My half a modern grandma, Na-Na, worked for Bell Telephone, Ma Bell, as a telephone operator. When you dialed, way back when, you might have talked to my Na-Na! Her phone was the very standard black with the rotary dial.



SQUARE Block to 12.5" x 12.5"

Finished in the quilt is Size 12"

My more modern grandma, Granny, had the newest style phones. I remember in the last house she had a wall mounted, Slimline phone with push buttons on the handle, very snazzy stuff!

I designed this phone applique for the button club and it's just perfect for my Grandma's Kitchen quilt.

If you prefer no phone, you can leave the center as beautiful fabric. Or use your favorite 6" finished block in the middle. What style phone did your grandma have?

Cutting & Sewing

Light Fabric

- Cut 1 square 6.5" x 6.5"

Medium Fabric

- Cut 2 strips 1.5" x 6.5"
- Cut 2 strips 1.5" x 8.5"
- Cut 2 strips 1.5" x 10.5"
- Cut 2 strips 1.5" x 12.5"

Dark Fabric

- Cut 2 strips 1.5" x 8.5"
- Cut 2 strips 1.5" x 10.5"

Telephone -

Find the shapes on the last page

- Cut 1 handle
- Cut 1 body
- Cut 1 base
- Cut 1 large circle
- Cut 1 medium circle
- Cut 1 small circle
- Cut 1 rotary dial 'tab'



NOTE - Use buttons for dials

I used a fabric with a rotary dial print

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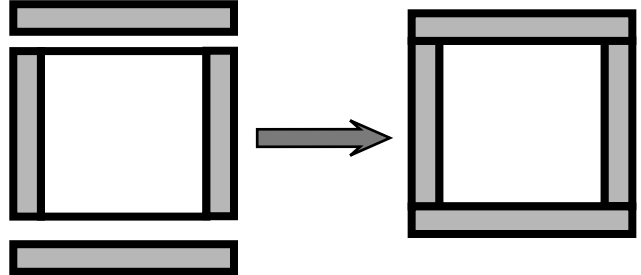
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Directions

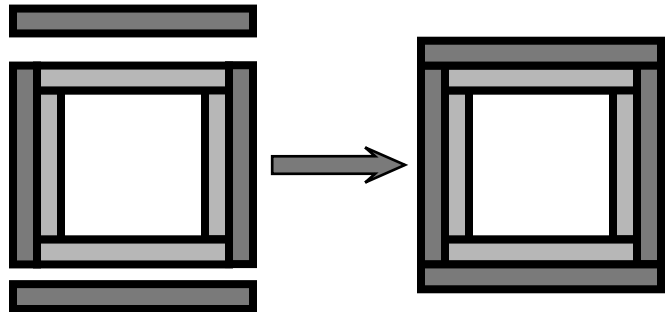
- 1) Sew 2 medium strips 1.5" x 6.5"
to the side of the square
Sew 2 medium strips 1.5" x 8.5"
to the top & bottom

Make 1 unit - Measures 8.5" x 8.5"



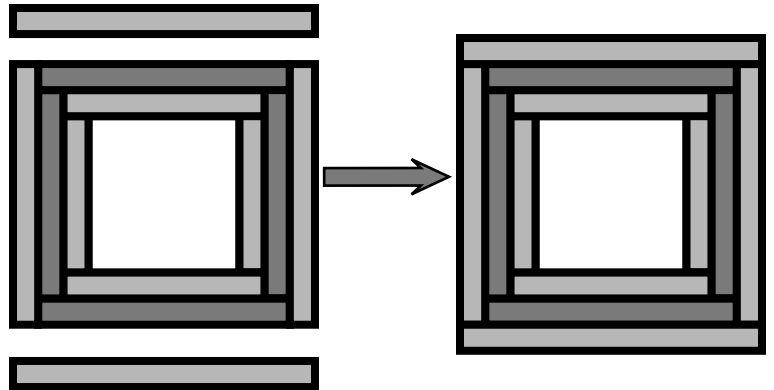
- 2) Sew 2 dark strips 1.5" x 8.5"
to the side of the square
Sew 2 dark strips 1.5" x 10.5" to the top & bottom

Make 1 unit - Measures 10.5" x 10.5"

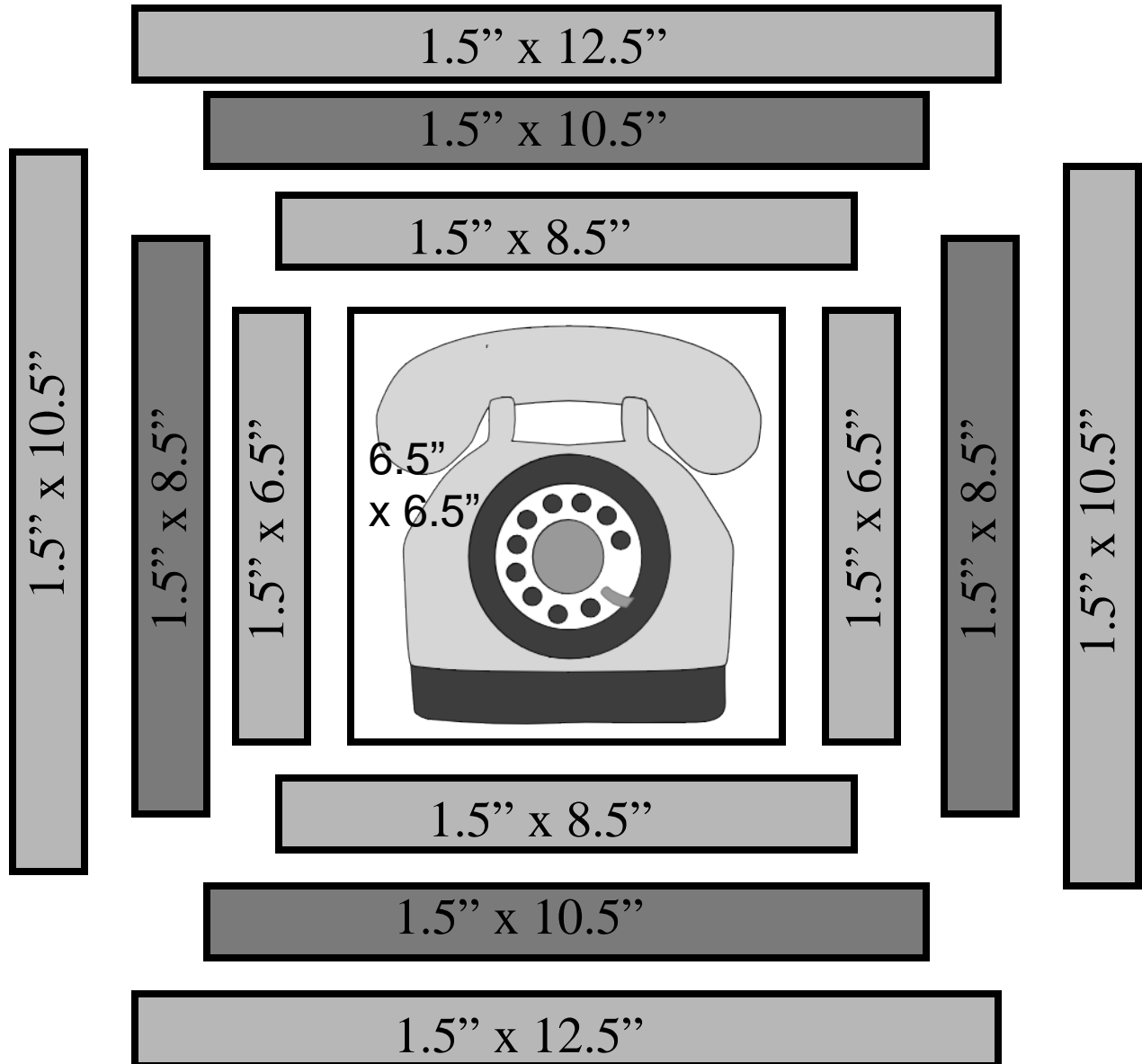


- 3) Sew 2 medium strips 1.5" x 10.5"
to the side of the square
Sew 2 medium strips 1.5" x 12.5" to the top & bottom

Make 1 unit - Measures 12.5" x 12.5"



Unfinished Sizes



Square the Block to $12.5'' \times 12.5''$

IN the Quilt it is finished size $12'' \times 12''$

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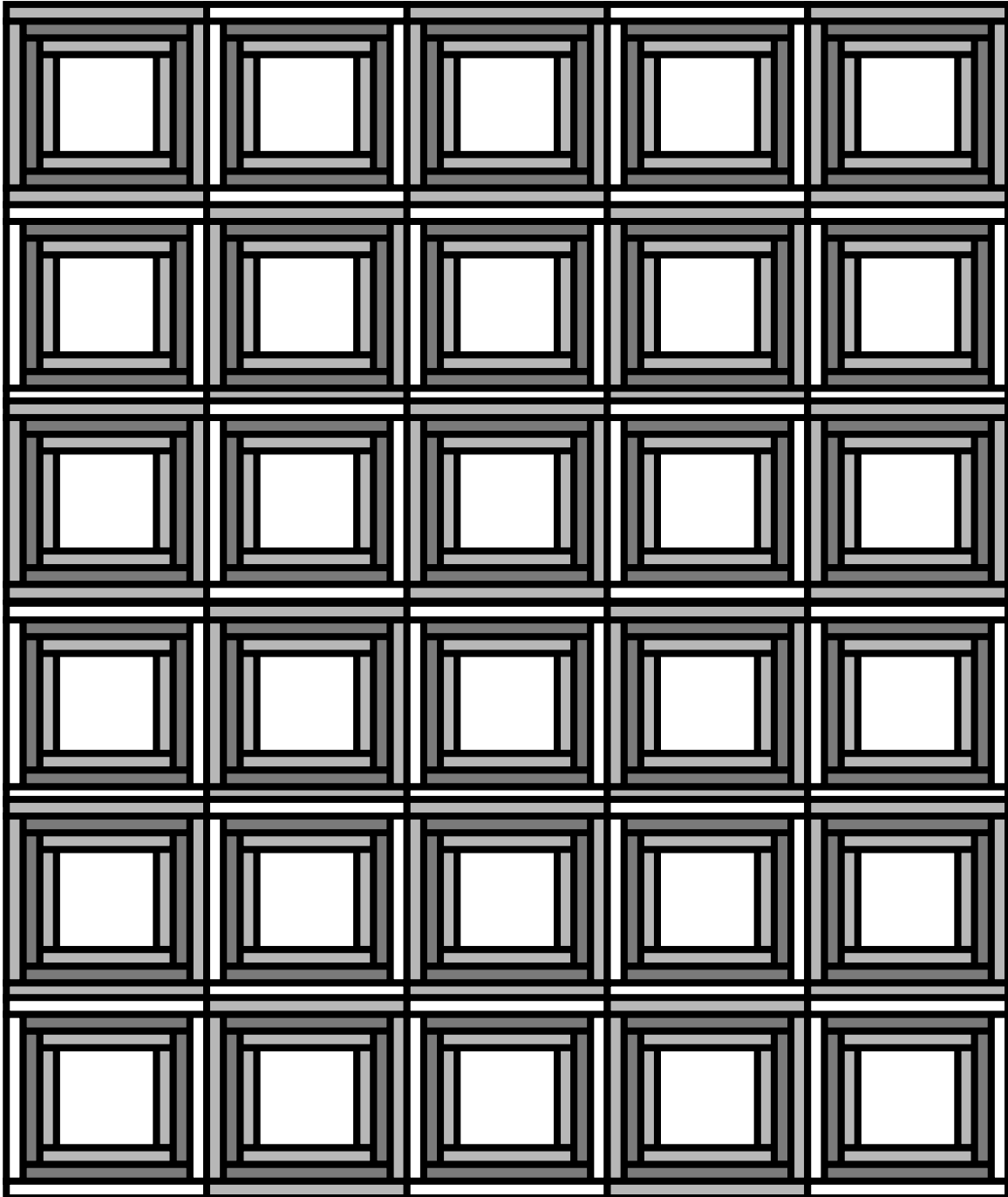
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60" x 72" quilt using 30 blocks

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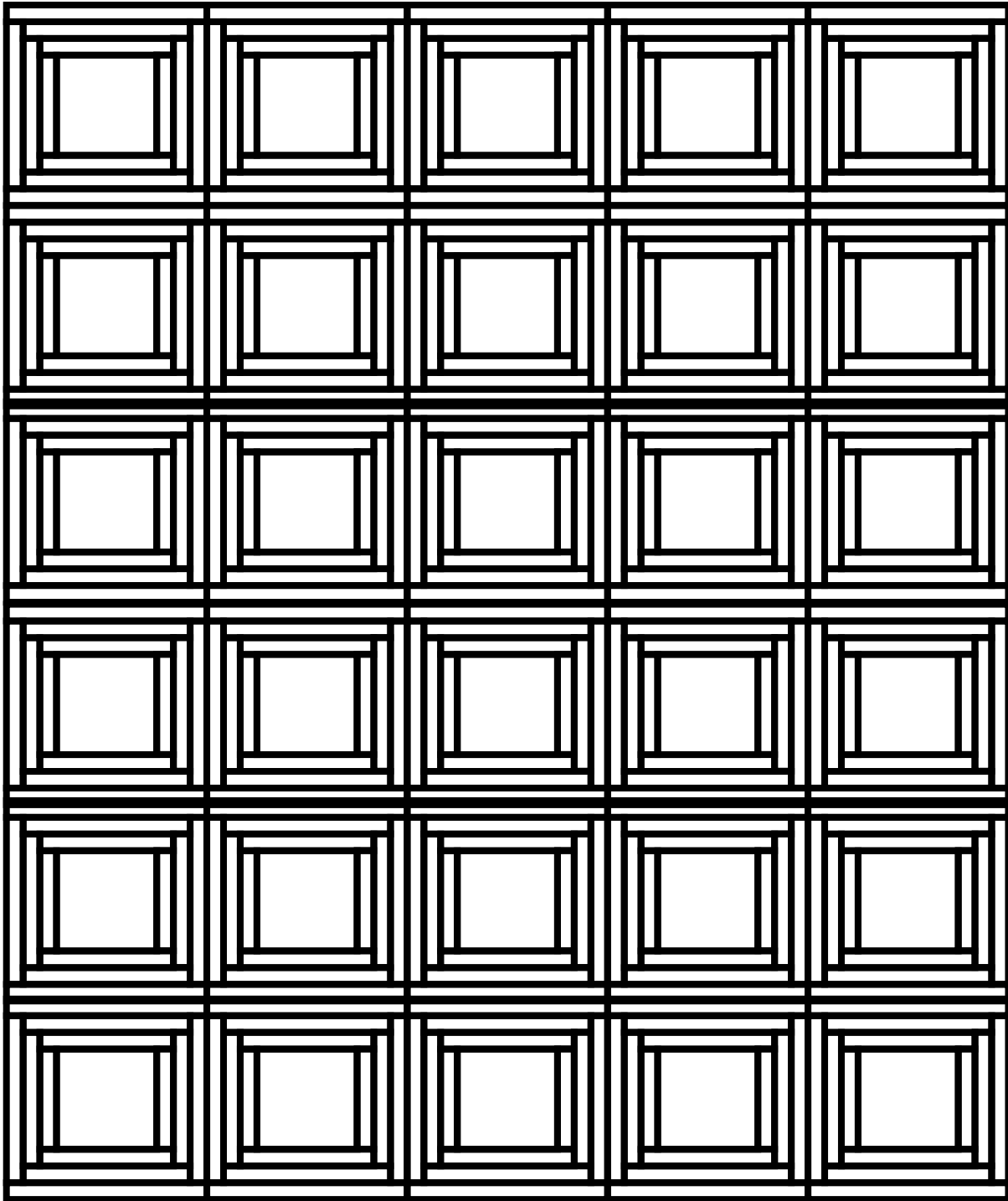
