Block 13/17 – Christmas Eve

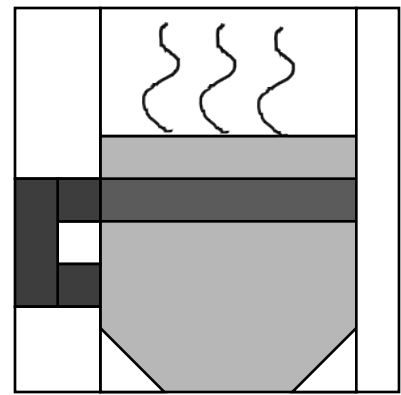

Cutting & Sewing

Background Fabric #1

- Cut 1 strip 1.5" x 9.5"
- Cut 1 rectangle 3.5" x 6.5"
- Cut 1 rectangle 2.5" x 4.5"
- Cut 1 squares 2.5" x 2.5"
- Cut 2 squares 2" x 2"
- Cut 1 square 1.5" x 1.5"

Light Fabric

- Cut 1 rectangle 1.5" x 6.5"
- Cut 1 rectangle 4.5" x 6.5"

Medium Fabric

- Cut 1 rectangle 1.5" x 6.5"

Dark Fabric

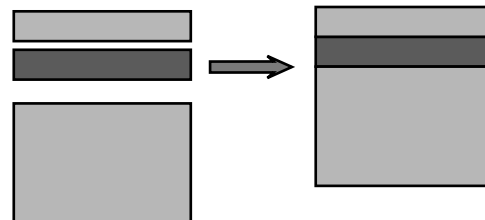
- Cut 1 rectangle 1.5" x 3.5"
- Cut 2 squares 1.5" x 1.5"

Directions

- 1) Following the diagram, sew the 1.5" light fabric rectangle to the 1.5" medium fabric rectangle. Sew that unit to the 4.5" x 6.5" light rectangle.

Make 1

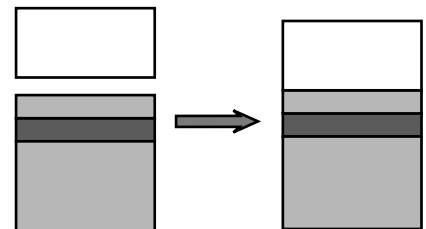
Measures 6.5" x 6.5"



- 2) Following the diagram, sew the 3.5" background rectangle to the unit made above

Make 1

Measures 6.5" x 9.5"



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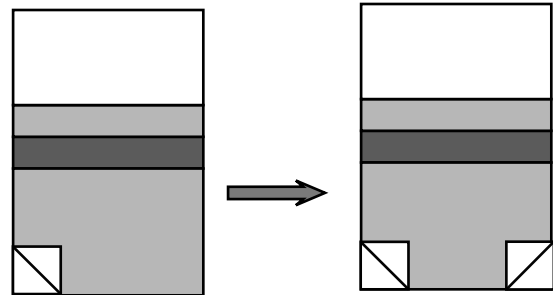

Directions

3) Following the diagram place a background 2" square on the bottom corners of the center unit. Sew ON the line.

Make 1

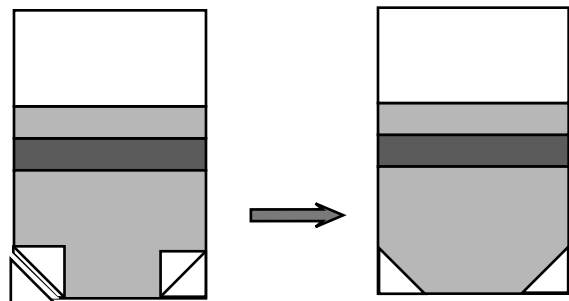
Measures 6.5" x 9.5"



4) Following the diagram trim away leaving a 1/4" seam allowance on both corners. Press triangles open.

Measures 6.5" x 9.5"

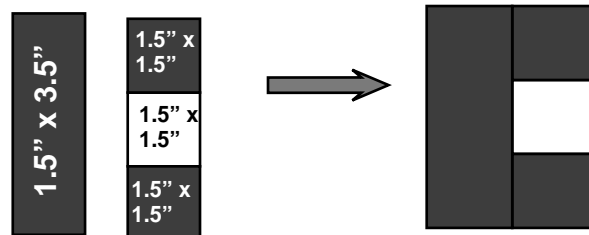


5) Following the diagram, sew a dark 1.5" square, a background 1.5" square, and a dark 1.5" squares together

-Sew the 1.5" x 3.5" unit to the left

Make 1

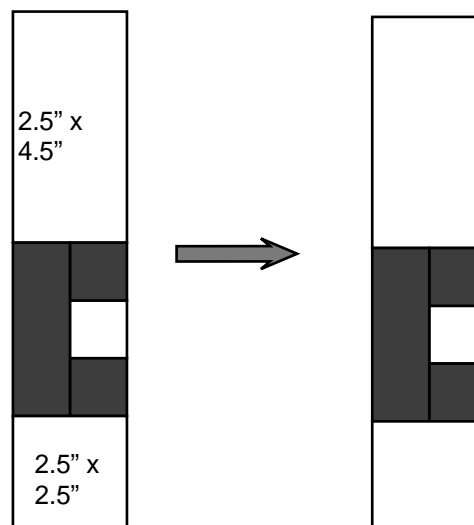
Measures 2.5" x 3.5"



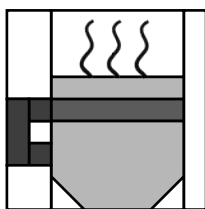
6) Following the diagram, sew the left section together

Make 1

Measures 2.5" x 9.5"

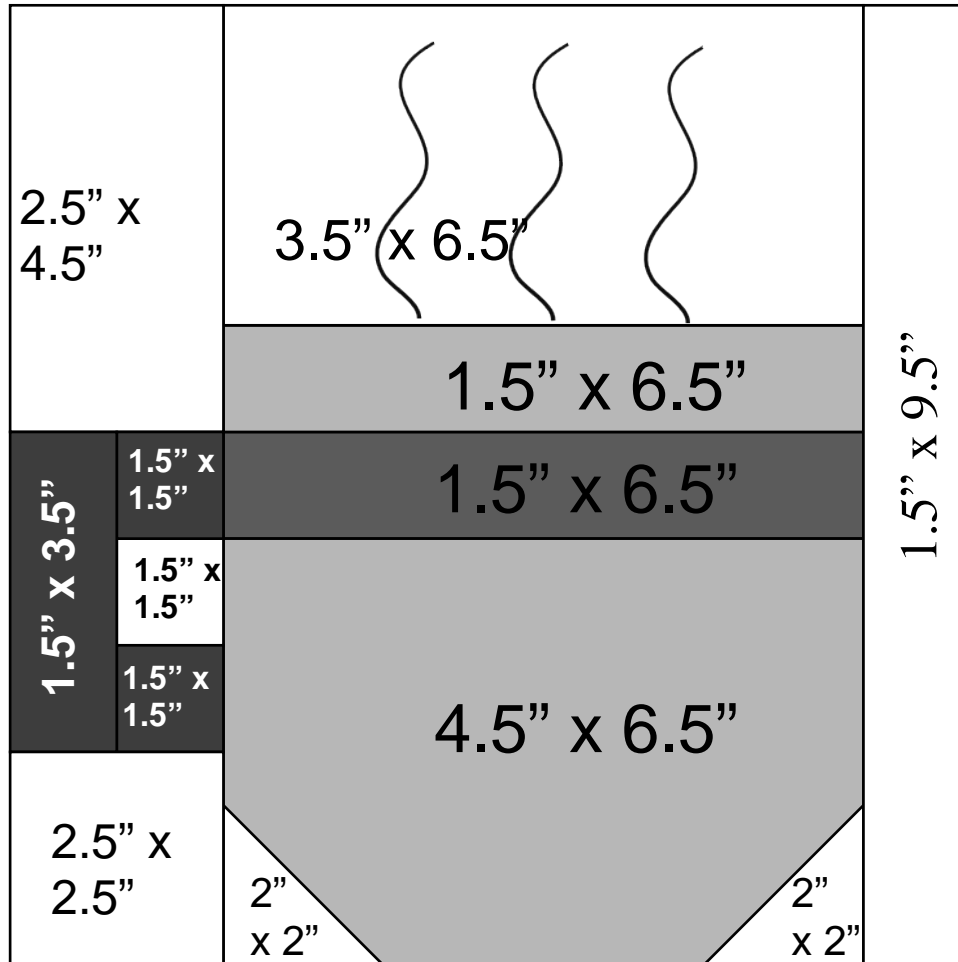

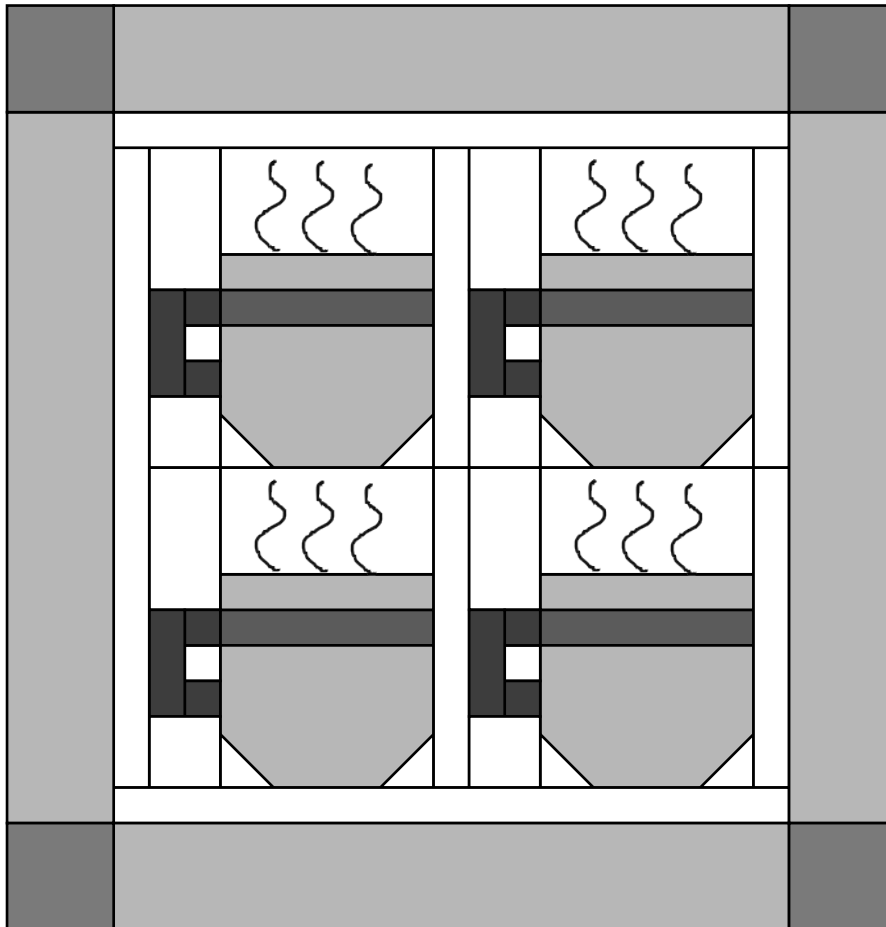


Block is 9.5" x 9.5"

4 Blocks

4 squares 3.5 x 3.5

1 left side inner border
strip 1.5" x 18.5"

Top & Bottom inner border (2)
strips 1.5" x 19.5"

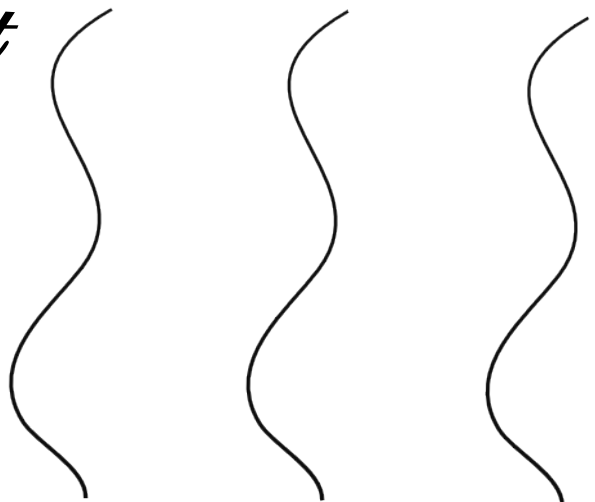
2 side border strips 3.5" x 20.5"

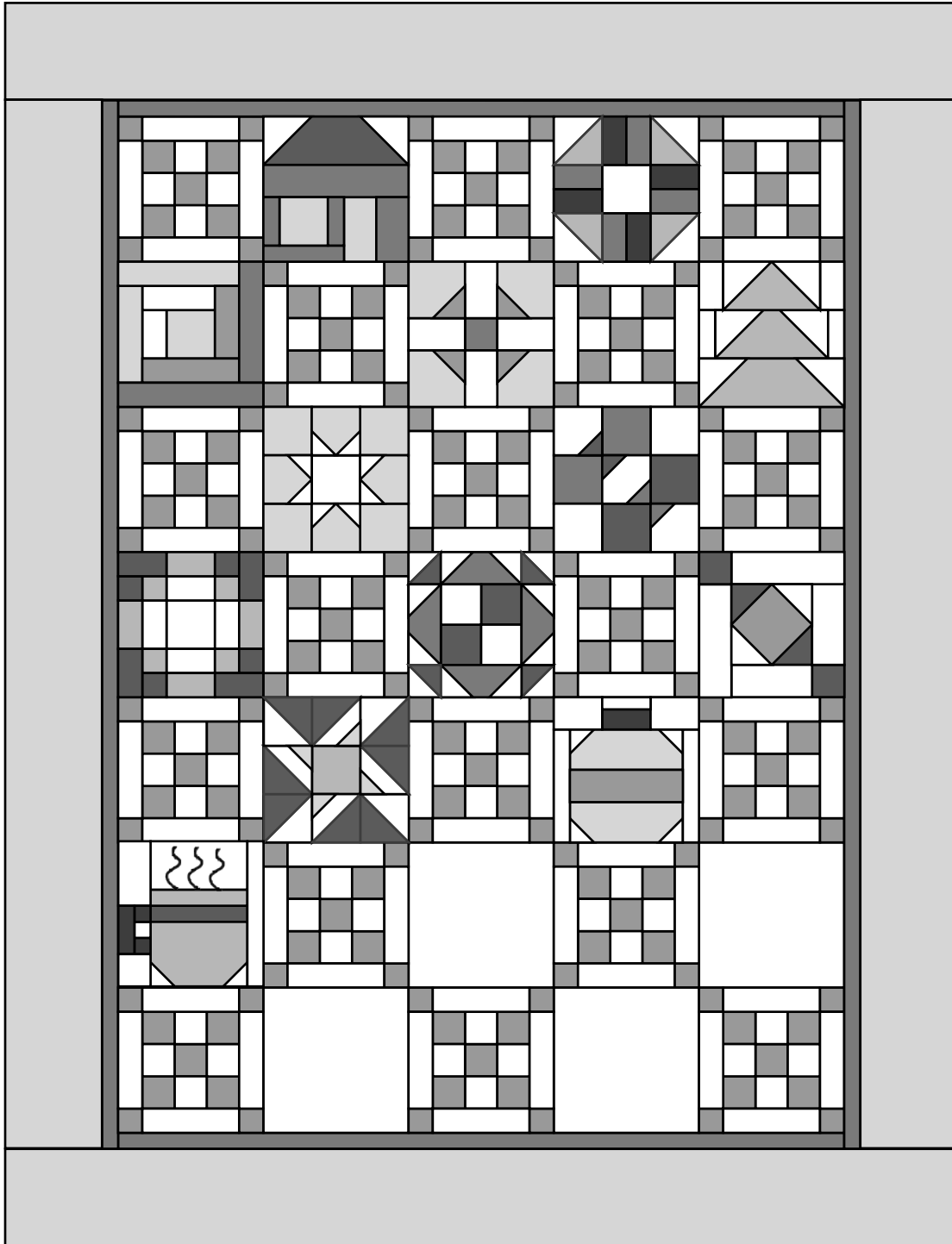
Top & Bottom border strips (2)
3.5" x 19.5"

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Embroidery

Trace then stem stitch
With Aurifil 12 wt thread
