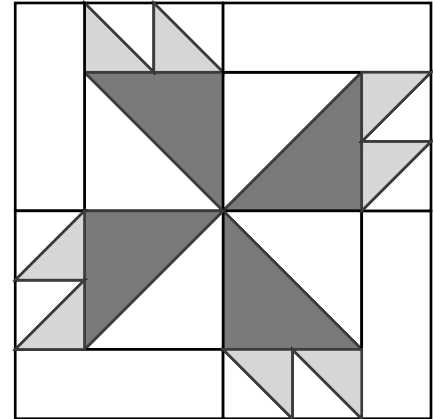
Have you made a quilt from ties? There are so many ways we can do that, I enjoy the creativity of quilters!

UNFINISHED Block is 12.5" x 12.5"
Finished in the quilt is Size 12"

Cutting & Sewing

Light Fabric

- Cut 4 squares 3" x 3" for HST
- Cut 2 squares 5" x 5" for HST
- Cut 4 rectangles 2.5" x 6.5"

Medium Fabric

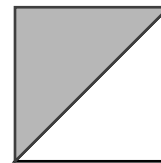
- Cut 4 squares 3" x 3" for HST

Dark Fabric

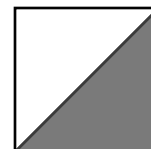
- Cut 2 squares 5" x 5" for HST

Directions

1) Sew the 3" medium and 3" light squares
Using HST method on last page.
Make 8 units - trim to 2.5" square



2) Sew the 5" dark and 5" light squares
Using HST method on last page.
Make 4 units - trim to 4.5" square

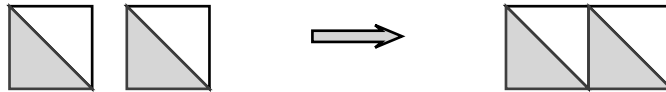

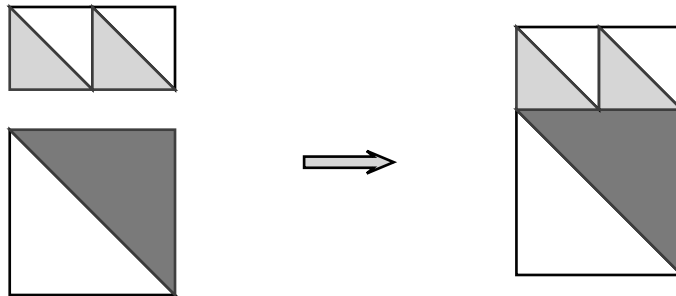

Directions

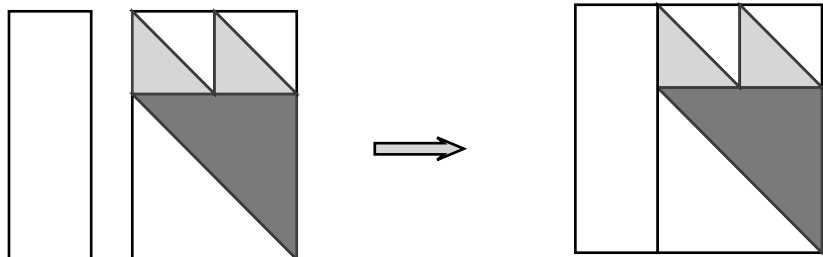
- 3) Following the diagram Sew 2 Medium HST units together
Make 4
Measures 2.5" x 4.5"



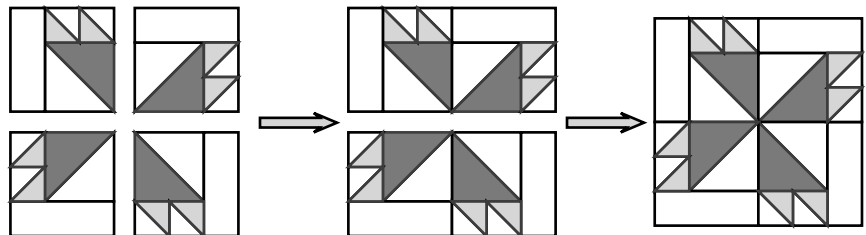
- 4) Following the diagram Sew a Dark/light HST to the unit from above
Make 4
Measures 4.5" x 6.5"



- 5) Following the diagram sew the rectangle to the side of the unit above.
Make 4
Measures 6.5" x 6.5"



- 6) Following the diagram sew the 4 units from above.
Make 1
Measures 12.5" x 12.5"

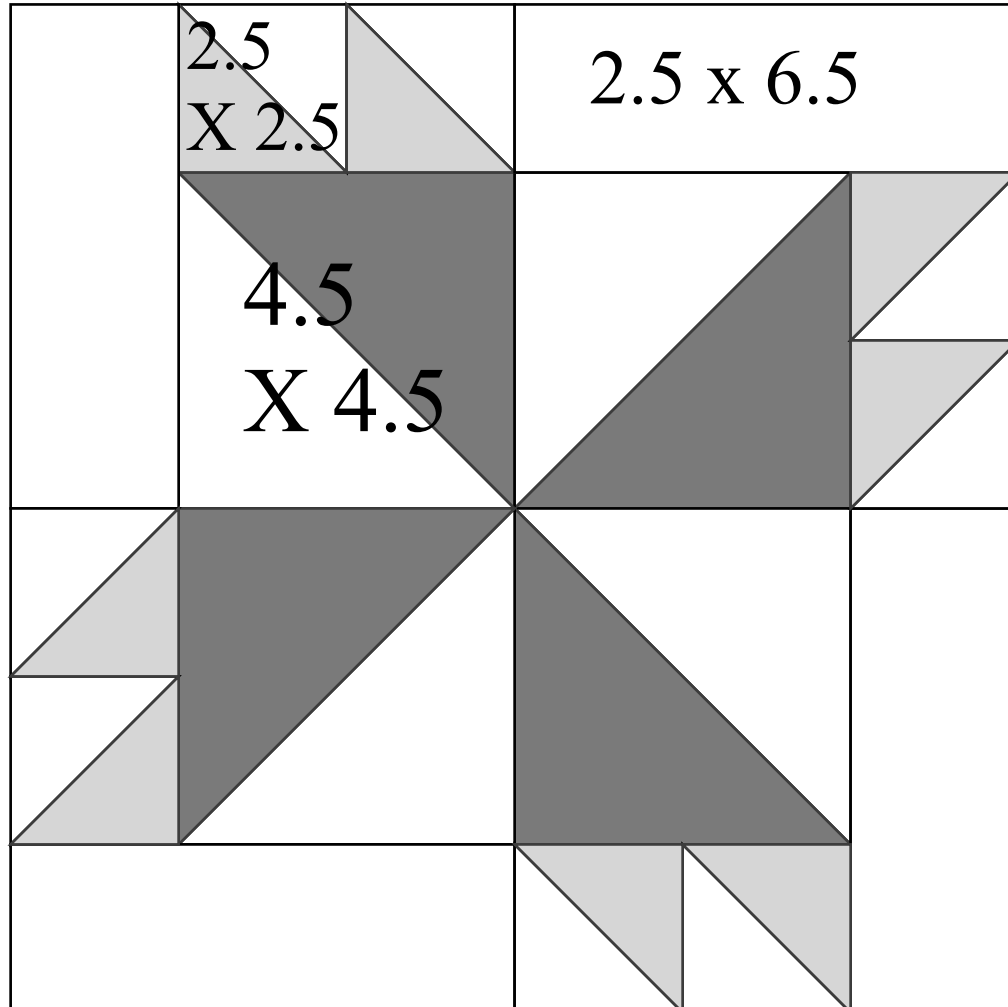

NOTE-

MAKE HST So they are the SIZE indicated using your favorite method



Square the Block to 12.5" x 12.5"

IN the Quilt it is finished size 12" x 12"

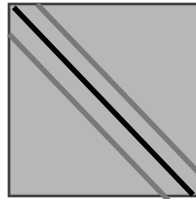
Half Square Triangles Tutorial

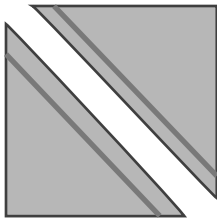
Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2

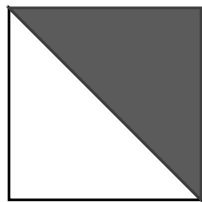
- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

Step 4



-Trim small squares to 2.5" x 2.5" using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.

- Trim large squares to 4.5" x 4.5"
