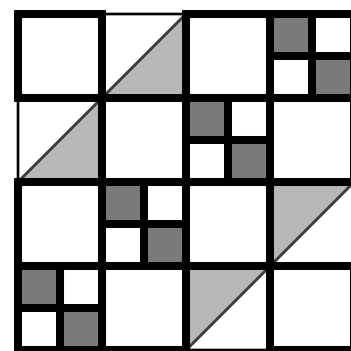

## Ruler Cutting

### Light fabrics

- Cut 8 squares 3.5" x 3.5"
- Cut 2 squares 4" x 4"
- Cut 8 squares 2" x 2"

### Medium fabrics

- Cut 2 squares 4" x 4"

### Dark Fabric

- Cut 8 squares 2" x 2"

## Gemini Die Cutting

### Light fabrics

- Cut 8 squares 3.5" x 3.5"
- Cut 4 triangles 3.5" x 3.5"
- Cut 8 squares 2" x 2"

### Medium fabrics

- Cut 4 triangles 3.5" x 3.5"

### Dark Fabric

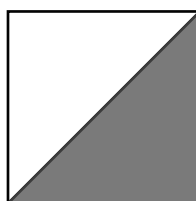
- Cut 8 squares 2" x 2"

## Directions

1) Using the 4" light and 4" medium fabric squares make HSTs using method on my separate HST PDF or use one of the other methods from my Triangle book

trim to 3.5" square

Make 4 units

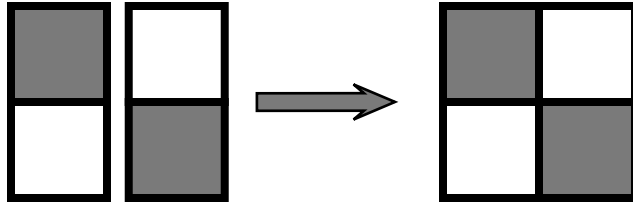

## Directions

2) Alternating the 2" light and 2" dark fabric squares to make 4patch units

Make 4

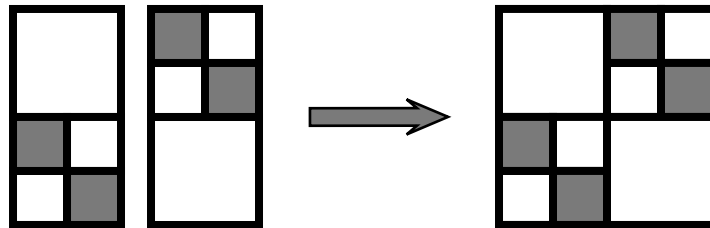
Measure 3.5" x 3.5"



3) Alternate the 4patch units and the 3.5" light squares - NOTE direction of the dark blocks

Make 2

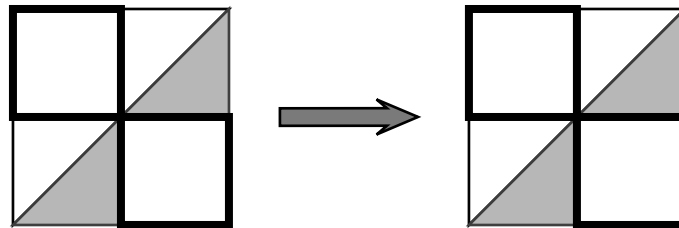
Measures 6.5" x 6.5"



4) Alternate the HSTs and the remaining squares together

Make 2

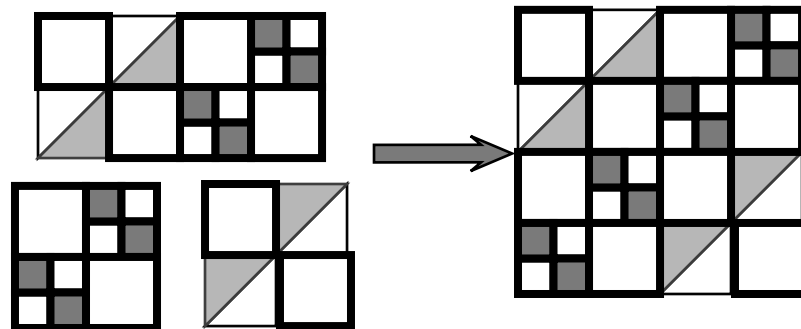
Measures 6.5" x 6.5"

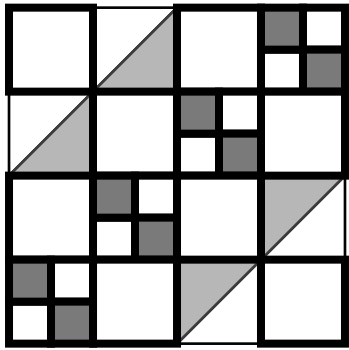


5) Alternate the the 4 units for the block - NOTE Direction of the blocks

Make 1

Measures 12.5" x 12.5"





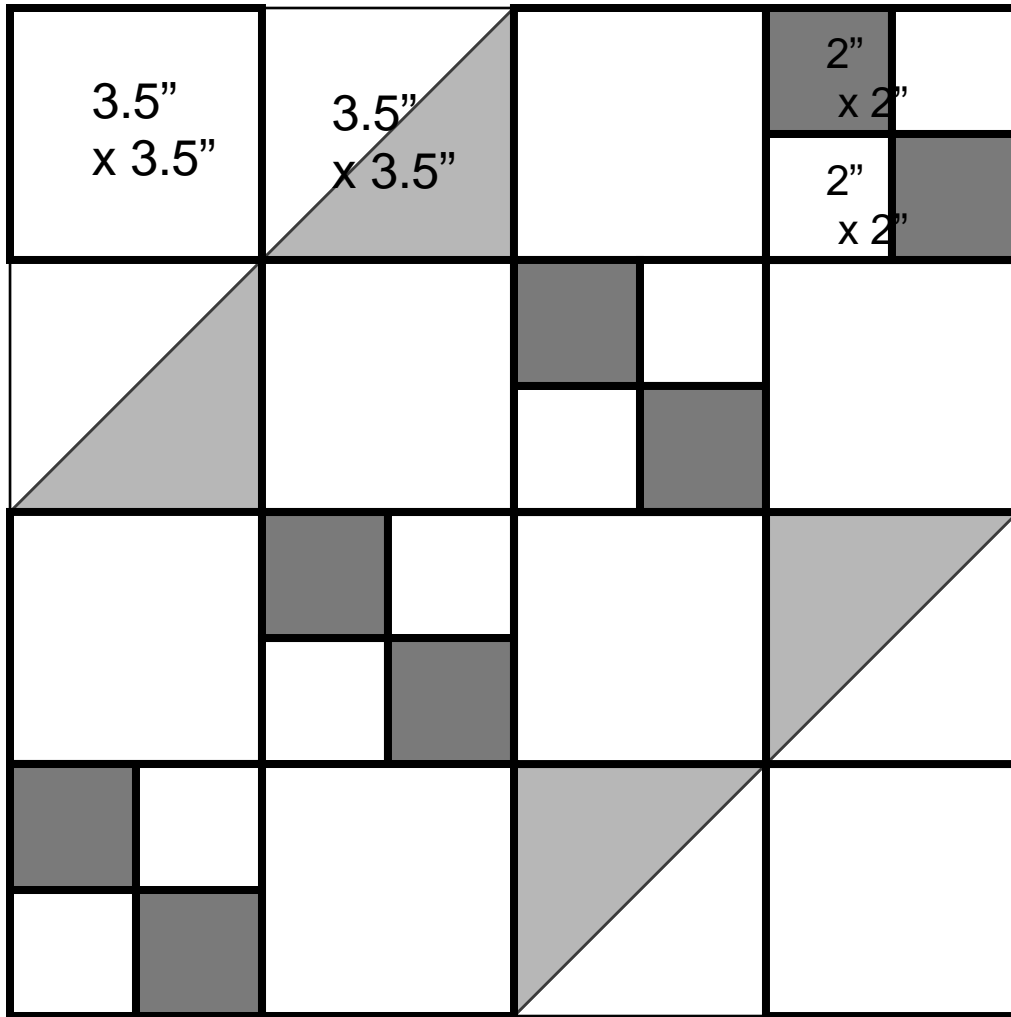

IN the Quilt it is finished size 12" x 12"

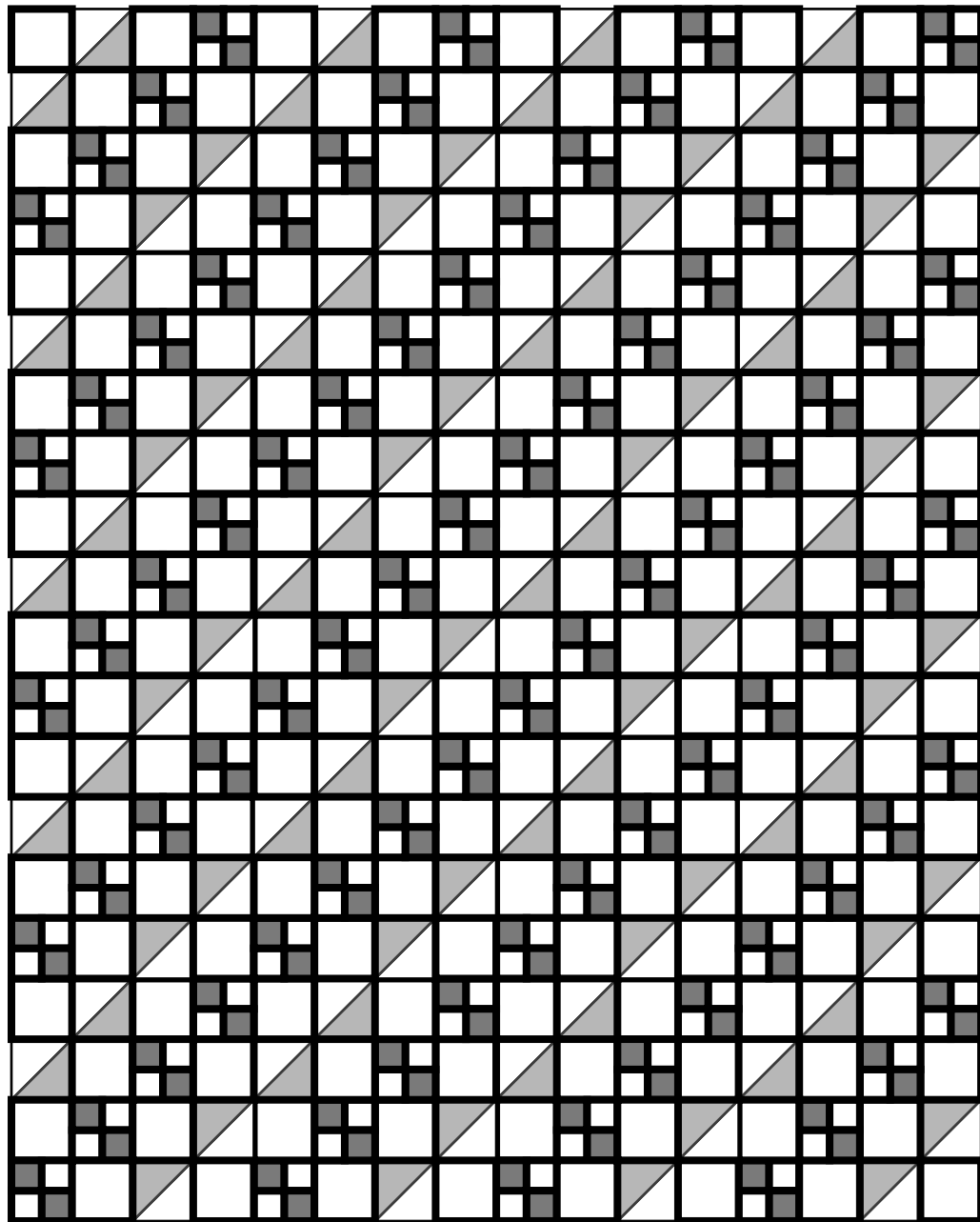

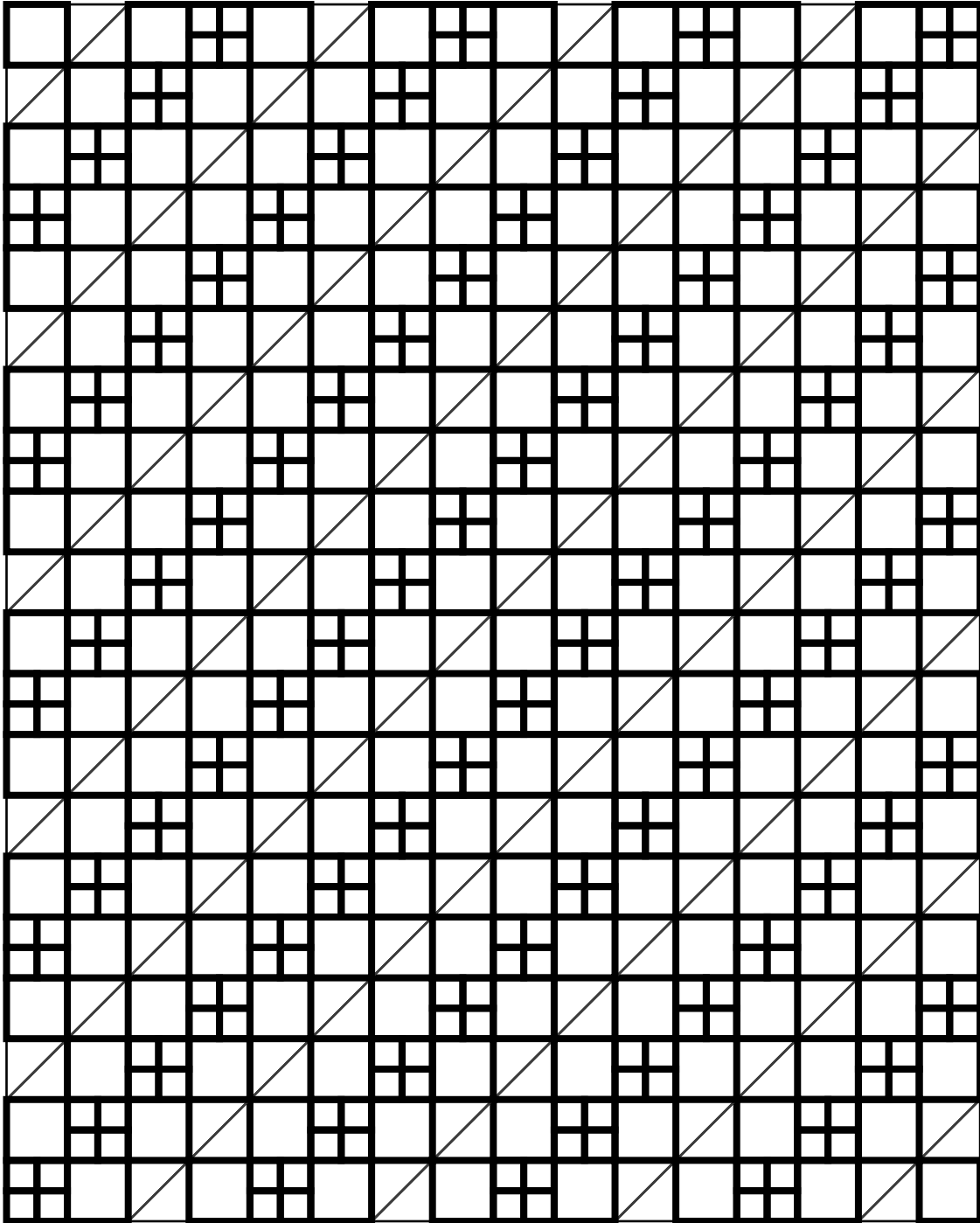
