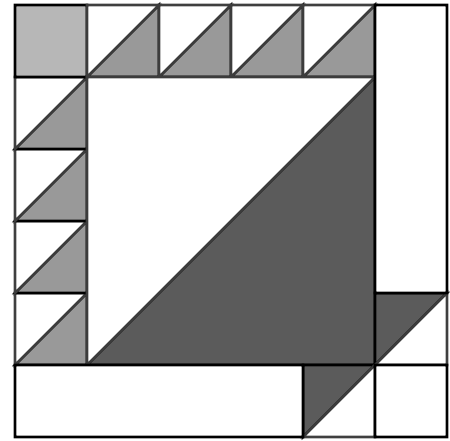
I have the BEST memories of both grandma's purses. They always seemed so big and were filled with so many treasures.

SQUARE Block to 12.5" x 12.5"
Finished in the quilt is Size 12"

Cutting & Sewing

Light Fabric

- Cut 1 square 9" x 9" for HST
- Cut 5 squares 3" x 3" for HST
- Cut 1 square 2.5" x 2.5"
- Cut 2 strips 2.5" x 8.5"

Medium Fabric - total needed

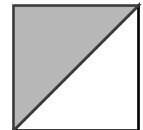
- Cut 4 squares 3" x 3" for HST
- Cut 1 square 2.5" x 2.5"

Dark Fabric - total needed

- Cut 1 square 9" x 9" for HST
- Cut 1 squares 3" x 3" for HST

Directions

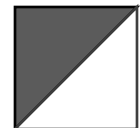
- 1) Sew 4 medium and light squares
Using HST method on last page.
Make 8 units - trim to 2.5" square



TIP

You may want to use multiple fabrics for your block. This is the total needed

- 2) Sew 1 dark and light 3" square
Using HST method on last page.
Make 2 units - trim to 2.5" square



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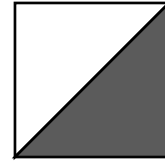
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Directions

- 3) Sew 1 dark and light 9" squares
Using HST method on last page.
NOTE Trim this one to 8.5" x 8.5"



Makes 2 units **NOTE**-One will not be used, keep the other to do a full quilt!

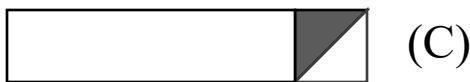
- 4) Following the diagram Sew light & medium HST together
Make 1 Measures 2.5" x 8.5"



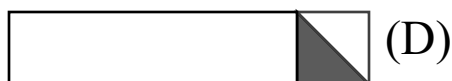
- 5) Following the diagram Sew light & medium HST together
Make 1 Measures 2.5" x 8.5"



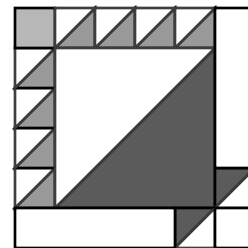
- 6) Following the diagram sew a light strip
And a dark HST, note the position of the
HST
Make 1 Measures 2.5" x 10.5"



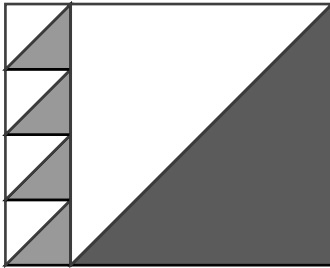
- 7) Following the diagram sew a light strip
And a dark HST, note the position of the
HST

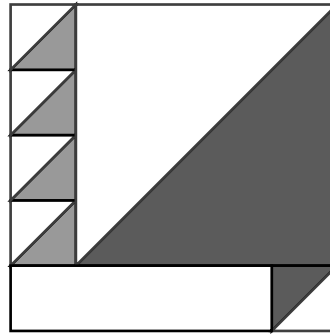


8) Sew Unit A to the left of the

Measures 8.5" x 10.5"



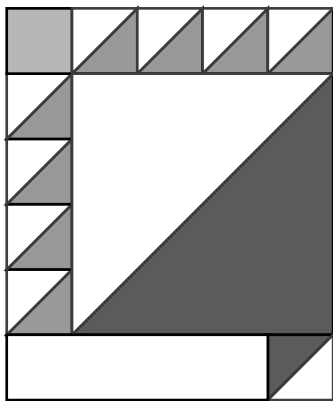

Measures 10.5" x 10.5"



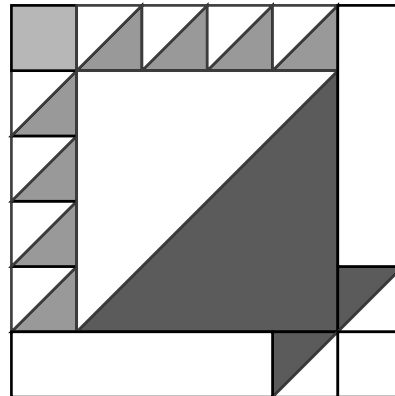

Measures 12.5" x 12.5"

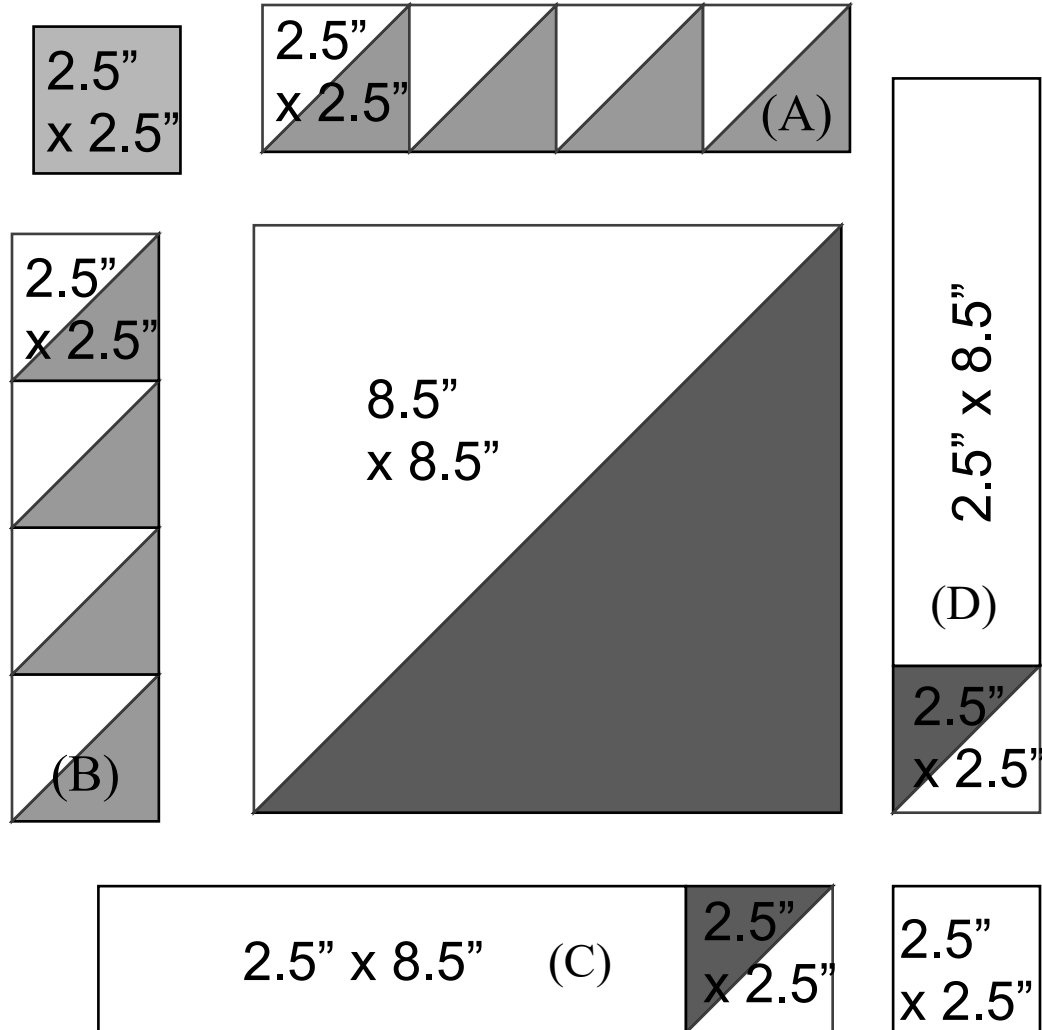

Block Assembly

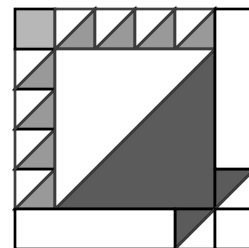
Unfinished Sizes

Use HST method on last page.



Square the Block to $12.5'' \times 12.5''$

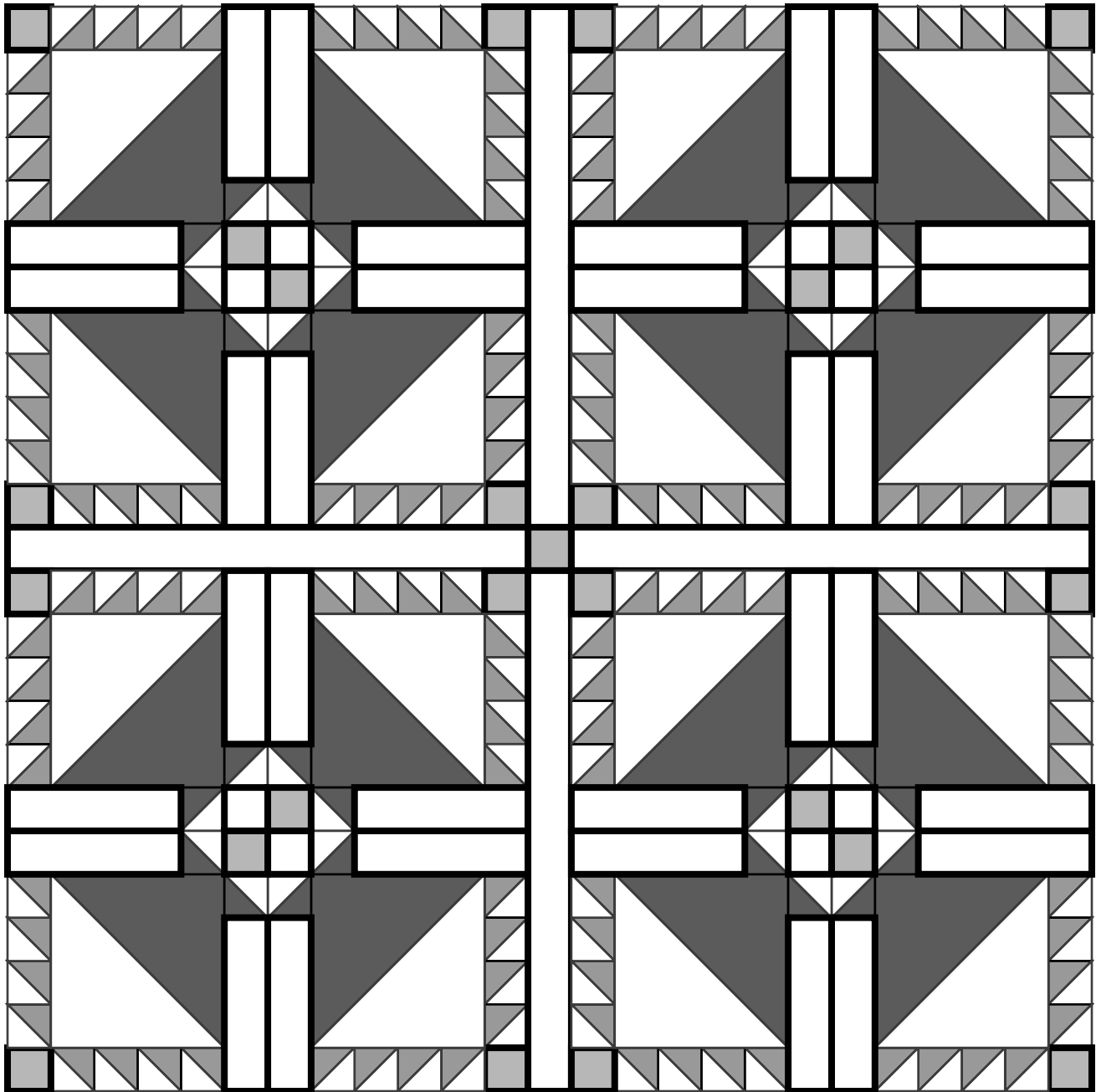
IN the Quilt it is finished size $12'' \times 12''$



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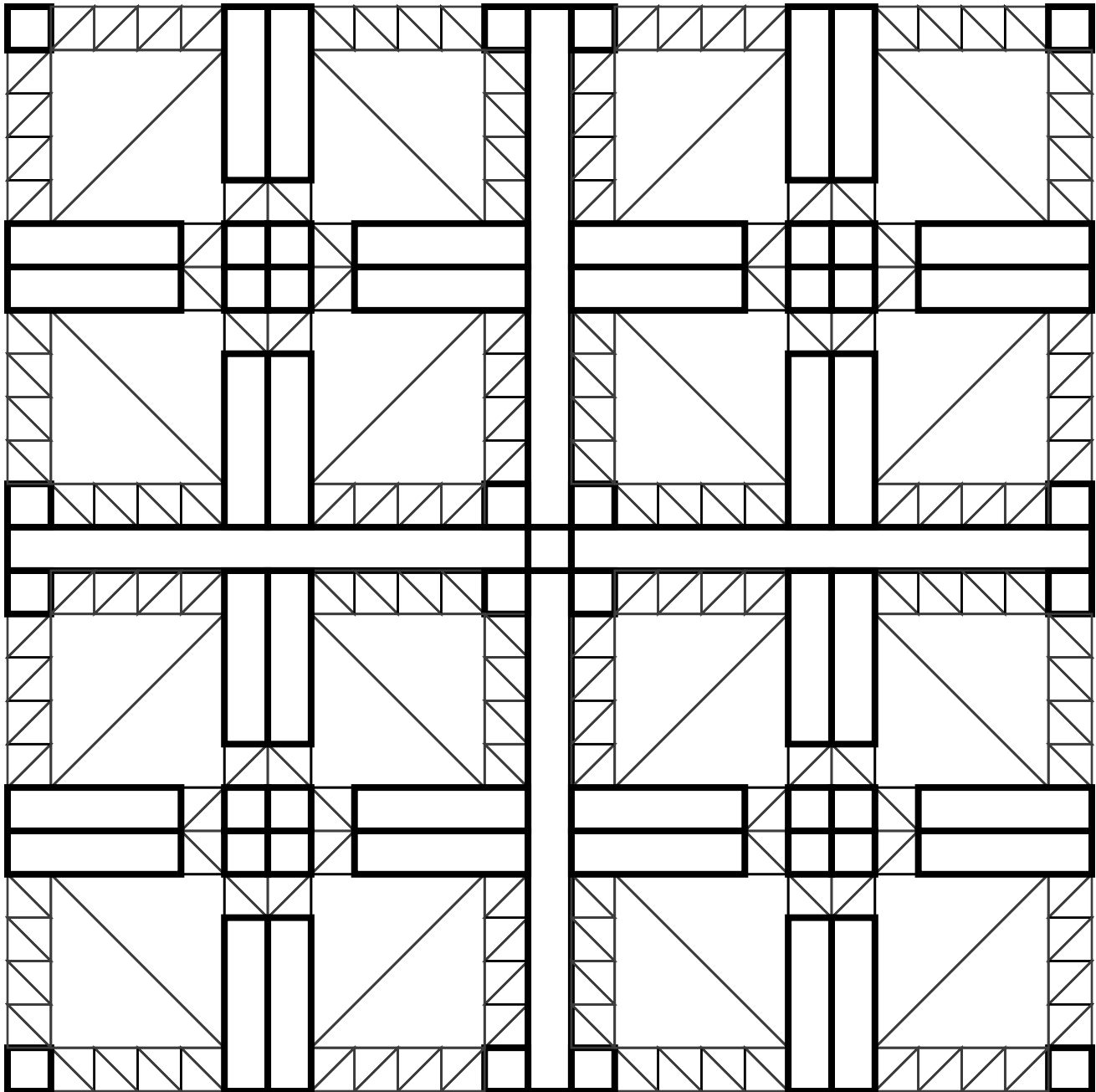


50" x 50" quilt - 16 blocks
Cut 4 sashing strips 2.5" x 24.5"
Cut 1 center square 2.5" x 2.5"

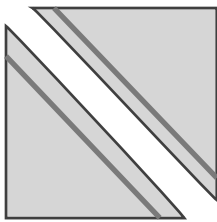
Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2

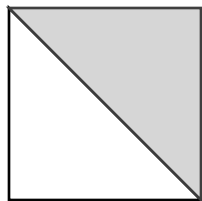
- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

Step 4



-Trim squares to 2.5" x 2.5" using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
