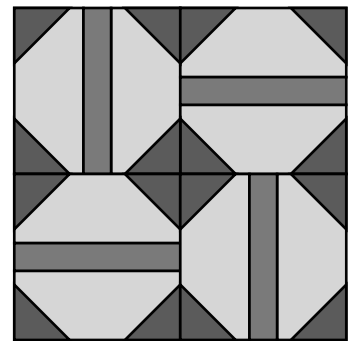

### Cutting Directions

#### Light fabric

– Cut 8 rectangles 3" x 6.5"

#### Medium fabric

– Cut 4 rectangles 1.5" x 6.5"

#### Dark Fabric

– Cut 16 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

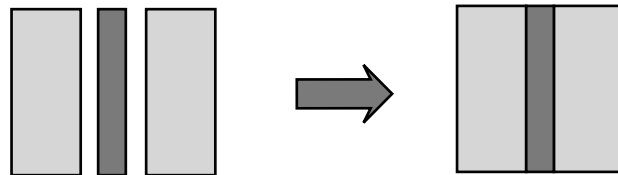
For Sew and Flip corners

### Directions

1) Following the diagram sew a light rectangle, medium rectangle then a light rectangle

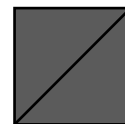
Measures 6.5" x 6.5"

Make 4 units



2) Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of all the 2.5" x 2.5" squares

Make 16 units

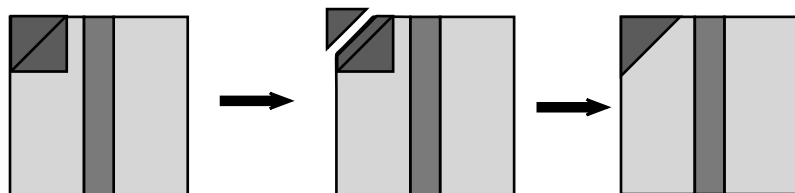

## Directions

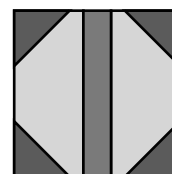
3) Following the diagram

- place a dark 2.5" square on the top left corner 6.5" x 6.5" unit from step 1
- Sew on the line.
- Flip over and press, check the back to be sure it matches up to the rectangle
- Trim away the excess corner fabric behind the triangle. Leave a 1/4" seam.
- Make 4 – VERIFY it still Measures 6.5" x 6.5"



4) Following the diagram repeat Step #3 placing a dark 2.5" square in the other 3 corners

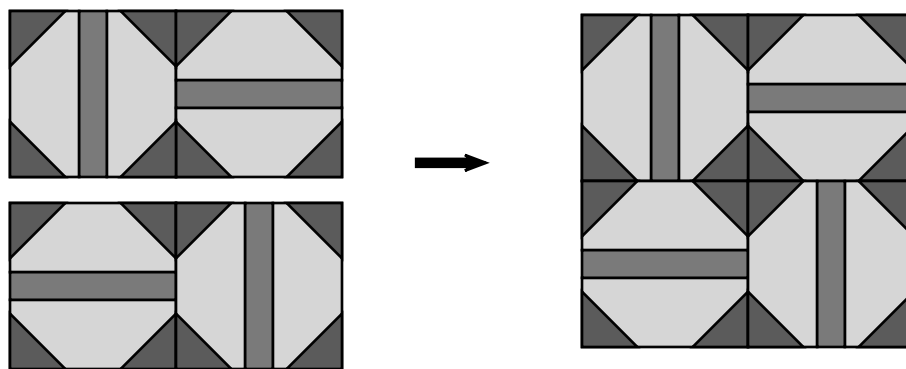
Make 4 – VERIFY they still Measures 6.5" x 6.5"



5) Following the diagram, Assemble the squares.

Make 1

Measures 12.5" x 12.5"

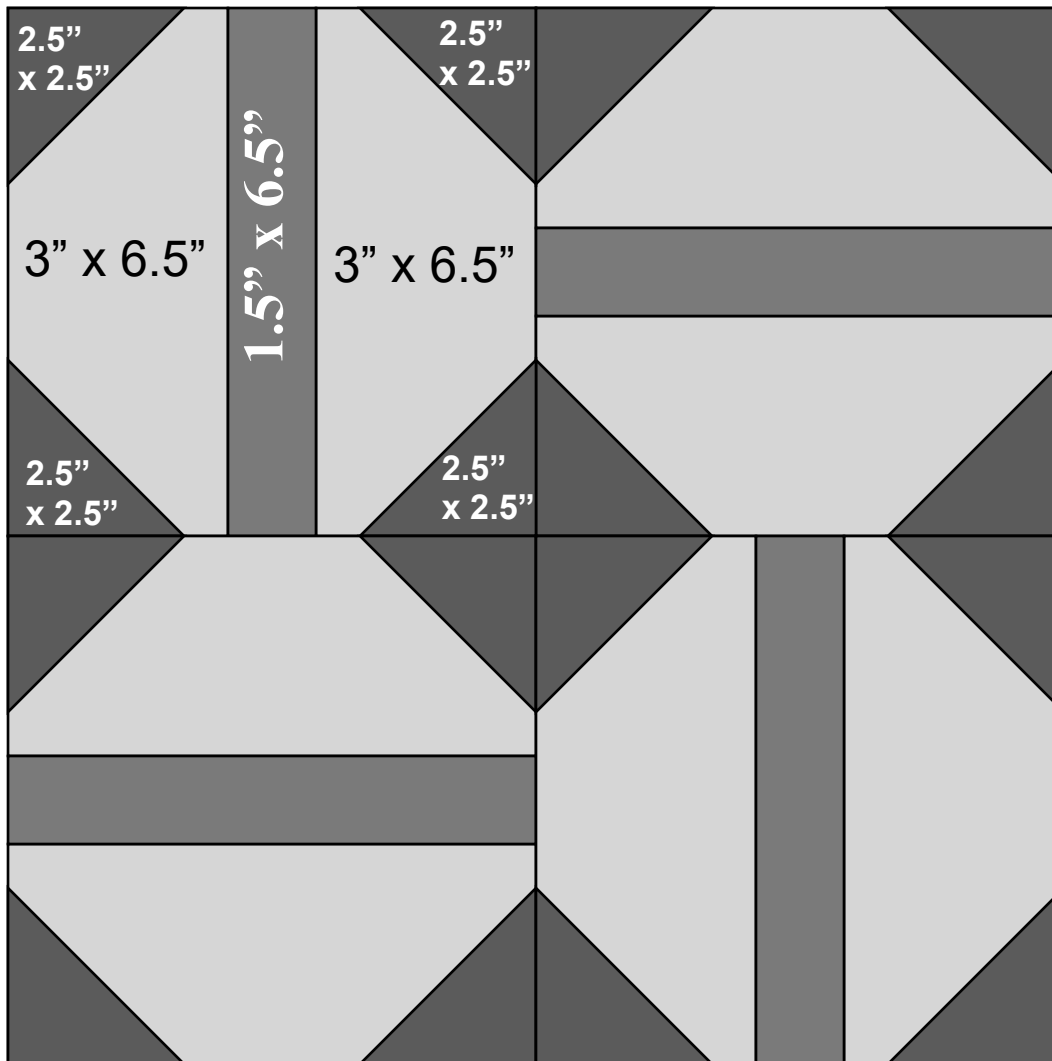

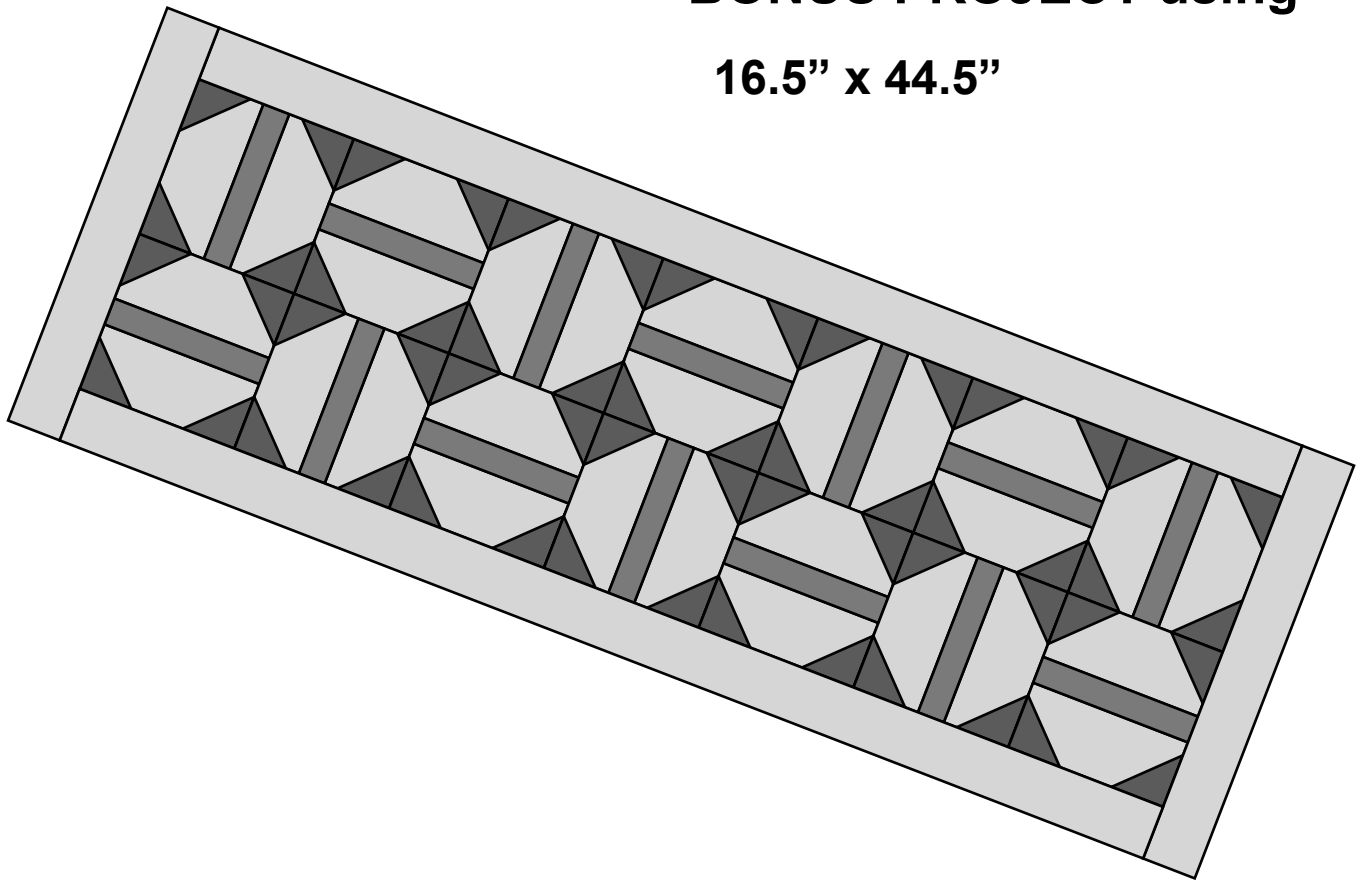
IN the Quilt it is finished size 12" x 12"

**Make 3 ½ blocks.**

**Cut 2 long borders 2.5" x 42.5"**

**Cut 2 short borders 2.5" x 16.5"**
