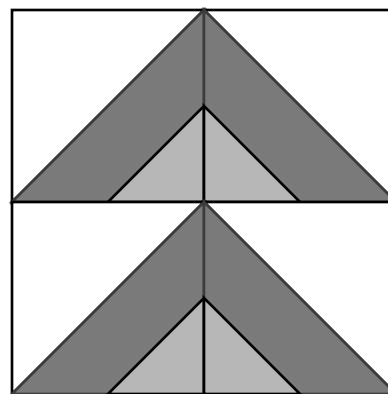


Block 10/25 Recipe Box

SQUARE Block to 12.5" x 12.5"

Finished in the quilt is Size 12"

mmm... my family wasn't quite like that. My grandma's were not known for their cooking. If it had been available I'm sure they would have been the earliest adopters of meals already made!

Which would not have been all bad, BUT, my step mom is an incredible cook. So today I'm looking to Karen's cooking skills and her massive collection of recipe cards and cook books. She learned to cook in France and is a master of changing this ... and adjusting that .. for incredible food.

Cutting & Sewing

Light Fabric

- Cut 2 squares 7" x 7" for HST

Medium Fabric

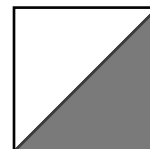
- Cut 4 squares 3.5" x 3.5"

Dark Fabric

- Cut 2 squares 7" x 7" for HST

Directions

- 1) Sew the 7" light and dark squares using HST method on last page. Make 4 units - trim to 6.5" square

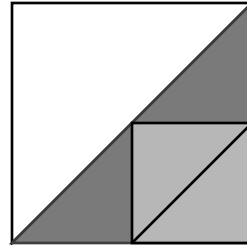

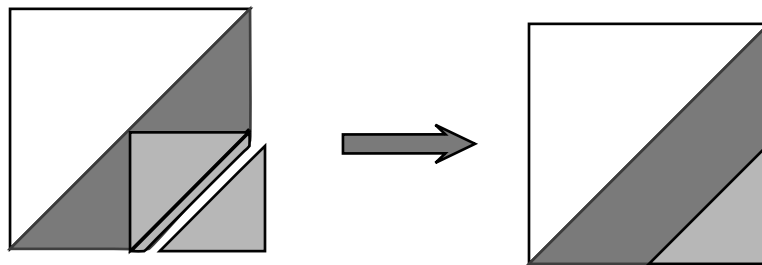

Directions

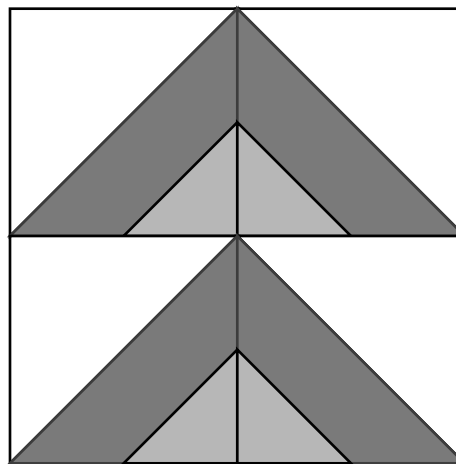
- 2) Following the diagram place the medium 3.5" square on the dark Triangle, right sides together
Sew ON the line.
Make 4



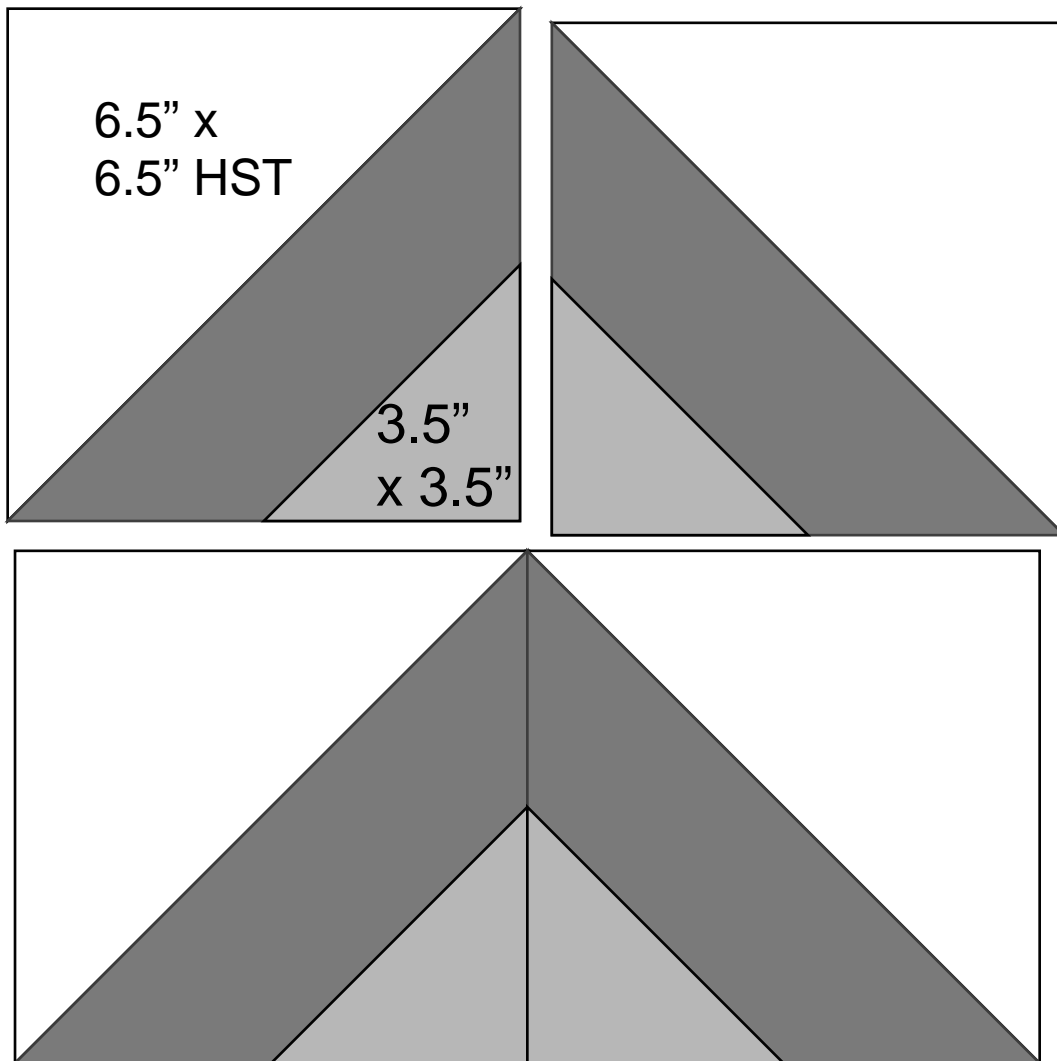
- 3) Following the diagram trim away the outer side leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.
Trim 4 all 4 blocks
Press triangles open
Measures 6.5" x 6.5"



- 4) Get creative!

And make your Recipe box fun!

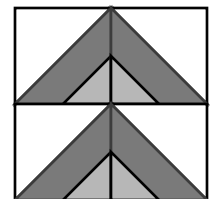


Cutting Sizes



Square the Block to 12.5" x 12.5"

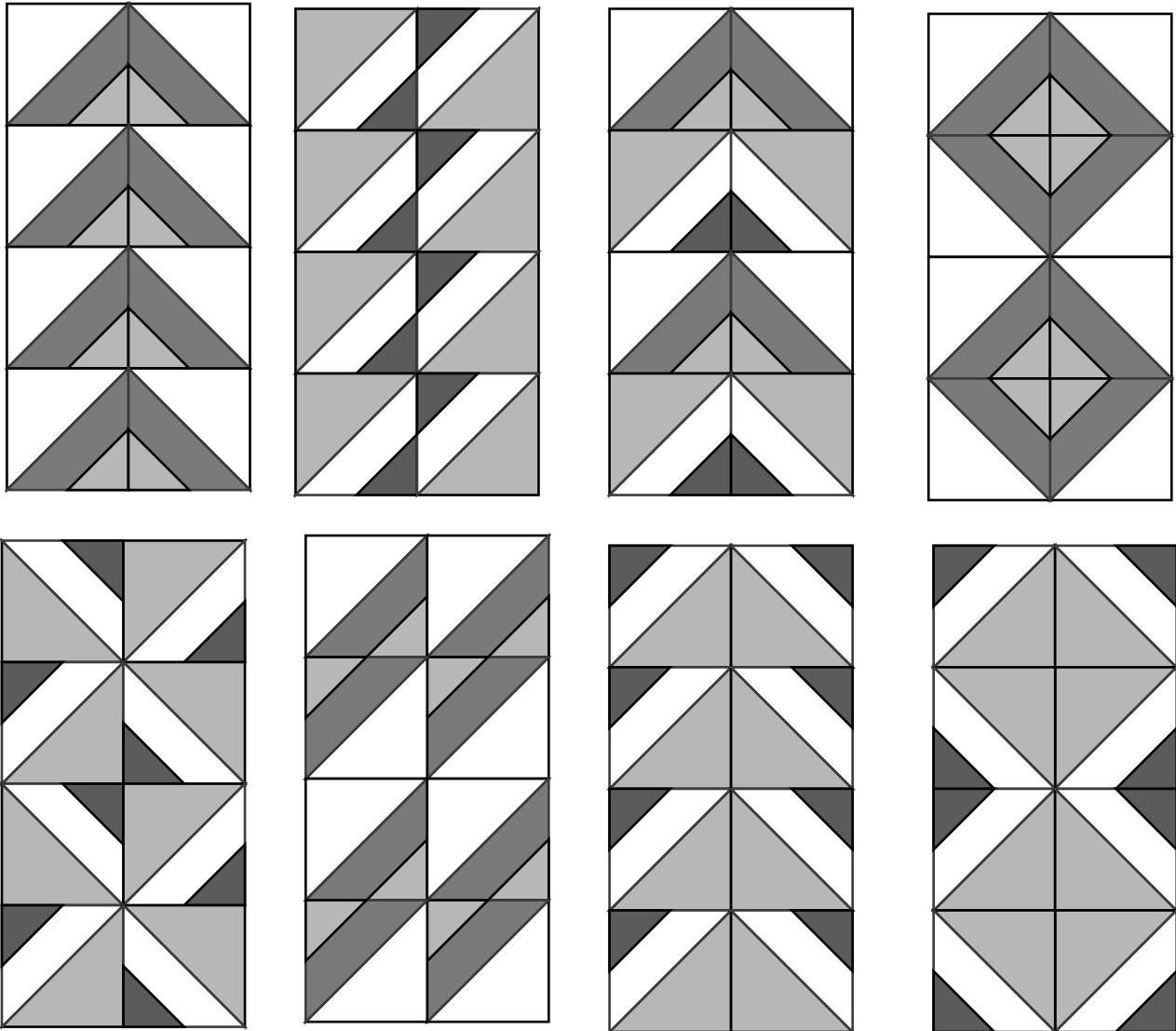
IN the Quilt it is finished size 12" x 12"

I put 2 together for each so you can see how they look**

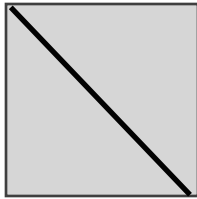
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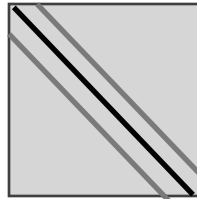

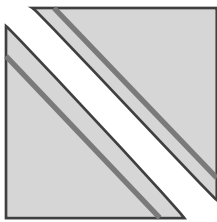
Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the light squares



Step 2

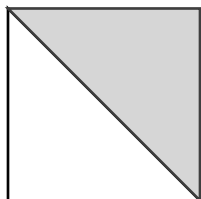
- Layer the dark and light square
- Sew a 1/4" seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

Step 4



-Trim squares to 6.5" x 6.5" using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
