

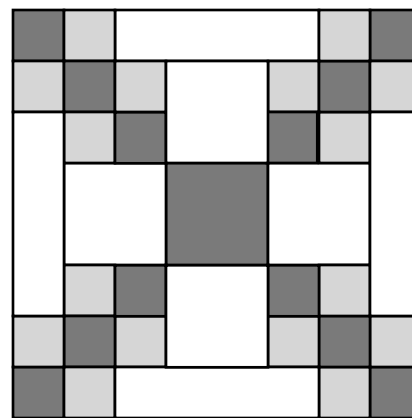

SQUARE Block to 12.5" x 12.5"

Finished in the quilt is Size 12"

The items served didn't vary much. Turkey and ham with mash potatoes, creamed corn (which to this day I still don't eat), sweet pickles, and yummy gravy. Then we had the wonderful white bakery boxes filled with cakes and cookies for dessert. My granny worked for a meat packer and is my grandmother that was at the farmer's market working the booth each week, those white boxes are my very favorite thing to see!

Our 'dinner' was really at lunch time, no matter what the occasion. She also had a tradition that about 5pm she would bring out rolls, lunch meat, cheeses and chips for a buffet of dinner.

Cutting & Sewing

Light Fabric

- Cut 4 squares 3.5" x 3.5"
- Cut 4 strips 2" x 6.5"

Medium Fabric

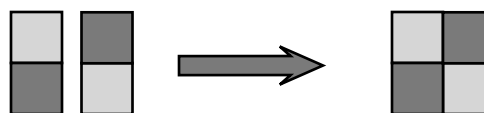
- Cut 16 squares 2" x 2"

Dark Fabrics

- Cut 1 square 3.5" x 3.5"
- Cut 12 squares 2" x 2"

Directions

- 1) Sew 2 medium and 2 dark squares
Make 4 units - measure 3.5" square



- 2) Sew 2 medium squares on the ends of
The light strips
Make 4 units - measure 2" x 9.5"



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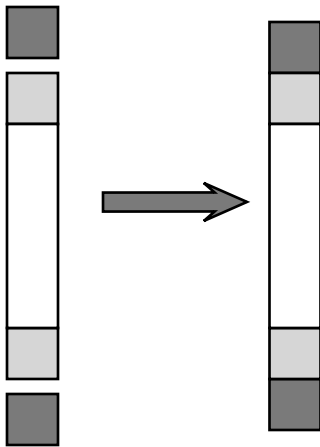
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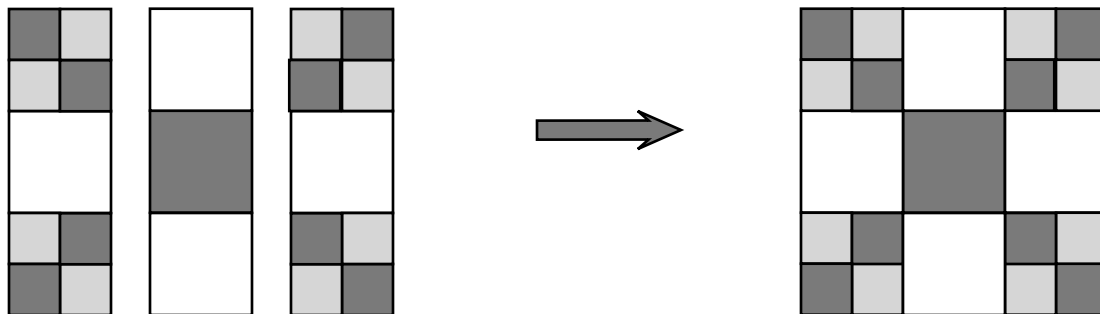

Directions

- 3) Following the diagram Sew the dark squares to the end of a strip from step #2
Make 2 Measures 2" x 12.5"

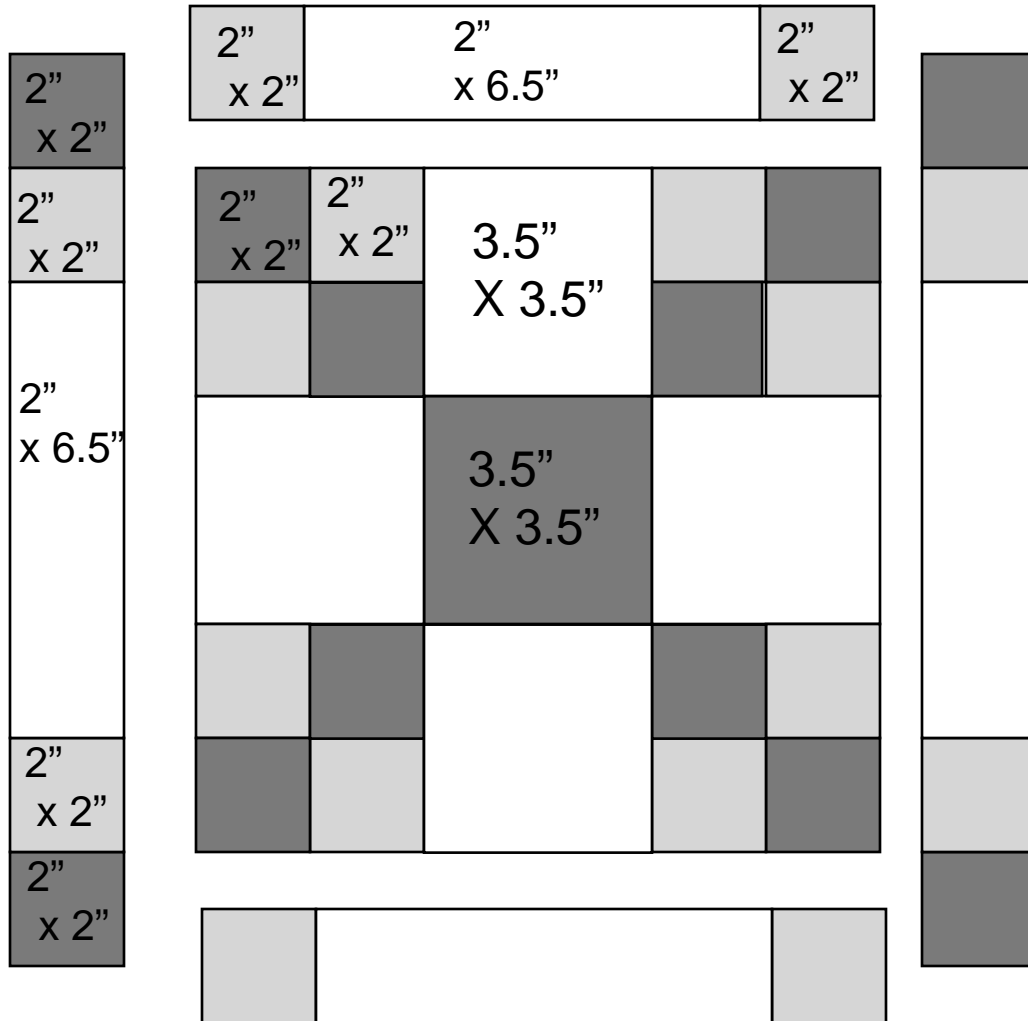


- 4) Following the diagram alternate 4-patch units, light 3.5" squares and dark 3.5" square.
Make 1 Measures 9.5" x 9.5"

Unfinished Sizes



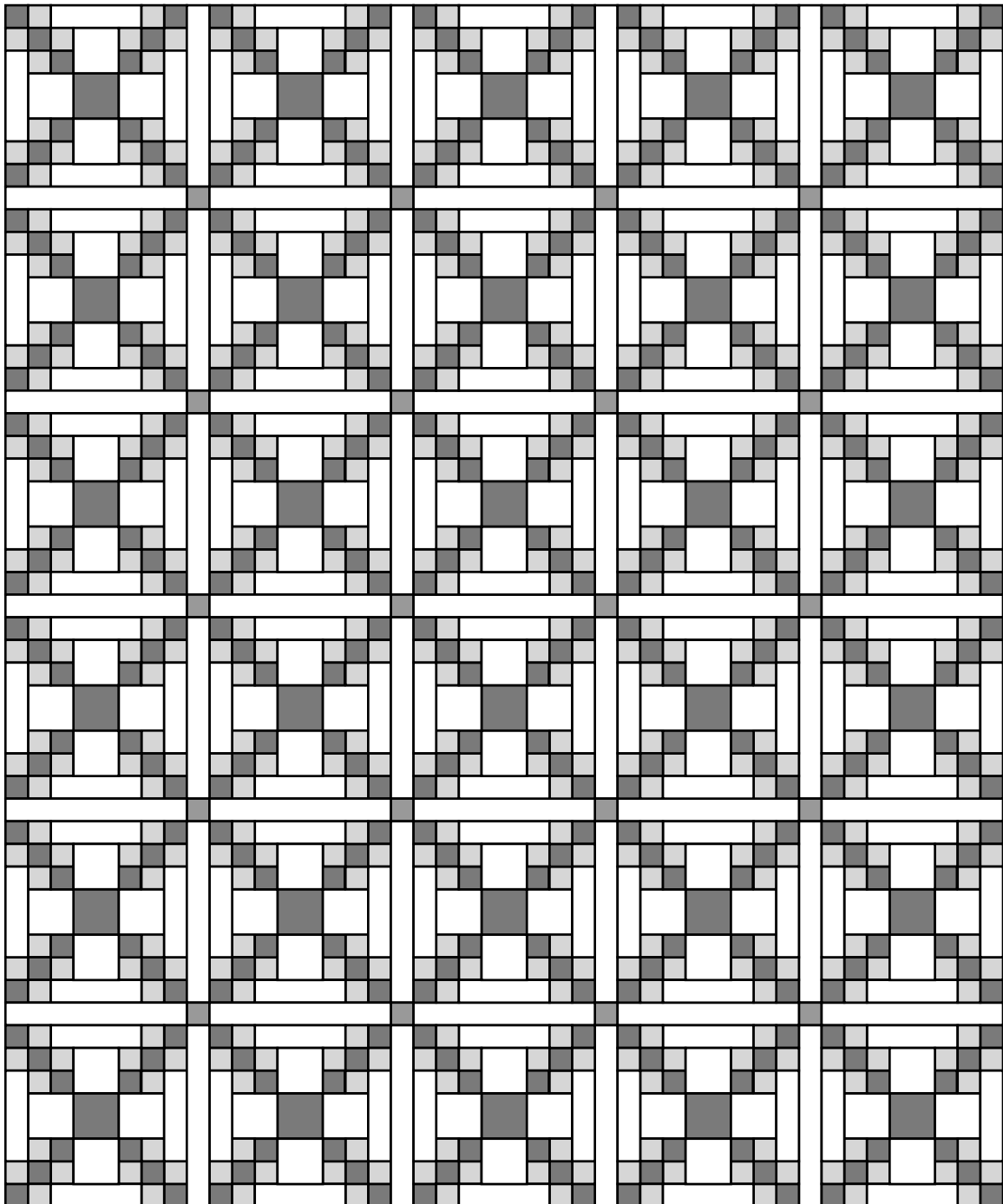
Square the Block to 12.5" x 12.5"

IN the Quilt it is finished size 12" x 12"

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66 1/2" x 80" quilt using 30 blocks

Sashings Cut 49 strips 2" x 12.5"

Cut 20 Squares 2" x 2"

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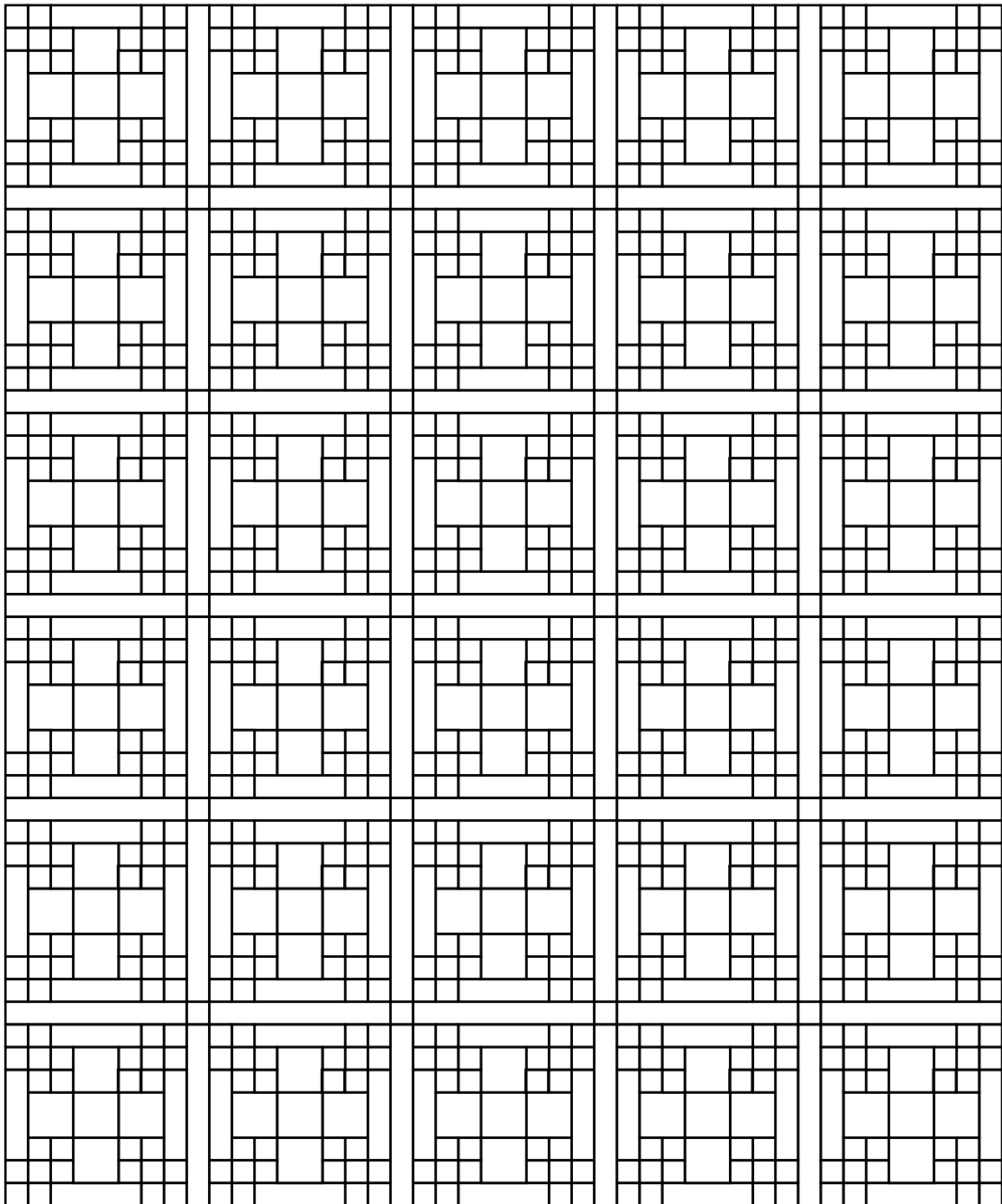
