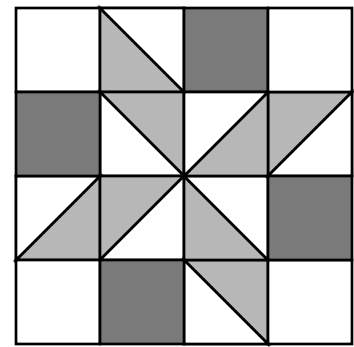

Cutting Directions

Background fabric

- Cut 4 squares 4" x 4" for (Half square triangles HST)
- Cut 4 squares 3.5" x 3.5"

Medium fabric

- Cut 4 squares 4" x 4" for (Half square triangles HST)

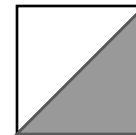
Dark fabric

- Cut 4 squares 3.5" x 3.5"

Directions

1) Using a 4" background and a 4" Medium fabric square make HSTs using method on my separate HST PDF sheet at the end

trim to 3.5" square
Make 8 units

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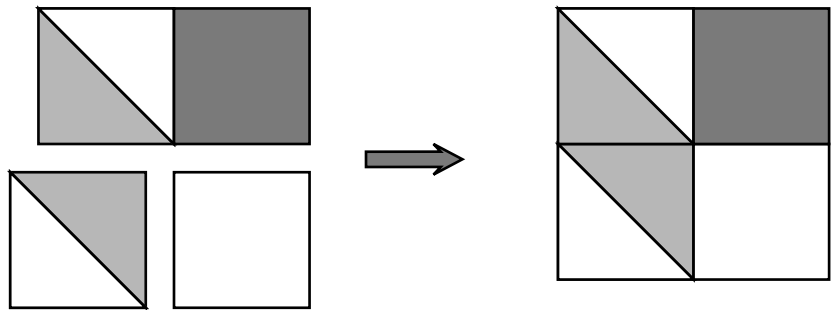

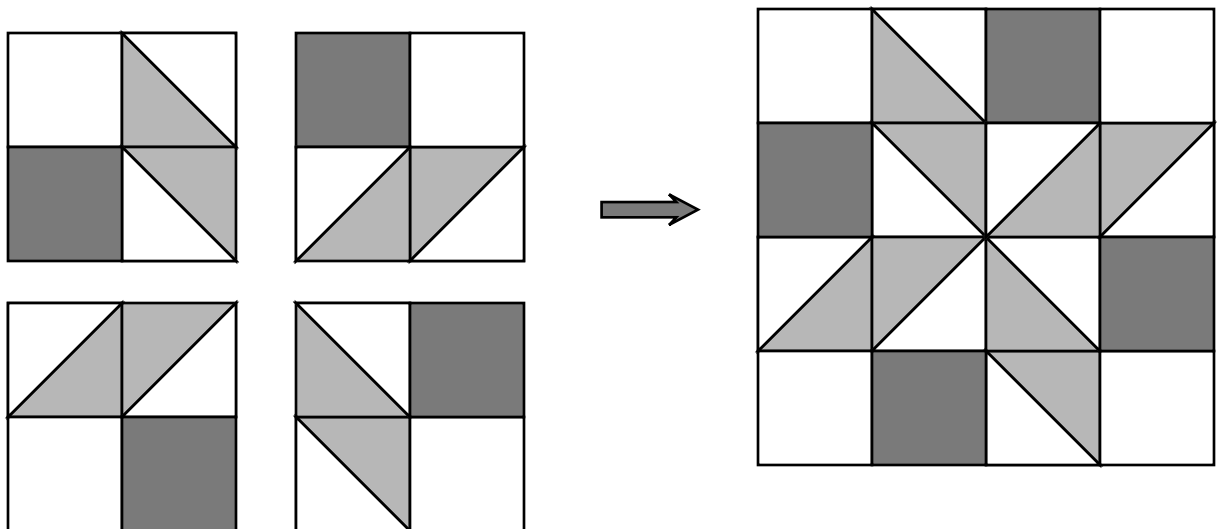

Directions

2) Following diagram sew together 1 Background 3.5" x 3.5" square, 2 HST, and 1 dark 3.5" x 3.5" square
 Measures 6.5" x 6.5"
 Make 4



3) Following the diagram sew the 4 units from step #2 together to make the block
 NOTE - Be care to place in the correct direction to make the pinwheel.
 Make 1
 Measures 12.5" x 12.5"

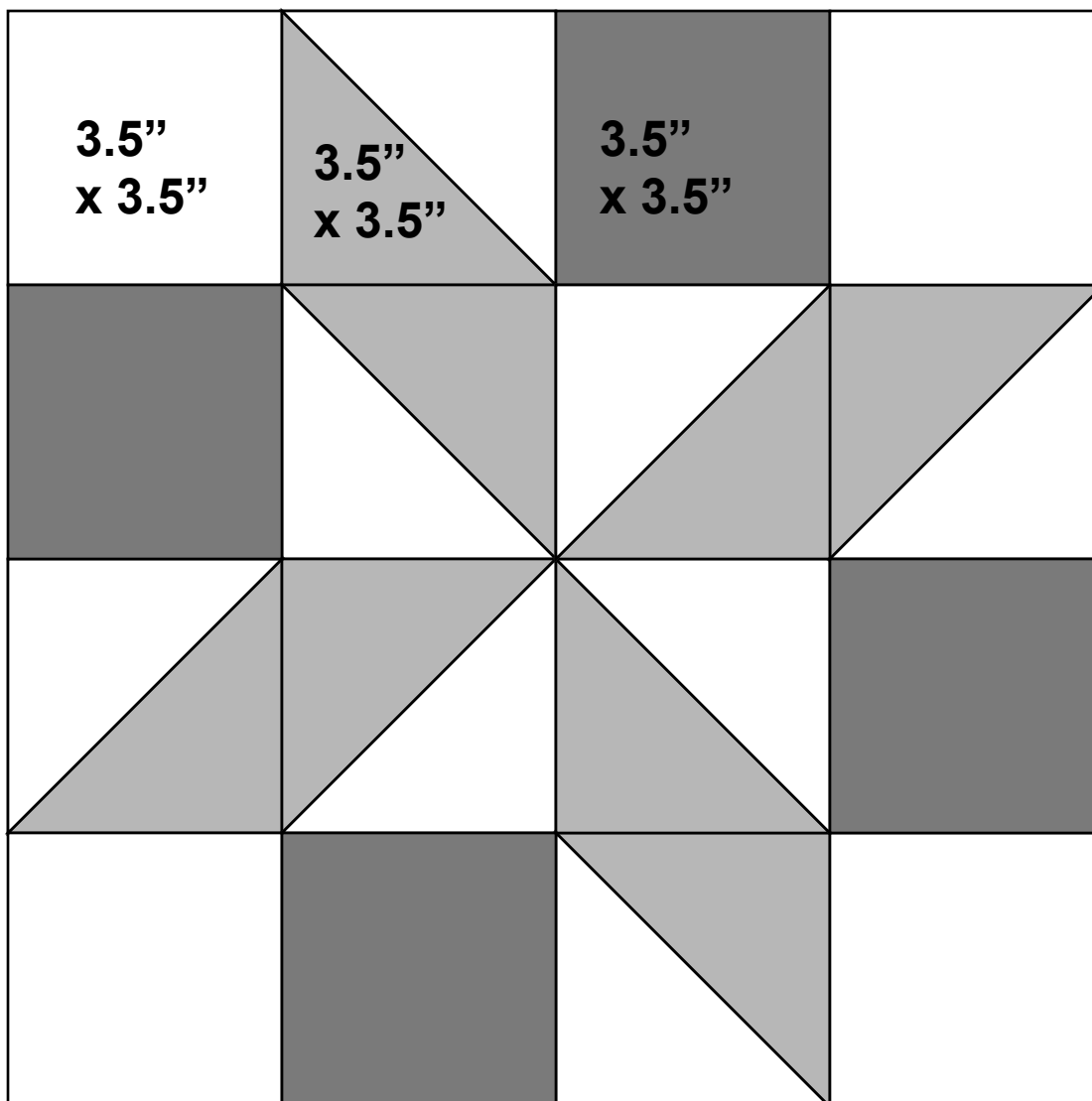

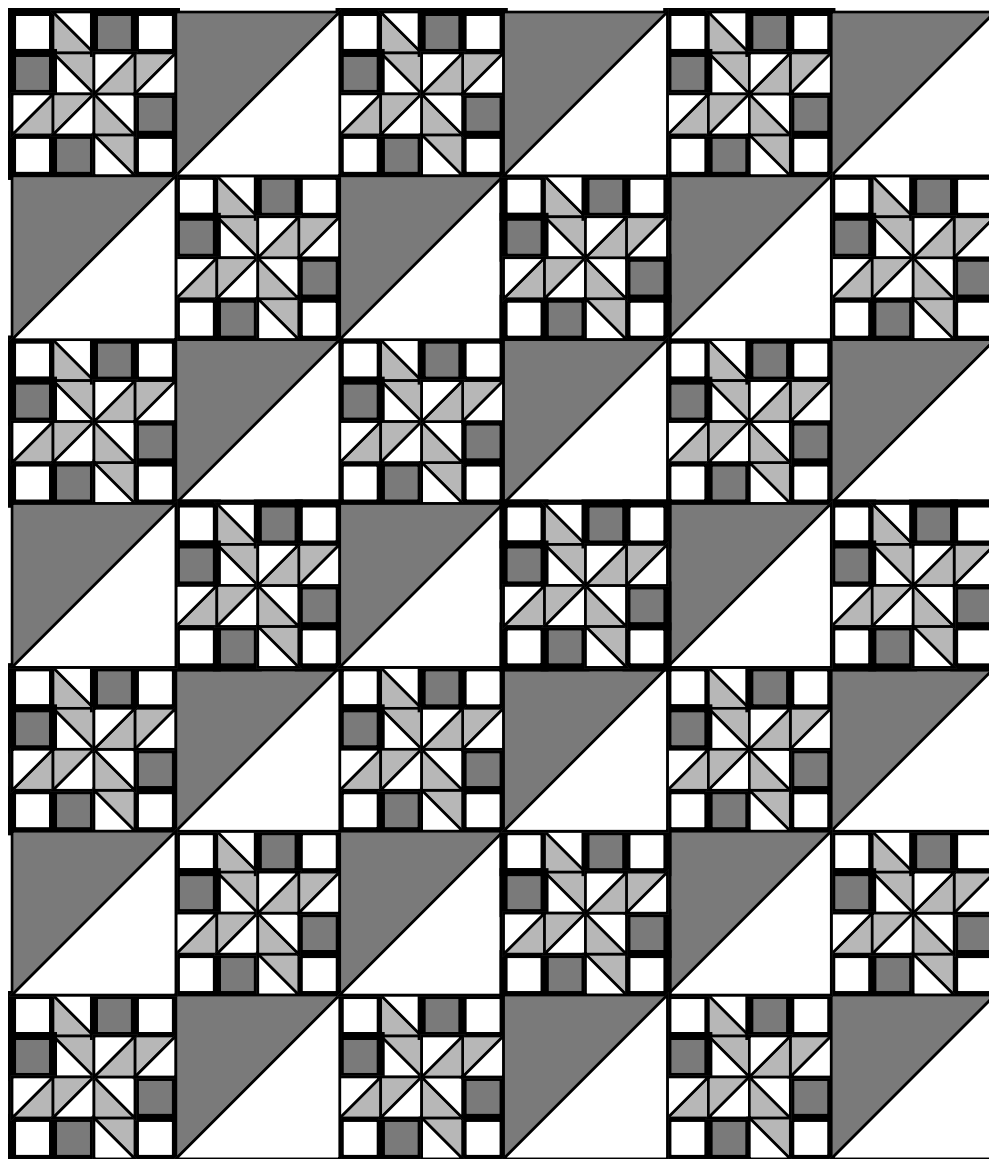

72.5" x 84.5" - 21 Blocks

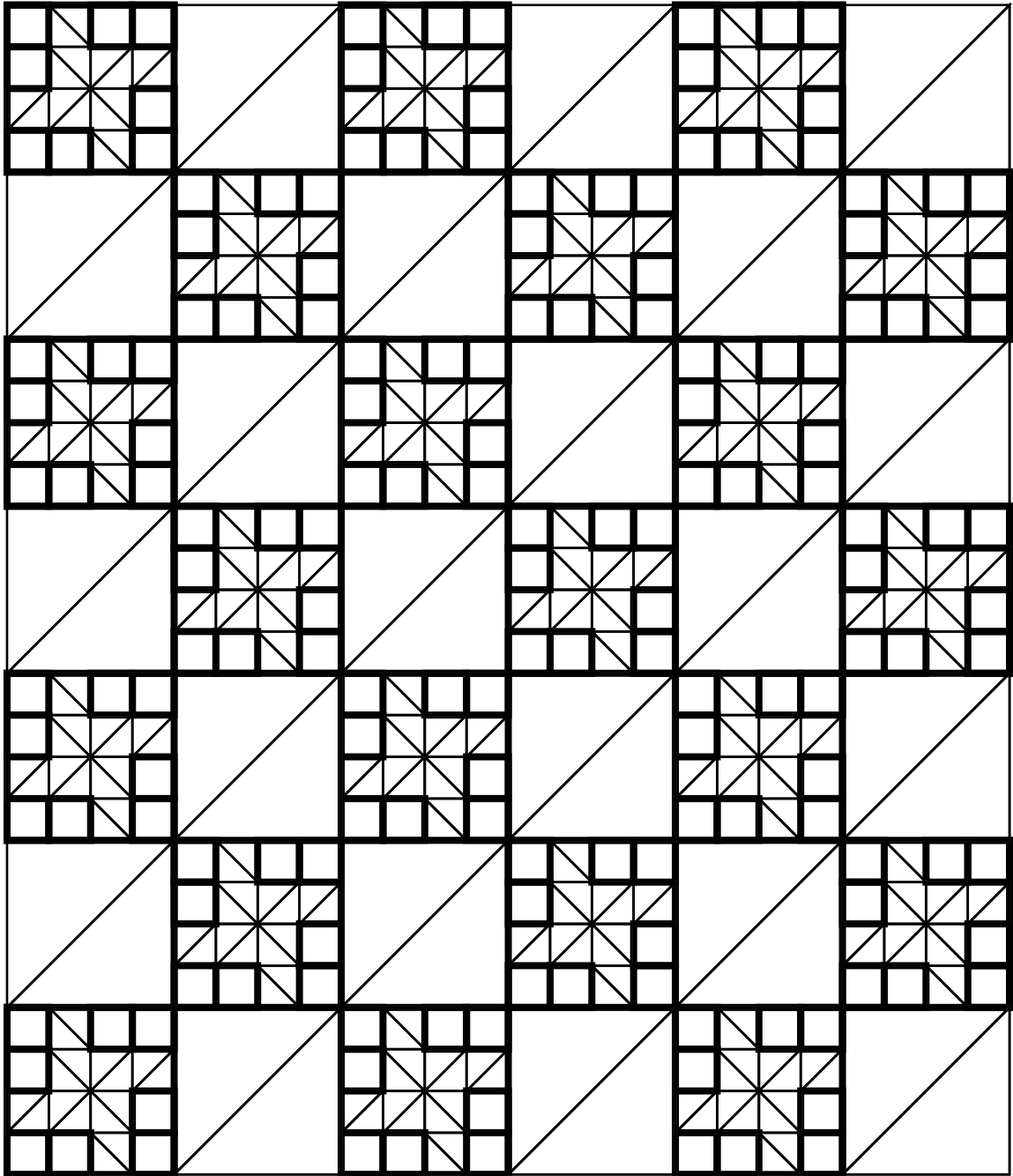
Cut 11 medium squares 13" x 13"

Cut 11 light squares 13" x 13"

Make 21 Hst using directions on page.

Trim HST to 12.5" x. 12.5"

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Half Square Triangles Tutorial

Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2

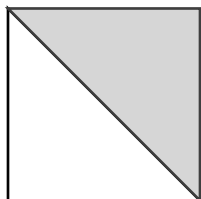
- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a 1/4" seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

Step 4



-Trim squares to size needed using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
