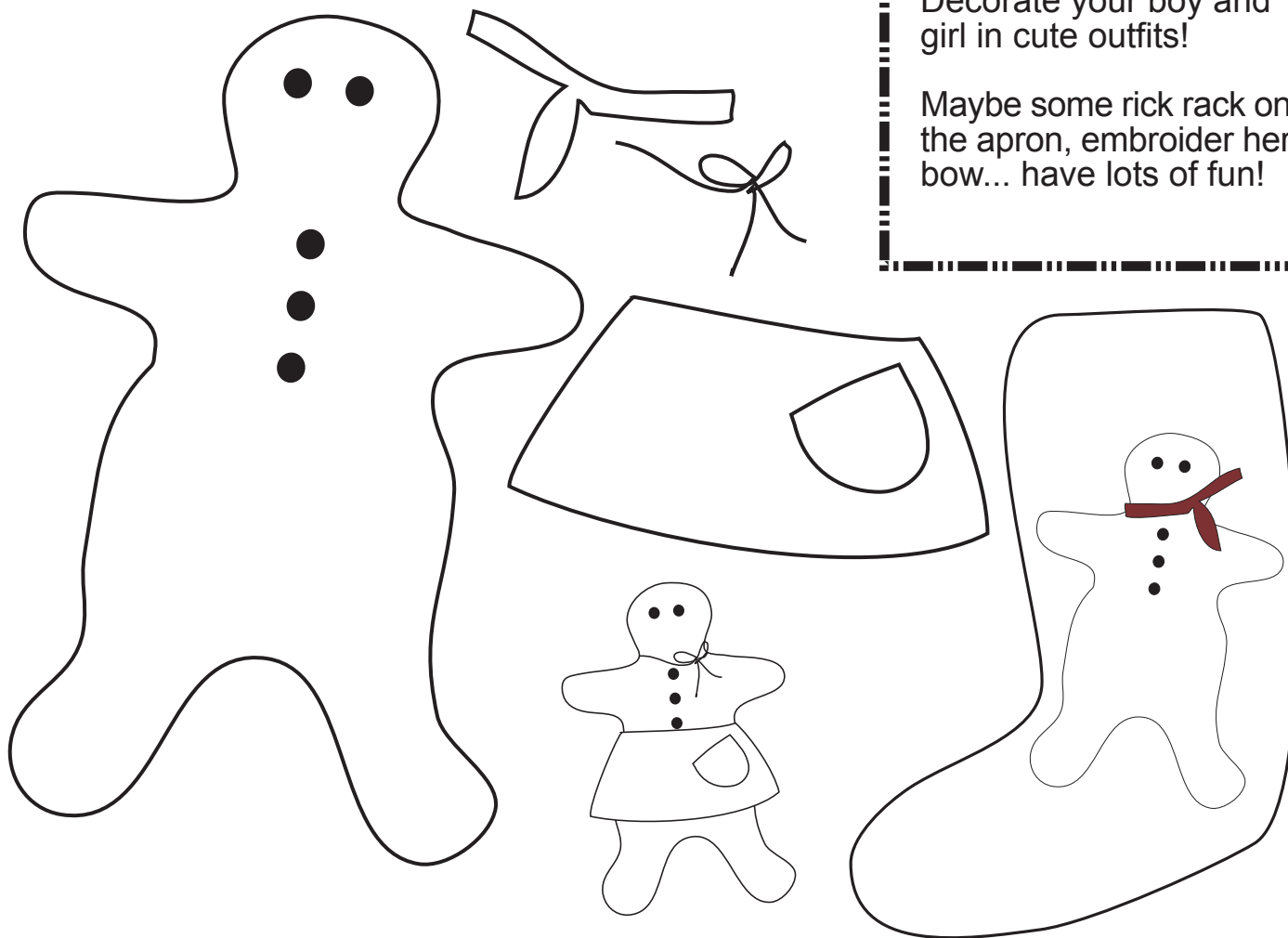
So to celebrate add a sweet Gingerbread Man to your stocking!
