

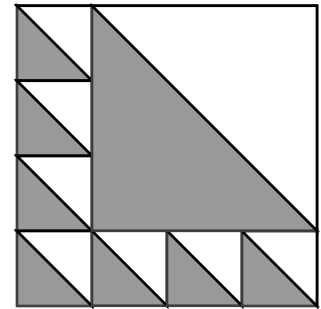
Ode to our National Parks

In my video on Sept 18, 2024 I did a checkerboard to use for the 10" squares in Block #2 because my fat 8th of fabric Was not wide enough.

This one page sheet is just the pattern for a 10.5" block I did not trim to 10", just use 2 blocks 10.5" in place of the 10" in the pattern



Block is 12.5" x 12.5"
Finished size 12" x 12"

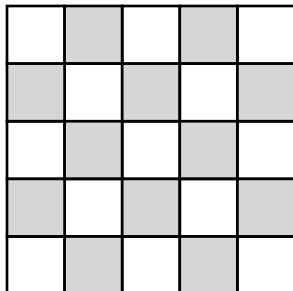
Cutting Directions

Light fabrics

– Cut 13 square 2.5" x 2.5"

Dark Fabric

– Cut 12 square 2.5" x 2.5"



Directions

(1) Alternate a dark and light square

Make 3 rows

Measures 2.5" x 10.5"



(2) Alternate a light and dark square

Make 2 rows

Measures 2.5" x 10.5"



(3) Alternate the Rows

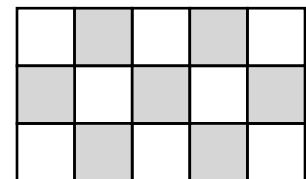
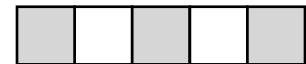
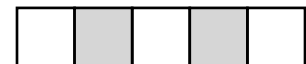
For a 5 x 5 checkerboard
