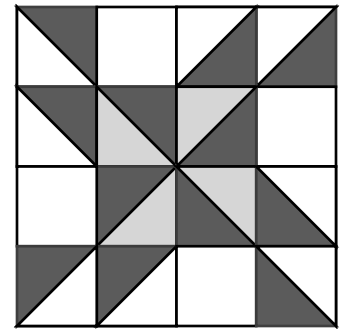


# Childhood Games

**Block is 12.5" x 12.5"**  
Finished size 12" x 12"

The goal is to be the first player to get all four of color pawns from your start space, all the way around the board to your "home" space. If you managed to block your opponents you yelled 'SORRY!!' (not sorry...)

## Cutting Directions

### Light fabrics

- Cut 4 squares 4" x 4" for HST (HST - Half Square Triangle)
- cut 4 squares 3.5" x 3.5"

### Medium fabrics

- Cut 2 squares 4" x 4" for HST (HST - Half Square Triangle)

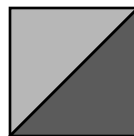
### Dark Fabric

- Cut 6 squares 4" x 4" for HST (HST - Half Square Triangle)

## Directions

1) Using the 4" medium and 4" dark fabric squares make HSTs using method on the last page

trim to 3.5" square  
Make 4 units

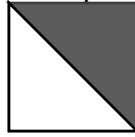

## Directions

2) Using the 4" light and remaining 4" dark fabric squares make HSTs using method on the last page

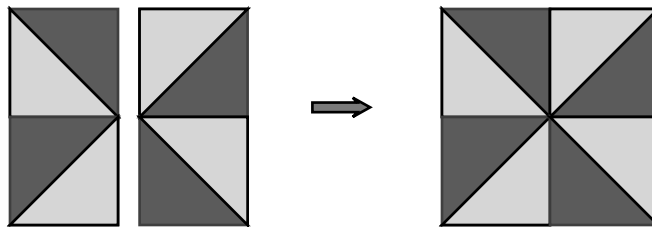


Trim to 3.5" square  
Make 8 units

3) Following the diagram, Assemble the HST units from step #1

Make 1

Measures 6.5" x 6.5"

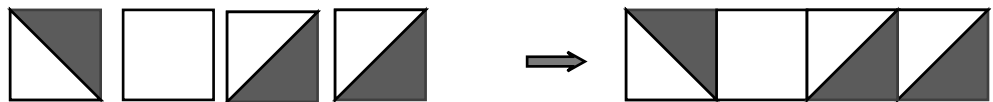


4) Follow the Diagram closely Using a 3.5" light square and 3 HST from step #2

sew the top row

Measures 3.5" x 12.5"

Make 1 unit

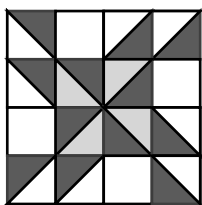


5) Follow the Diagram closely Using a 3.5" light square and 3 HST from step #2

sew the bottom row

Measures 3.5" x 12.5"

Make 1 unit

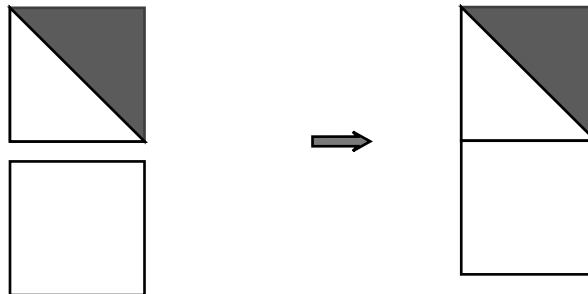

6) Follow the Diagram closely Using a 3.5" light square and a HST from step #2

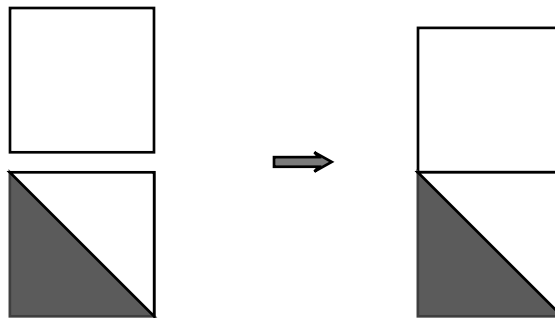
sew the left side

Measures 3.5" x 6.5"

Make 1 unit



7) repeat for the right side

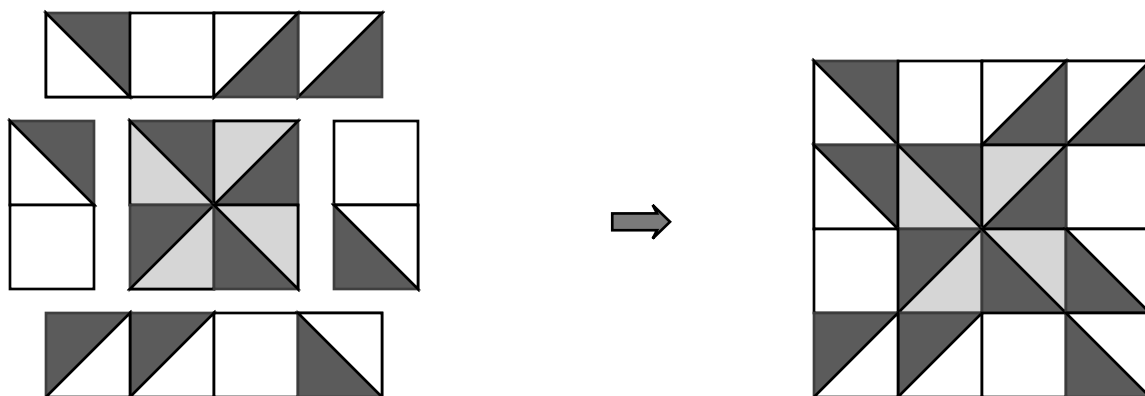


8) Following the diagram, Assemble the units from steps 4 -7 and the center

Pinwheel from step #3

Make 1

Measures 12.5" x 12.5"

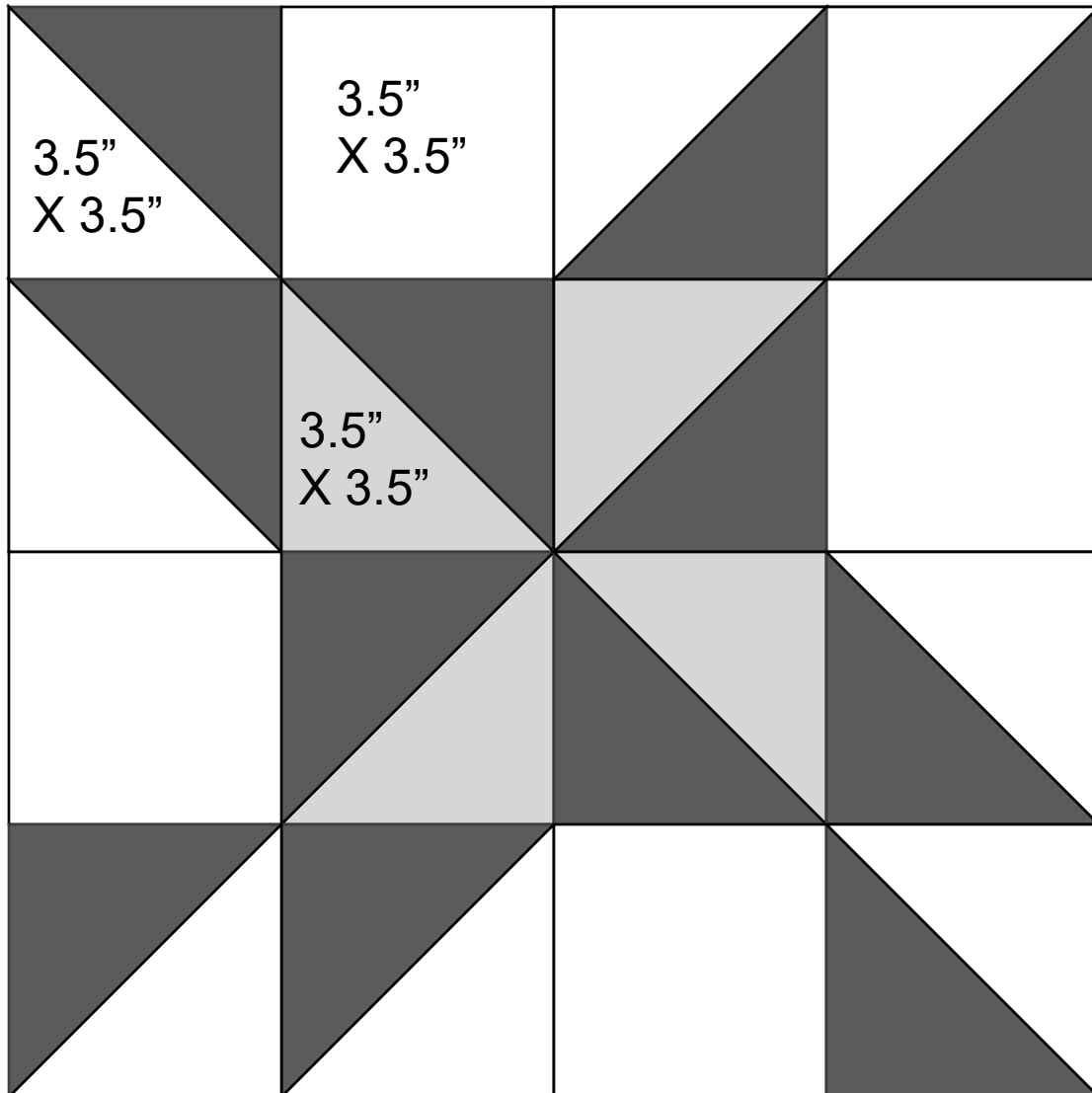

**Block is 12.5" x 12.5"**

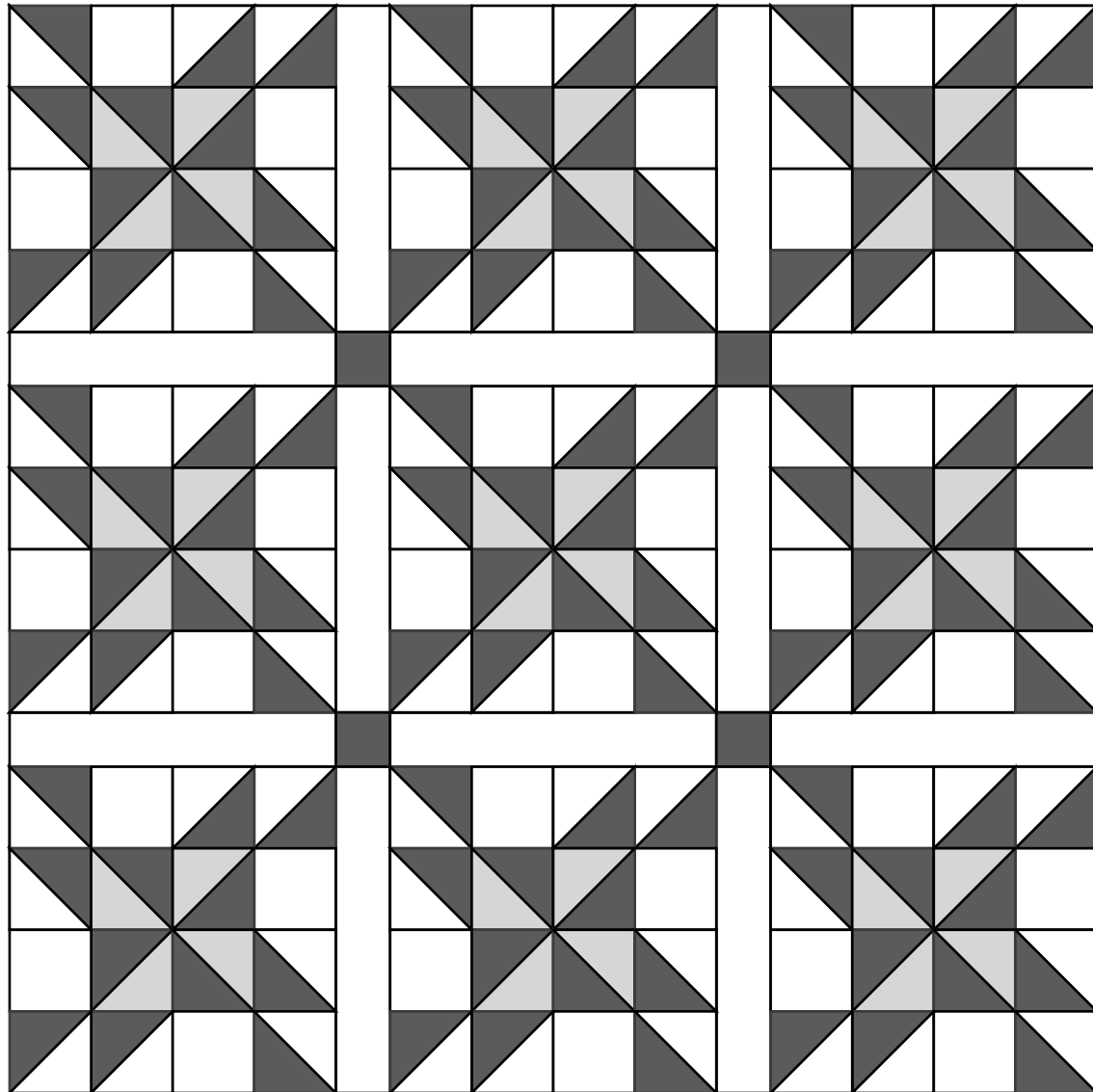
IN the Quilt it is finished size 12" x 12"

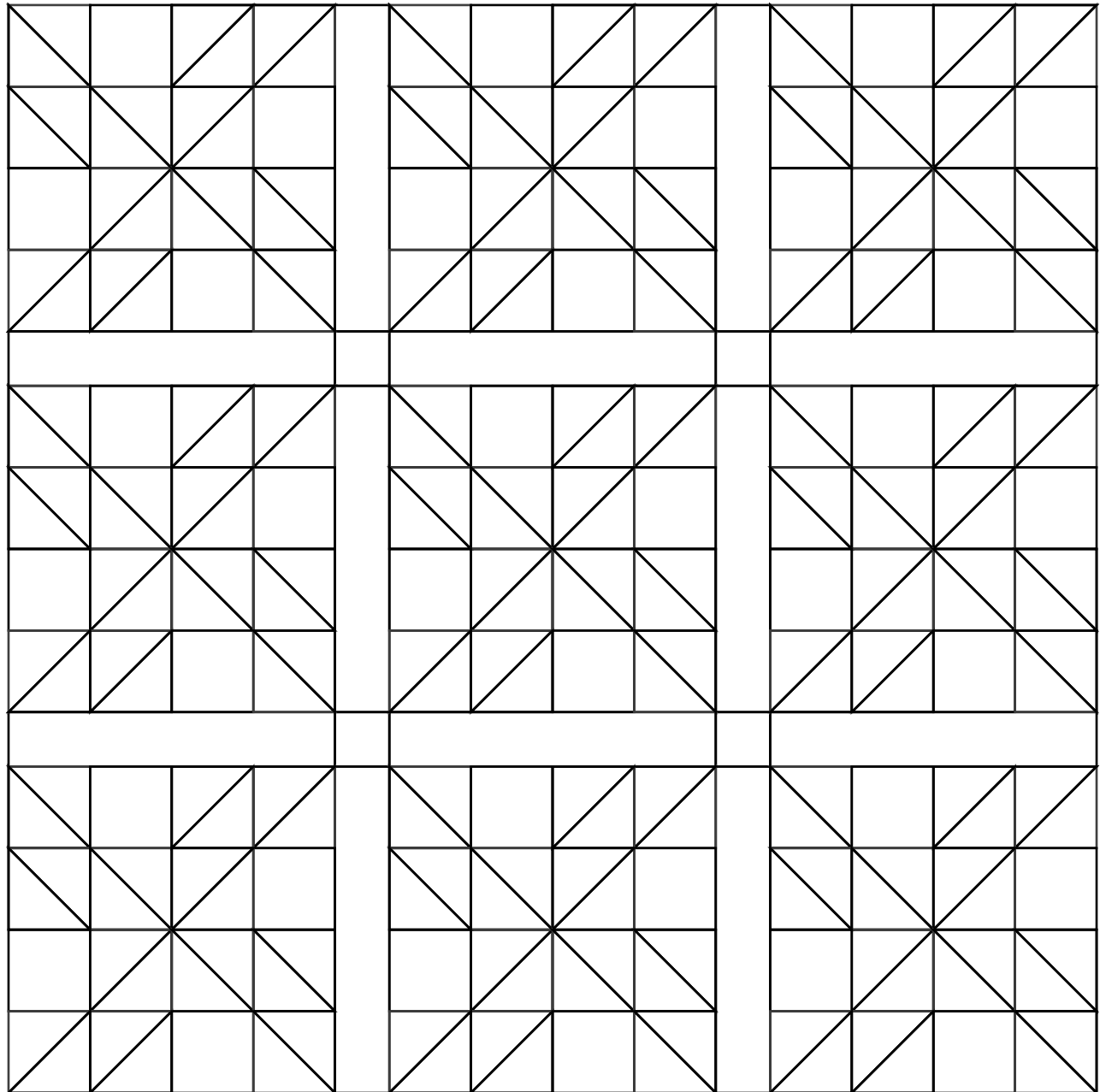


**Block 6 – Sorry! BONUS PROJECT using  
40.5” x 40.5” - 9 Blocks  
Cut 12 sashing 2.5” x 12.5”  
Cut 4 corners stones 2.5” x 2.5”**

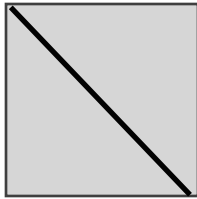

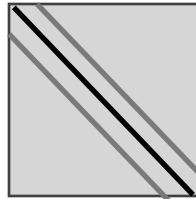
## Half Square Triangles Tutorial

"Pat Sloan's Teach Me to Sew Triangles"**



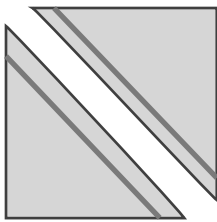
**Step 1**

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



**Step 2**

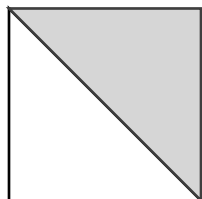
- Layer the 2 squares  
- Sew a 1/4" seam on both Sides of the drawn line



**Step 3**

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

**Step 4**



-Trim squares to size needed using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
