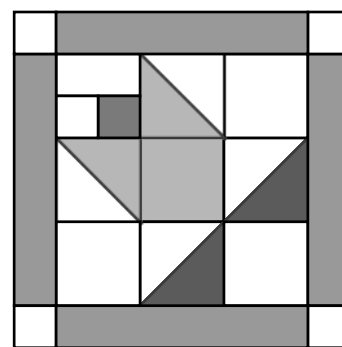


A Flower Bouquet

Blocks are 12.5" x 12.5"
Finished size 12" x 12"

There are early spring, spring, late spring blooms. Then we repeat for each season and sometimes for an individual plant. What is your most anticipated bloom?

Ruler Cutting

Light Fabric Frame

- Cut 4 squares 2" x 2"

Light Fabric background

- Cut 2 squares 4" x 4" for HST
- Cut 3 squares 3.5" x 3.5"
- Cut 1 square 2" x 2"
- Cut 1 rectangle 2" x 3.5"

Medium Fabric flower

- Cut 1 square 4" x 4" for HST
- Cut 1 square 3.5" x 3.5"

Medium Dark Fabric Bud

- Cut 1 square 2" x 2"

Medium Fabric Frame

- Cut 4 rectangles 2" x 9.5"

Dark Fabrics

- Cut 1 square 4" x 4" for HST

Gemini Die Cutting Dies

Light Fabric Frame

- Cut 4 squares 2" x 2"

Light Fabric background

- Cut 4 triangles 3.5" x 3.5" for HST
- Cut 3 squares 3.5" x 3.5"
- Cut 1 square 2" x 2"

Medium Fabric flower

- Cut 2 triangles 3.5" x 3.5" for HST
- Cut 1 square 3.5" x 3.5"

Medium Dark Fabric Bud

- Cut 1 square 2" x 2"

Dark Fabrics

- Cut 2 triangles 3.5" x 3.5" for HST

Ruler Cutting

Light Fabric background

- Cut 1 rectangle 2" x 3.5"

Medium Fabric Frame

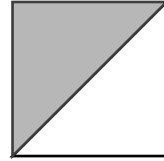
- Cut 4 rectangles 2" x 9.5"

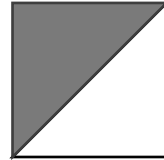

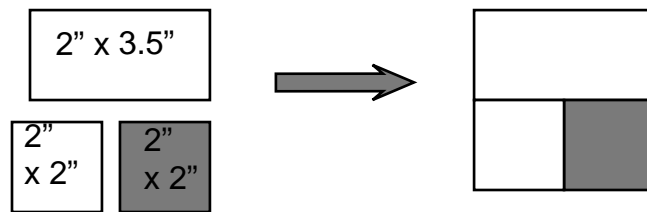
1) Sew medium flower and light 4" squares using HST method.
Make 2 units - trim to 3.5" square



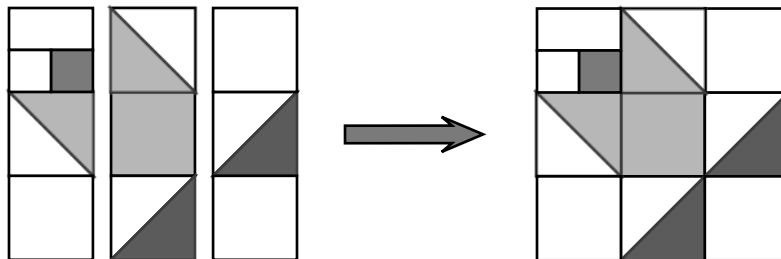
2) Sew dark and light 4" squares Using HST method.
Make 2 units - trim to 3.5" square



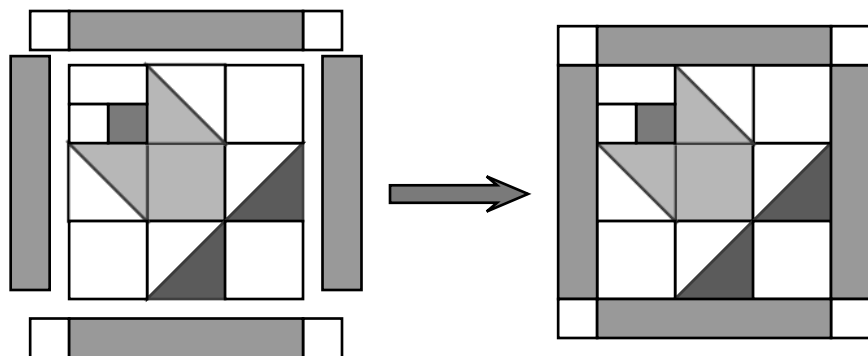
3) Following the diagram sew the light fabric strip, light 2" square and medium 2" square
Measures 3.5" x 3.5"
Make 1



3) Following the diagram sew the flower bud
Watch placement of the
HST so they are going the
Correct direction
Measures 9.5" x 9.5"
Make 1

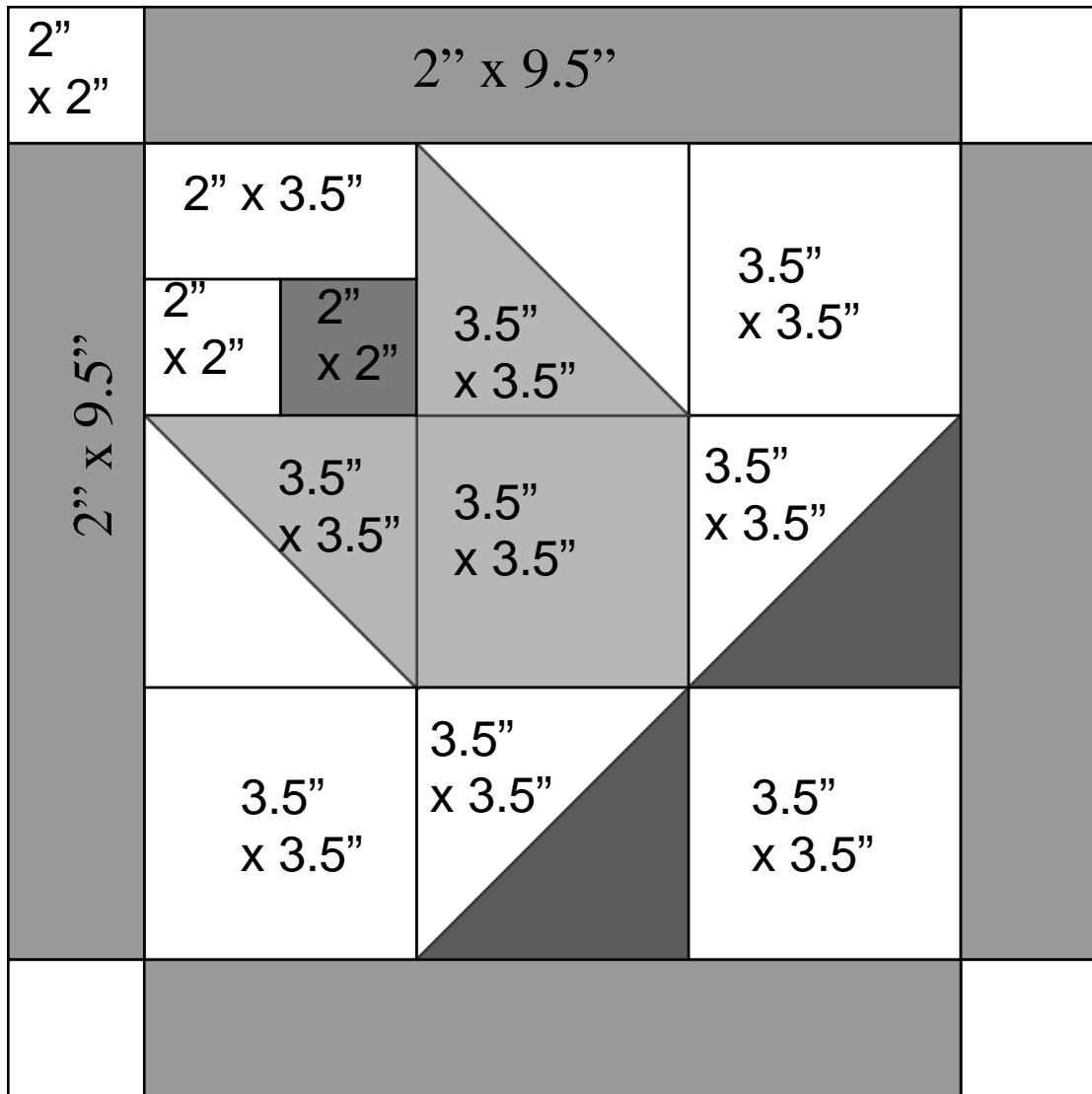


4) Following the diagram add the frame to the flower bud.
Make 1
Measures 12.5" x 12.5"

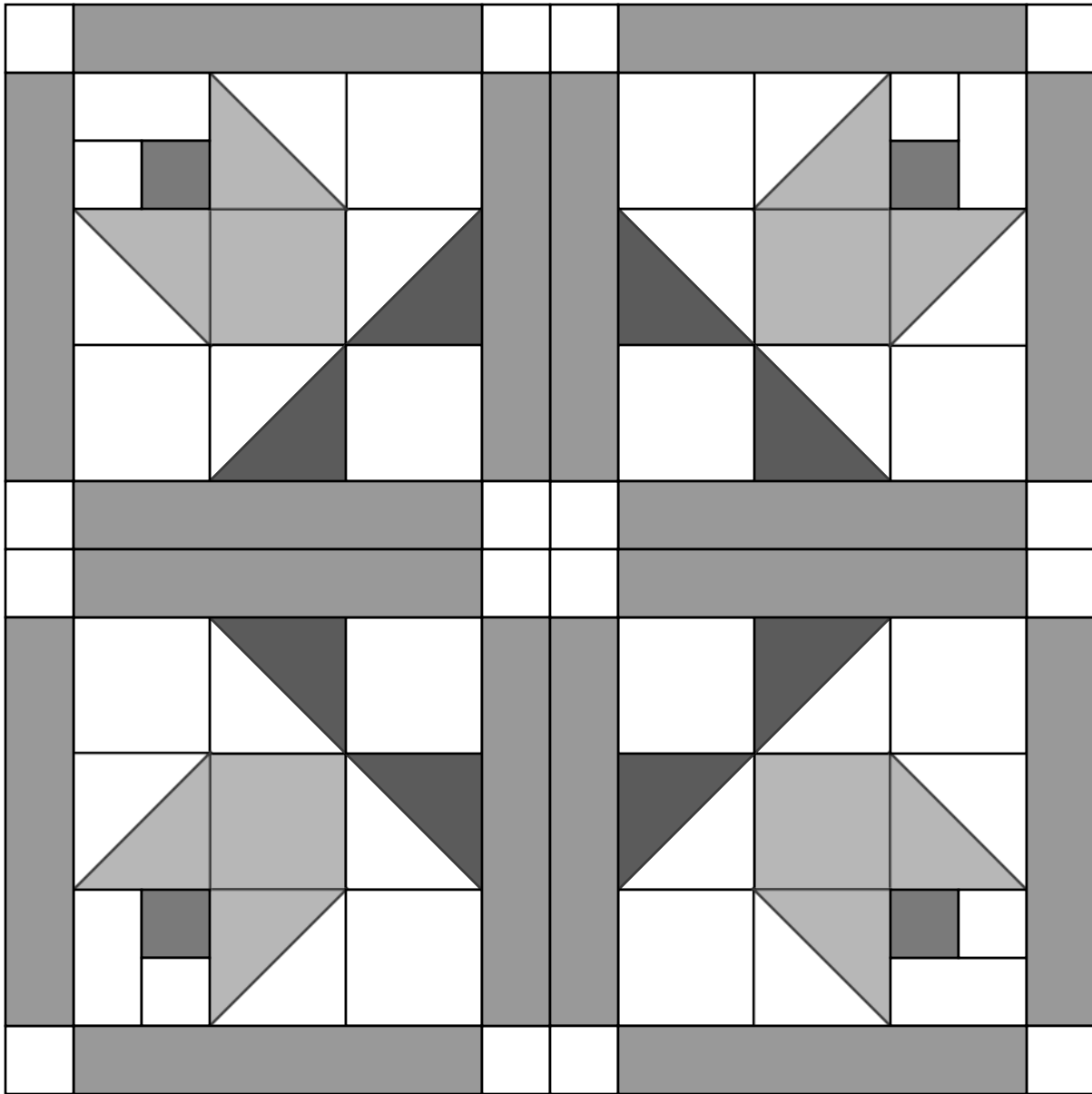
Block is 12.5" x 12.5"

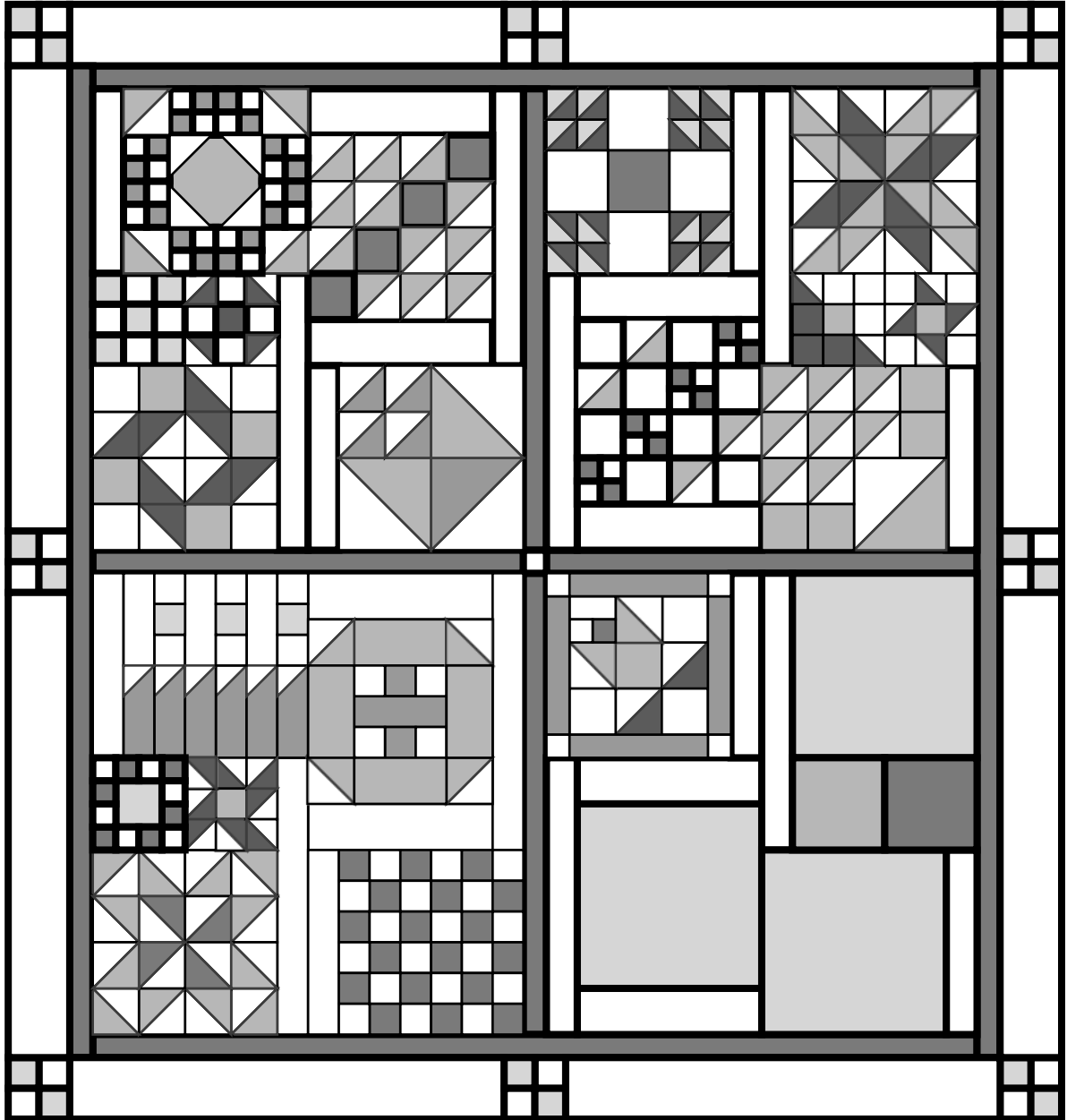
