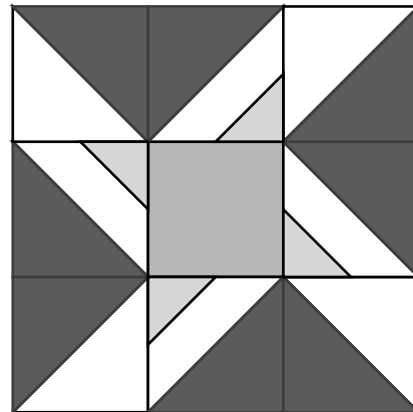
Block 4 – Camp Food

Block is 12.5" x 12.5"
Finished size 12"x 12"

Cutting & Sewing

Light Fabric

– Cut 4 squares 5" x 5" for HST

Medium Fabric -

– Cut 4 squares 3" x 3"

Center Fabric -

– Cut 1 square 4.5" x 4.5"

Dark Fabric -

– Cut 4 squares 5" x 5" for HST

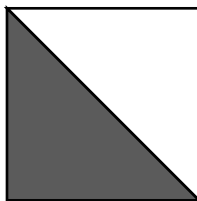
** HST - Half Square Triangle

Directions

1) Using the 5" light and 5" Dark fabric squares make HSTs using method on my separate HST PDF or use one of the other methods from my Triangle book

trim to 4.5" square

Make 8 units



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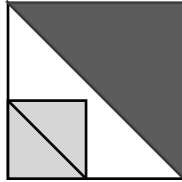
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Directions

1) Following the diagram, place a 3" medium square on the LIGHT corner of a 4.5" square. Sew ON the line.

Make 4

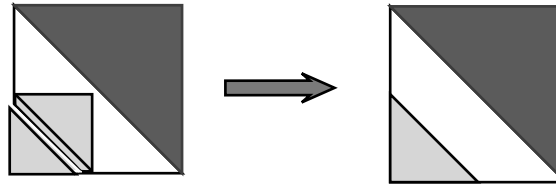
Measures 4.5" x 4.5"



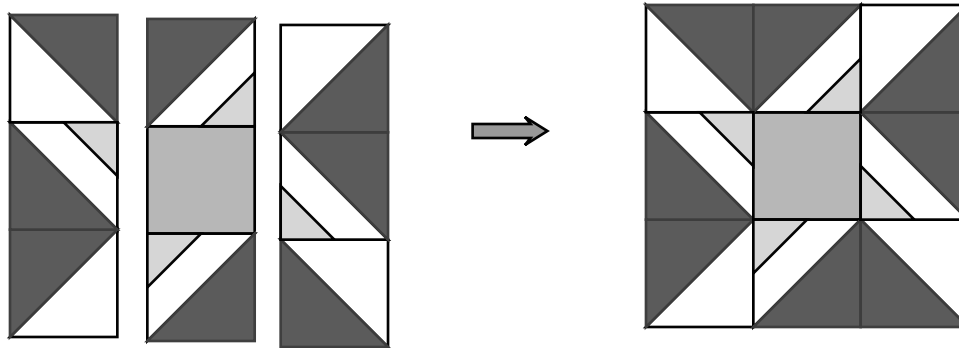
2) Following the diagram trim away leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make star points. Press triangles open.

Make 4

Measures 4.5" x 4.5"



3) Following diagram carefully place the star point blocks and sew the block
Measures 12.5" x 12.5"



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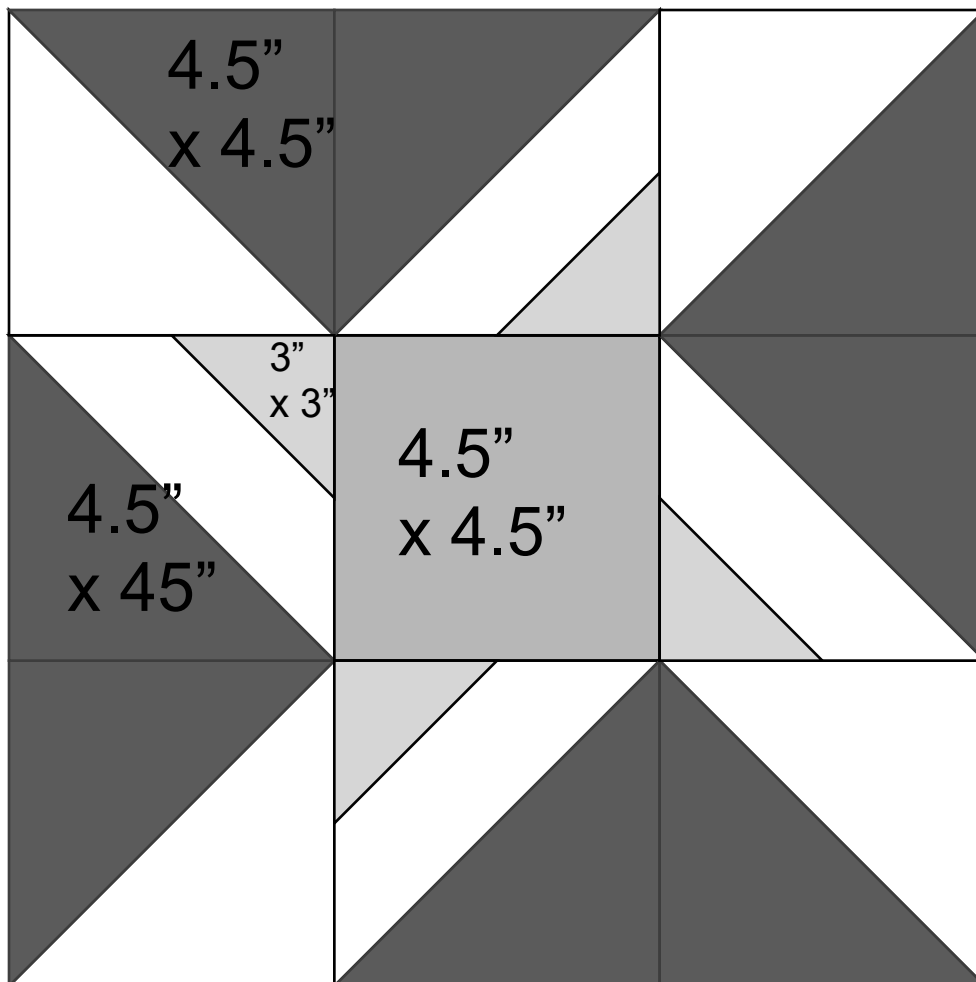
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Sew & Flip Corners

IN the Quilt it is finished size 12" x 12"

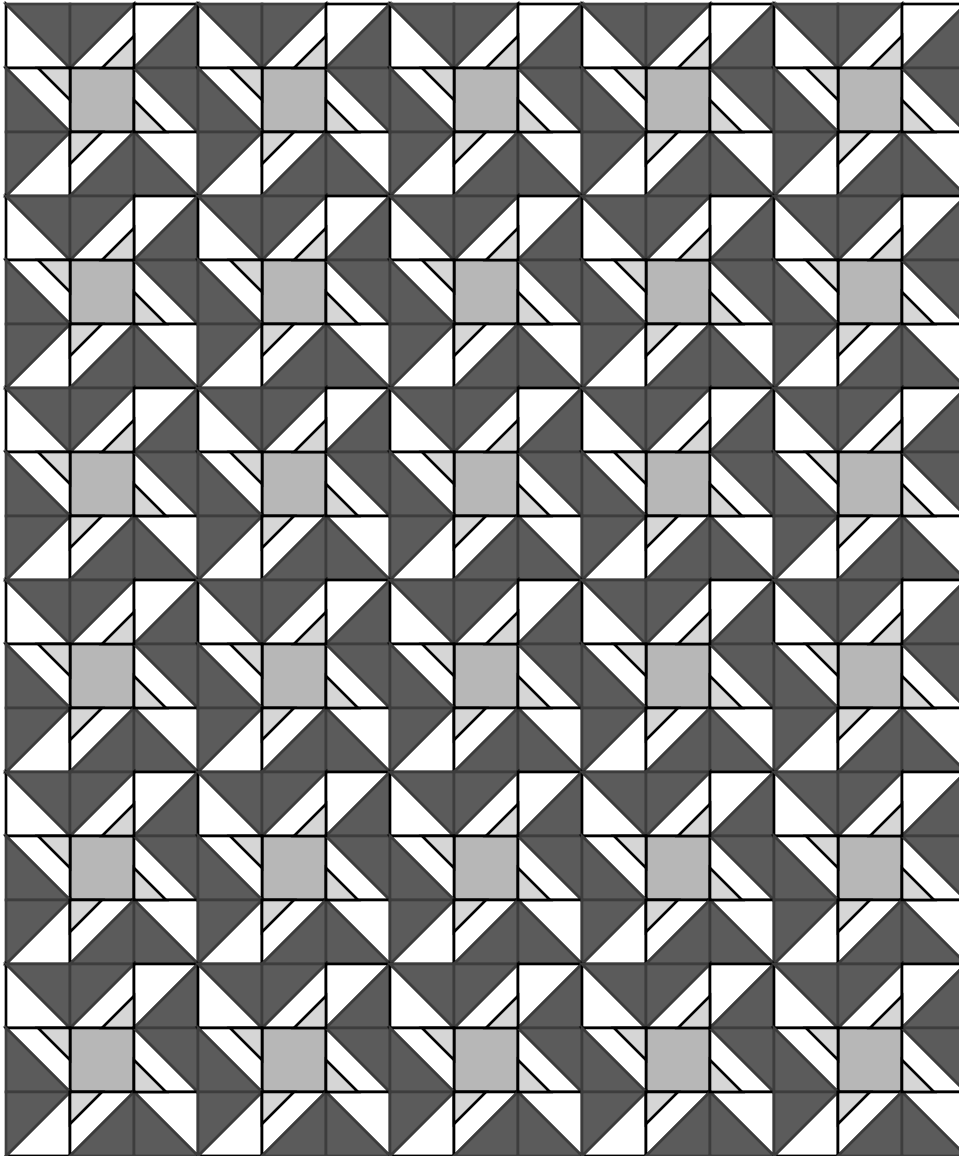

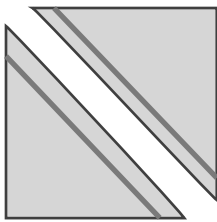
Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2

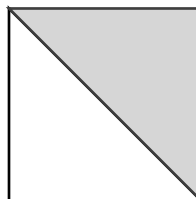
- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

Step 4



-Trim squares to size using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
