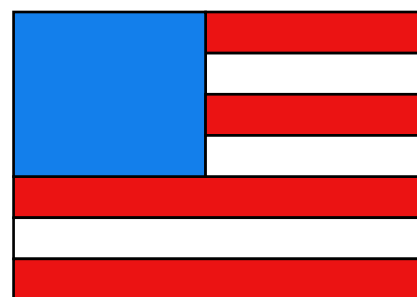

## Grand Ole Flag

Finished Sizes  
Single Flag 10.5" x 15"  
Full Quilt 53" x 52"



## Cutting & Sewing

### White Fabrics - Total 1 yd

- Cut 24 rectangles 2" x 8.5"
- Cut 12 rectangles 2" x 15.5"

### Red Fabric - Total 1 ¼ yd

- Cut 24 rectangles 2" x 8.5"
- Cut 24 rectangles 2" x 15.5"

### Navy Fabric - Total 2/3 yd

- Cut 12 rectangles 6.5" x 7.5"

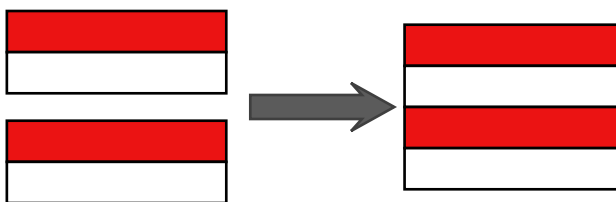
### Setting fabric + binding 1 1/2yd

You can cut sashing length of fabric with no piecing

- Cut 8 rectangles 2.5" x 11"
- Cut 5 rectangles 2.5" x 49.5"
- Cut 2 rectangles 2.5" x 52.5"

### Directions

- 1) Sew the short Red & white strips to each other  
Make 12 units - 6.5" x 8.5"



- 2) Sew the long Red & white strips to each other  
Make 12 units - 5" x 15.5"



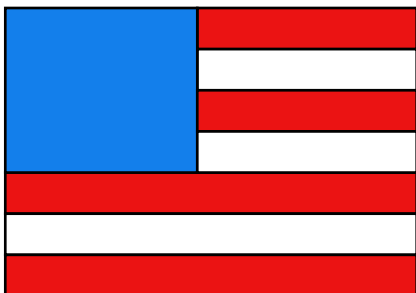
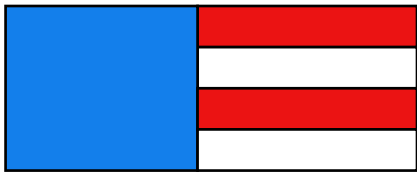

## Directions

- 3) Sew the Blue rectangle to the short stripes  
Make 12 units - 6.5" x 15.5"



- 4) Sew the flags  
Make 12 - 11" x 15.5"

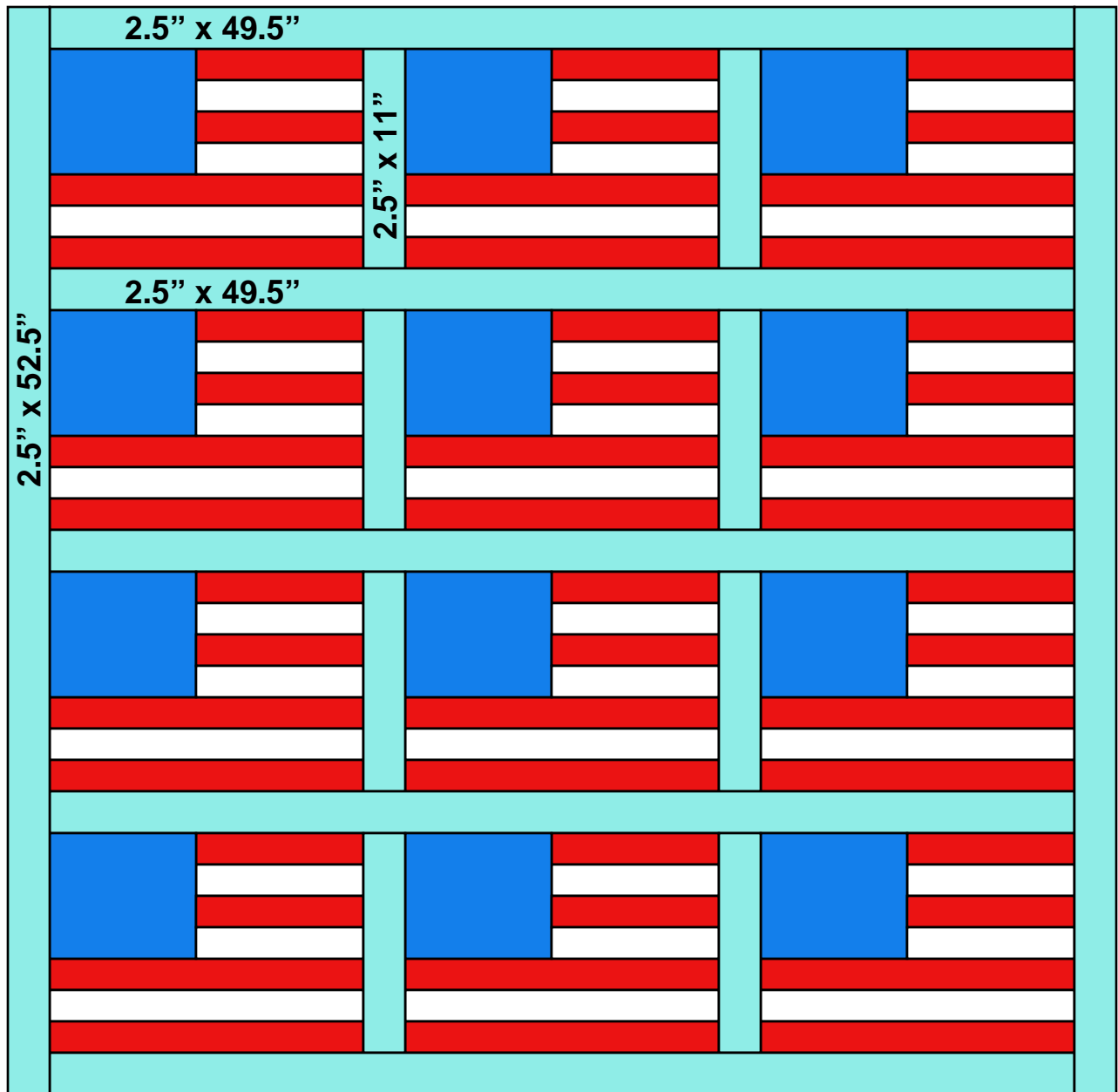
