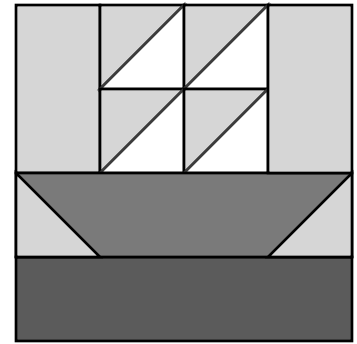

Cutting Directions

Sky fabrics

- Cut 2 strips 3.5" x 6.5"
- Cut 2 squares 4" x 4" for making Half Square Triangles (HST)
- Cut 2 squares 3.5" x 3.5"

Sail fabric

- Cut 2 squares 4" x 4" for making HST

Boat Fabric

- Cut 1 strip 3.5" x 12.5"

Water Fabric

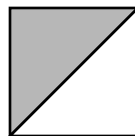
- Cut 1 strip 3.5" x 12.5"

Directions

Using the 4" sky and 4" sail fabric squares make HSTs using method on the last page

Trim to 3.5" square

Make 4 units



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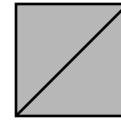
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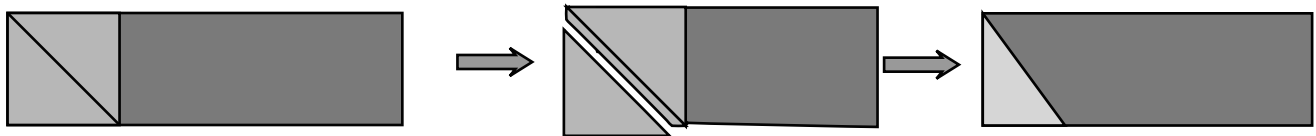
Directions

2) Draw a diagonal line on the back of the 3.5" sky squares



3) Following diagram place the 3.5" square on a 3.5" x 12.5" boat fabric square, right sides together sew ON the line.
Measures 3.5" x 12.5"
Make 1

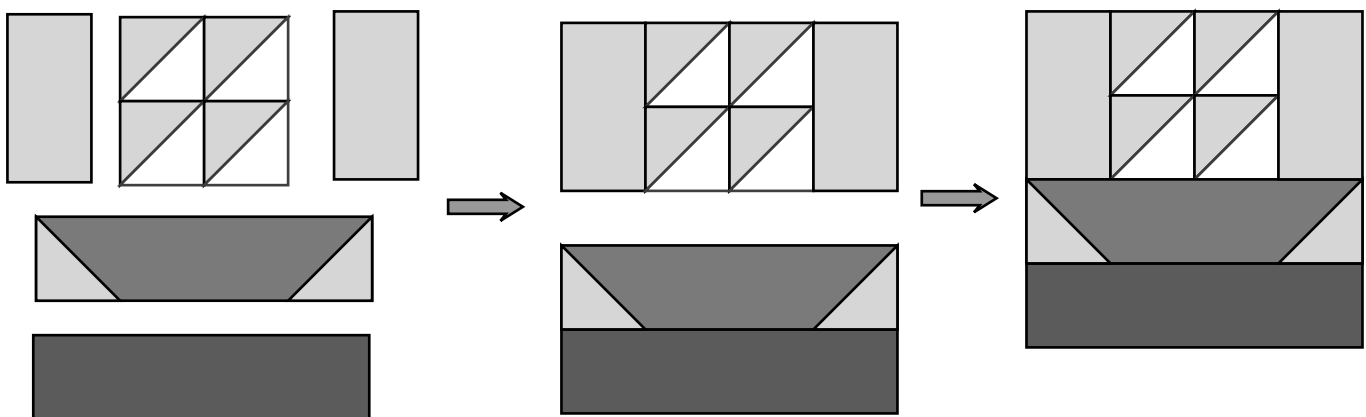
4) Following diagram trim away Leaving a 1/4" seam allowance
Trim all
Measures 3.5" x 12.5"



5) Following diagram above repeat with a sky square on the other end of the boat
Measures 3.5" x 12.5"



6) Following the diagram, use the 3.5" x 6.5" sky rectangles, the water fabric, and the units from above to sew the block
Measures 12.5" x 12.5"
Make 1



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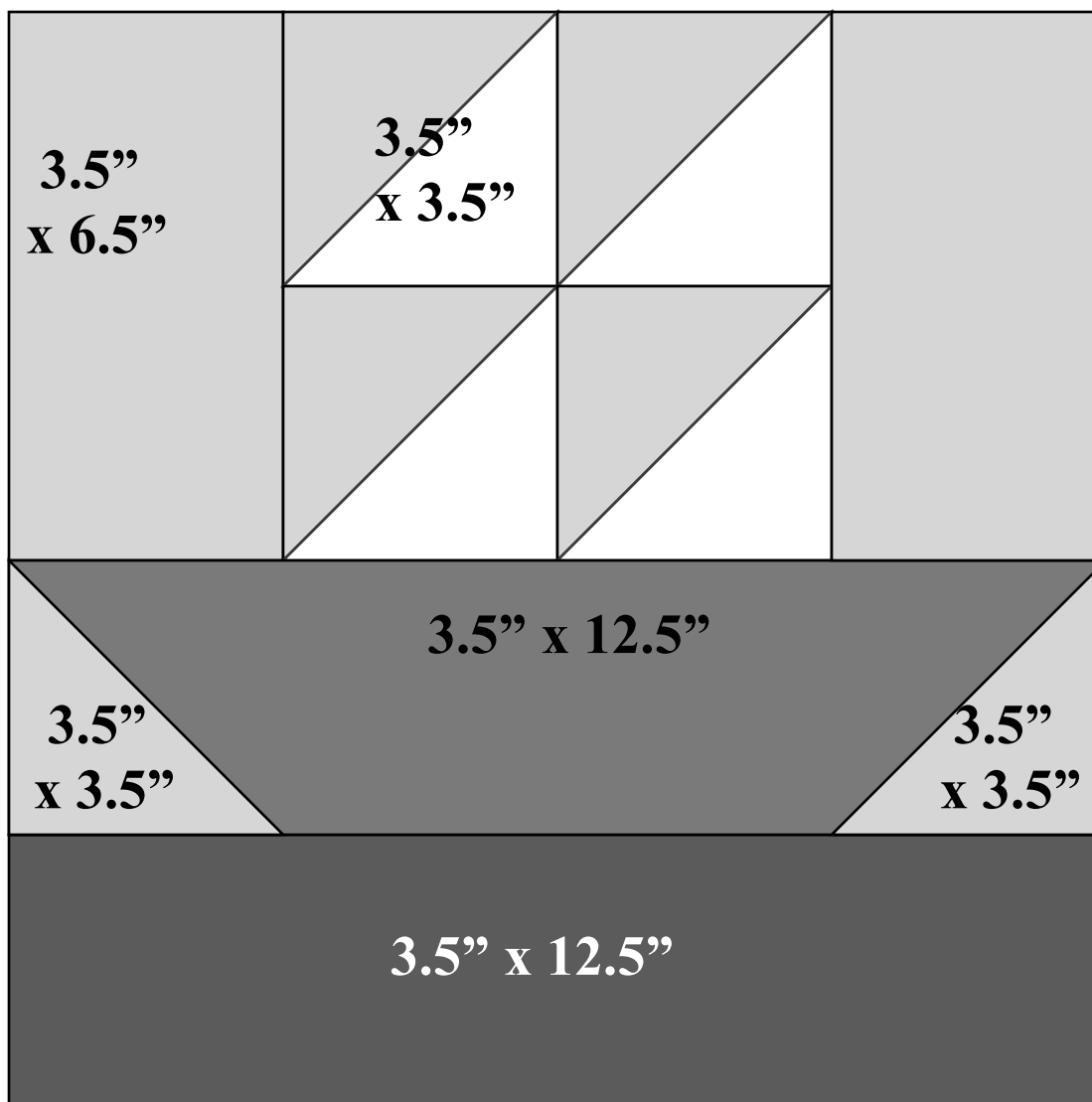

IN the Quilt it is finished size 12'' x 12''

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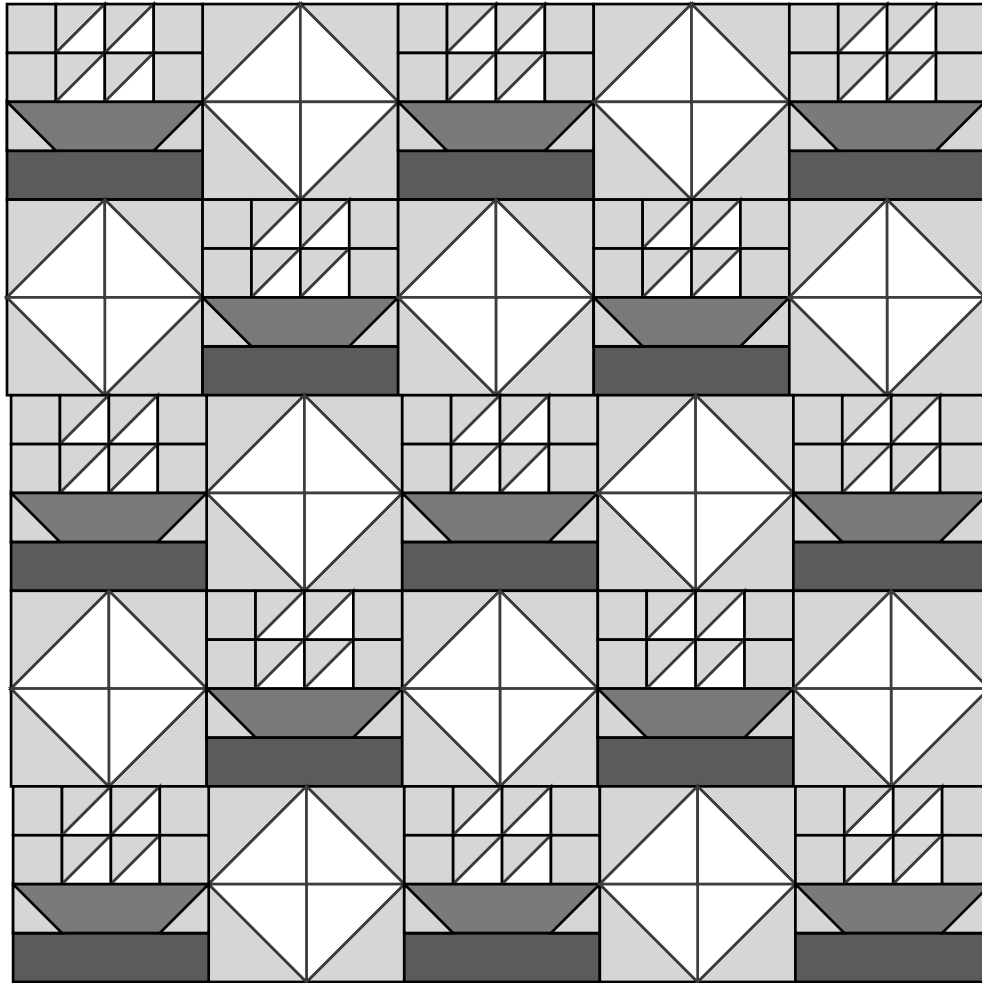
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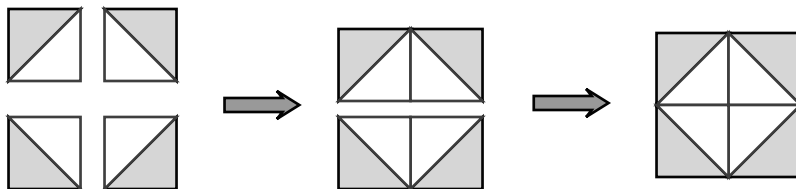

Assemble Alternate Block - Make 12 - measures 12.5" x 12.5"



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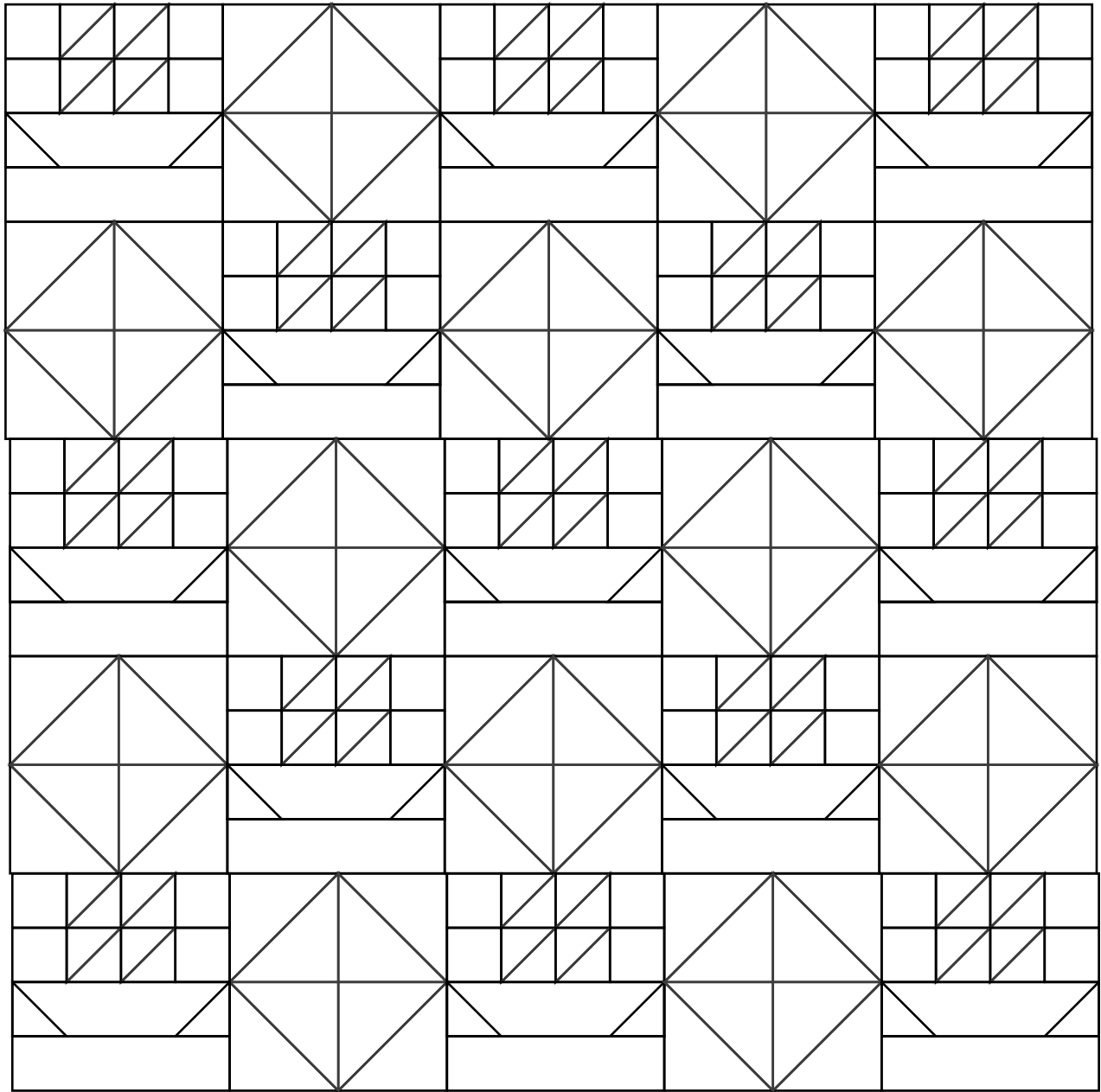

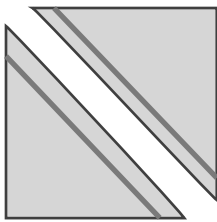
Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2

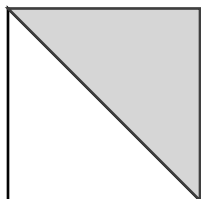
- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

Step 4



-Trim squares to 3.5" x 3.5" using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
