

## Cutting Directions

### Black print 1

Cut 2 rectangles 6 1/2" x 9 1/2"

### Black print 2

Cut 2 rectangles 6 1/2" x 9 1/2"

### Orange print

Cut 1 strip 2 1/2" x 21 1/2"

Cut 1 strip 2 1/2" x 17 1/2"

Cut 6 squares 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"

### Purple Print

Cut 6 squares 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"

### Make 11 quarter square blocks

-On the wrong side of the orange square draw a diagonal line going both directions.

-Lay the orange square on the black square, right sides together.

-Sew on both sides of ONE drawn line (see diagram).

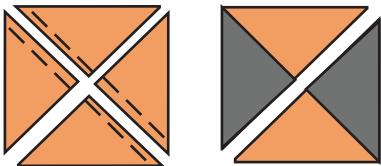
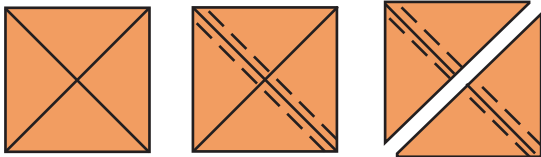
-Cut on other drawn line.

-Cut between the sewn lines.

-Press open

-Sew the Quarter squares alternating black/orange (see diagram).

-Trim to 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares

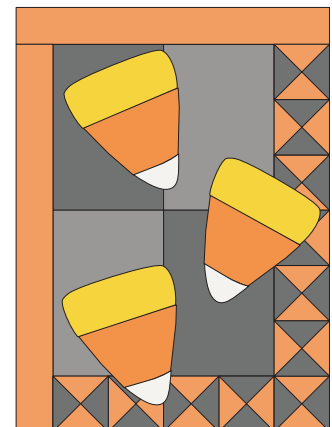
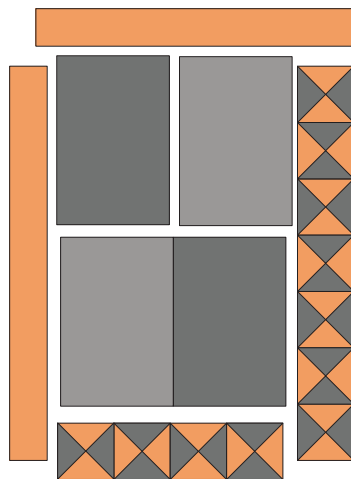


(Note - there are 2 pieces left over)

### Finish

-Sew the Top following the diagram.

-Applique the Candy Corns (tuck the dotted line area under the shape above)

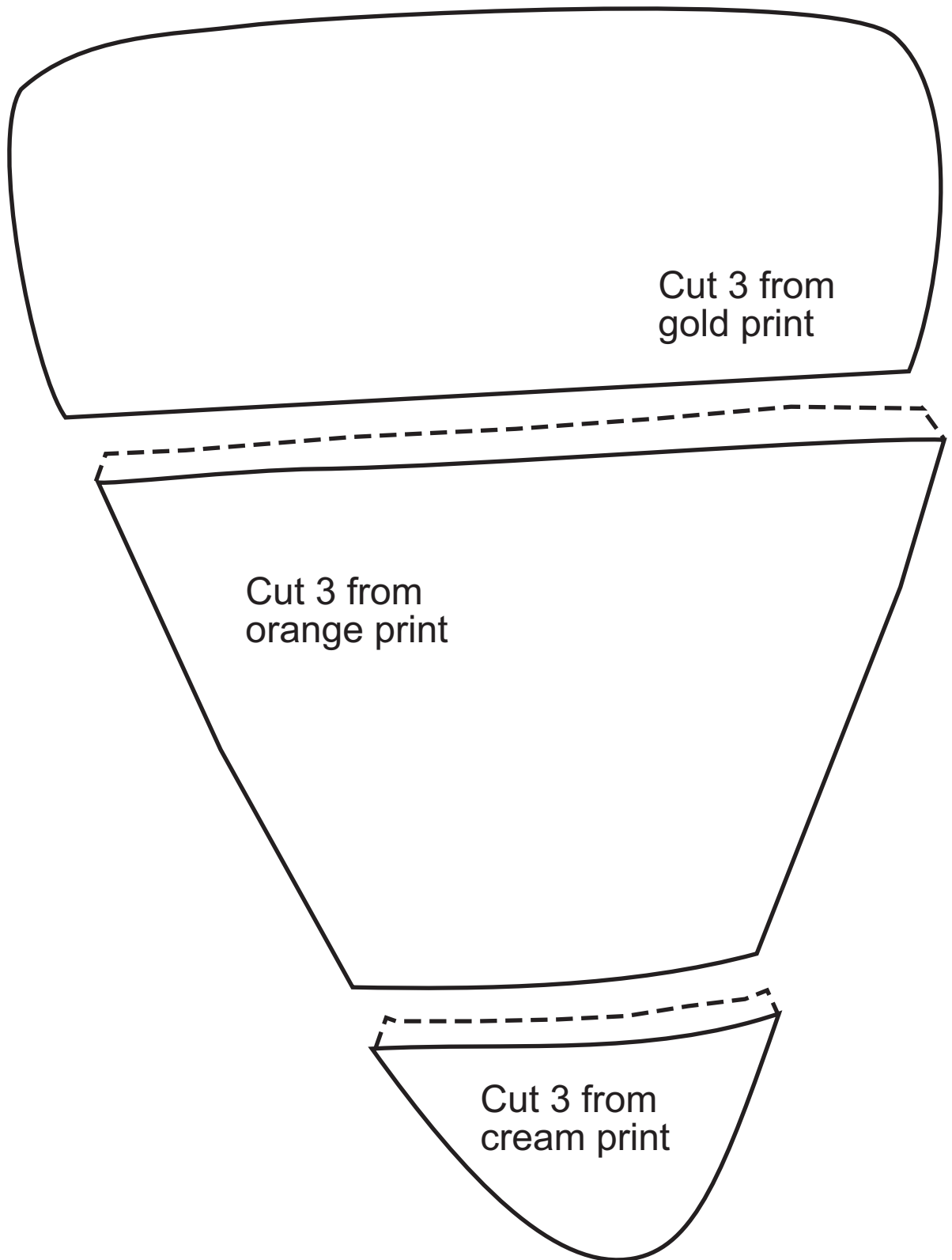
