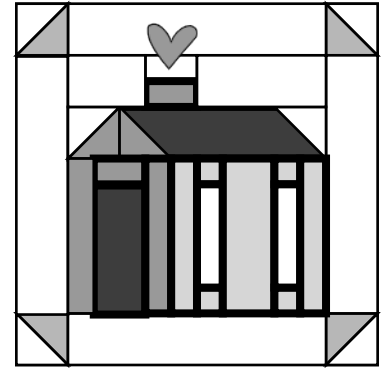


'Home Is.'

Block is 14.5" x 14.5"
Finished size 14" x 14"

We have to start our 'Home Is' sew along with a house block. Home is often a feeling more than just a place. Many of us have moved a lot, so the place we call home is the place we are currently. It might be a place you've lived in for along time, it might be your RV, or your winter rental. I lived in several places as a child, and repeated that as an adult, until we ended up where we are now. I never expected to be here more than a few years, that was 35 years ago. Today tell me about your home or the place you most consider home, it could be your grandparents or an aunts house. We want to channel that warm, cozy, hygge, feeling of home for this sew along

Cutting Directions

Background fabric

- Cut 3 squares 3" x 3" for (Half square triangles HST)
- Cut 4 strips 2.5" x 10.5"
- Cut 1 square 2.5" x 2.5"
- Cut 1 strip 2.5" x 5.5"
- Cut 1 strip 1.5" x 2.5"
- Cut 1 strip 2.5" x 3.5"

Front of house & chimney fabric

- Cut 1 square 3" x 3" for (Half square triangles HST)
- Cut 1 square 2.5" x 2.5"
- Cut 2 strips 1.5" x 6.5"
- Cut 2 strips 1.5" x 2.5"

Corner fabric

- Cut 2 squares 3" x 3" for (Half square triangles HST)

Side of house fabric

- Cut 4 squares 1.5" x 1.5"
- Cut 1 strip 2.5" x 6.5"
- Cut 2 strips 1.5" x 6.5"

Roof fabric

- Cut 1 strips 2.5" x 8.5" for

Door fabric

- Cut 1 strip 2.5" x 5.5"

Heart fabric

- Cut 1 applique Heart

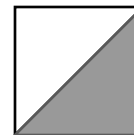
Window fabric

- Cut 2 strips 1.5" x 4.5"

Directions

1) Using a 3" background and a 3" corner fabric squares make HSTs using method on my separate HST PDF sheet at the end

trim to 2.5" square
Make 4 units

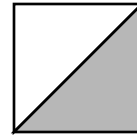

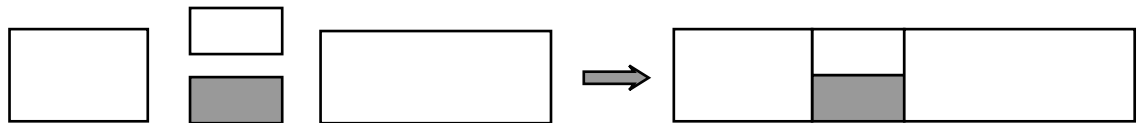

Directions

2) Using a 3" background and a 3" front of house fabric squares
 Make a HSTs using method on my separate HST
 PDF sheet at the end.
 trim to 2.5" square
 Make 2 units, Use one in the block



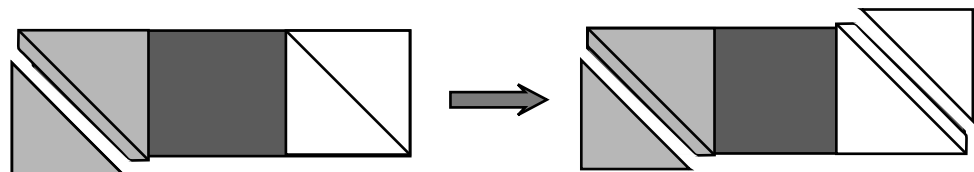
3) Following diagram sew together Background 2.5" x 3.5" strip, 1.5" x 2.5" strip,
 2.5" x 5.5" strip and the 1.5" x 2.5" chimney strip
 Measures 2.5" x 10.5"
 Make 1



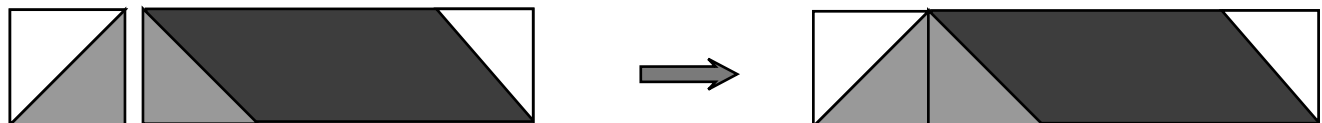
4) Following the diagram to make the roof. Place the house front 2.5" square on the left
 end, Sew ON the line.
 Place the 2.5" background square on the right end. Sew ON the line.
 Make 1
 Measures 2.5" x 8.5"



5) Following the diagram trim away leaving a 1/4" seam allowance on both corners
 Press triangles open to create the roof.
 Make 1
 Measures 2.5" x 8.5"



6) Following the diagram Sew the HST from step 2 to the left of the roof unit
 Make 1
 Measures 2.5" x 10.5"



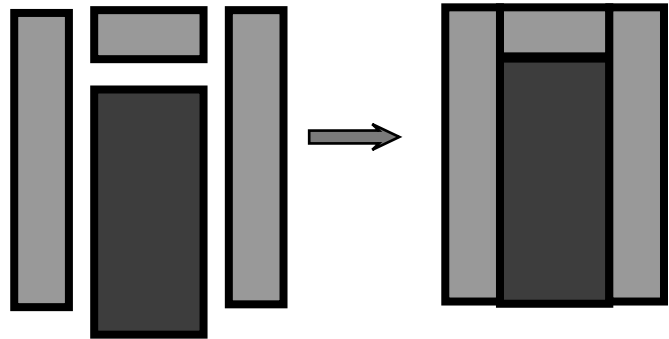

7) Following the diagram sew the 1.5" x 2.5" house front to the door.
 Sew the 1.5" x 6.5" house front strips to both sides of that.

Make 1

Measures 4.5" x 6.5"



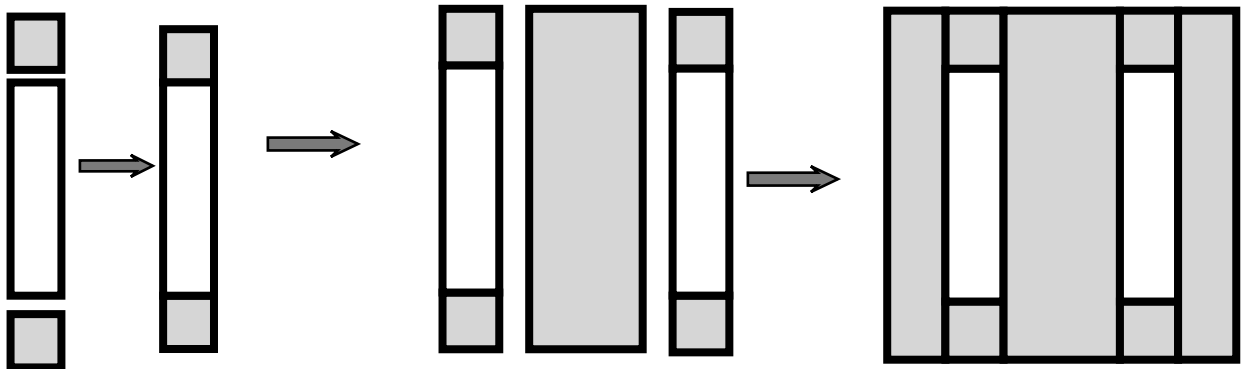
8) Following the diagram sew the 1.5" x 1.5" side of house squares to the top and Bottom of the 1.5" x 4.5" windows fabric.

Sew the windows to both sides of the 2.5" x 6.5" side of house strip

Sew the 1.5" x 6.5" side of house strips to both sides of that unit.

Make 1

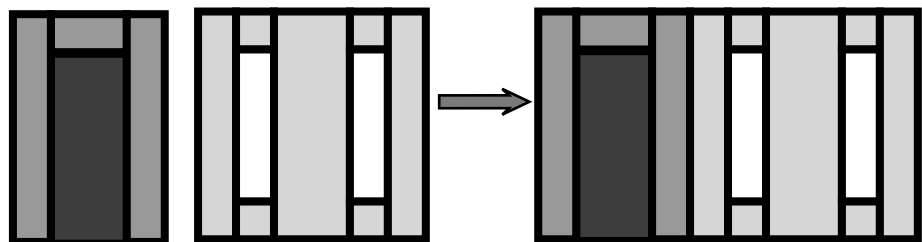
Measures 6.5" x 6.5"



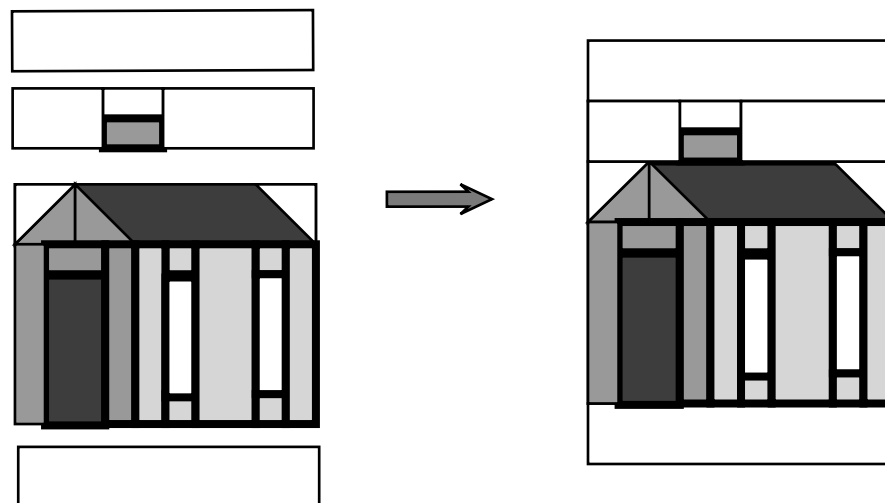
9) Following the diagram sew the front and side of house together

Make 1

Measures 6.5" x 10.5"



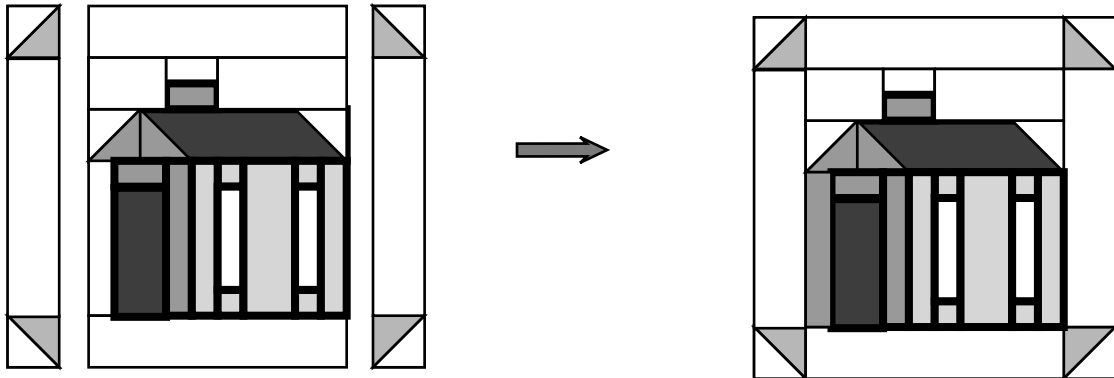
10) Following the diagram sew the chimney unit to the roof unit
 Sew that to the body of the house
 Sew a 2.5" x 10.5" background strip to the top and bottom
 Make 1
 Measures 10.5" x 10.5"



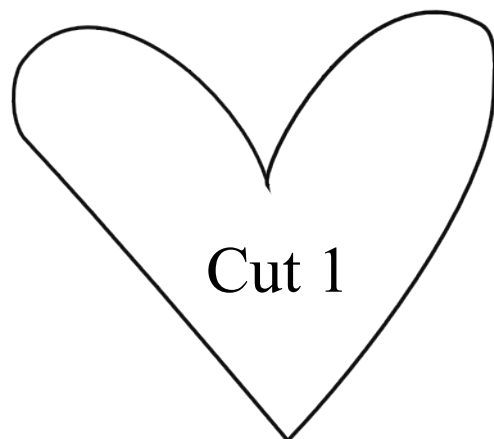
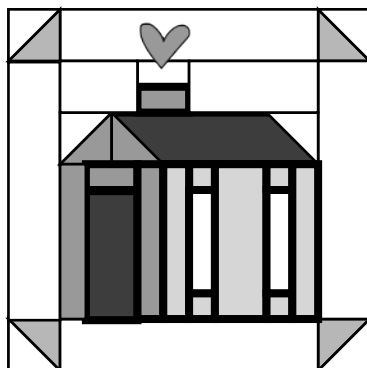
11) Following the diagram sew a 2.5" hst from step #1 to each end of the 2.5 x 10.5" background Strips. NOTE DIRECTION of HST for each
 Make 2
 Measures 2.5" x 14.5"



13) Following the diagram sew the units from the previous step to the sides of the house block
Make 1
Measures 14.5" x 14.5"



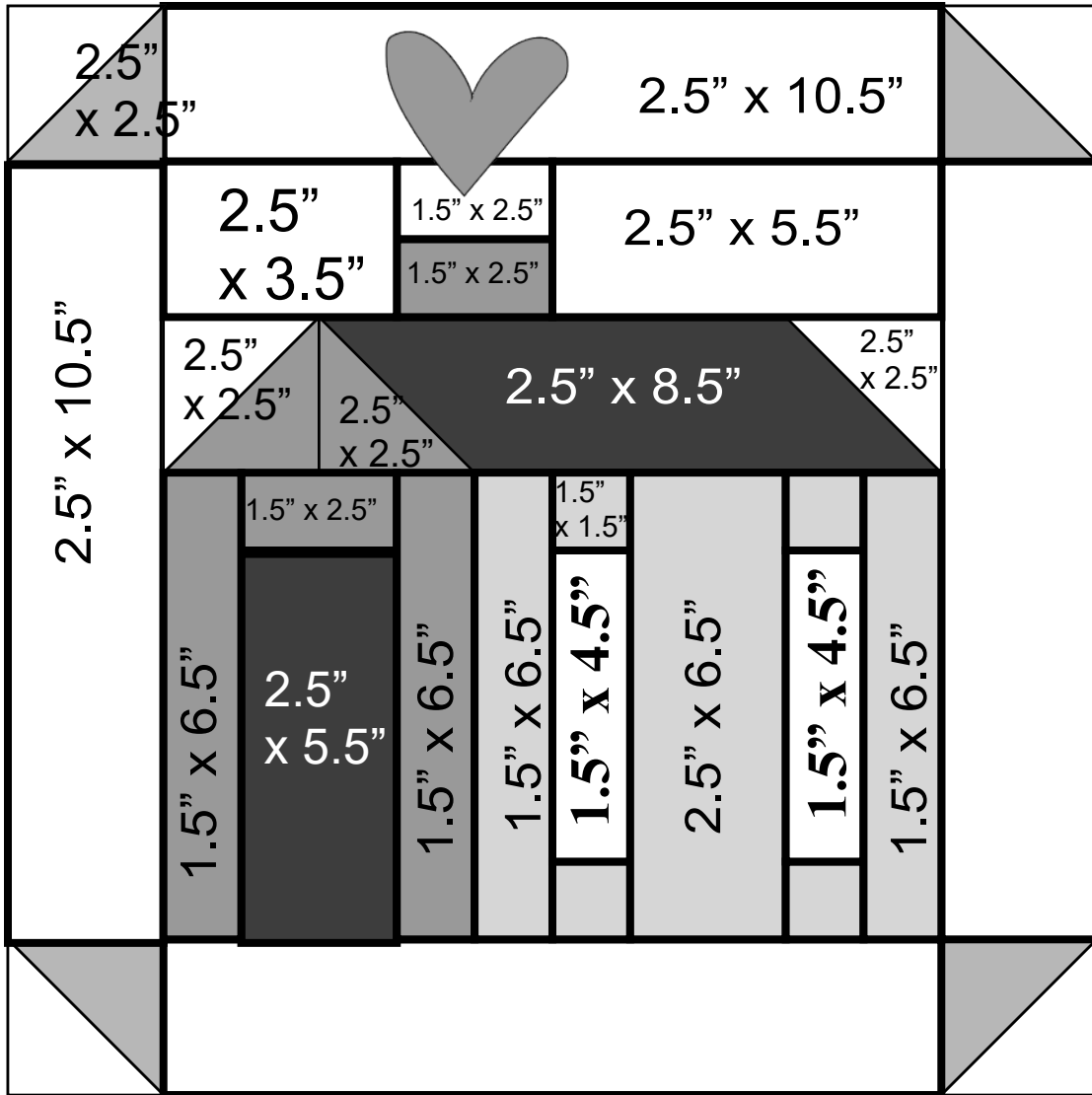
14) Applique one heart over the chimney
Make 1
Measures 14.5" x 14.5"

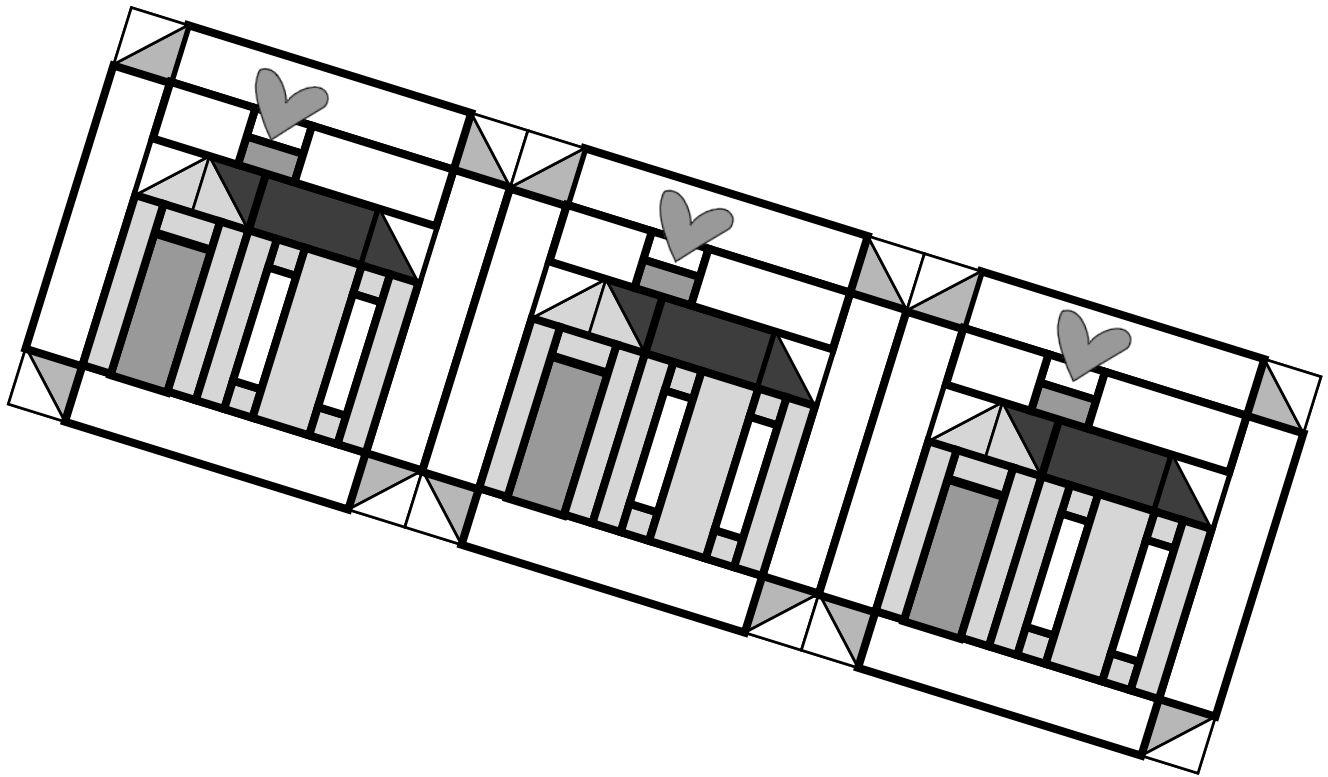

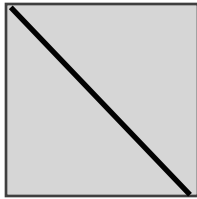

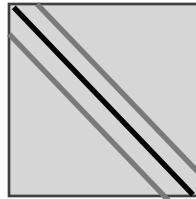
Half Square Triangles Tutorial

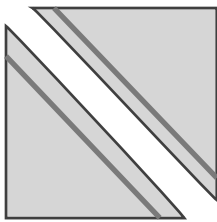
Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2

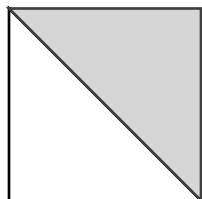
- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a 1/4" seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

Step 4



-Trim squares to size needed using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
