
Childhood Games

Block 1- Hide and Seek

I had to start with the childhood game of Hide-and-seek, or some of you know it as hide-and-go-seek. When I asked for your favorite game this was by and far the one named the most!



Block is 16.5" x 16.5" Finished size 16" x 16"

If you never played, there needs to be a few people. One person is 'it'. Finished size 16" x 16" All the other run and hide. The 'it' person then has to find them and starts the game by yelling "Ready or not, here I come!". They find each person until one is left, who is the winner and plays 'it' on the next round. Sometimes if players can't be found, 'it' will call out 'Olly Olly Oxen Free' or 'Olly Olly In come Free' to signal the end of this round and everyone comes out of hiding.

There are variations including someone who said they did this on horseback!

Cutting Directions

Light fabrics

- Cut 8 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

Medium fabrics

- Cut 4 squares 6.5" x 6.5"

Dark Fabric

- Cut 4 rectangles 2.5" x 6.5"
- Cut 4 rectangles 2.5" x 4.5"

TIP:

Use a Mix of fabrics for some!

Directions

1) Using the dark 2.5" x 6.5" rectangles and light 2.5" squares sew them together

Measures 2.5" x 8.5" Make 4 units



2) Using the dark 2.5" x 4.5" rectangles and light 2.5" squares sew them together

Measures 2.5" x 6.5" Make 4 units


3) Following the diagram sew the unit below using the 2.5" x 6.5" unit and the 6.5" square Measures 6.5" x 8.5"

Make 4




4) Following the diagram sew the unit below using the 2.5" x 8.5" unit and the prior unit Measures 8.5" x 8.5"

Make 4



5) Following the diagram, Assemble the block rotating the units. Make 1 Measures 16.5" x 16.5"



IN the Quilt it is finished size 16" x 16"


