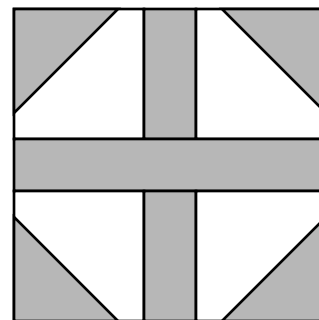

Cutting Directions

Background or Light fabric

– Cut 4 squares 3" x 3"

Medium fabric

- Cut 4 squares 2.5" x 2.5"
- Cut 2 strips 1.5" x 3"
- Cut 1 strip 1.5" x 6.5"

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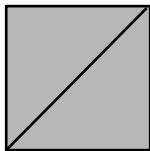

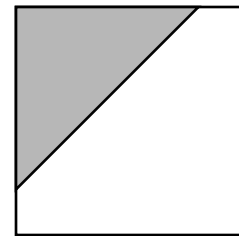
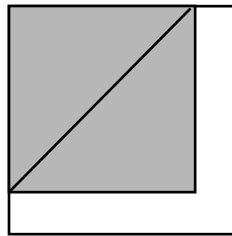
Directions

1) Using the 2.5" medium squares do a sew and flip corner on the 3" light squares



Step A Directions

Draw a diagonal line on each 2.5" square
Make 4

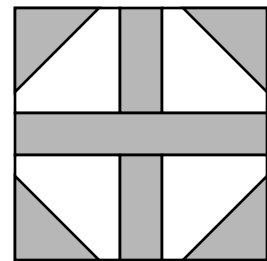
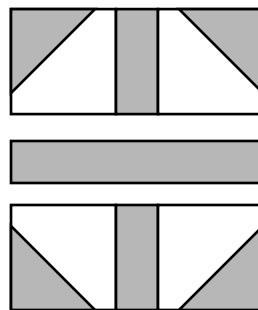
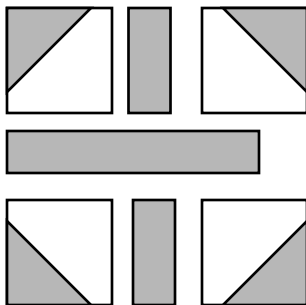


Step B Directions

- 1) Following the diagram, Place a medium square on the light 3" square
- 2) Sew on the line.
- 3) Flip over and press, check the back to be sure it matches up to the rectangle
- 4) Trim away the excess corner fabric behind the triangle. Leave a 1/4" seam.
- 5) Make 4 Measures 3" x 3"

2) Following the diagram, use all 4 squares from step #1 and the 1.5" strips to sew the block

Measures 6.5" x 6.5"
Make 1 unit

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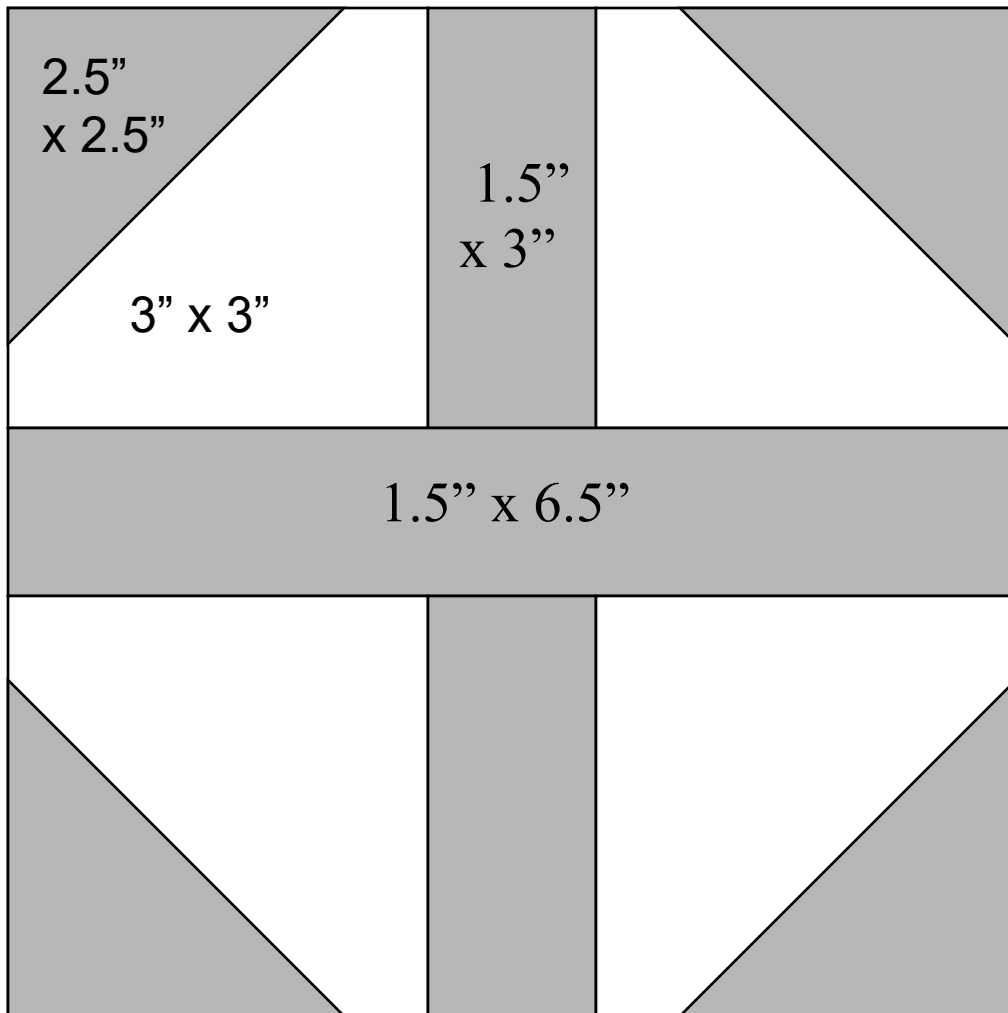

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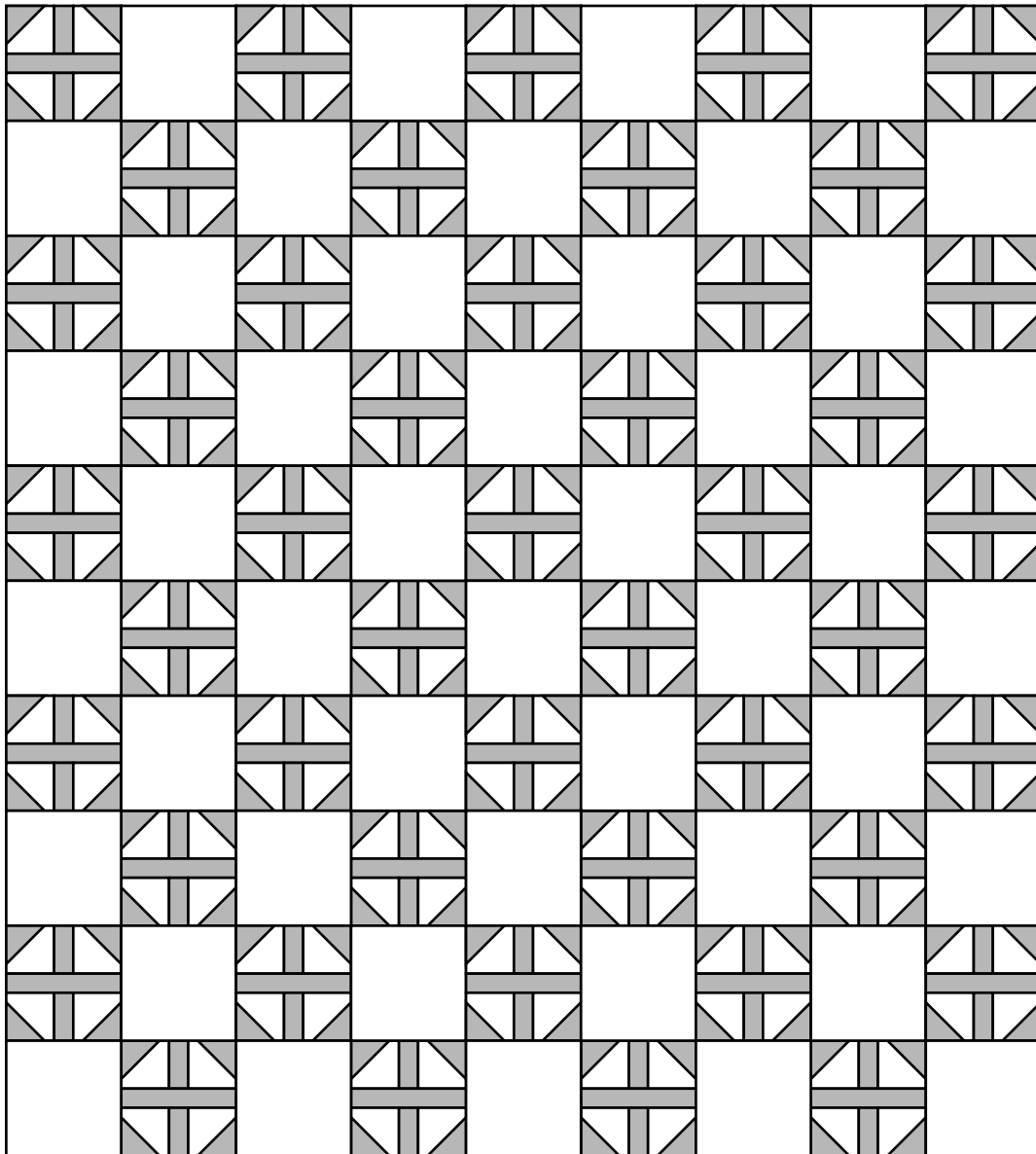

Cut 45 squares 6.5" x 6.5"

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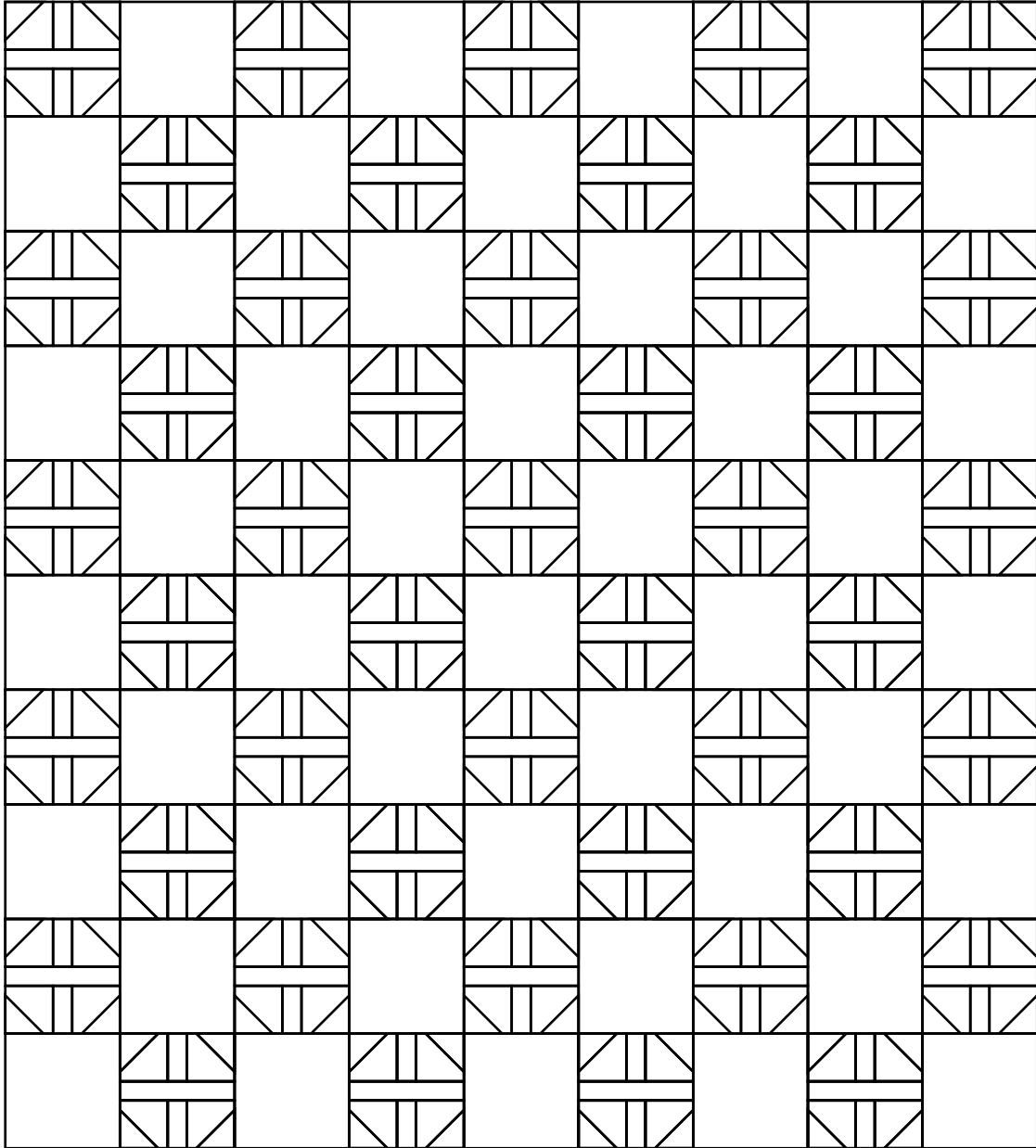

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Half Square Triangles Tutorial

Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2

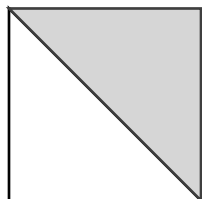
- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

Step 4



-Trim squares to size using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
