For me that includes some beach time!

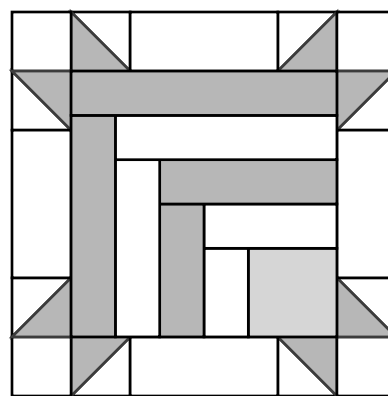
When I was a very little girl we lived just a few blocks from 'The Shore'. Can you guess what state that was in?

Block to 13.5" x 13.5"

Finished in the quilt is Size 13"

Cutting & Sewing

Light Fabric 2 different fabrics

- Cut 1 rectangle 2" x 3.5"
- Cut 1 rectangle 2" x 5"
- Cut 1 rectangle 2" x 6.5"
- Cut 1 rectangle 2" x 8"

Medium Fabric -

- Cut 1 square 3.5" x 3.5"

Dark Fabric 2 different fabrics

- Cut 1 rectangle 2" x 5"
- Cut 1 rectangle 2" x 6.5"
- Cut 1 rectangle 2" x 8"
- Cut 1 rectangle 2" x 9.5"

Background Fabric

- Cut 4 squares 3" x 3" for HST
- Cut 4 squares 2.5" x 2.5"
- Cut 4 rectangles 2.5" x 5.5"

Star points Fabric

- Cut 4 squares 3" x 3" for HST

OPTIONAL to work ahead

Cut all 10 star border fabrics

Layout on last page

Background Fabric

- Cut 40 squares 3" x 3" for HST
- Cut 40 squares 2.5" x 2.5"
- Cut 40 rectangles 2.5" x 5.5"

Star points Fabric

- Cut 40 squares 3" x 3" for HST

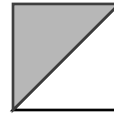

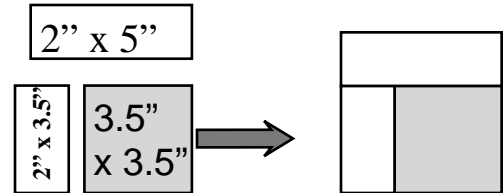

Directions

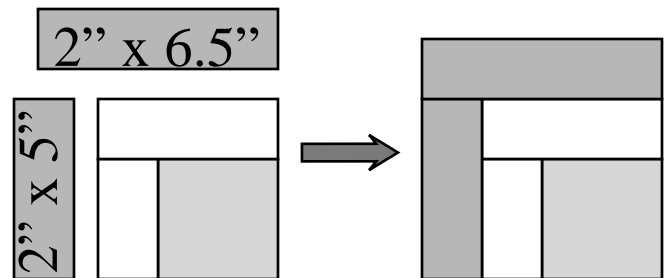
1) Using the 3" background and 3" Star point fabric squares make HSTs using method on last page. Make 8 units - trim to 2.5" square



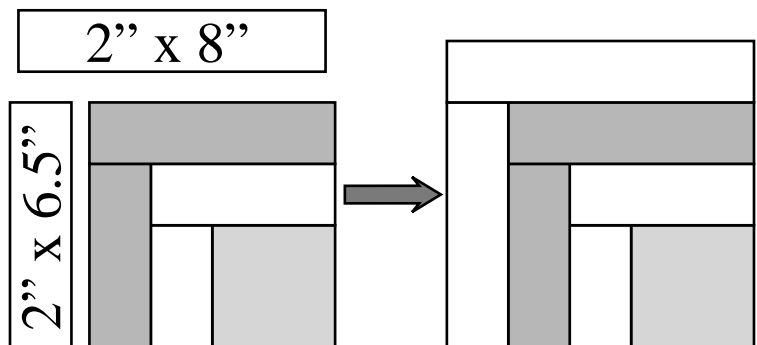
2) Following the Diagram, sew the shorter light rectangles to the medium squares
Make 1 unit - Measures 5" x 5"



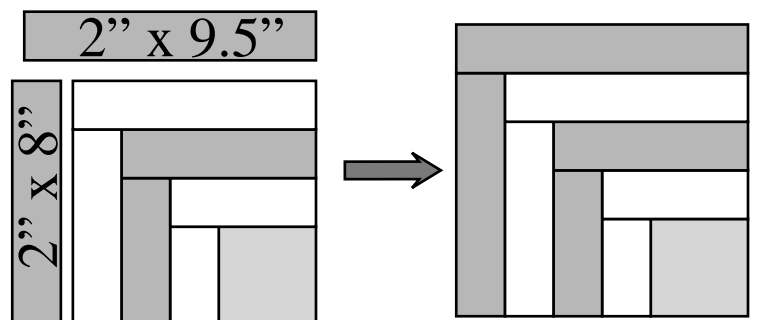
3) Following the Diagram, sew the shorter dark rectangles to the unit from step 2
Make 1 unit - Measures 6.5" x 6.5"



4) Following the Diagram, sew the remaining light rectangles to the unit from step 3
Make 1 unit - Measures 8" x 8"



5) Following the Diagram, sew the remaining dark rectangles to the unit from step 4
Make 1 unit - Measures 9.5" x 9.5"



Following diagram on next page
Set the block into the star frame

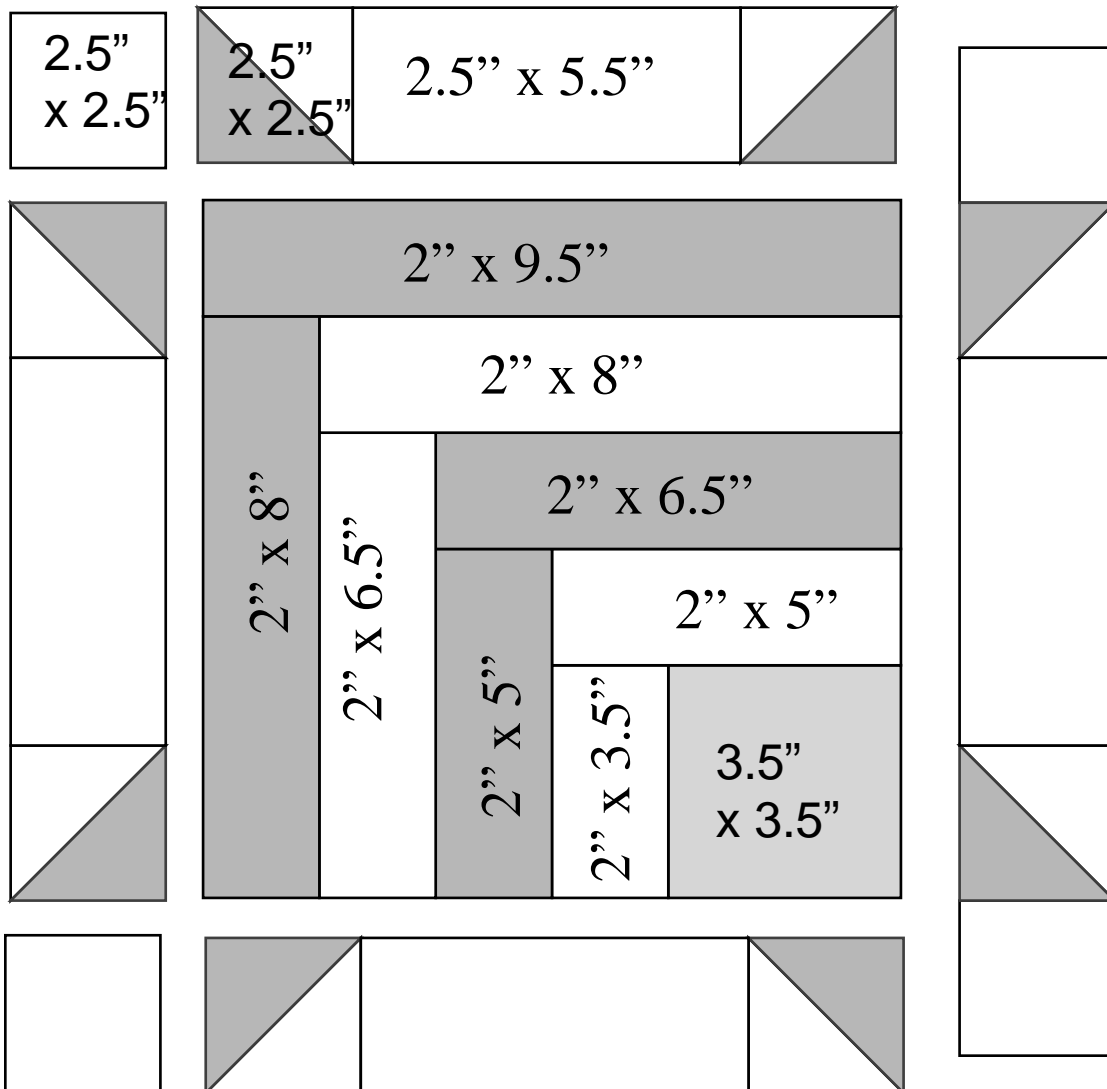

Unfinished Sizes



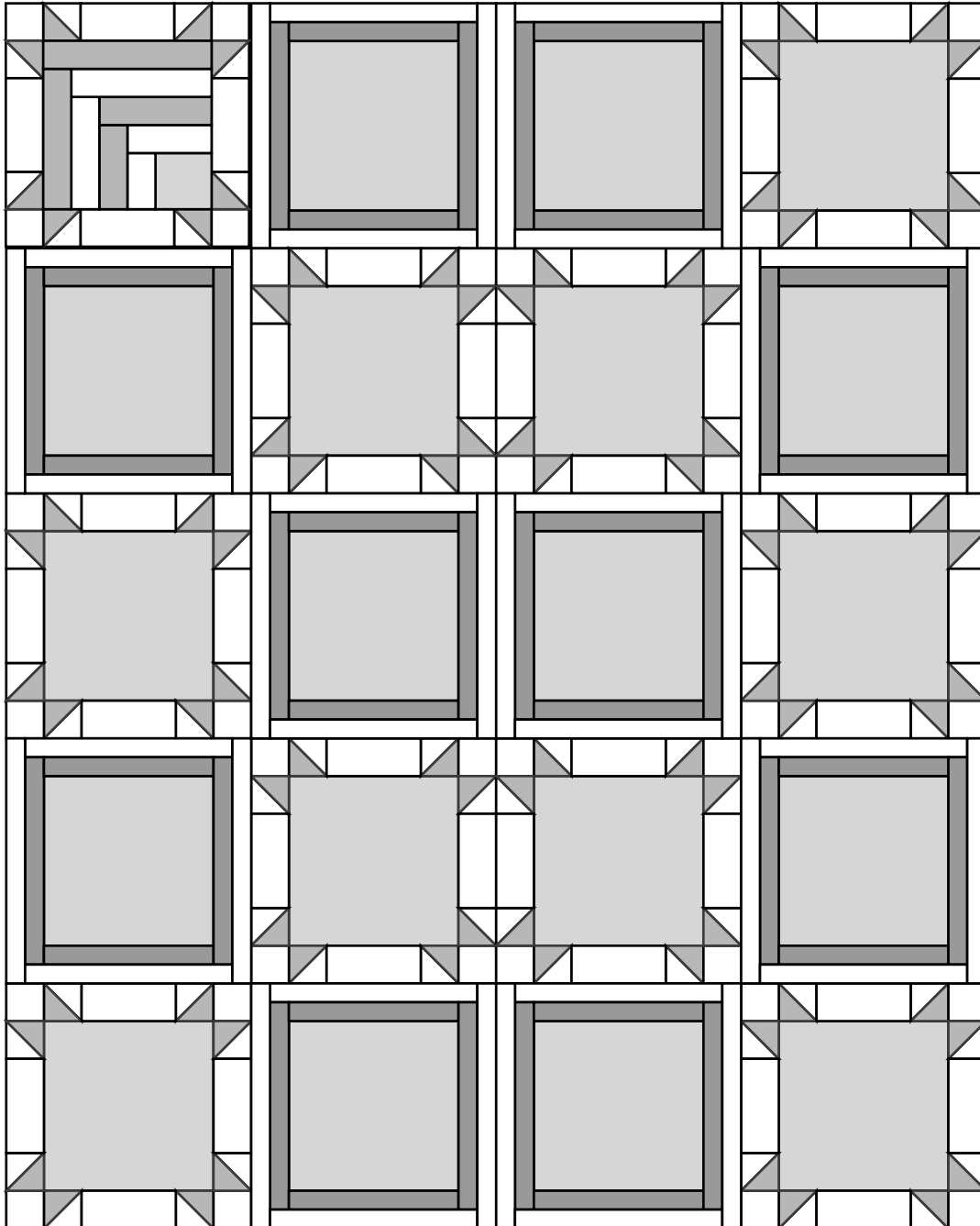
Square the Block to 13.5" x 13.5"

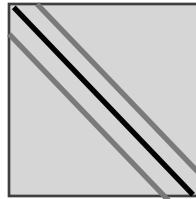
Half Square Triangles Tutorial

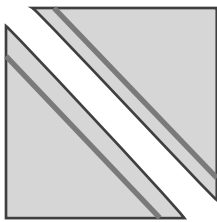
Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2

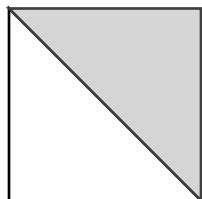
- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a 1/4" seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

Step 4



-Trim squares to 2.5" x 2.5" using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
