Block 7/9 – Sledding!

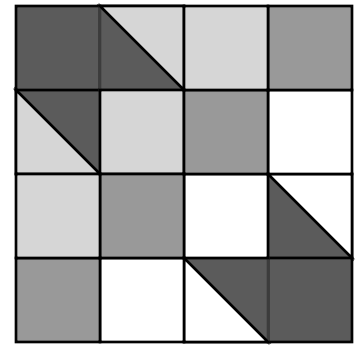

Block is 12.5" x 12.5"
Finished size 12" x 12"

Cutting Directions

Light fabric #1

- Cut 1 square 4" x 4" for Half Square Triangles (HST)
- Cut 3 squares 3.5" x 3.5"

Light fabric #2

- Cut 1 square 4" x 4" for Half Square Triangles (HST)
- Cut 3 squares 3.5" x 3.5"

Medium fabric

- Cut 4 squares 3.5" x 3.5"

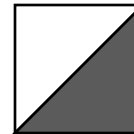
Dark Fabric

- Cut 2 squares 4" x 4" for Half Square Triangles (HST)
- Cut 2 squares 3.5" x 3.5"

Directions

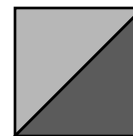
1) Using the 4" light #1 and 4" dark fabric squares make HSTs using method on my separate HST PDF sheet

trim to 3.5" square
Make 2 units



2) Using the 4" light #2 and 4" dark fabric squares make HSTs using method on my separate HST PDF sheet

trim to 3.5" square
Make 2 units

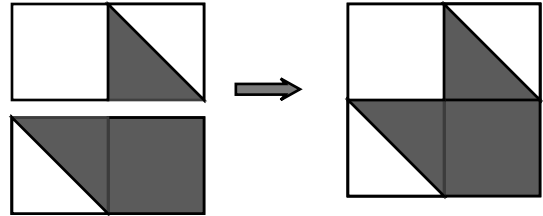

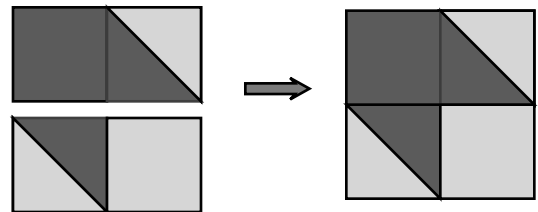

Directions

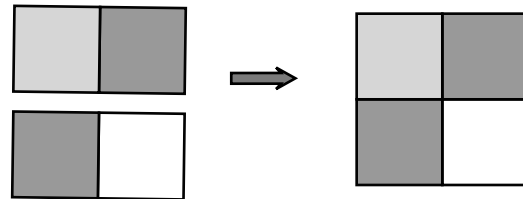
- 3) Following the diagram, use both HST with Light #1 fabric, a dark square and a light #1 square
Measures 6.5" x 6.5"
Make 1



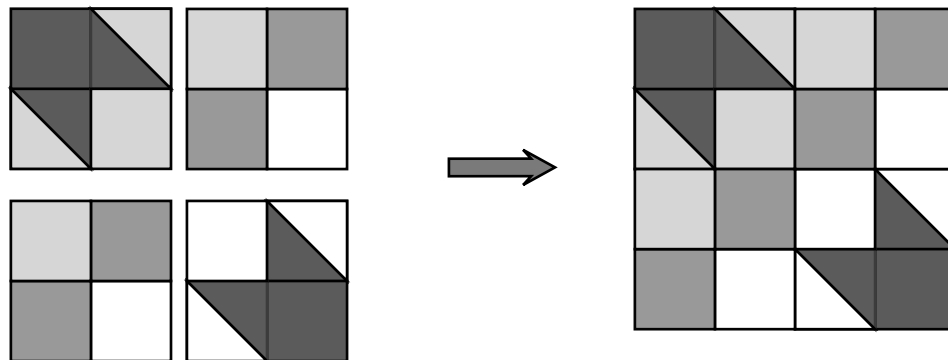
- 4) Following the diagram, use both HST with Light #2 fabric, a dark square and a light #2 square
Measures 6.5" x 6.5"
Make 1



- 5) Following the diagram, sew a 4 patch with 1 light #1, 1 Light #2 and 2 Medium squares
Measures 6.5" x 6.5"
Make 2



- 6) Following the diagram, Assemble the block by sewing the units together
Measures 12.5" x 12.5"
Make 1

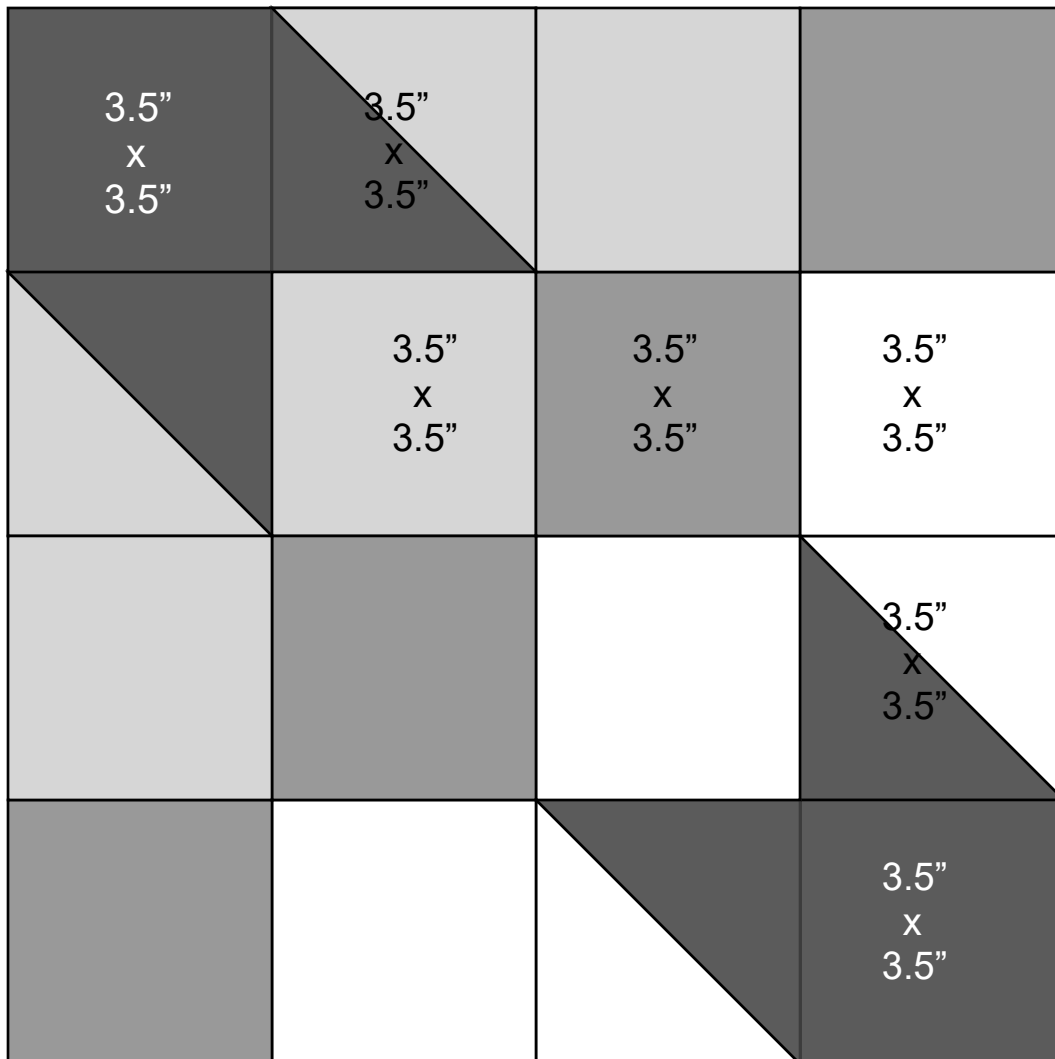

Block is 12.5" x 12.5"

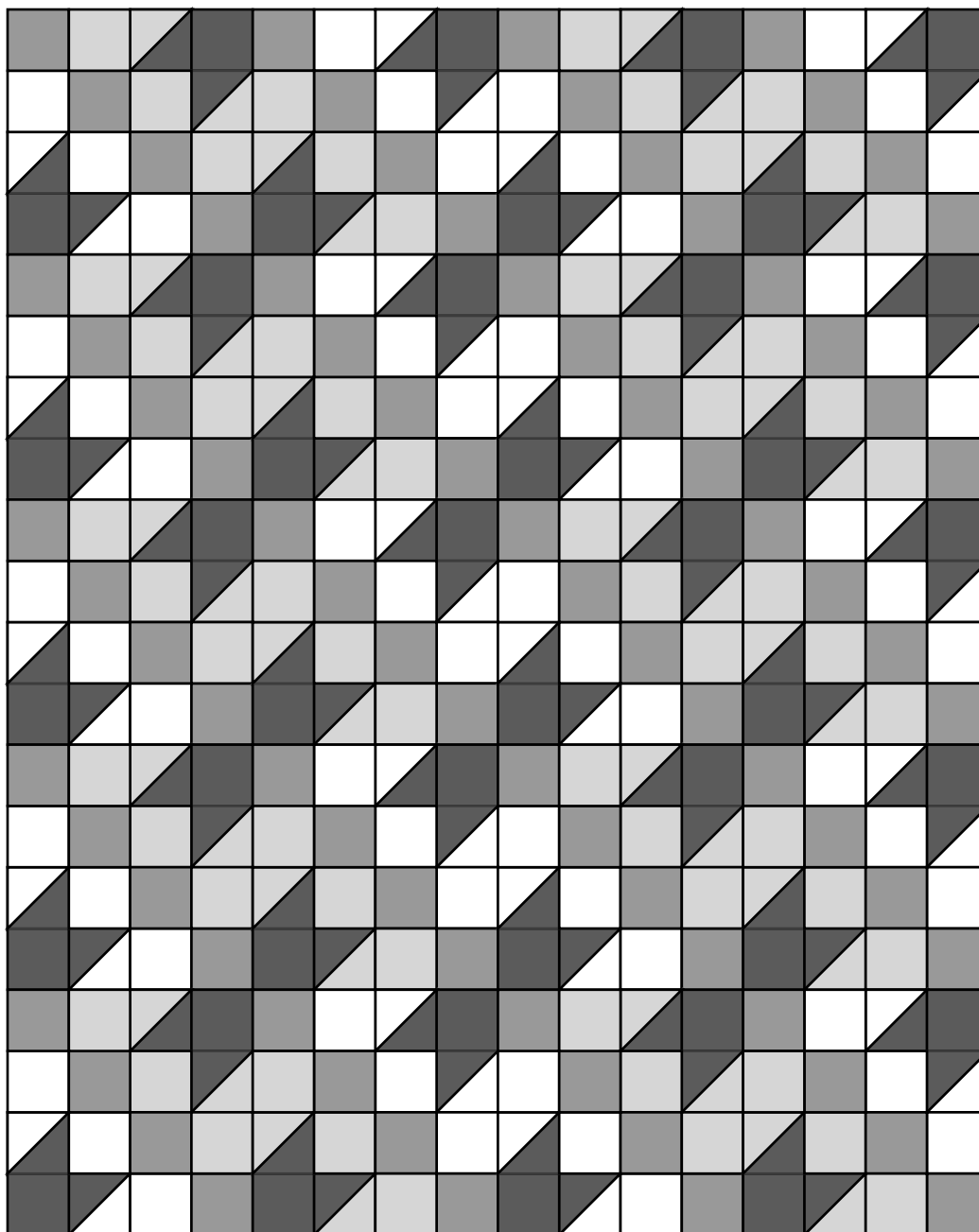
IN the Quilt it is finished size 12" x 12"

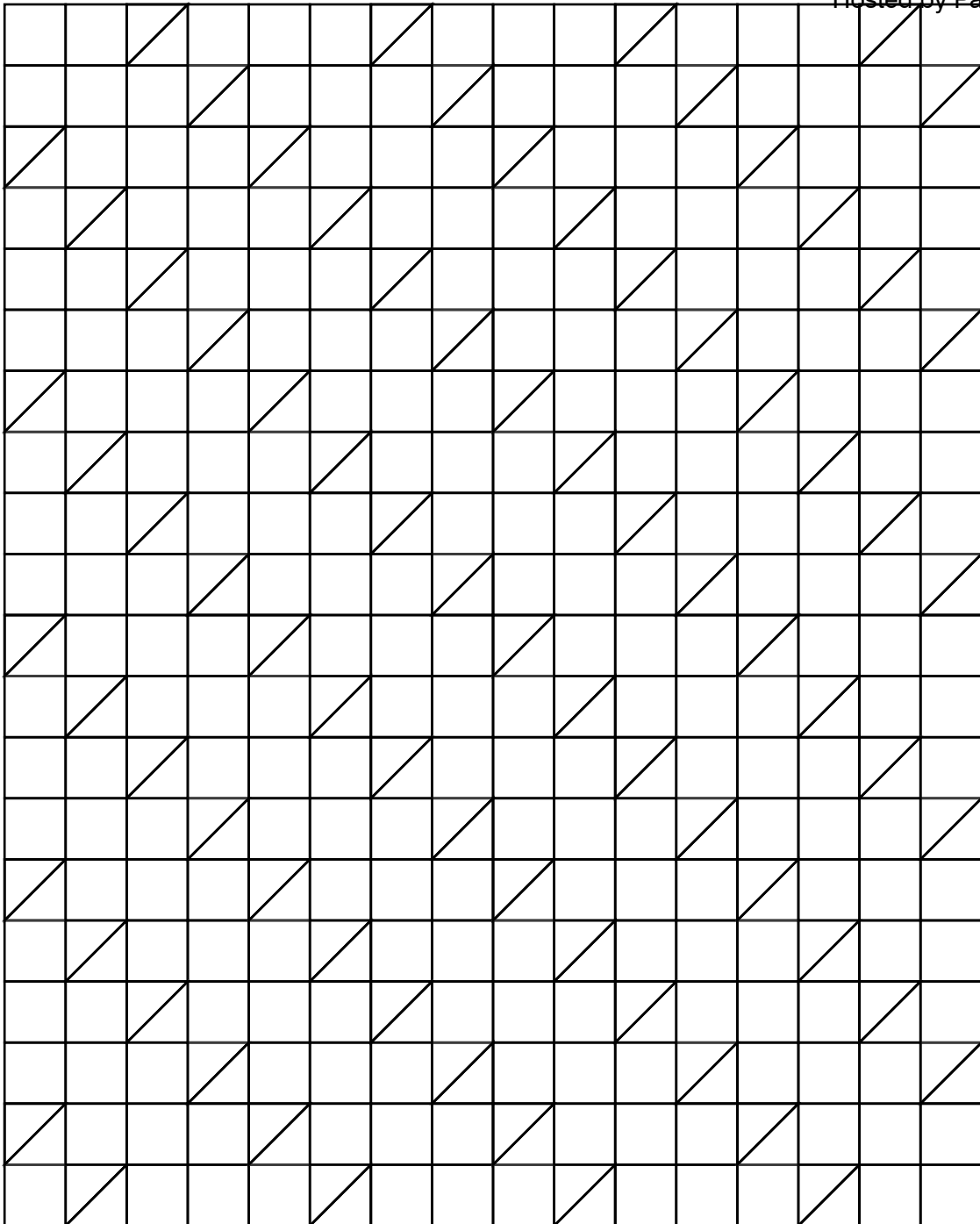

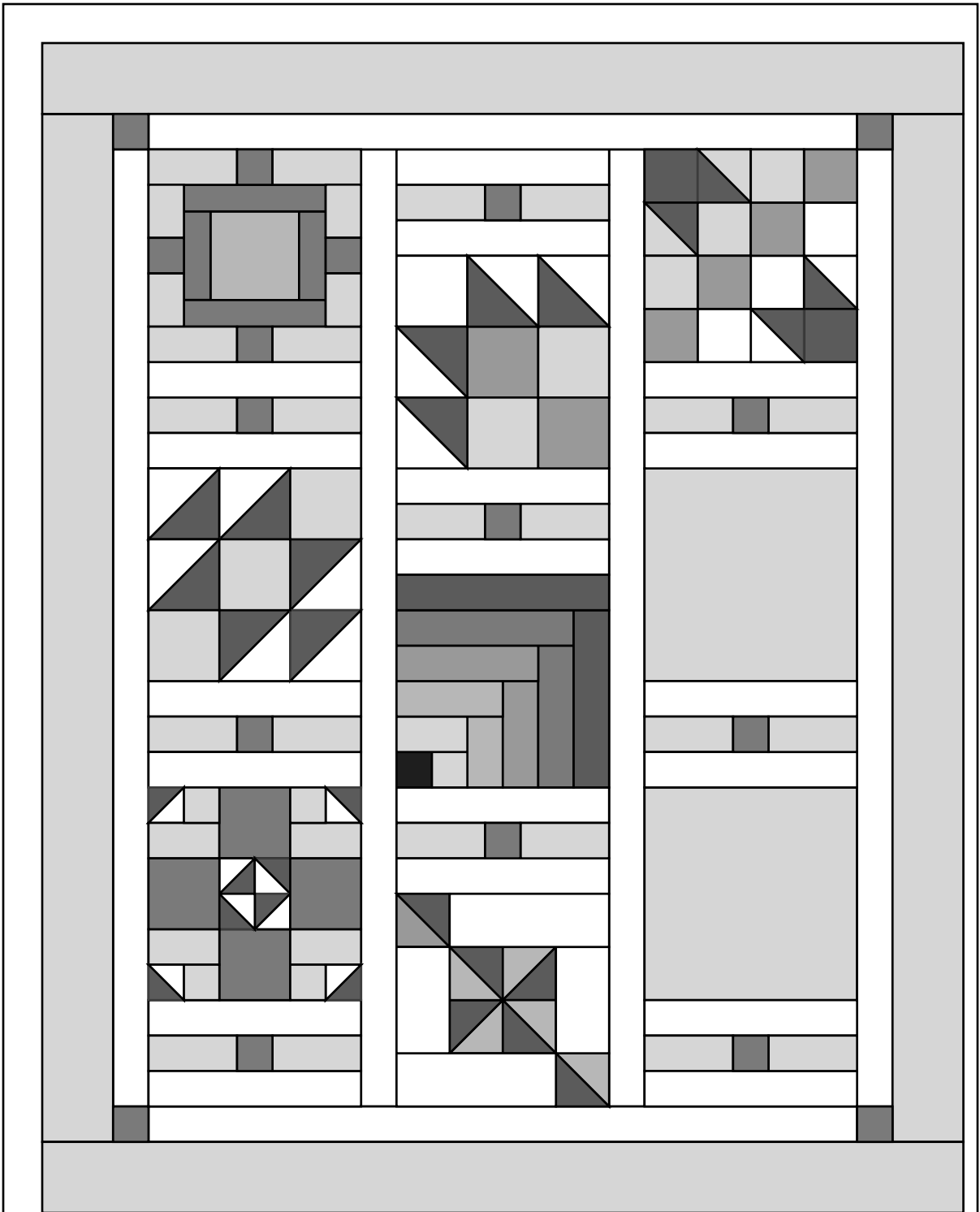
