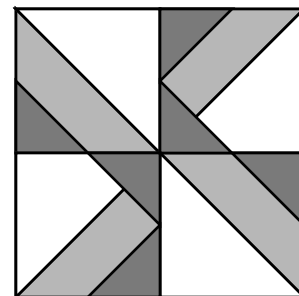

Block is 6.5" x 6.5"
Finished size 6" x 6"

Cutting Directions

Background or Light fabric

– Cut 2 squares 4" x 4"

Medium fabric

– Cut 2 squares 4" x 4"

Dark Fabric

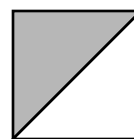
– Cut 6 squares 2" x 2"

Directions

1) Using the 4" Medium and 4" light/background squares make HSTs using method on the last page

Trim to 3.5" square

Make 4 units

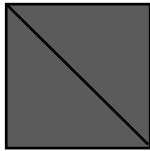

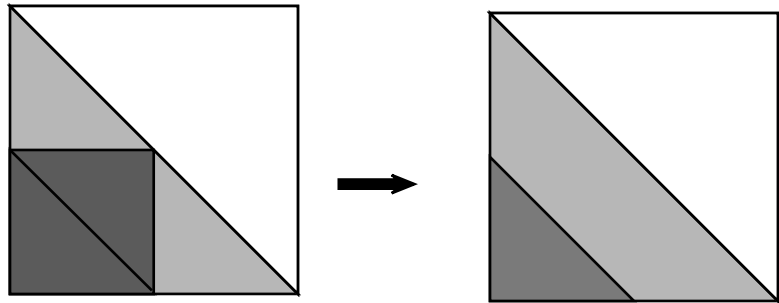
Directions

2) Using the 2" dark square do a sew and flip corner on the HST from Step #1



Step A Directions

Draw a diagonal line on each 2" square
Make 6



Step B Directions

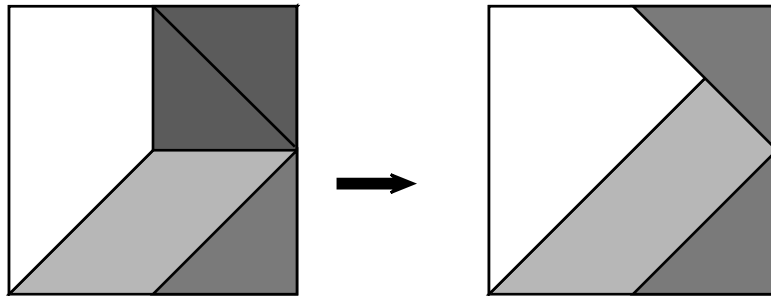
- 1) Following the diagram, Place a square on the HST
- 2) Sew on the line.
- 3) Flip over and press, check the back to be sure it matches up to the rectangle
- 4) Trim away the excess corner fabric behind the triangle. Leave a 1/4" seam.
- 5) Make 4 Measures 3.5" x 3.5"

3) Using the remaining 2" dark squares and 2 units from Step #2 do a sew and flip corner

Following the diagram

Measures 3.5" x 3.5"

Make 2 units

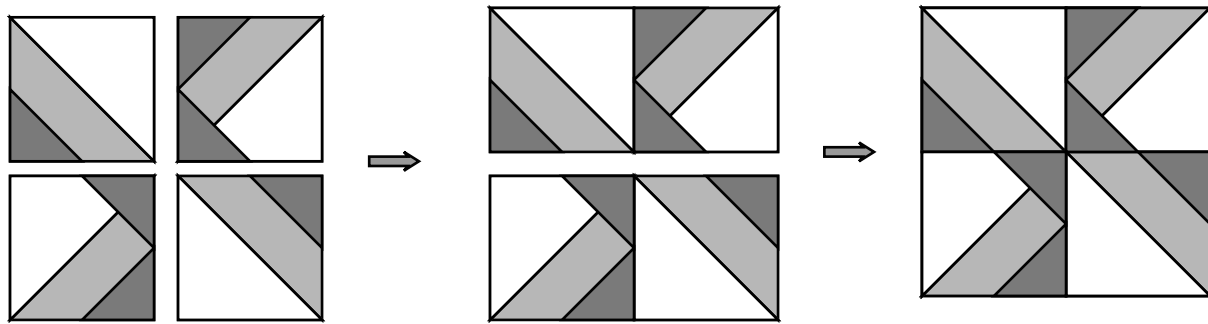

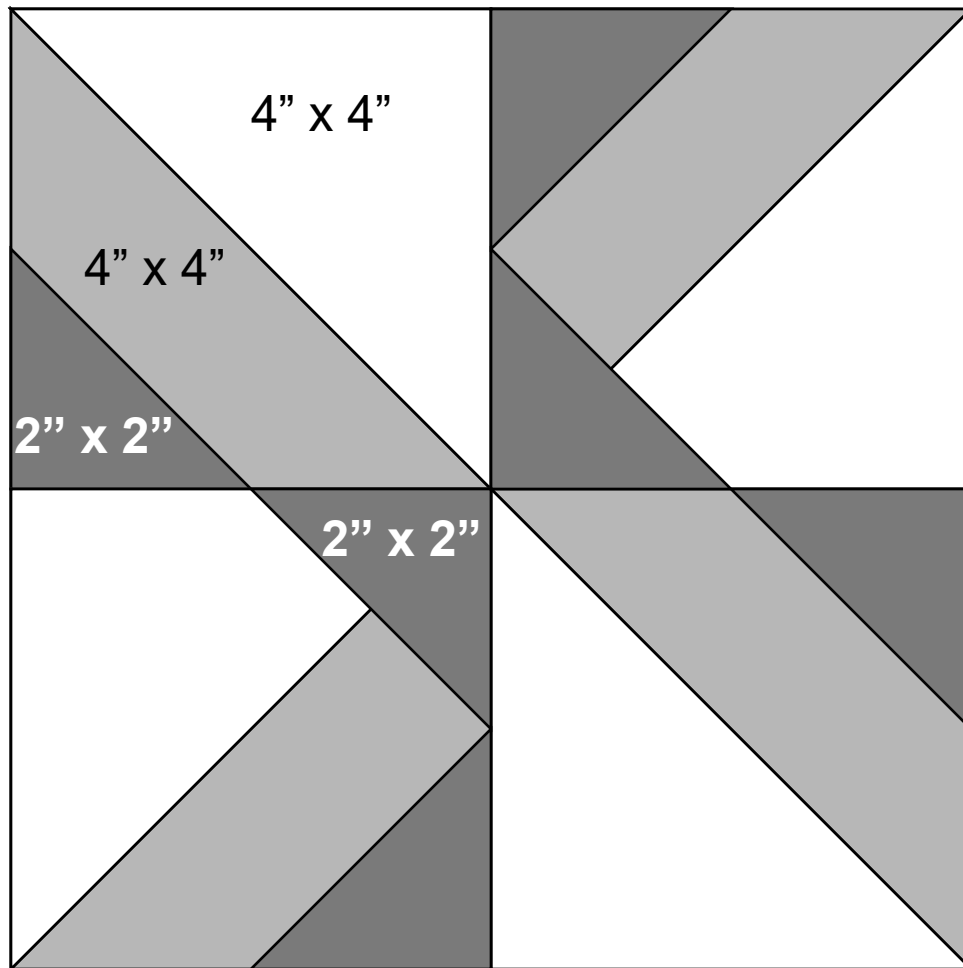

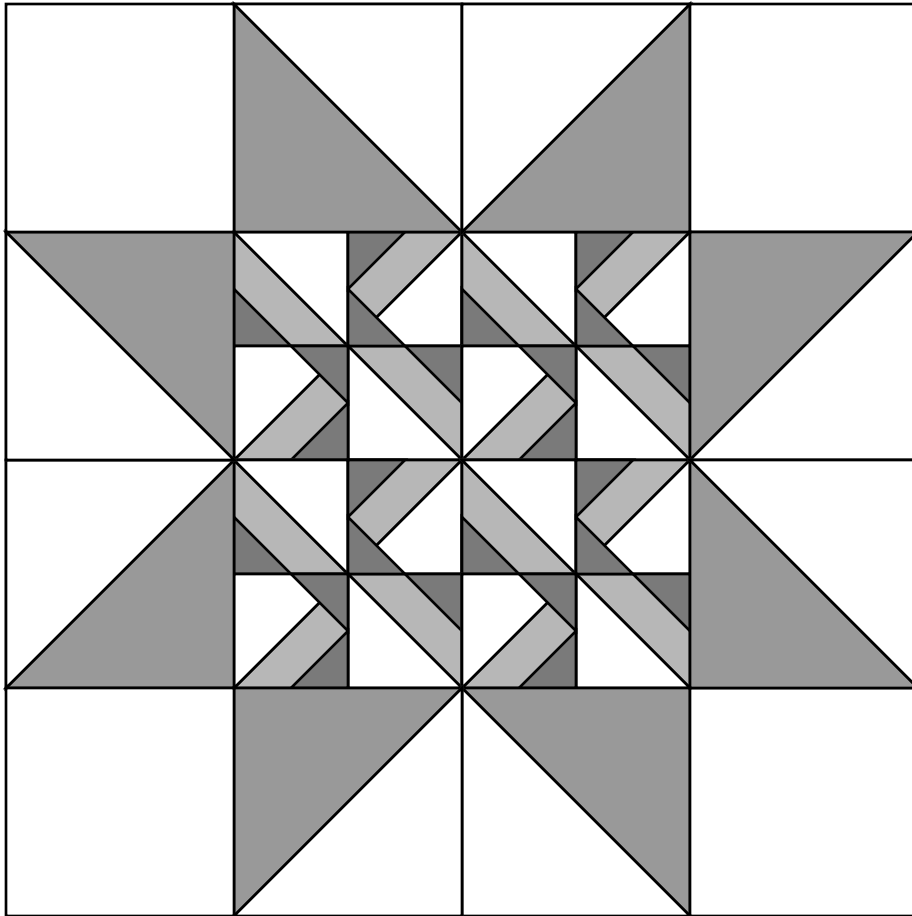

BONUS PROJECT

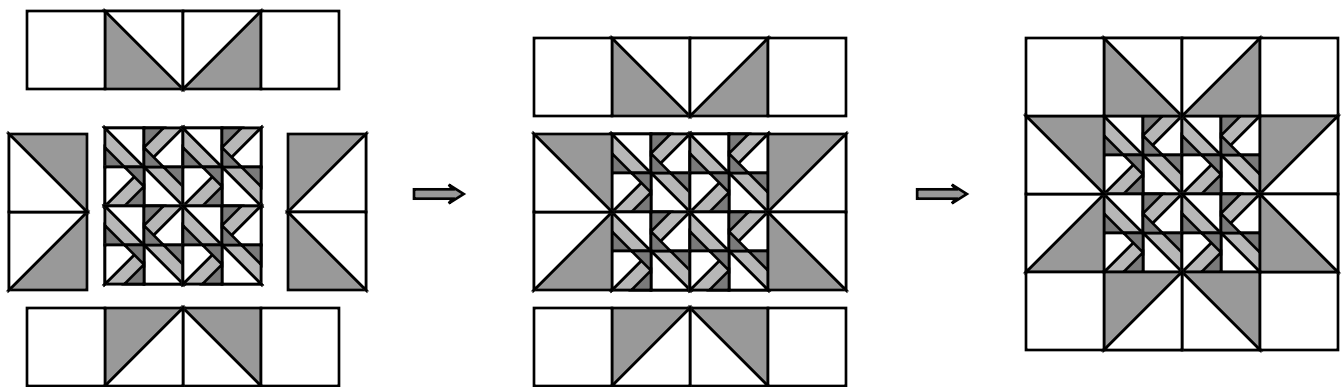
****Size****
24.5" x 24.5"

Make 4 Blocks

Cut
4 light squares 7" x 7"
4 dark squares 7" x 7"
4 light squares 6.5" x 6.5"

Using the 7" squares make HST using the patten
At the end.
Trim to 6.5" x 6.5"

Assemble

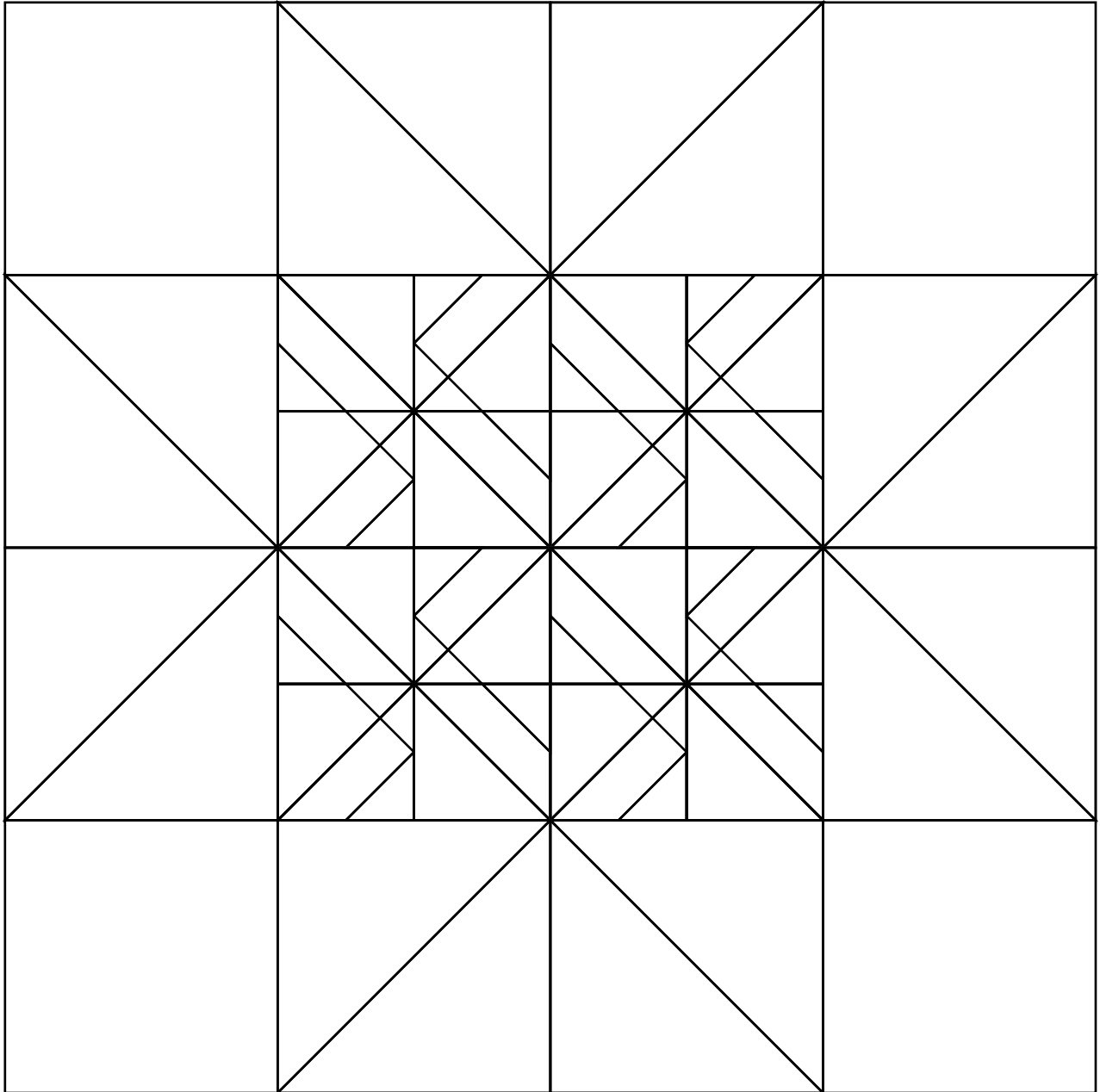

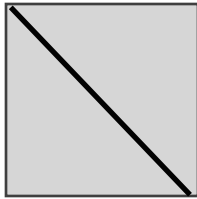

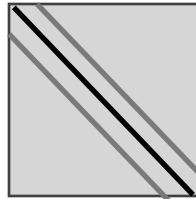
Half Square Triangles Tutorial

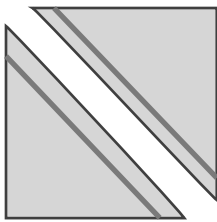
Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2

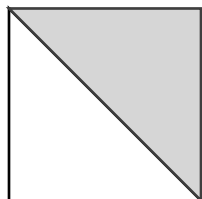
- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a 1/4" seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

Step 4



-Trim squares to size using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
