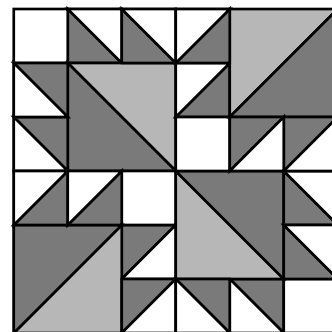

Block is 12.5" x 12.5"
Finished size 12" x 12"

Cutting Directions

Light or Background fabrics

- Cut 8 squares 3" x 3" for (Half square triangles HST)
- Cut 4 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

Medium fabrics

- Cut 2 squares 5" x 5" for (Half square triangles HST)

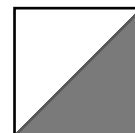
Dark fabrics

- Cut 2 squares 5" x 5" for (Half square triangles HST)
- Cut 8 squares 3" x 3" for (Half square triangles HST)

Directions

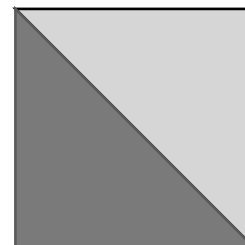
1) Using a 3" Light and a 3" dark fabric square make HSTs using method on my separate HST PDF sheet at the end

trim to 2.5" square
Make 16 units



2) Using a 5" medium and a 5" dark fabric square make HSTs using method on my separate HST PDF sheet at the end

trim to 4.5" square
Make 4 units

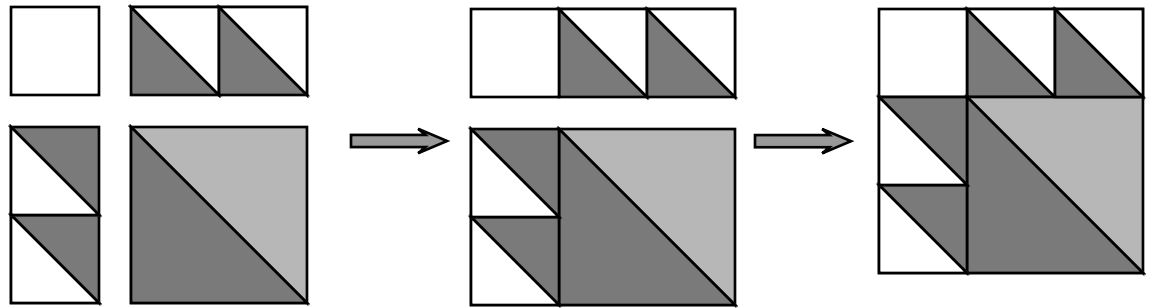

3) Following the diagram sew the unit using a 2.5" Light square, 4 HST 2.5" x 2.5" and one 4.5" HST

Measures 6.5" x 6.5" square

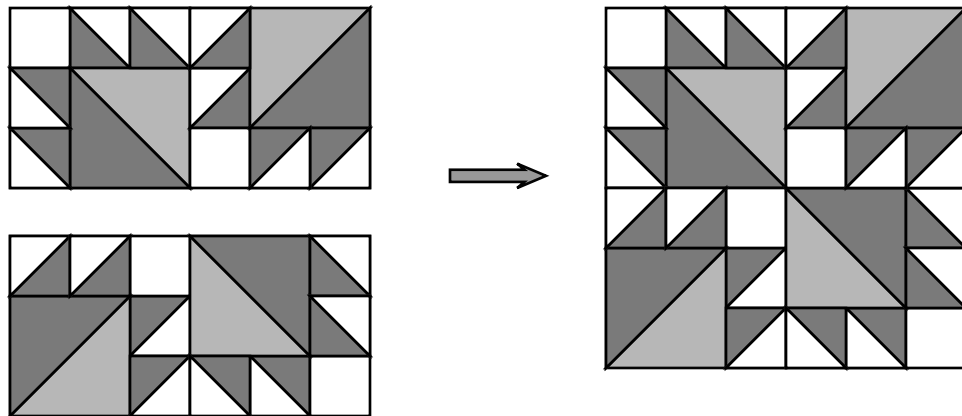
Make 4 units



4) Following the diagram, Assemble the block using units from the step above.

Make 1

Measures 12.5" x 12.5"

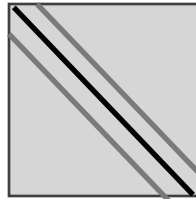
Half Square Triangles Tutorial

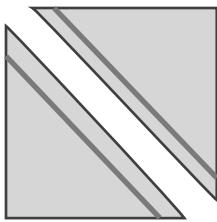
Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares



Step 2

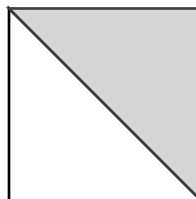
- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a 1/4" seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST

Step 4



-Trim squares to size using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
