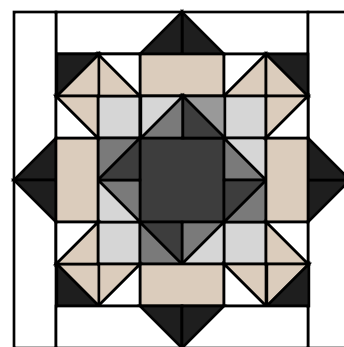

Cutting Directions

Background or Light fabric

- 4 rectangles 2 ½" x 6 ½"
- 4 rectangles 2 ½" x 8 ½"
- 4 squares 3" x 3" for Half Square triangles (HST)

Center Pinwheel fabric

- 2 squares 3" x 3" for Half Square triangles (HST)
- 1 square 4½" x 4½"

Medium light fabric

- 2 squares 3" x 3" for Half Square triangles (HST)
- 4 squares 2 ½" x 2 ½"

Medium fabric

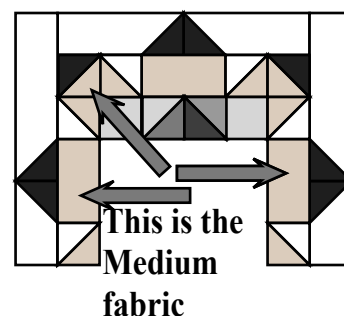
- 4 rectangles 2 ½" x 4 ½"
- 6 squares 3" x 3" for Half Square triangles (HST)

Medium dark fabric used around the Pinwheel

- 4 squares 3" x 3" for Half Square triangles (HST)

Dark Fabric

- 2 squares 3" x 3" for Half Square triangles (HST)
- 8 square 2½" x 2½"

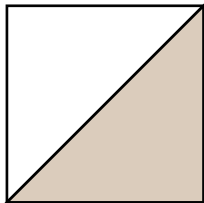

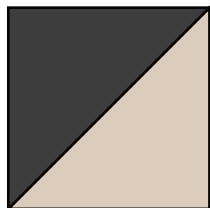
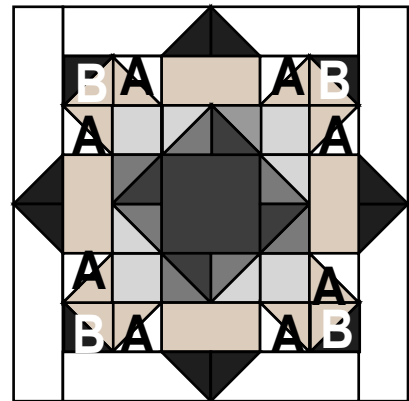

Sewing HST units



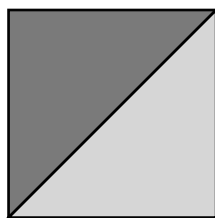
A- Background & Medium Fabric

Using 4 of the 3" Squares
Make 8 HST
Trimmed to 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"



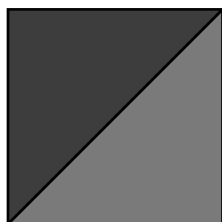
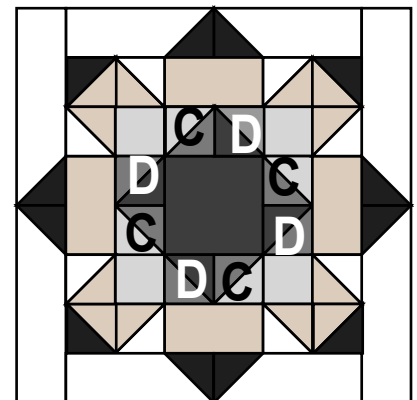
B- Dark & Medium Fabric

Using 2 of the 3" Squares
Make 4 HST
Trimmed to 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"



C- Medium Light & Medium Dark Fabric

Using 2 of the 3" Squares
Make 4 HST
Trimmed to 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"



D- Pinwheel & Medium Dark Fabric

Using 2 of the 3" Squares
Make 4 HST
Trimmed to 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"

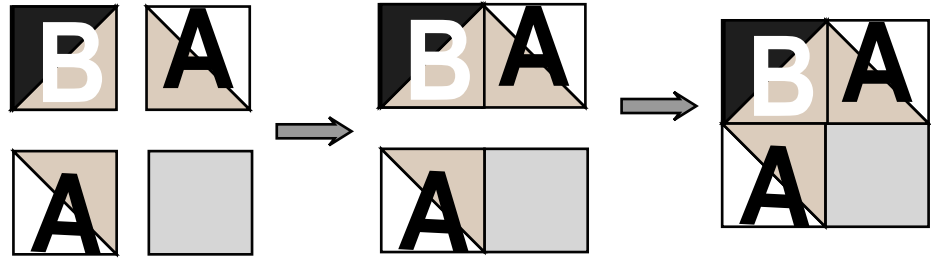

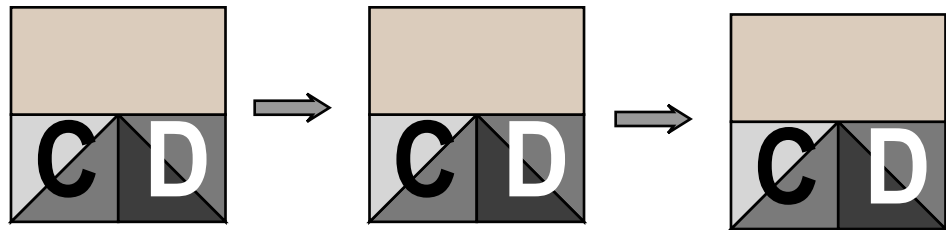
Directions - Sew Unit 1

1) Follow the diagram and sew Unit #1 using 2 HST #A, 1 HST #B, and a 2.5" Medium Light square
Measures 4.5" x 4.5"
Make 4



Directions - Sew Unit 2

1) Follow the diagram and sew Unit #2 using 1 HST #C 1 HST #D, and a 2.5" x 4.5" Medium rectangle
Measures 4.5" x 4.5"
Make 4

Border Unit directions

Step 1

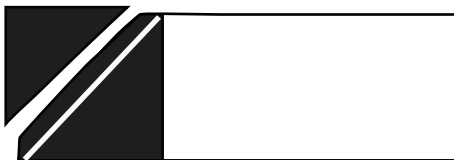


- Using a Background 2.5" x 6.5" Rectangle and a Dark Fabric 2.5" square
- Draw a diagonal line on the Square
 - Place on the end
 - Sew ON the line



- Trim off the extra
- Fold open the triangle
- Press
- Measures 2.5" x 6.5"
- Make 2.

Step 2



- Repeat step #1 putting the 2.5" square on the Opposite end
- Measures 2.5" x 6.5"
- Make 2

Step 3



- Repeat step #1 using Background 2.5" x 8.5" rectangle and a dark 2.5" square
- Measures 2.5" x 8.5"
- Make 2



- Repeat step #1 putting the 2.5" square on the Opposite end
- Measures 2.5" x 8.5"
- Make 2

Step 4



Following the diagram Sew the border units matching the short strips together and the longer strips together

Make 2 borders 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" using step #1 & step #2 units

Make 2 borders 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" using step #3 units

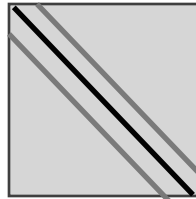
Half Square Triangles Tutorial

"Pat Sloan's Teach Me to Sew Triangles"**



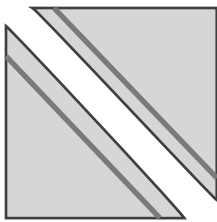
Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2

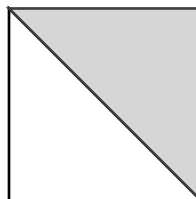
- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a 1/4" seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

Step 4



-Trim squares to size using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
