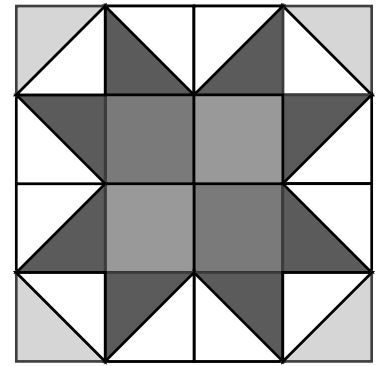


# WINTER FUN!

There is nothing better than flopping down to make snow angels after a beautiful layer of fresh snow! Wave your arms back and forth, then have someone 'help you up' so that you don't make a mess of your creation! Then your little brother immediately runs through it.. Grrr! ALL great memories!



**Block is 12.5" x 12.5"**  
Finished size 12" x 12"

On the other side of that beautiful snow is a snow fort built to withstand the battery of snowballs thrown by the opposing team. When I was a kid in New Jersey we had a LOT of snow and made a LOT of forts!

This is block 9 and we are done with Winter Fun! Time to finish up your top and get it quilted so you can enjoy it this winter. My next Block Wednesday starts Jan 1, 2020!

### Cutting Directions

#### Light fabric #1

– Cut 6 squares 4" x 4" for  
Half Square Triangles (HST)

#### Light Fabric #2

– Cut 2 squares 4" x 4" for  
Half Square Triangles (HST)

#### Medium fabric #1

– Cut 2 squares 3.5" x 3.5"

#### Medium fabric #2

– Cut 2 squares 3.5" x 3.5"

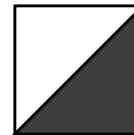
#### Dark Fabric

– Cut 4 squares 4" x 4" for  
Half Square Triangles (HST)

### Directions

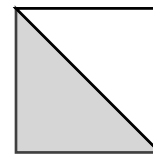
1) Using the 4" dark and 4" light #1 fabric squares  
make HSTs using method on my separate HST  
PDF sheet

trim to 3.5" square  
Make 8 units



2) Using the 4" light #1 and 4" light #2 fabric squares  
make HSTs using method on my separate HST  
PDF sheet

trim to 3.5" square  
Make 4 units

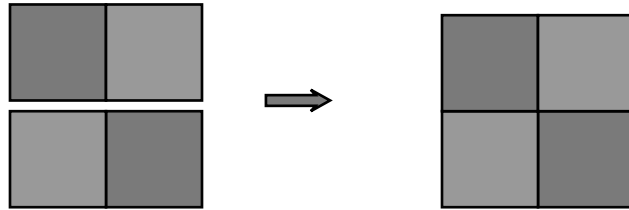

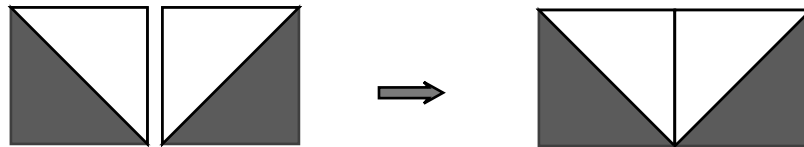

## Directions

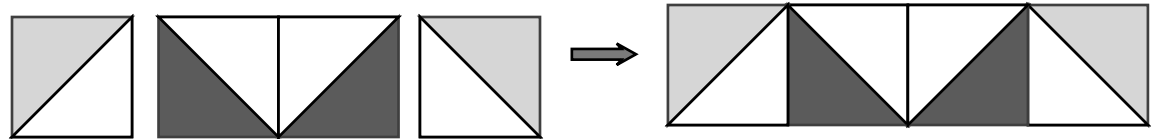
- 3) Following the diagram, sew a 4 patch with 2 medium #1 and 2 medium #2 squares  
Measures 6.5" x 6.5"  
Make 1



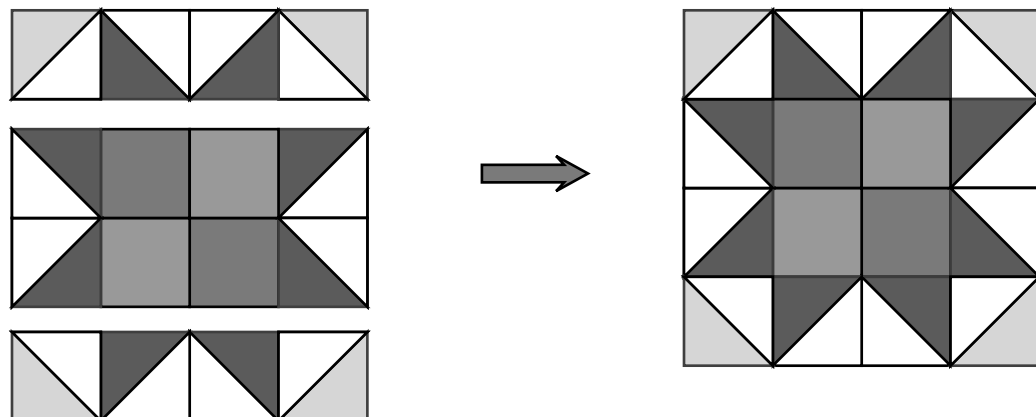
- 4) Following the diagram, Assemble the Star points units  
Measures 3.5" x 6.5"  
Make 4



- 5) Following the diagram, Assemble the top and bottom rows by using the Light HST units  
Measures 3.5" x 12.5"  
Make 2



- 6) Following the diagram, Assemble the block by sewing the units together  
Measures 12.5" x 12.5"  
Make 1

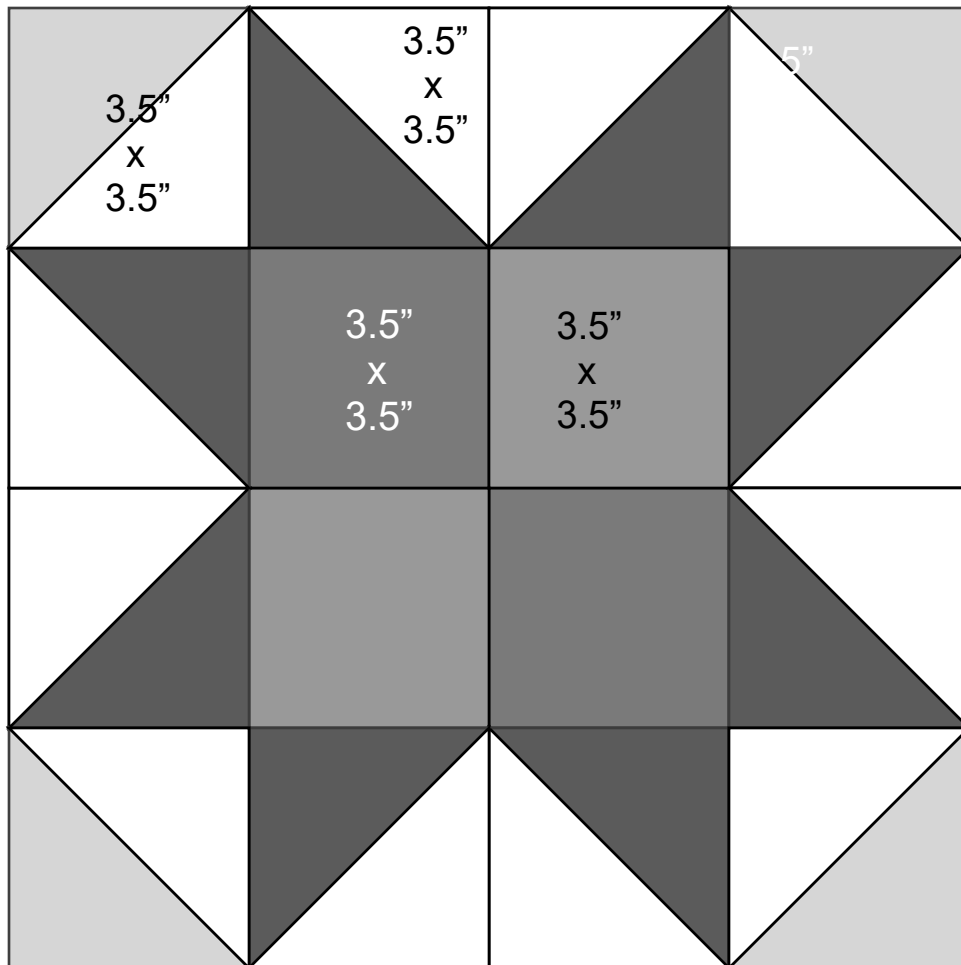

## Unfinished / CUTTING Sizes

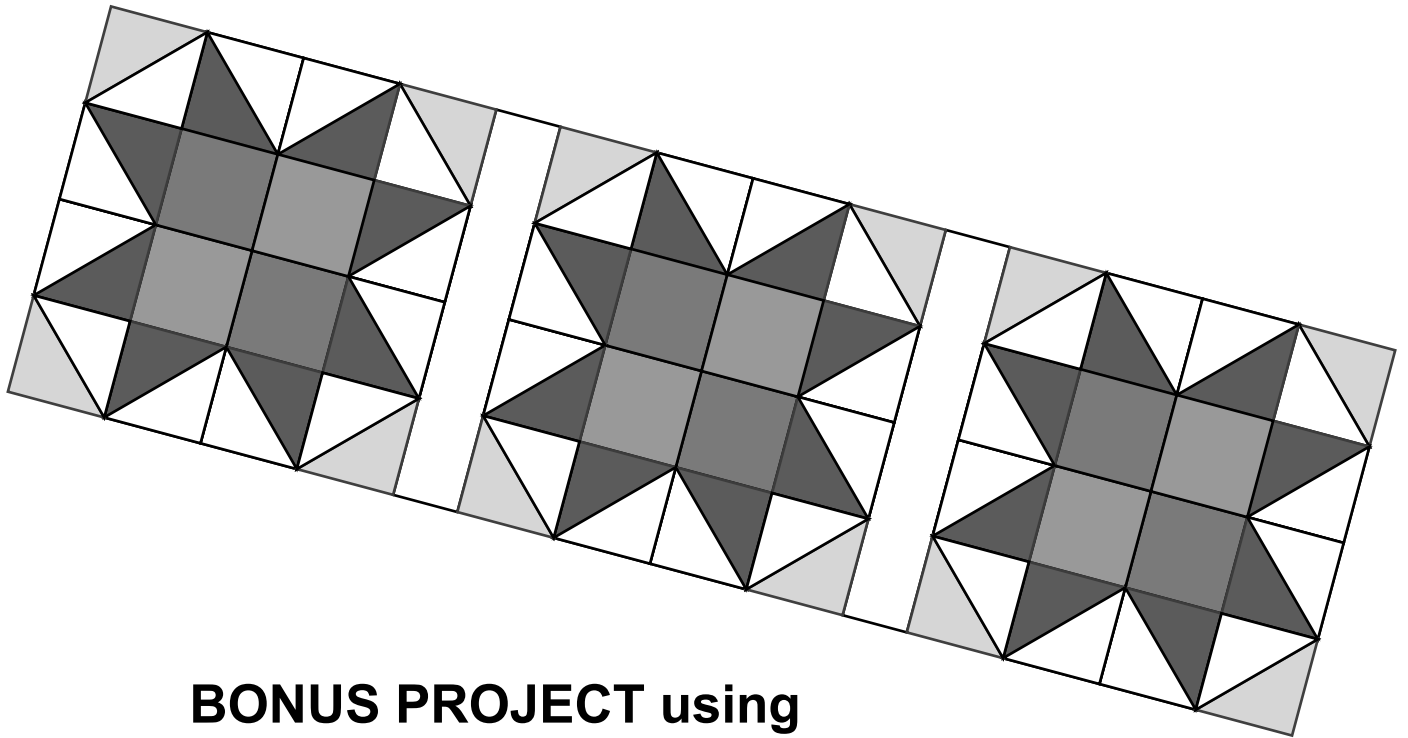

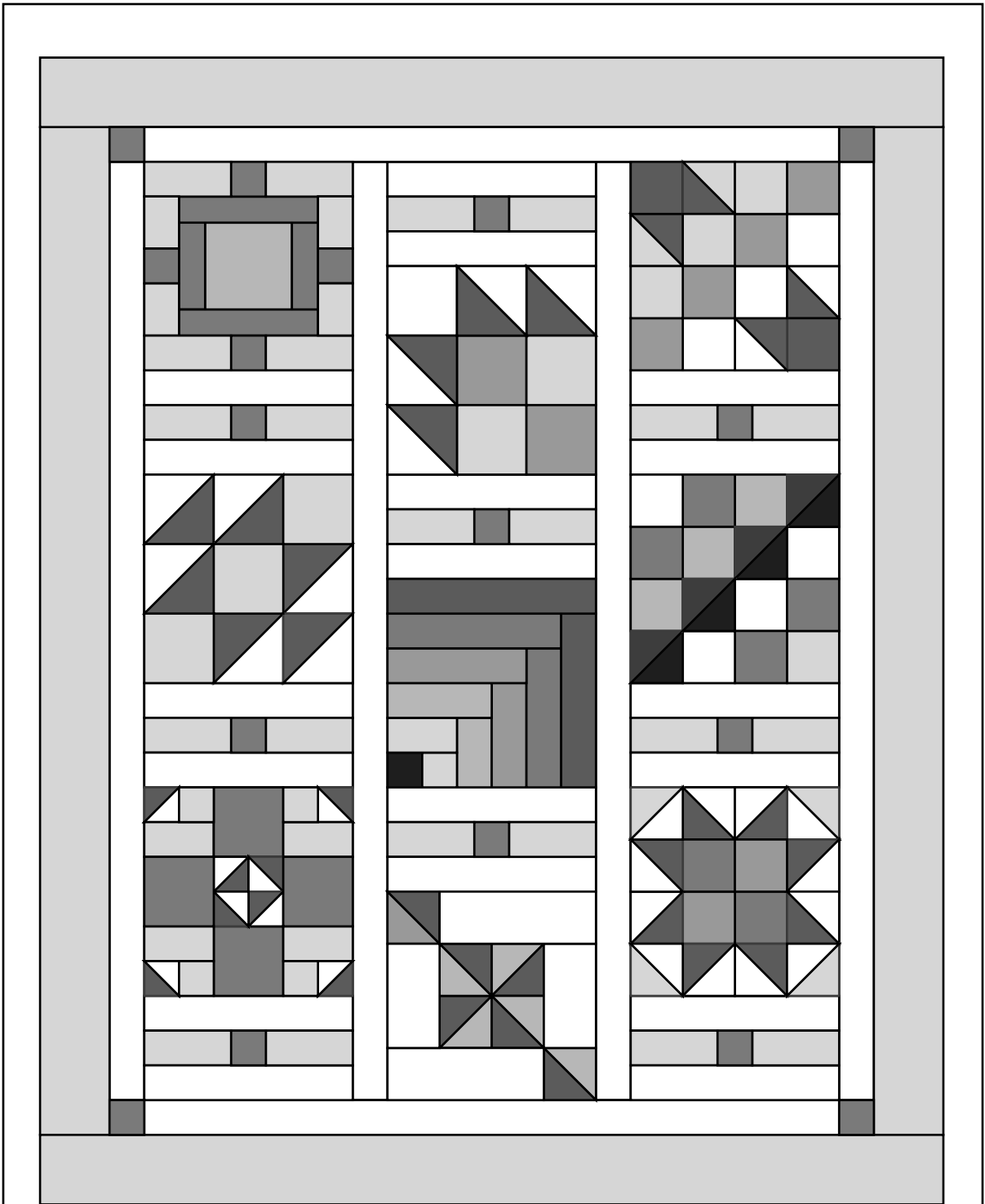


## BONUS PROJECT using
