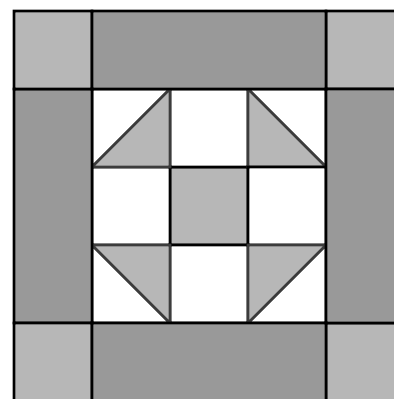


Block 17/25 Pantry Goods

Doing this block in the fall makes me think of 'putting up for the winter'. Many of you are taking your garden vegetables and canning them for winter. And many grandmas are well known for their canning expertise. They created yummy goodness that you ate all winter and While dreaming of summer days, mmmm... strawberry jam on breakfast toast, yes please!



SQUARE Block to 10.5" x 10.5"
Finished in the quilt is Size 10"

My grandma's didn't like to cook, and they didn't do canning or anything like that. But I have fabulous memories of a particular spice cookie that only was sold in the fall that my half-a-modern grandma would buy. And my very modern grandma had a hall pantry and basement shelves stocked at all times with goodies!

Cutting & Sewing

Light Fabric

- Cut 2 squares 3" x 3" for HST
- Cut 4 square 2.5" x 2.5"

Medium Fabric

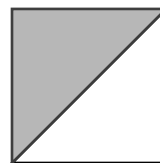
- Cut 2 squares 3" x 3" for HST
- Cut 5 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

Dark Fabric

- Cut 4 rectangles 2.5" x 6.5"

Directions

- 1) Sew the 2 light 3" square and 2 medium 3" squares Using the HST method on last page.
Make 4 units - trim to 2.5" square

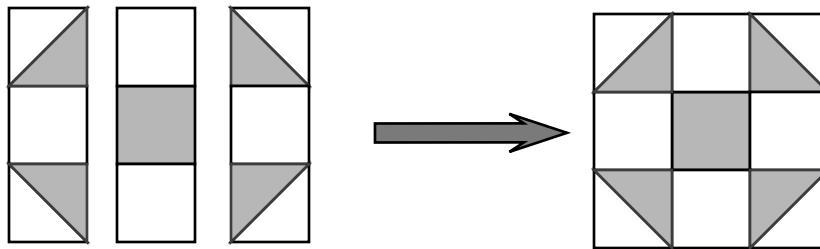

Directions

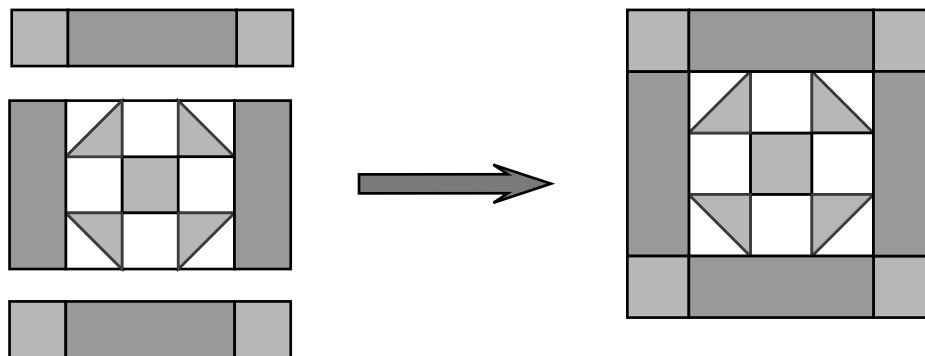
- 2) Following the diagram, sew the shoo-fly block using the light 2.5" squares, Medium 2.5" square, and all 4 of the HST
Make 1 unit - Measures 6.5" x 6.5" square



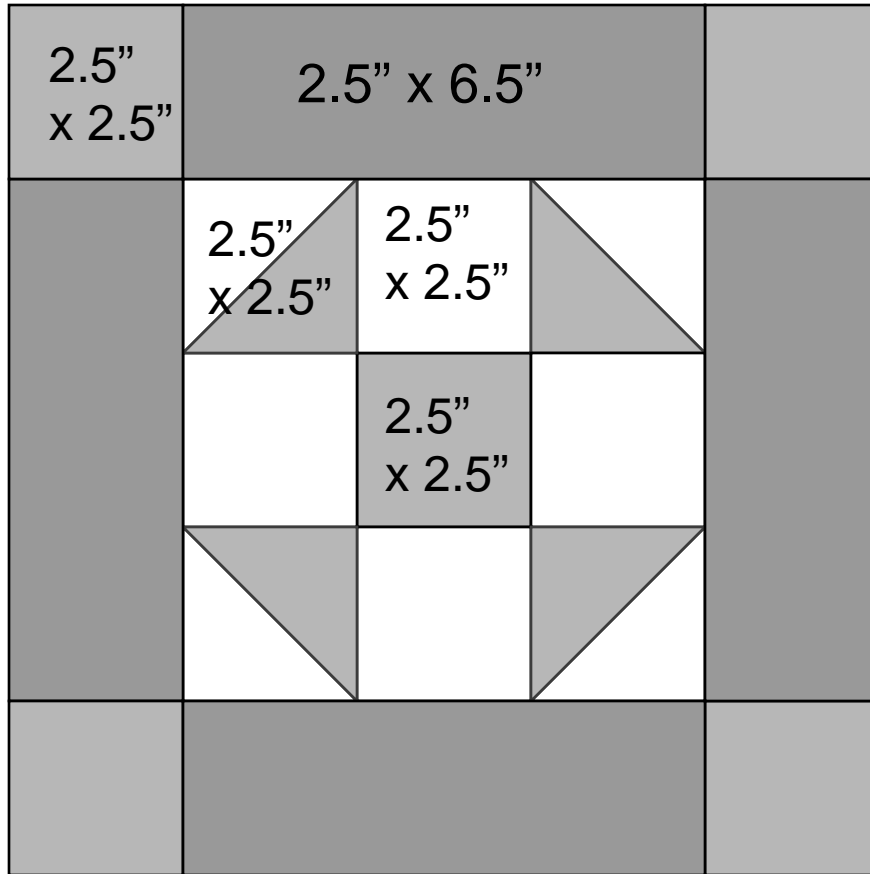
- 3) Following the diagram, sew a medium 2.5" square to both ends of a dark rectangle.
Make 2 - Measures to 2.5" x 10.5"



- 4) Following the diagram, sew the 2.5" x 6.5" medium strips to the side of the Block. Sew the units from step 3 to the top and bottom of the shoo-fly block
Make 1
Measures to 10.5" x 10.5" square



Cutting & unit Sizes



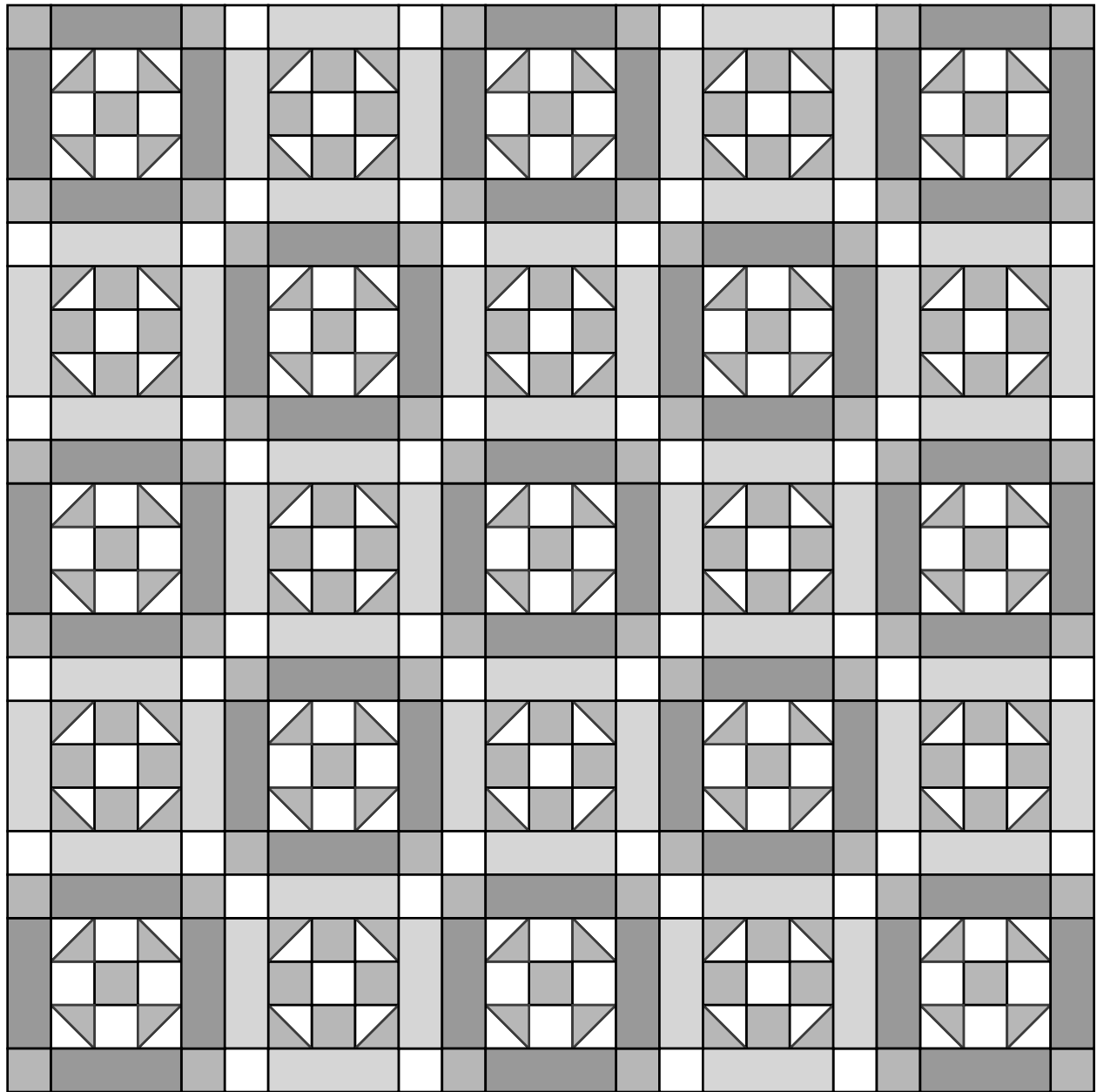
Square the Block to 10.5" x 10.5"

IN the Quilt it is finished size 10" x 10"

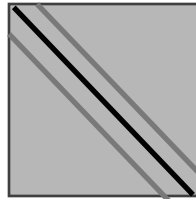
Half Square Triangles Tutorial

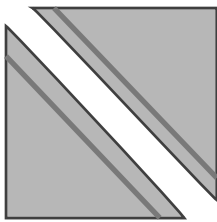
Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2

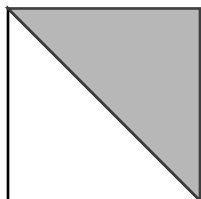
- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

Step 4



-Trim squares to 2.5" x 2.5" using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
