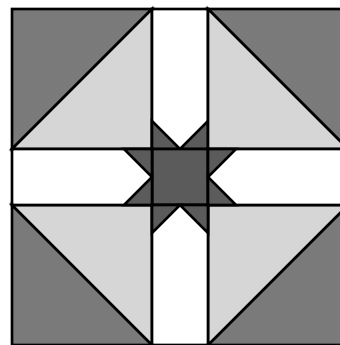


# Fall Frolic

**Block is 12.5" x 12.5"**  
Finished size 12"x 12"

### Cutting

#### Background print

- 4 rectangles 2 1/2" x 5 1/2"

#### Light print

- 2 squares 6" x 6" for HST

#### Dark print

- 2 squares 6" x 6" for HST

#### Star print

- 1 center square 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"  
- 8 squares 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" Draw a diagonal line on each to use for star points.

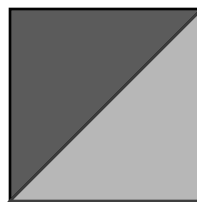
**TIP:** For the 1 1/2" squares try starching your fabric BEFORE you cut the squares. You may find them easier to handle with less stretch

### Directions

1) Using the 6" light and 6" dark fabric squares make HSTs using method on my separate HST PDF or use one of the other methods from my Triangle book

trim to 5.5" square

Make 4 units

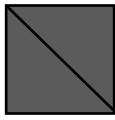

## (2) Directions for star portion



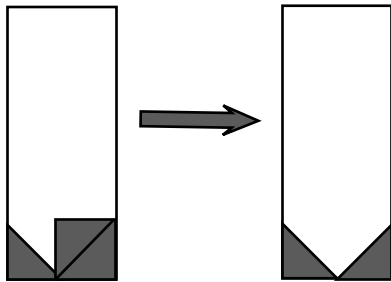
### Step 1 Directions

- 1) Draw a diagonal line on all of the 1 1/2" dark squares



### Step 2 Directions

- 1) Following the diagram, Place a 1 1/2" dark square on the background rectangle
- 2) Sew on the line.
- 3) Flip over and press, check the back to be sure it matches up to the rectangle
- 4) Trim away the excess corner fabric behind the triangle. Leave a 1/4" seam.
- 3) Make 4



### Step 3 Directions

- 1) Following the diagram, repeat step 2 for the 2<sup>nd</sup> star point
- 2) Make 4

Each measure 2.5" x 5.5"

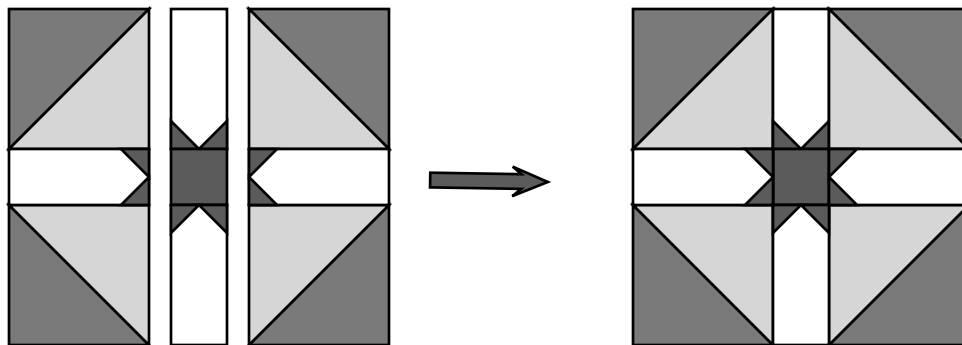

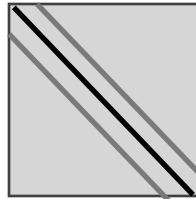
## Half Square Triangles Tutorial

"Pat Sloan's Teach Me to Sew Triangles"**



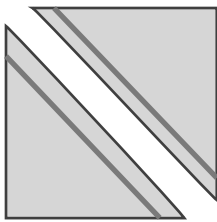
**Step 1**

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



**Step 2**

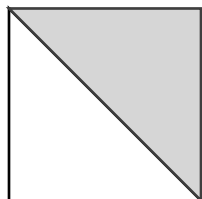
- Layer the 2 squares  
- Sew a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on both Sides of the drawn line



**Step 3**

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

**Step 4**



-Trim squares to size using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
