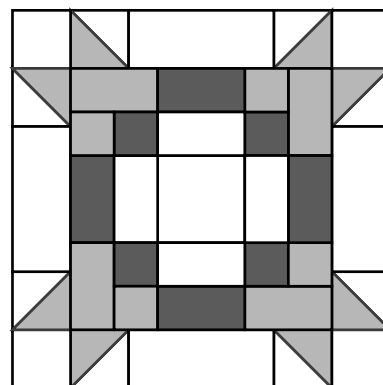

Cutting & Sewing

Light Fabric

- Cut 1 square 3.5" x 3.5"
- Cut 4 rectangles 2" x 3.5"

Medium Fabric -

- Cut 4 rectangles 2" x 3.5"
- Cut 4 squares 2" x 2"

Dark Fabric 2 different fabrics

- Cut 4 rectangles 2" x 3.5"
- Cut 4 squares 2" x 2"

Background Fabric

- Cut 4 squares 3" x 3" for HST
- Cut 4 squares 2.5" x 2.5"
- Cut 4 rectangles 2.5" x 5.5"

Star points Fabric

- Cut 4 squares 3" x 3" for HST

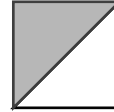

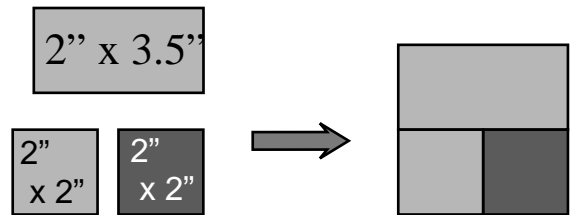

Directions

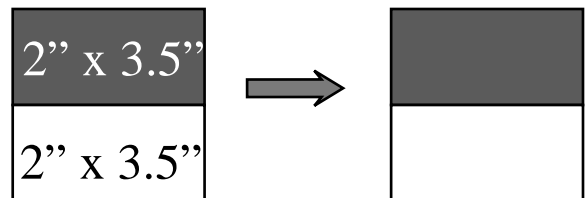
1) Using the 3" background and 3" Star point fabric squares make HSTs using method on last page.
Make 8 units - trim to 2.5" square



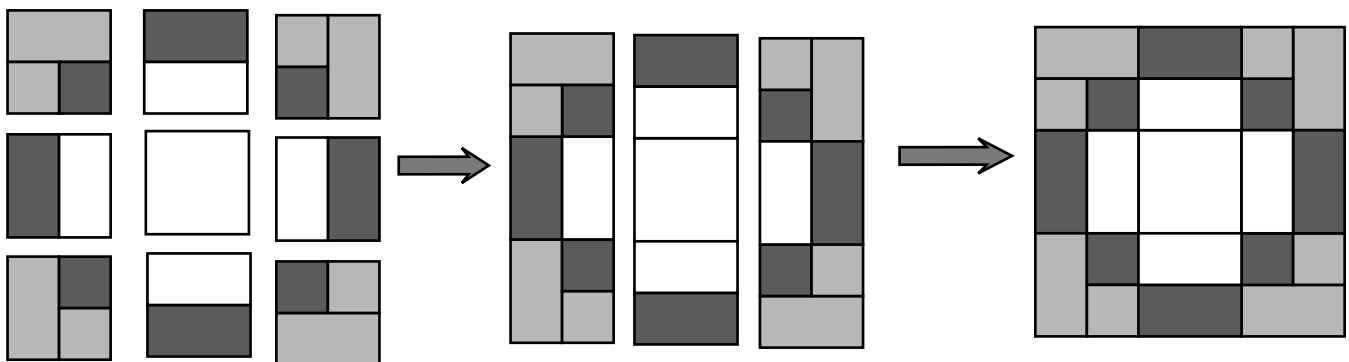
2) Following the Diagram, sew the medium and dark squares to each other.
Sew the medium rectangle to the top
Make 4 units - Measures 3.5" x 3.5"



3) Following the Diagram, sew the dark and light rectangles to each other
Make 4 units - Measures 3.5" x 3.5"

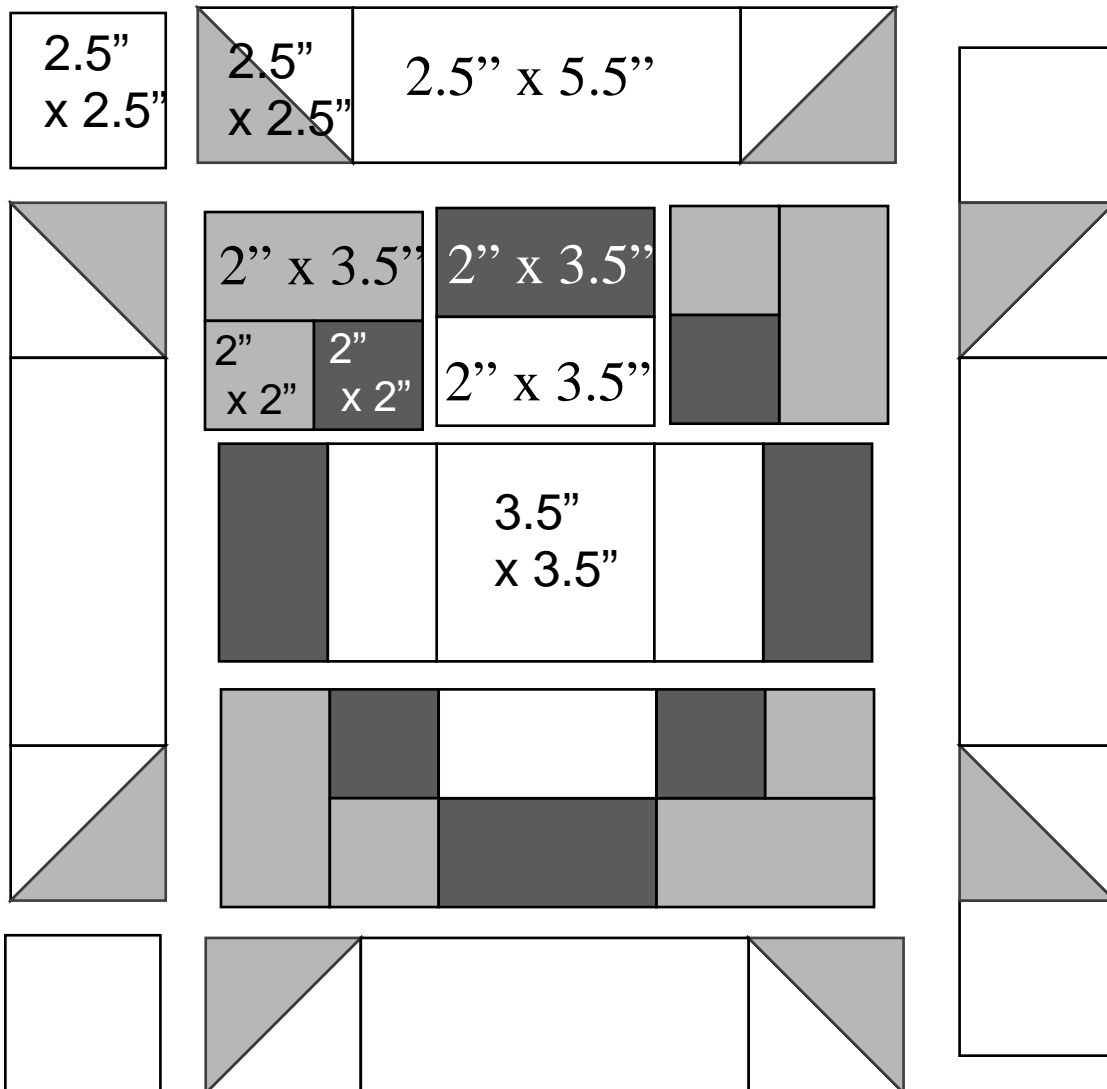


4) Following the Diagram, sew the Units from above and the light 3.5" square
Make 1 unit - Measures 9.5" x 9.5"



Following diagram on next page
Set the block into the star frame

Unfinished Sizes



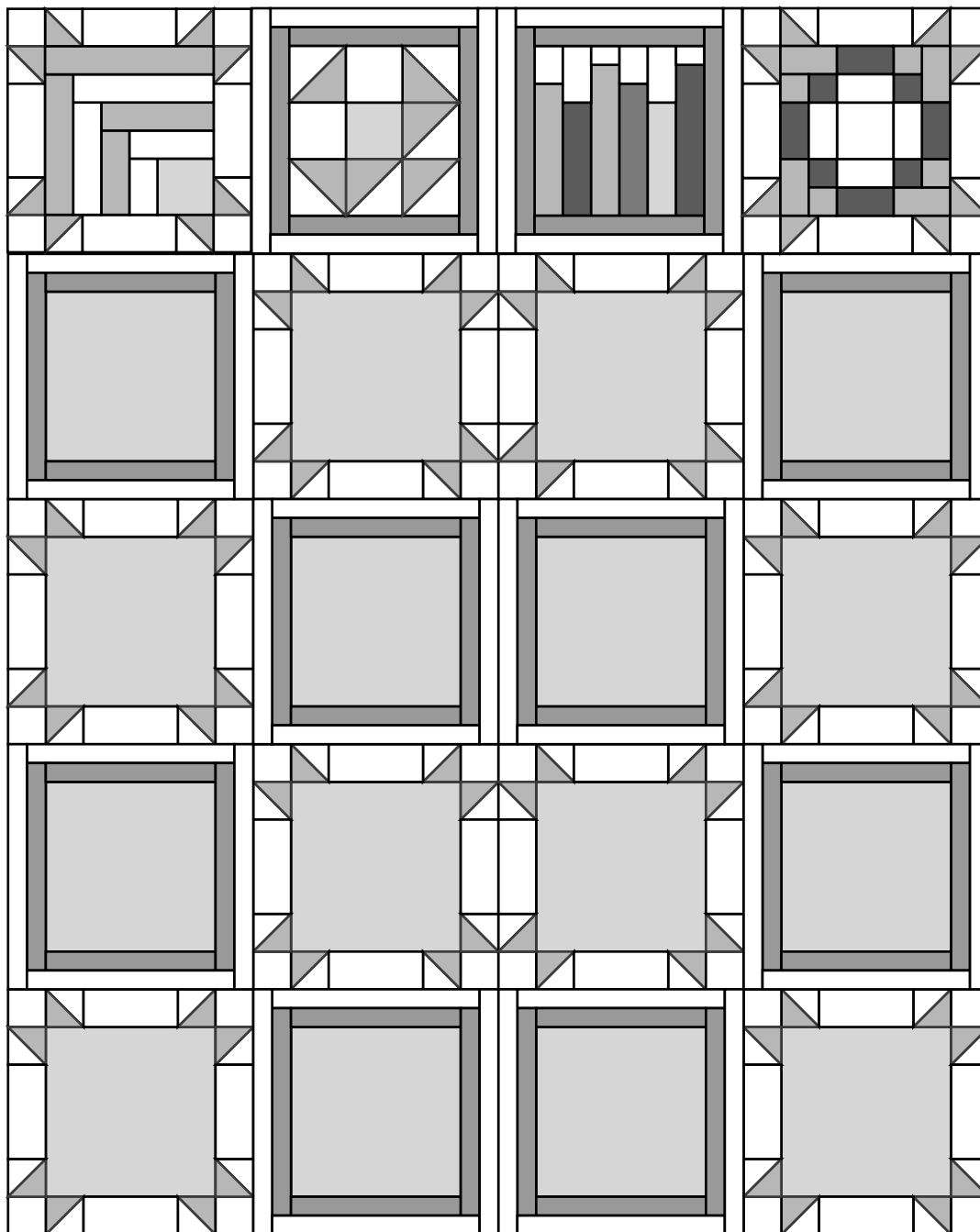
Square the Block to 13.5" x 13.5"

IN the Quilt it is finished size 13" x 13"

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52" x 65"

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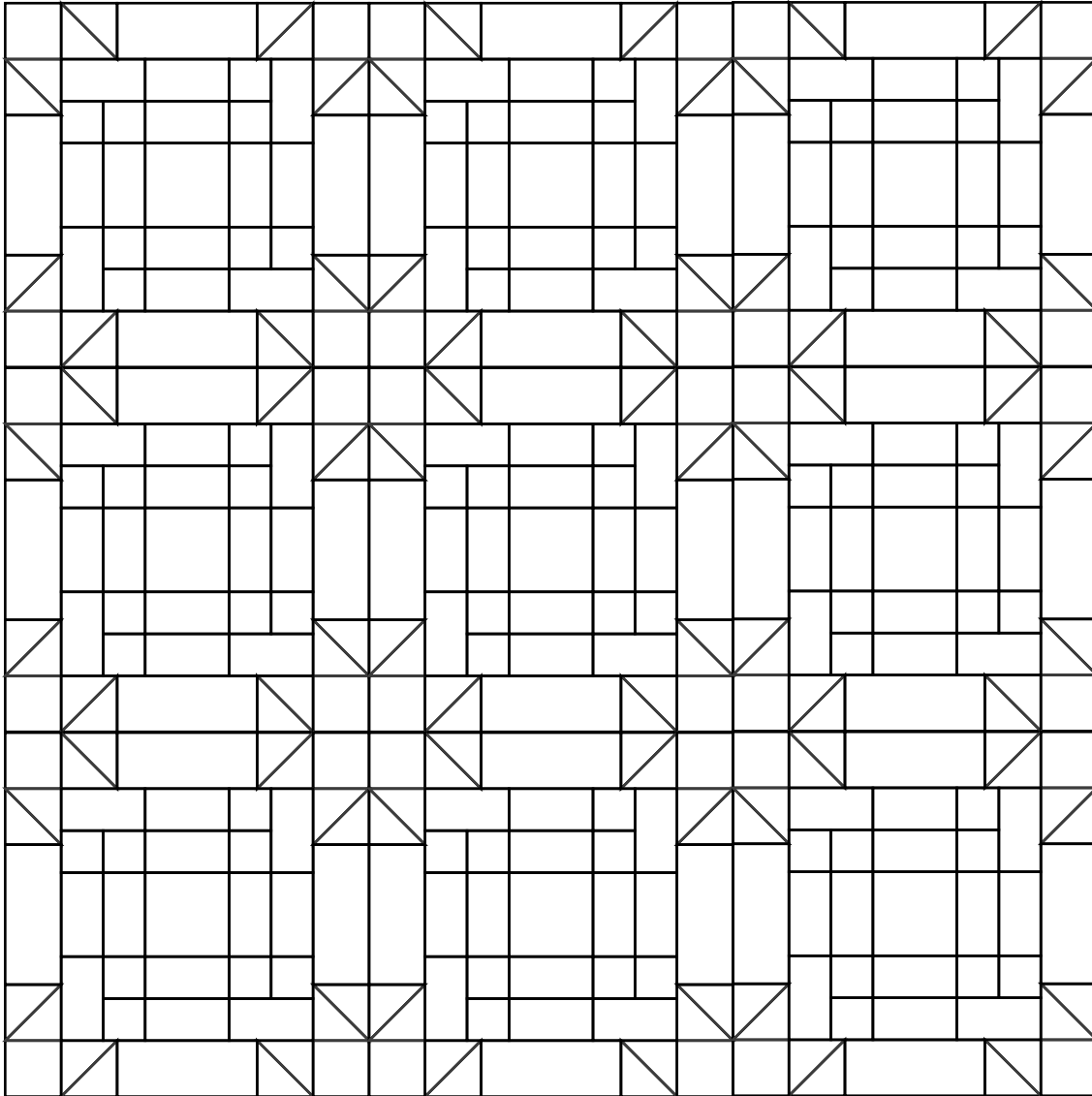

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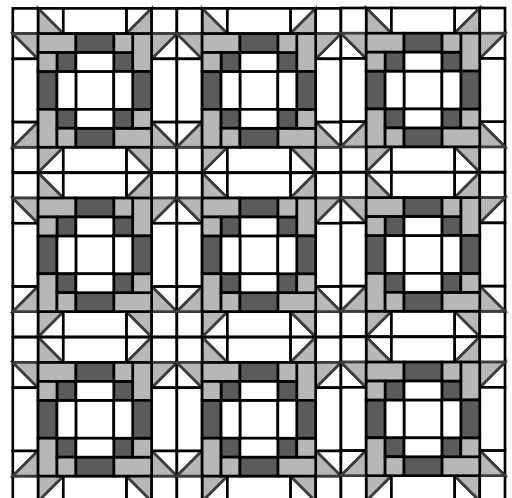

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Half Square Triangles Tutorial

Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2

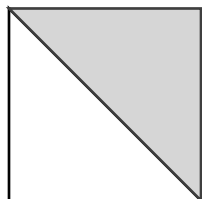
- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

Step 4



-Trim squares to 2.5" x 2.5" using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
