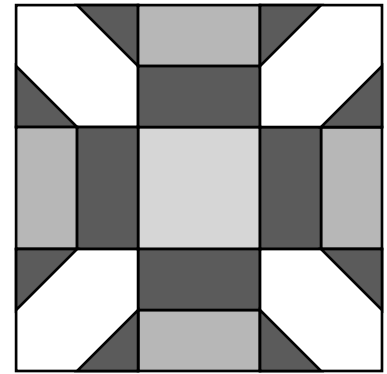
Do you remember the days when the only way to send a note was by mailing it?

Block is 12.5" x 12.5"
Finished size 12" x 12"

Cutting Directions

Light fabrics

- Cut 4 squares 4.5" x 4.5"

Light Medium center fabric

- Cut 1 square 4.5" x 4.5"

Medium fabrics

- Cut 4 rectangles 2.5" x 4.5"

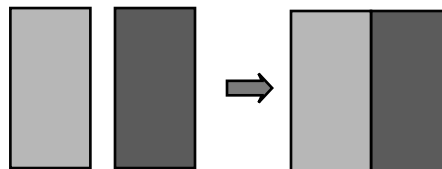
Dark Fabric

- Cut 4 rectangles 2.5" x 4.5"
- Cut 8 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

Directions

- 1) Following the diagram, use the 2.5" x 4.5" medium and 2.5" x 4.5" dark fabric rectangles. Sew them together on the long side.

Measure 4.5" x 4.5"
Make 4 units

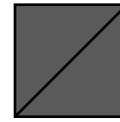

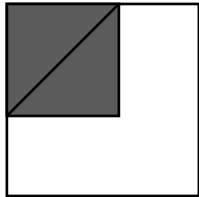
Directions

2) Draw a diagonal line on the back of all the 2.5" squares

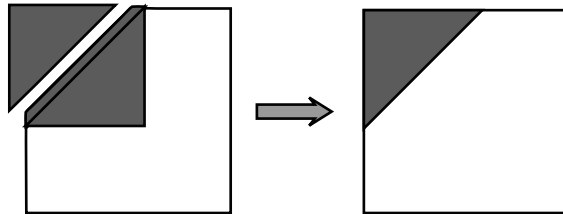


3) Following diagram place the 2.5" square on a 4.5" light fabrics square, right sides together sew ON the line.

Measures 4.5" x 4.5"
Make 4

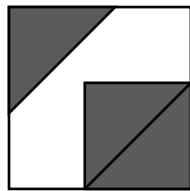


4) Following diagram trim away Leaving a 1/4" seam allowance Trim all 4 Measures 4.5" x 4.5"

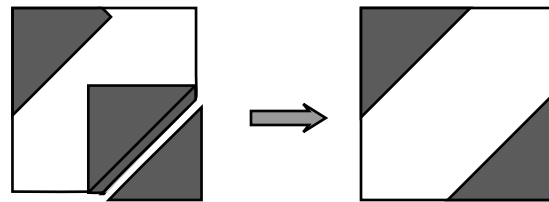


5) Following diagram place another 2.5" square on the opposite corner of The 4.5" square, right sides together sew ON the line.

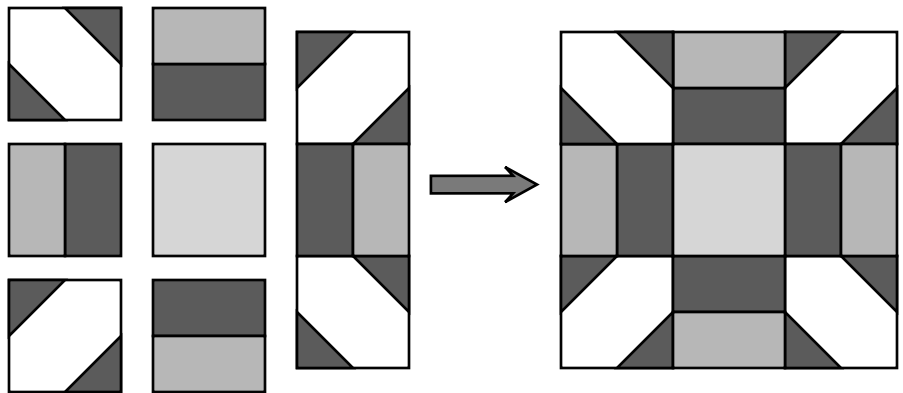
Measures 4.5" x 4.5"
Make 4



6) Following diagram trim away The other side leaving a 1/4" seam allowance Trim 4 Press triangles open to make a square Measures 4.5" x 4.5"
Make 4

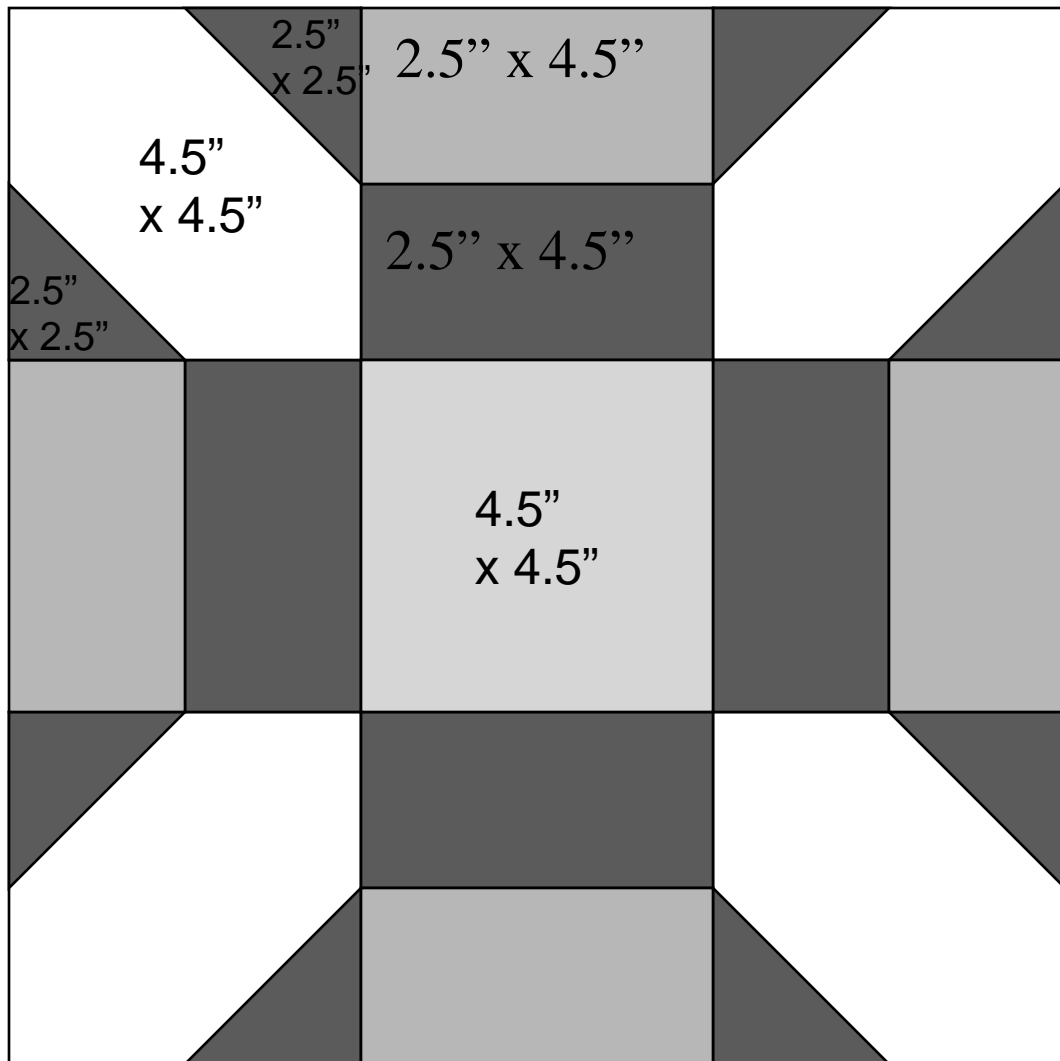


7) Following the diagram, Assemble the block
Make 1
Measures 12.5" x 12.5"

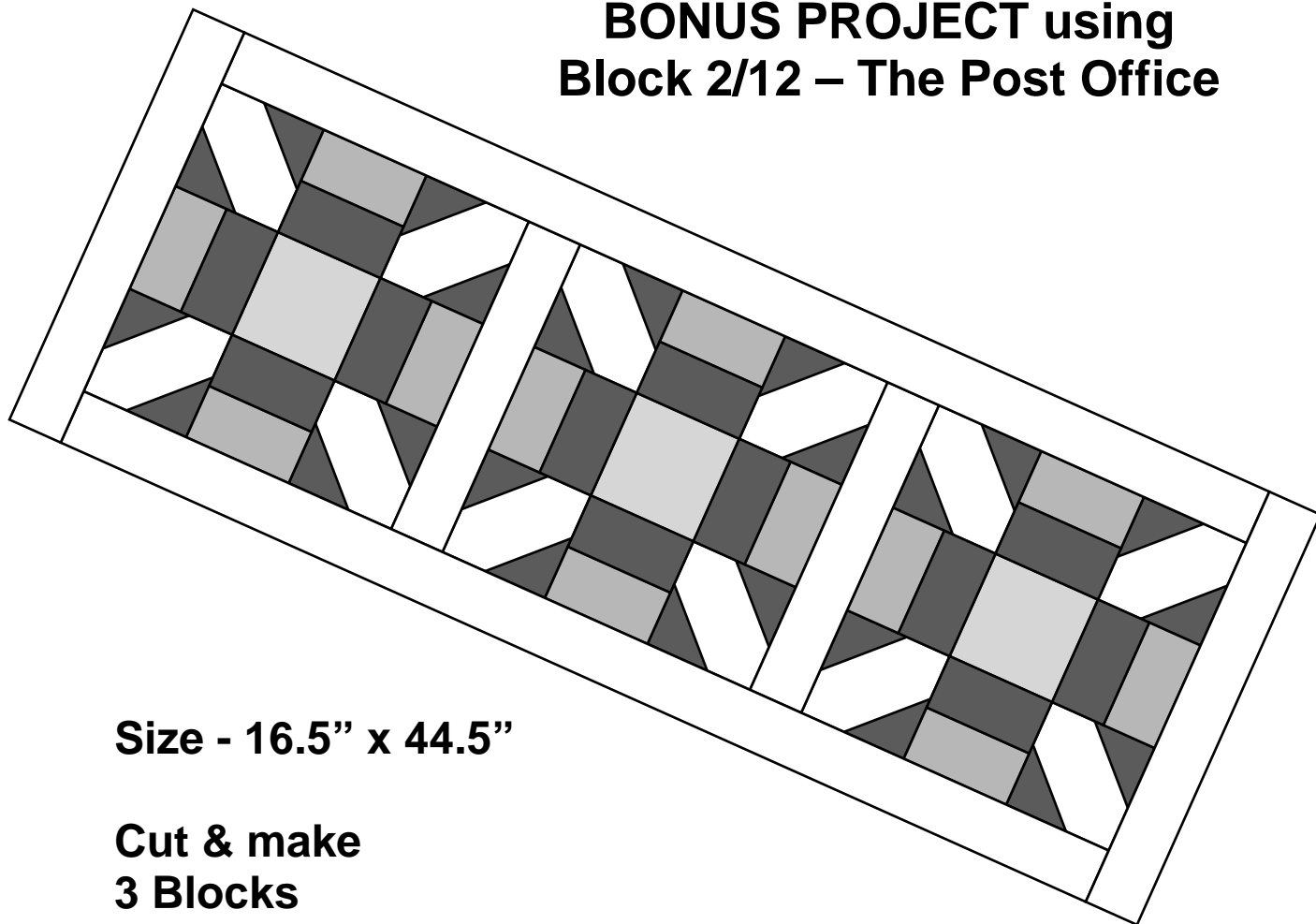


Block is 12.5" x 12.5"

Size - 16.5" x 44.5"

Cut & make

3 Blocks

2 sashing 2.5" x 12.5"

2 long outer borders 2.5" x 40.5"

2 short outer borders 2.5" x 16.5"
