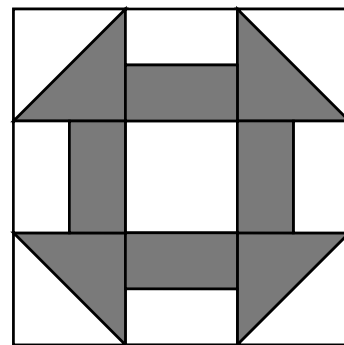

Block is 12.5" x 12.5"
Finished size 12" x 12"

Cutting Directions

Background fabrics

- Cut 2 squares 5" x 5"
- For Half Square Triangles (HST)
- Cut 1 square 4.5" x 4.5"
- Cut 4 rectangles 2.5" x 4.5"

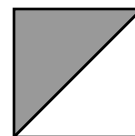
Medium fabric

- Cut 2 squares 5" x 5"
- For Half Square Triangles (HST)
- Cut 4 rectangles 2.5" x 4.5"

Directions

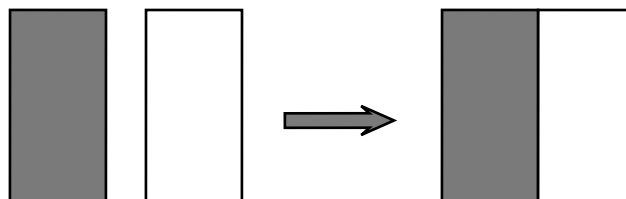
1) Using the 5" medium and 5" background squares make HSTs using method on the last page

Trim to 4.5" square
Make 4 units



2) Following the diagram use the 2.5" x 4.5" medium and 2.5" x 4.5" background rectangles to make the dash unit.

Measures 4.5" x 4.5" square
Make 4 unit

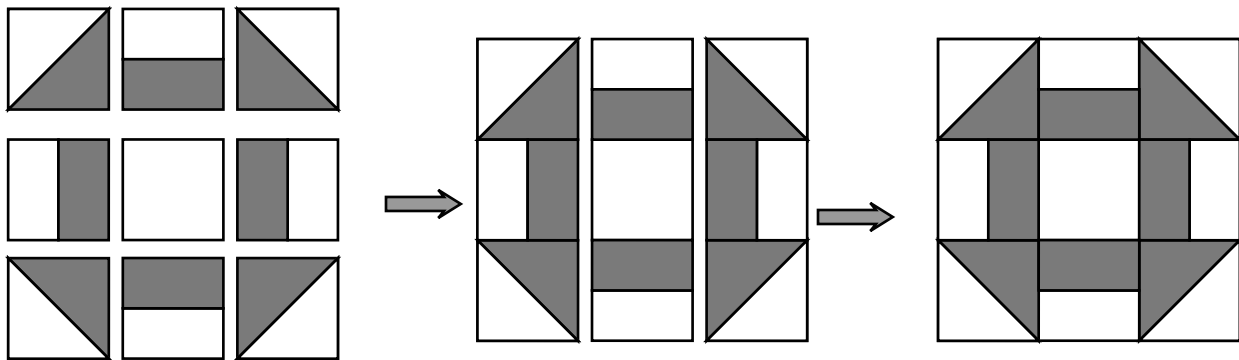

Measures 12.5" x 12.5"

Make 1 block

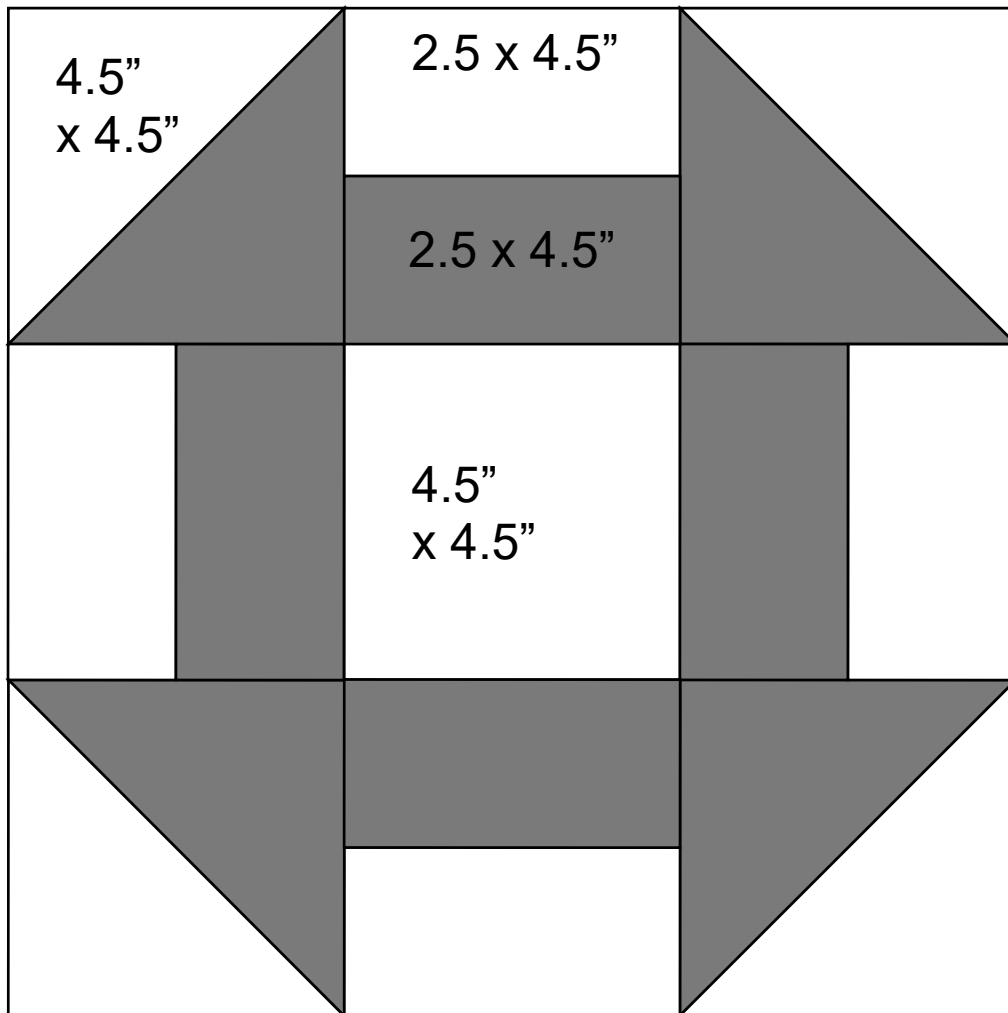

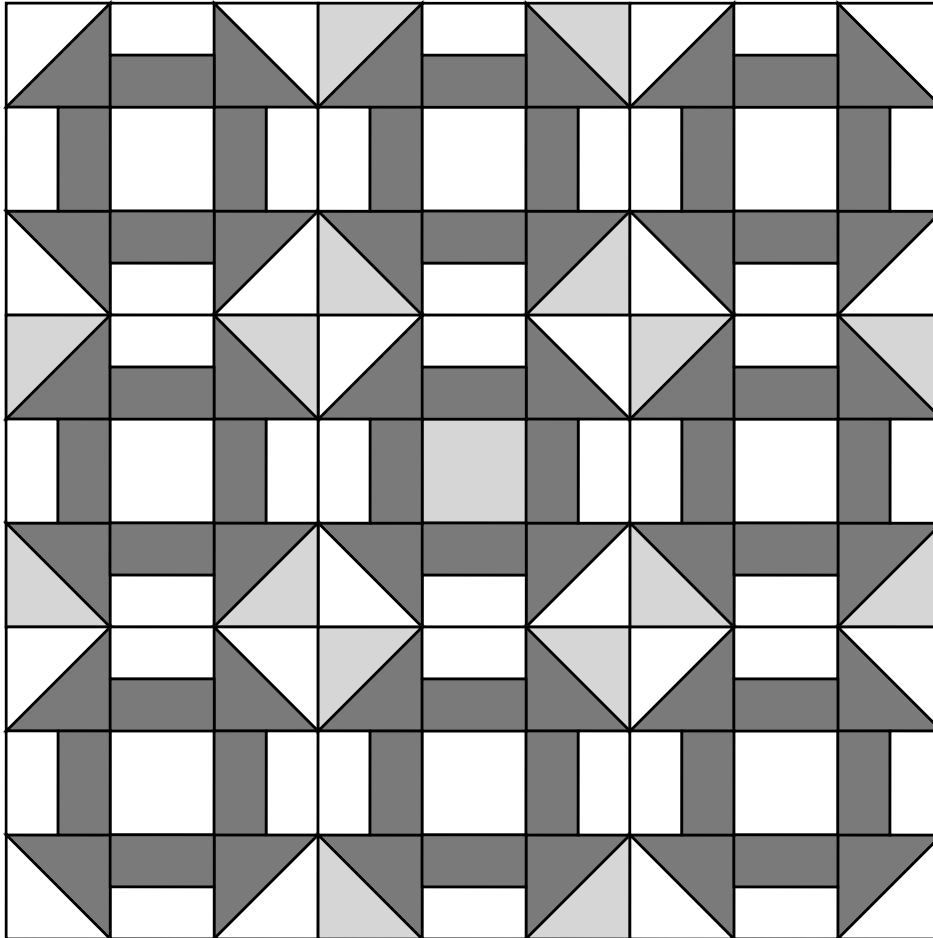

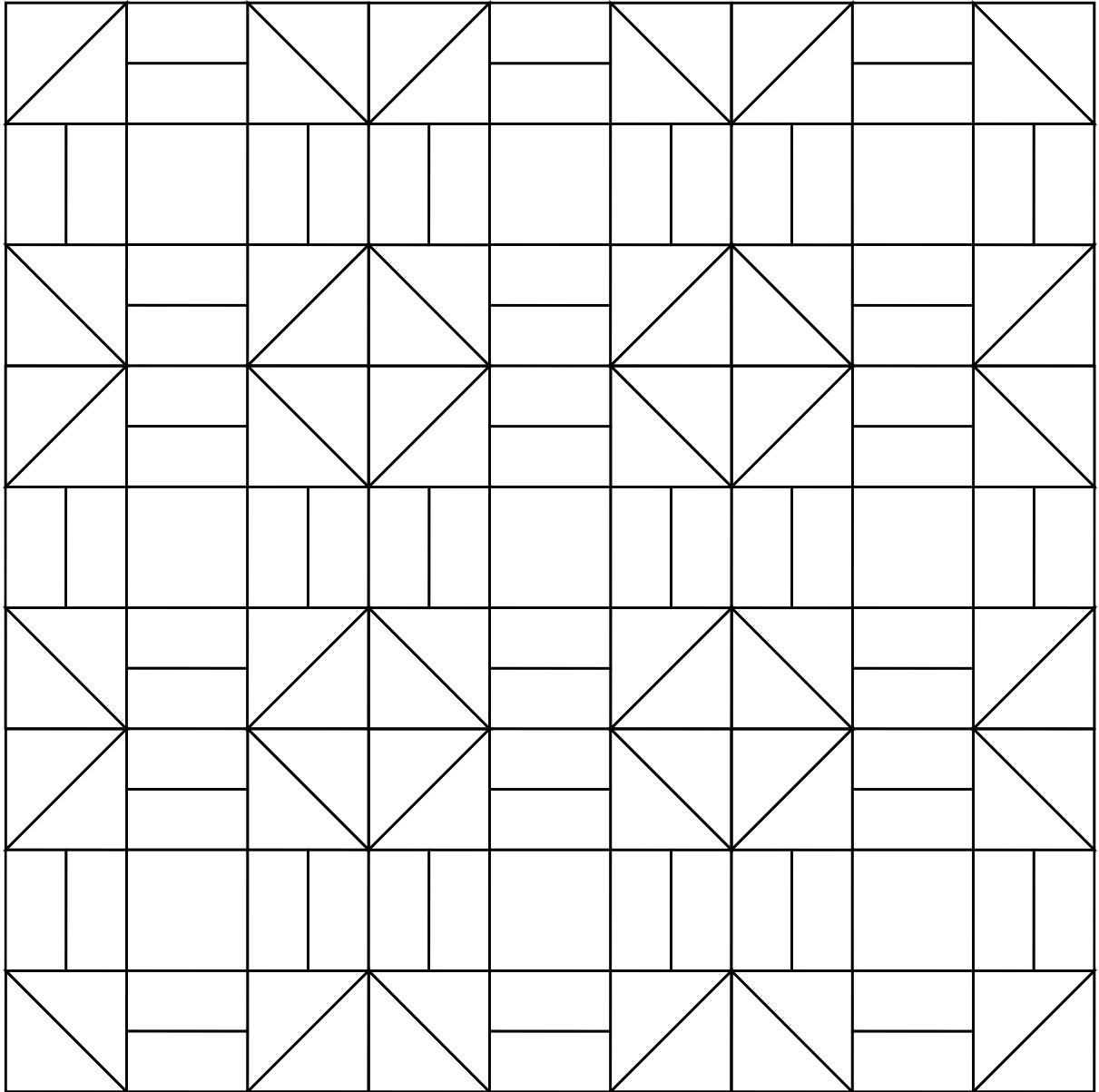

Half Square Triangles Tutorial

**NOTE- For other ways to make HST units, see my book

Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2

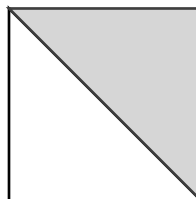
- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

Step 4



-Trim squares to the pattern size using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
