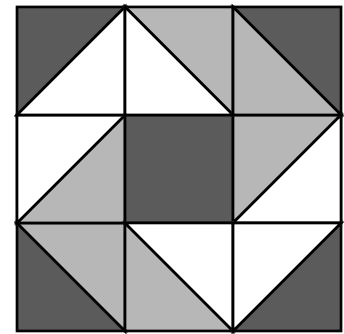

As quilt makers I imagine many of us were fascinated by Spirographs. This might not be a traditional ‘game’ but I think of it as a game I did by myself. Long before there were cell phones with Panda Pop on them, we had to find ways to play when we were by ourselves.



Block is 12.5” x 12.5”
Finished size 12” x 12”

The part I love most is how all those wonderful designs magically appear! The serendipity of how when we go round and round it makes new connections. I had to go look for Spirographs and they still make them. Should I get one??

Cutting Directions

Light fabrics

– Cut 3 squares 5” x 5” for HST
(HST - Half Square Triangle)

Medium fabrics

– Cut 3 squares 5” x 5” for HST

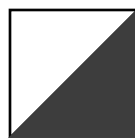
Dark Fabric

– Cut 2 squares 5” x 5” for HST
– Cut 1 squares 4.5” x 4.5”

Directions

1) Using a 5” Light and a 5” dark fabric squares make HSTs using method on my separate HST PDF sheet at the end

trim to 4.5” square
Make 2 units

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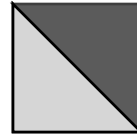

Directions

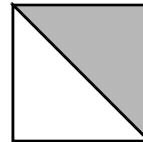
2) Using a 5" medium and a 5" dark fabric squares make HSTs using method on my separate HST PDF sheet at the end

trim to 4.5" square
Make 2 units

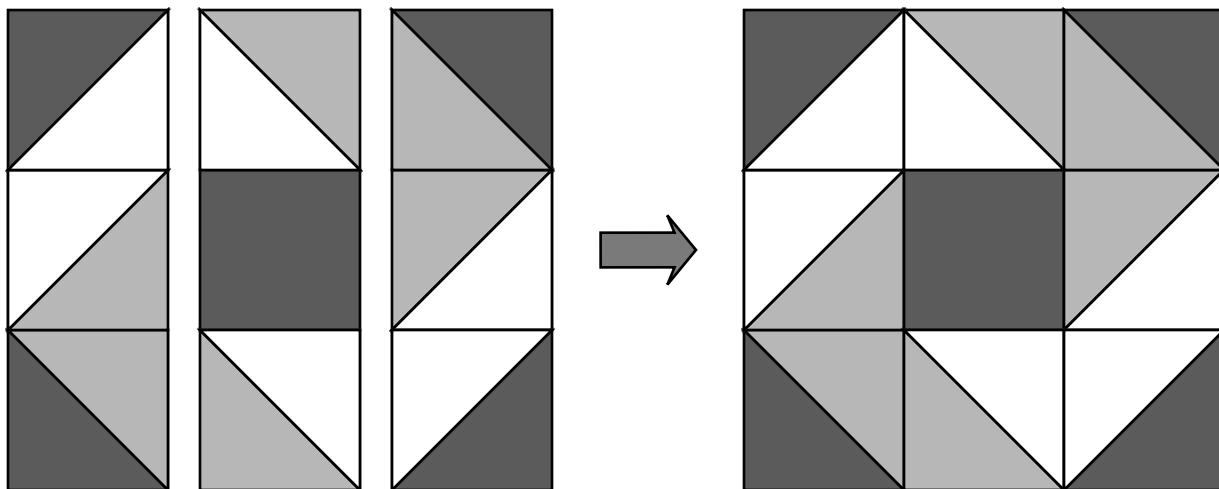


3) Using a 5" medium and a 5" Light fabric squares make HSTs using method on my separate HST PDF sheet at the end
Repeat with the other medium and light 5" squares

trim to 4.5" square
Make 4 units



4) Following the diagram, Assemble the 4.5" medium square and the HST units.
Sewing in strips then sew the strips together
Make 1
Measures 12.5" x 12.5"

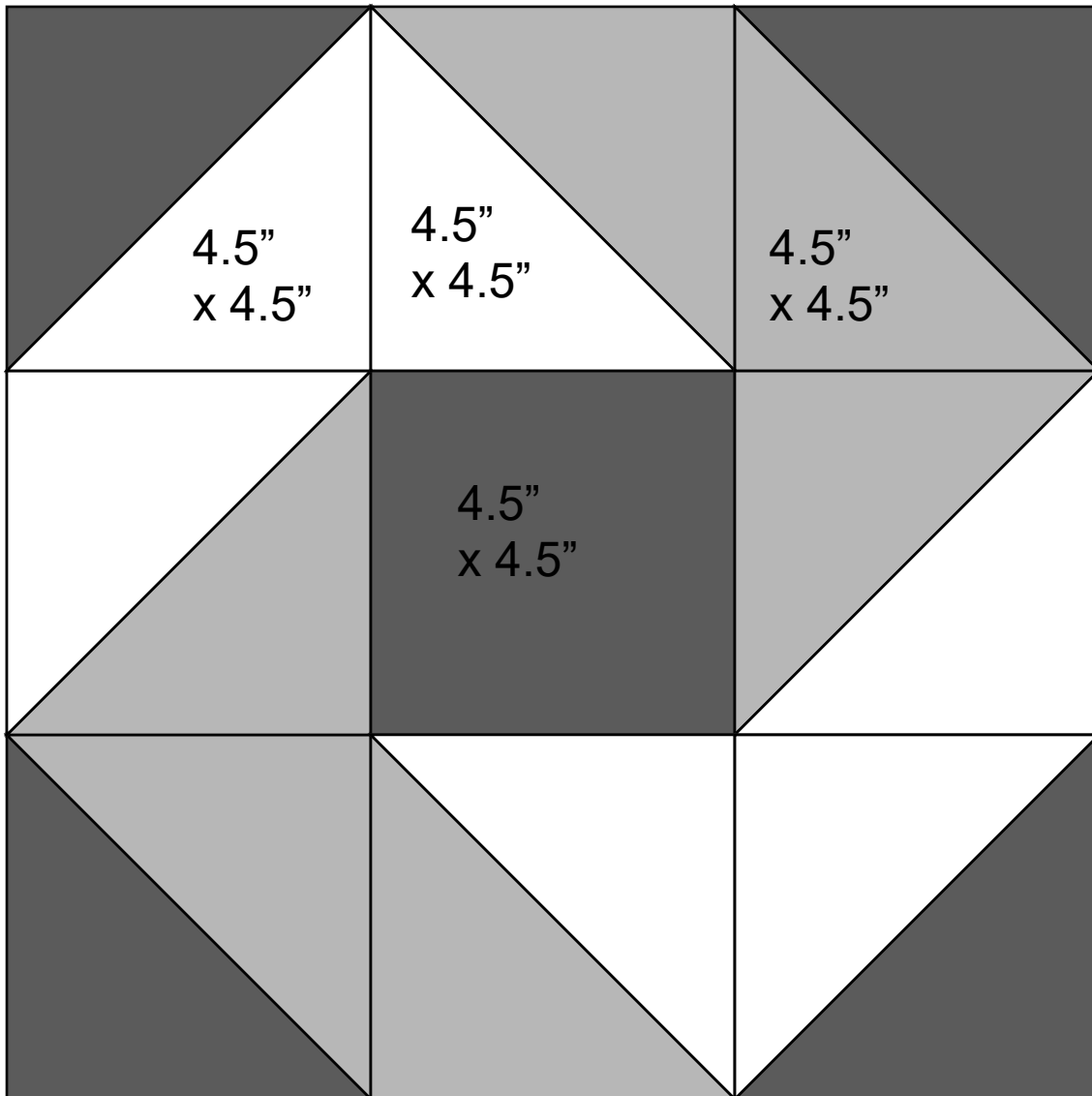

Block is 12.5" x 12.5"

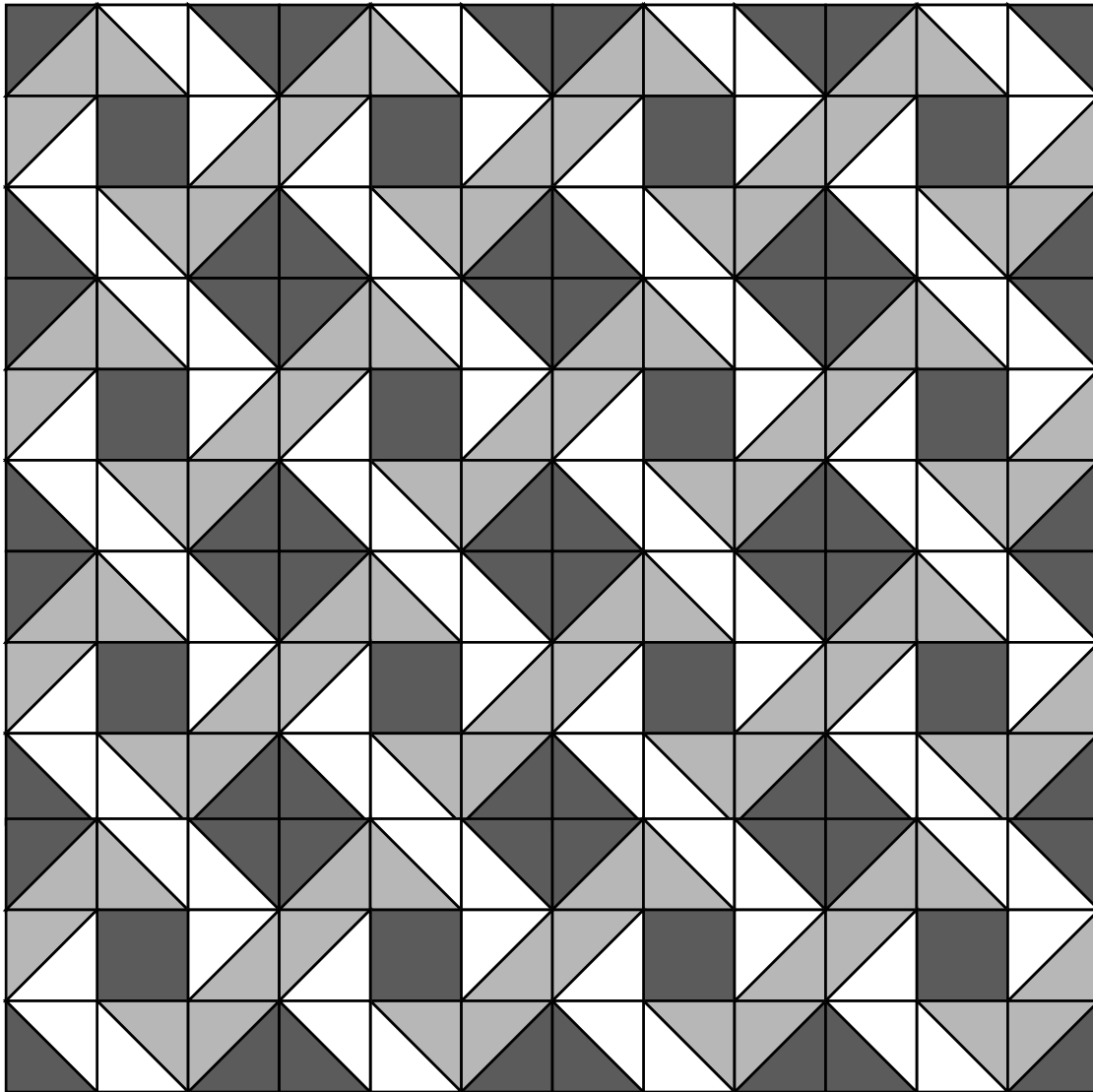
IN the Quilt it is finished size 12" x 12"

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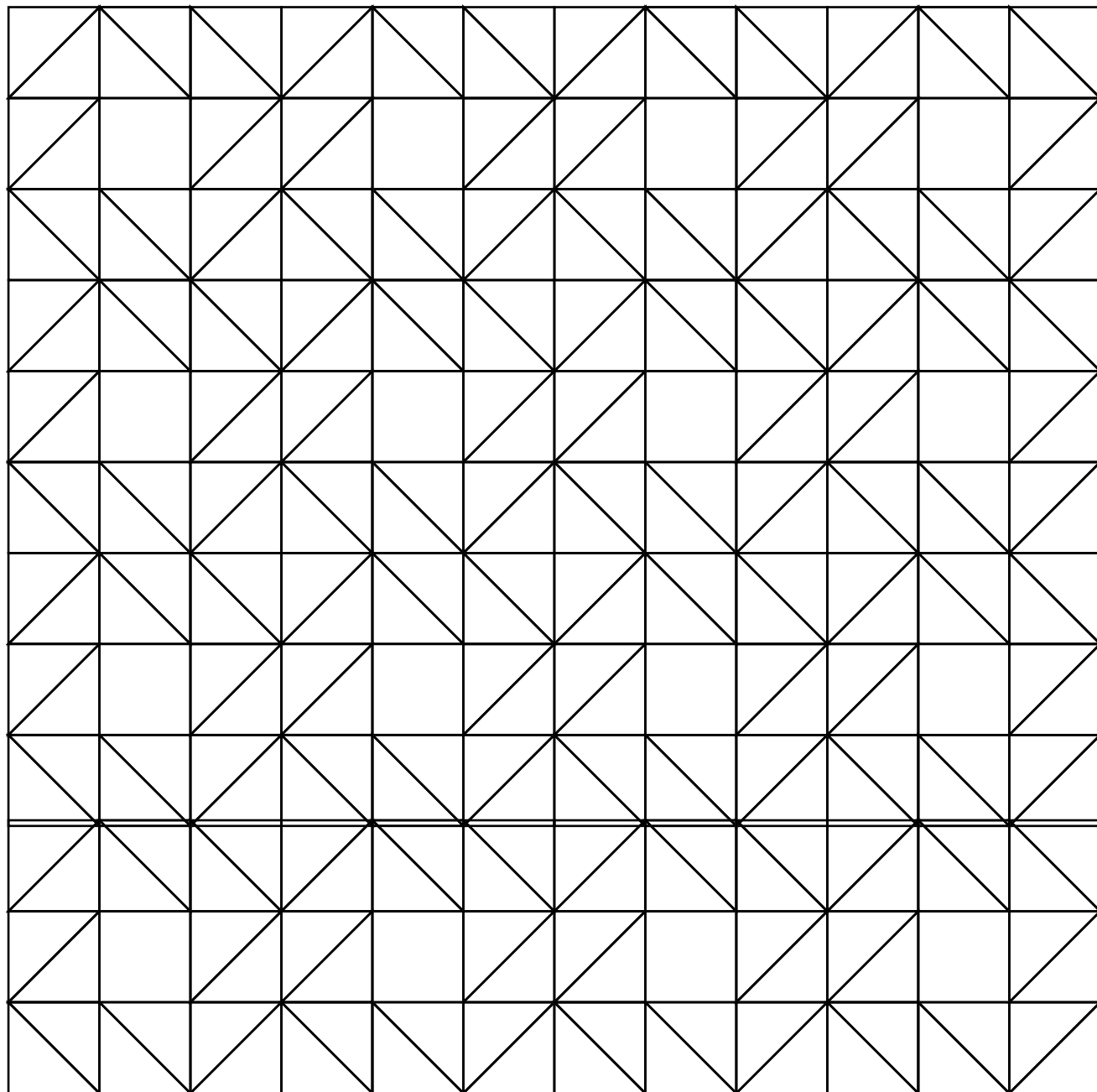

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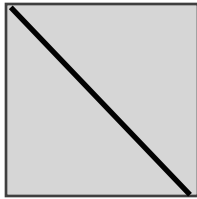

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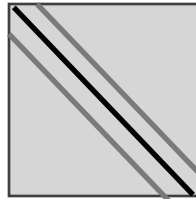
Half Square Triangles Tutorial

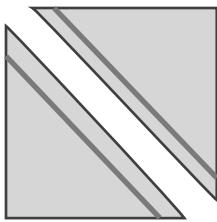
Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2

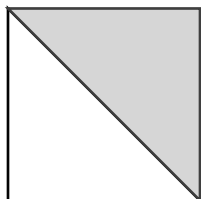
- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

Step 4



-Trim squares to size needed using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
