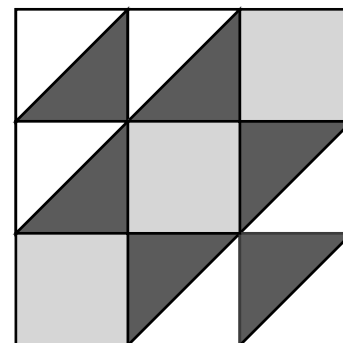

Finished size 12" x 12"

### Cutting Directions

#### Light fabrics

– Cut 3 squares 5" x 5" for Half Square Triangles (HST)

#### Medium fabrics

– Cut 3 squares 4.5" x 4.5"

#### Dark Fabric

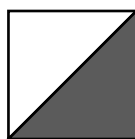
– Cut 3 squares 5" x 5" for Half Square Triangles (HST)

### Directions

Using the 5" Light and dark fabric squares make HSTs using method on my HST sheet at the end

trim to 4.5" square

Make 6 units

Make 1

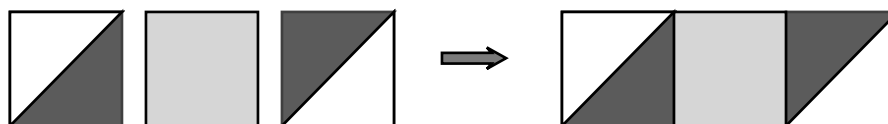
Measures 4.5" x 12.5"

Make 1

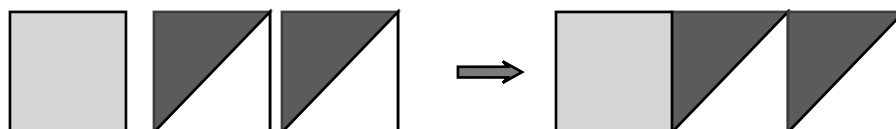
Measures 4.5" x 12.5"



4) Following the diagram, Assemble the bottom Row

Make 1

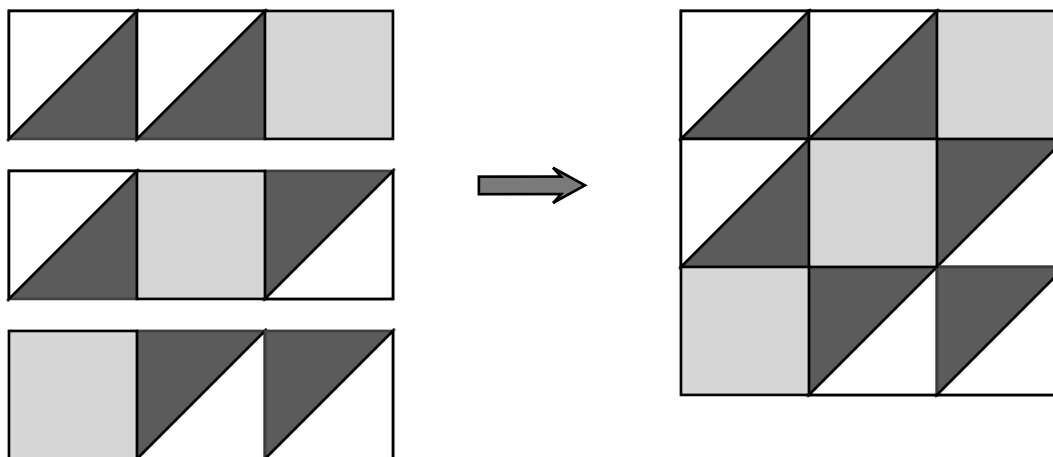
Measures 4.5" x 12.5"



5) Following the diagram, Assemble the rows in the block.

Make 1

Measures 12.5" x 12.5"

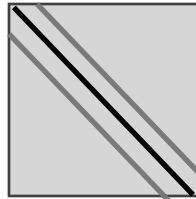

## Half Square Triangles Tutorial



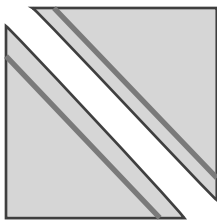
**Step 1**

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



**Step 2**

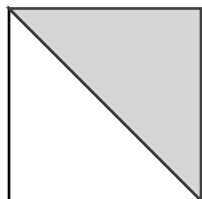
- Layer the 2 squares  
- Sew a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on both Sides of the drawn line



**Step 3**

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

**Step 4**



-Trim squares to size on the Pattern using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
