

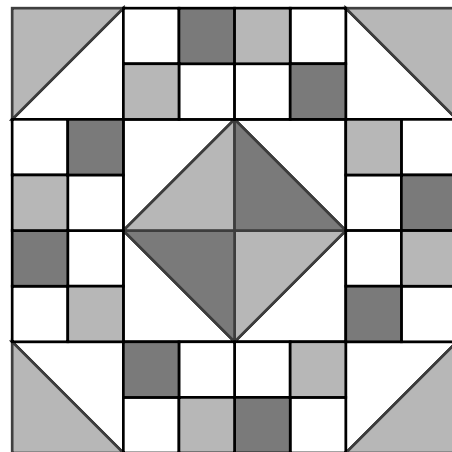

I imagine more homes than just my grandma's had a key holder in the kitchen. It was where the car keys went, the key to the shed, and I'm sure my grandpa Pappy had keys for other things too! As a child I was endlessly fascinated by those keys hanging up there. When little I couldn't quite reach them, which I'm sure was by design, they didn't want to have to hunt for the keys. Later when Pappy got ready to pick up Granny from work, we'd follow him into the kitchen where he selected the keys for the car.



SQUARE Block to 12.5" x 12.5"
Finished in the quilt is Size 12"

My Granny was a quiet lady. She didn't talk a whole lot, but she did have a sense of humor. The key holder she used had a 'Dog House' section on it. When Pappy was 'in trouble' his keys were put in the dog house. We would often go and check to see the status, haha! I think Pappy sometimes put his keys there so we'd giggle like crazy about the joke of him putting himself in the doghouse.

Anyone else have a place for keys? I might need to get one!

Cutting & Sewing

Light Fabric

- Cut 4 squares 4" x 4" for HST
- Cut 2 strips 2" x 17"

Medium Fabric

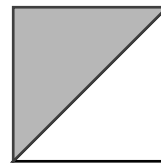
- Cut 3 squares 4" x 4" for HST
- Cut 1 strip 2" x 17"

Dark Fabric

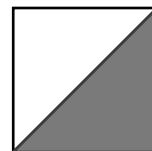
- Cut 1 squares 4" x 4" for HST
- Cut 1 strip 2" x 17"

Directions

- 1) Sew the 4" medium and light squares
Using HST method on last page.
Make 6 units - trim to 3.5" square



- 2) Sew the 4" dark and light squares
Using HST method on last page.
Make 2 units - trim to 3.5" square



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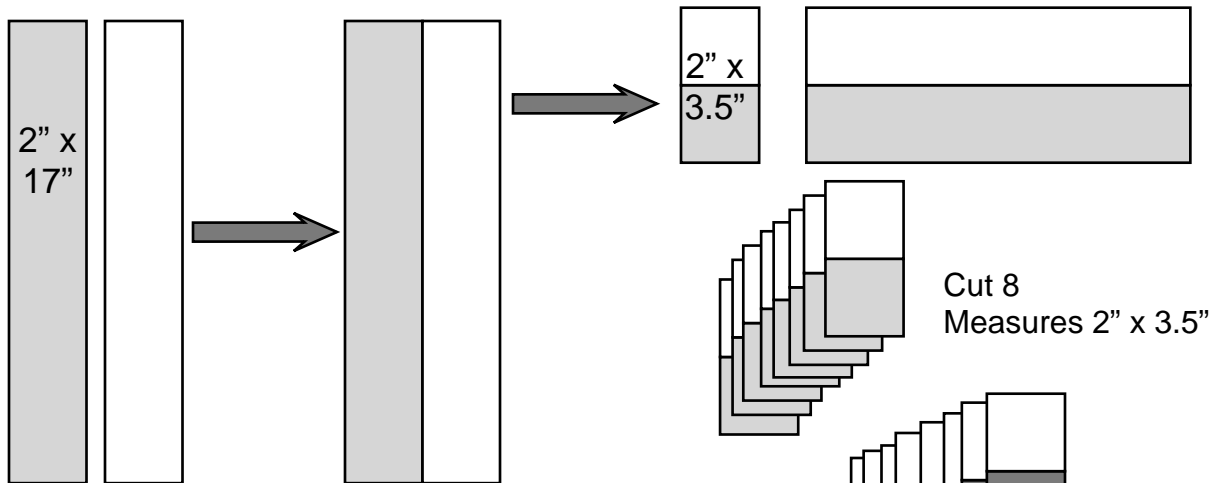
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Directions

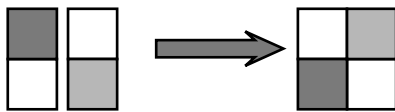
- 3) Following the diagram Sew the light and medium strips together
Sub cut into 2" wide 2-patch units
Cut 8 Measures 2" x 3.5"



- 4) Repeat Step 3 using the light and dark strips

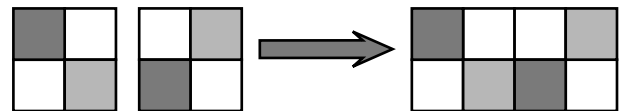


- 5) Following the diagram alternate a medium and dark 2-patch unit to sew a 4-patch
Make 8 Measures 3.5" x 3.5"

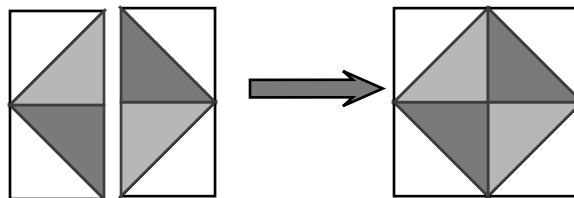


- 6) Following the diagram create the chain unit.

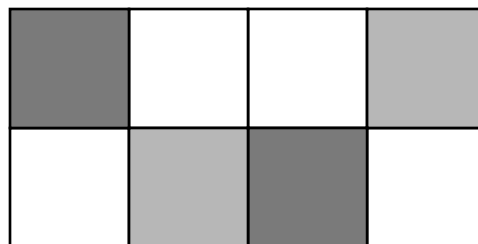
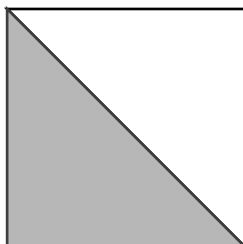
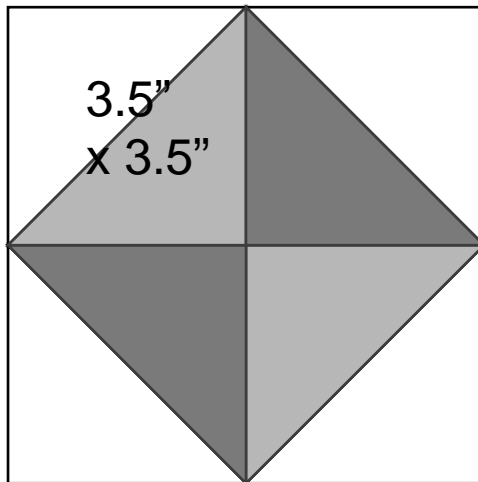
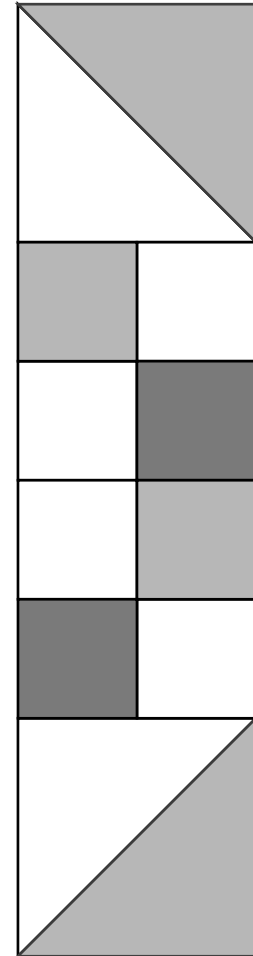
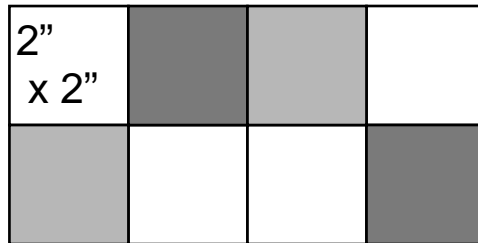
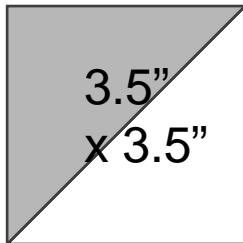
NOTE COLOR PLACEMENT
Make 4 Measures 3.5" x 6.5"



- 7) Following the diagram create the center diamond with chain unit.
NOTE COLOR PLACEMENT
Make 1 Measures 6.5" x 6.5"



Unfinished Sizes

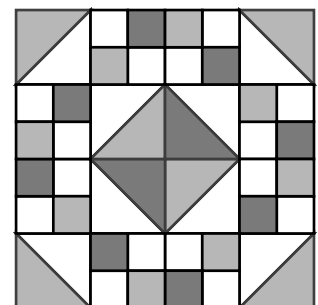


Square the Block to 12.5" x 12.5"

IN the Quilt it is finished size 12" x 12"

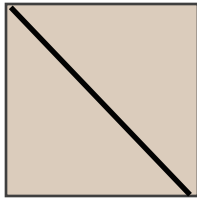
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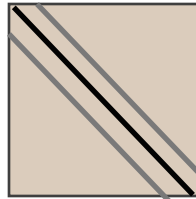
Half Square Triangles Tutorial

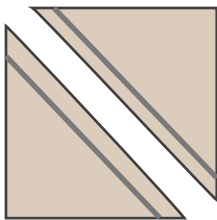
Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2

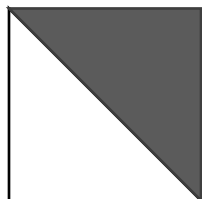
- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

Step 4



-Trim squares to 3.5" x 3.5" using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.

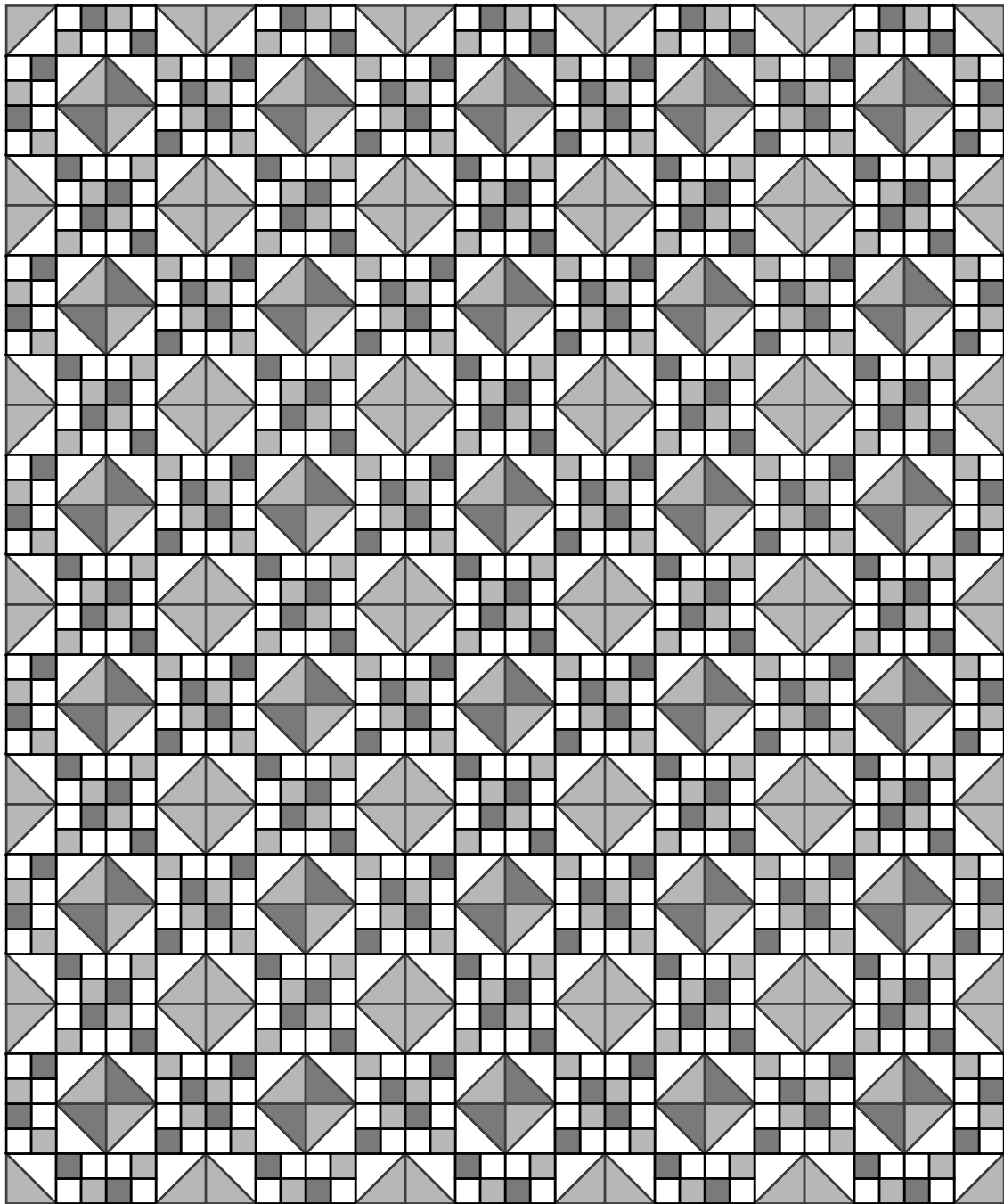

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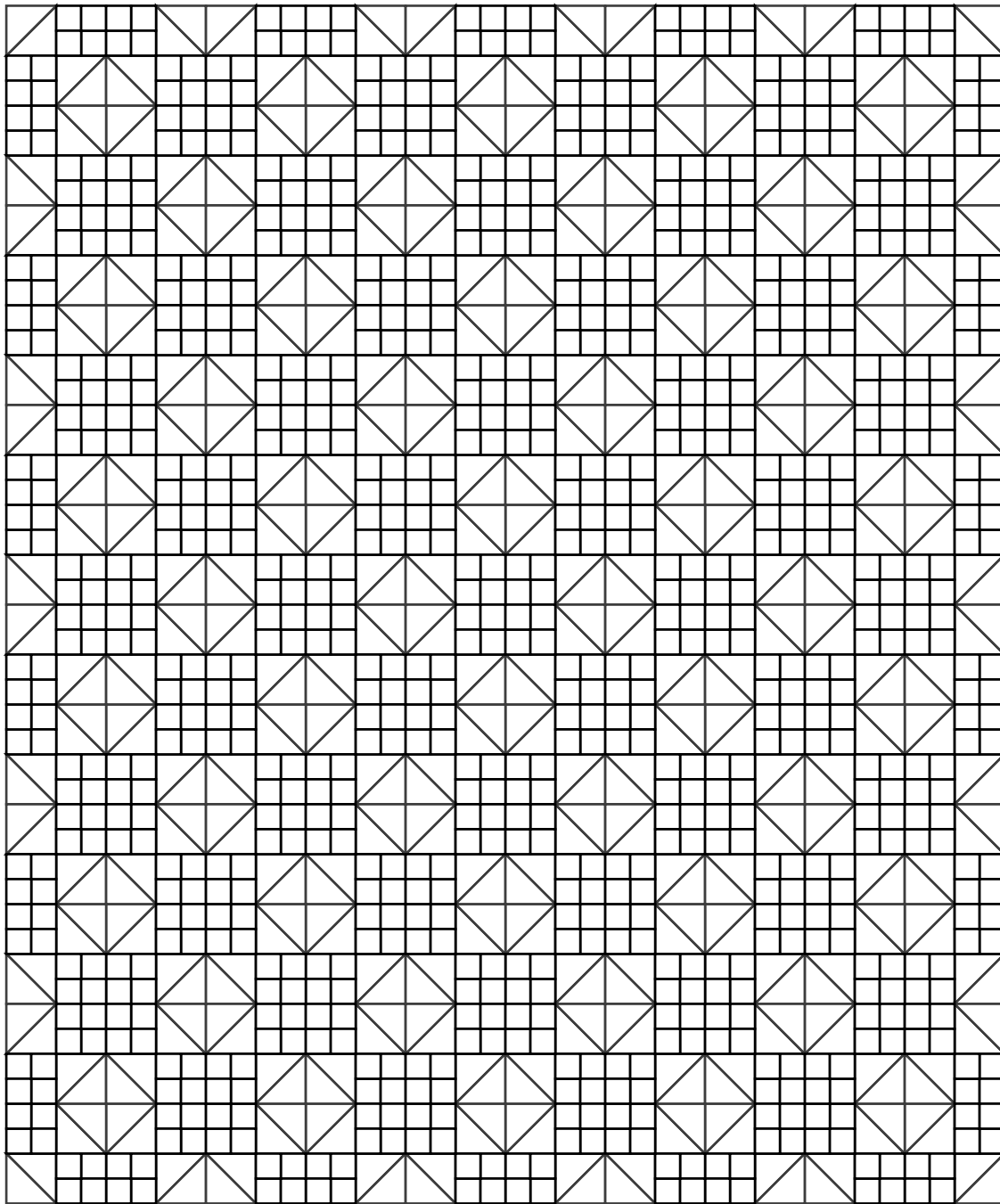
